Program is celebrating its 125th season dating back to 1892.

Making first NCAA Semifinals Appearance since 1991; a win would earn SU its first-ever national championship game berth

Set program record for 12 wins in one season, topping the previous mark of 11 set by the NCAA-bound 1986 and 1991 teams. Three NCAA Playoff wins are the most ever in one season in program history.

Ranked 12th in D3football.com Preseason Poll, never fell in either the D3football.com or AFCA national rankings all season. Highest rank ever was 4th in 1991.

Reached 500 all-time program wins after beating Wilkes 48-21 on Oct. 26

Members of Landmark Conference since league added football in 2023. Prior to that Susquehanna was members of the Centennial Conference (2010-22, winning 2022 league title), Liberty League (2007-09, winning 2009 league title), and Middle Atlantic Conference from 1958 to 2006.

Team has compiled 51 wins over last five seasons, winning at least ten games in four of them (2019, 2022, 2023, 2024). This year's senior class are 41-5 in their River Hawks career.

This year's tournament run is a direct result of resilience after Susquehanna hosted and lost its previous two first-round NCAA playoff games, suffering a 17-10 defeat to Utica in 2022 and a heartbreaking 21-20 loss in last-minute fashion to Grove City in 2023. Susquehanna's NCAA playoff record is currently 6-5.

#14 Josh Ehrlich, Quarterback

First Susquehanna quarterback ever with at least 3,000 passing yards in one season and at least 30 touchdown passes in one season

Favored the run in 2023, but focused on his passing game ahead of the 2024 season to turn in the finest passing performance in team history.

Was a quarterback in high school before deciding to convert to receiver at SU

#28 Rahshan La Mons, Running Back

Burst onto the scene in season-opening 41-7 win vs. Bridgewater in a Landmark Offensive Player of the Week performance; highlight was 86-yard screen pass TD

Turned in the longest play from scrimmage in school history with a 96-yard touchdown run against Juniata on Oct. 19

Three punt return touchdowns this season, including two against Keystone on Oct. 12, covering 73 yards and 72 yards, respectively

#92 Dominic Bourgeois, Kicker

Primarily a kickoff specialist, added placekicking duties halfway through the season from Christian Colasurdo

Connected on 5-of-5 field goals, including a career-high of 43 yards at St. John's in NCAA Third Round and then making the game-winner as time expired from 37 yards out in a 41-38 victory.

Tom Perkovich, Head Coach

Second all-time in career wins with a 73-21 career mark, trailing just his predecessor Steve Briggs' 127-126 career record from 1990-2014. First with .761 win pct.

Named head coach in 2015 after successful coaching run as assistant at Muhlenberg College from 2003-04, 2006-14. Served as offensive coordinator from 2010-14 after serving as running backs coach from 2003-04 and returning as offensive line coach and special teams coordinator from 2006-10.

Between stints at Muhlenberg was Tight Ends Coach at Holy Cross in 2005 and briefly at Colgate University as Running Backs Coach in 2006.

Known as "Coach Perk". Birthday was on December 18. He and his wife Brandi have been married since 2010 and have three children: Georgia, Trey, and Reed.

Two-sport athlete at Canisius College in Buffalo, NY near his hometown of Tanawanda, NY. Played football and basketball; football program at Canisius was discontinued in 2002. Coach Perk's senior season. Graduated in 2003. Was an offensive lineman for the Golden Griffins, earning All-MAAC and Division I-AA Mid Major All-American from the Football Gazette.

About Susquehanna University

Founded in 1858. Enrollment is 2,200. Located in Selinsgrove, PA, about an hour north of state capital Harrisburg and 45 minutes south of Williamsport, home to the Little League World Series. Just off the Susquehanna River, hence the name.

Athletics team name was "Crusaders" before changing to "River Hawks" in 2015.

Doug Arthur Stadium, which opened in 2000, is a football-only field with an outdoor track. Has hosted many notable football games and track and field meets. Stadium underwent renovations in 2022-23 that included a new video board and turf field. Sassafras Multipurpose Field is home to soccer, lacrosse, and field hockey, offering ample practice and playing time for all outdoor sports.

#6 FOOTBALL BEATS HOBART 42-35 IN NCAA SECOND ROUND GAME

SELINGSGROVE, PA - The #6 Susquehanna football team broke through and won its first national playoff game in over three decades Saturday, using a big first half to push themselves to a 42-35 victory over Hobart in the second round of the NCAA Division III playoffs at Doug Arthur Stadium.

Getting the ball to start off the afternoon, the River Hawks rolled down the field on a long 10-play, 69-yard drive that culminated in a 4-yard touchdown pass thrown by Josh Ehrlich to Kyle Howes. Susquehanna (10-1) would score on all three of their next drives as well, with rookie sensation Rahshan La Mons trucking through a Hobart (9-2) defender on his way to an 18-yard score that capped off another long drive. Ehrlich would find another one of his favorite targets on the next drive, hitting Chris Bookter for a 20-yard score to give the hosts a three-score lead after a tip-drill interception by defensive back Dominic Winn. E.J. Taylor put the Statesmen, who qualified for the NCAA playoffs via winning the Liberty League, on the board with an explosive 74-yard touchdown run, which was quickly equalized on a 1-yard quarterback sneak by Ehrlich. The River Hawks led 28-7 at halftime.

Ehrlich continued to dominate in the second half, running for another 1-yard score on Susquehanna's opening drive of the half before tossing another touchdown pass to another unique wideout, this time from 17-yards out to Hunter Morgenroth, who finished the game as the River Hawks' leading receiver with 6 catches for 59 yards. Meanwhile, the Statesmen staged a valiant comeback attempt, coming within a single score of the River Hawks as Taylor ran for two more scores; Hobart quarterback Johnny Colombi also ran for a 12-yard score of his own and chucked a 25-yard touchdown pass to Luke Hescocock on what would prove to be the final score of the day.

After forcing the Statesmen to use all three of their timeouts, the River Hawks were faced with a crucial 3rd-and-9 at Hobart's 32-yard line. Ehrlich once again delivered in the clutch, finding tight end Michael Robbins open for an 18-yard grab that allowed Susquehanna to enter victory formation to kneel out the

rest of the clock. Ehrlich completed 16 of 21 passes for 198 yards, three touchdowns and zero interceptions. He also ran for 48 yards and the aforementioned two scores. La Mons finished as the team's leading rusher with a career-high 29 carries for 116 yards. Drew Robinson finished with a team-high 7 tackles while Jake Schultes delivered the pressure up front with 1.5 sacks.

The win is the program's first in national action since 1991, a 31-24 win over rival Lycoming in the quarterfinals. The then-Crusaders also defeated Dickinson in the first round that same season. It also continues Susquehanna's 19-game winning streak against unranked opponents.

Susquehanna will now travel to Colledgeville, Minnesota, next weekend to take on Saint John's (MN) in the third round of the NCAA playoffs at Clemens Stadium. The Johnnies defeated UW-La Crosse 24-13 on Saturday to secure their place in the next round and are the #1 team in the NCAA's National Power Index (NPI) rankings and are #3 in D3football.com's rankings.

FOOTBALL WALKS OFF ON A FIELD GOAL TO TOPPLE #3 ST. JOHN'S, ADVANCE TO NCAA QUARTERFINALS

COLLEGEVILLE, MINN. – A history-making play appeared to be in reach after Rahshan La Mons' 30-yard touchdown run gave sixth-ranked Susquehanna (10-1) a 38-24 lead on number-three and top-seeded St. John's (11-0) in the fourth quarter of the NCAA Championship Third Round game Saturday. The Johnnies, who are no strangers to the national stage with four national titles, answered the River Hawks' challenge with two unanswered touchdowns to tie the game at 38-38.

What St. John's didn't account for was the three-and-a-half minutes remaining that Susquehanna had to work in a game-winning drive. The maroon and orange converted on two third downs to keep the drive going, each done by a pair of 16-yard completions from quarterback Josh Ehrlich to Michael Robbins. Moving the ball down to the 20 yard line set up a 37-yard field goal from Dominic Bourgeois with two seconds remaining, which he calmly drilled to

FOOTBALL PREVAILS OVER BETHEL, ADVANCES TO NCAA SEMIFINALS

SELINGS GROVE, PA - Susquehanna University's football team played perhaps their grittiest second half all year long as they pulled out the best in themselves to defeat Bethel in last minute fashion Saturday, 24-21, to advance to the NCAA Division III Semifinals, marking the furthest the program has ever gotten that was matched only one other time by the 1991 team. The River Hawks only held the lead for 38 seconds, which happened to be the last 38 ticks of the contest after quarterback Josh Ehrlich fought his way across the goal line on a fourth and goal from the one yard line. Susquehanna moves on, traveling to North Central Saturday, Dec. 21.

Ehrlich opted to keep it himself, fighting through two Royals defenders and getting enough of the ball over the goal line to send Doug Arthur Stadium into a frenzy with a 24-21 lead. After a successful squib kick from Bourgeois set Bethel back to its own 27, Drews aired it out to get the Royals closer to a potential scoring opportunity with no timeouts, aided by a few clock stoppages on first downs. With five seconds left at Susquehanna's 30, Drews fired a prayer that found receiver Josh Kidder in the end-zone, but was called back due to a holding penalty. After an unsportsmanlike drew Bethel back to its own 45 for an untimed down, the Royals could only hope for a series of laterals to hit the mark, but was not realized.

Susquehanna, under tenth-year head coach Tom Perkovich, continue its historic run with the most wins ever in a season with a 12-1 record, topping the previous mark of 11 set by the 1986 and 1991 NCAA-bound teams. The program has also amassed 51 victories over the last five seasons, winning at least ten games four of those years. Waiting for them in the semifinals is a 13-0 Cardinals team that has reached the last four NCAA Division III national championship games, capturing the 2019 and 2022 national titles. They made it this far by hosting and defeating Whitworth 42-17, Hope 41-21, and Springfield after Saturday's 27-3 decision. On the other side of the bracket Mount Union is set to host Johns Hopkins Saturday, with the winners of both games heading to Houston, Tex. for the Stagg Bowl on Sunday, Jan. 5 from Shell Energy Stadium.

Howes and Booker each caught four passes, with Howes' last two receptions hauling his numbers up to 105 receiving yards. Booker's 18-yard touchdown reception highlighted a day where he totaled 53 yards. La Mons added three catches for 17 yards, while Sean Yamada, Hunter Morgenroth, and Surtz each had one catch. The defensive unit posted three sacks, including highlight-worthy solo sacks from Jake Schultes and Brian Layton, with Layton and Shane Quast combining for an additional hit on Drews. The River Hawks notched one turnover on the day when linebacker Drew Robinson forced a ball our after Drew found Micah Niewald for what appeared to be a first down, which was recovered by lineman Brandon Shipley. Robinson's day was also marked by six total tackles, including four solo and one breakup, while Shipley had four tackles. Safety Andrew Wells led the defensive squad with eight total tackles, including five solo with one breakup, while cornerback Steven Williams broke up two passes with seven total tackles, including six solo and two for loss. Linebackers Garrett Carter and Jesse Ruisch each logged seven tackles also, with Ruisch having six solo tackles and Carter three.

The senior receiver Howes now has 201 career receptions and 2,930 career receiving yards, second only to Mark Bartosic (2000-03) in both categories. He is currently tied with Bartosic's 2002 campaign for the second-most receptions in a season with 74, with Bartosic's 78 catches in 2003 standing as the record, while moving to second all-time also with 1,235 receiving yards. Ehrlich became the first Susquehanna quarterback ever to amass 3,000 yards passing with 3,079, along with tying the most completions in a campaign with 218 alongside Nick Crusco's 2017 numbers. His school record for passing touchdowns in a season swells up to 33. Bourgeois is now 5-for-5 on the year in field goals after assuming field goal duties halfway during the year. Schultes' sack racks up his sack total to 8.5 on the year and 17.5 for his career, while Layton's blindside sack and half a sack mounts his sack total to 5.5 on the season and 6.5 lifetime.

Founded in 1892 and in its 125th season, Susquehanna University football enters its second season in the Landmark Conference.

Susquehanna was an associate member of the Centennial Conference from 2010-22, capturing the conference title in 2022, and the Liberty League from 2007-2009, winning the league title in 2009. As a member of the Middle Atlantic Conference, the River Hawks won or shared four MAC titles from 1983-2006. Susquehanna posted a 70-26-2 record (.725 winning percentage) from 1981-1990, with two undefeated regular seasons and a trip to the 1986 NCAA Division III quarterfinals.

From 1991-2000, the team went 68-34-0 (.667) under former head coach Steve Briggs, winning the outright MAC title in 1999 after sharing the crown in 1998.

The highlight came in 1991 with an 11-2 record and coming within one game of the Division III championship game, named the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl after former Susquehanna coach Amos Alonzo Stagg Sr. "The Grand Old Man of Football" shared the head coach position with his son, Amos Jr., for six years (1947 to 1952).

STAGG FIELD AT DOUG ARTHUR STADIUM

Opened in 2000, the 3,500-seat stadium boasts a state-of-the-art ProGrass playing surface — replaced in the summer of 2023 — and has retained the familiar Stagg Field designation, while the installation of lights prior to the 2002 season permitted teams to play on-campus night games for the first time in program history. A video display board on the west end of the stadium, replaced prior to the 2022-23 academic year, is a state-of-the-art piece of equipment that few Division II or III schools in the country can duplicate.

THE STAGG STORY

During their six years as co-head coaches at Susquehanna, the Staggs led Susquehanna to a 21-19-3 record, although official NCAA records do not credit the elder Stagg with those 21 wins. If they were included, Stagg would be seventh on the NCAA's list of career coaching victories at the highest level (335). His 63-year coaching career is second only to John Gagliardi (64 years) in NCAA longevity.

Both Staggs were inducted into the Susquehanna Athletics Hall of Fame in 1968. The school's football field formally took on the name of Amos Alonzo Stagg Field on September 26, 1981. Lou '50 and Ashie Santangelo dedicated sculptures of the coaching duo prior to the 2006 home opener.

A SUSQUEHANNA LEGEND

In January 2011, Susquehanna lost a legend in longtime coach Bob Pittello '51. Pittello, a member of the Susquehanna Sports Hall of Fame, was both a player and coach for nearly five decades and was active in the collegiate football world for more than 50 years.

Pittello had been with the team as either a player or a coach longer than anyone in the program's history and was the only player in team history to have his jersey number retired. The University retired his No. 66 during the 1998 season. In 2001, the football locker room was formally named in Pittello's honor.

THE GOLDEN GARRETT ERA

Susquehanna football's most prolific period was "The Golden Era" from 1960 – 1964, as head coach Jim Garrett compiled an amazing 39-4-1 record (.898). His teams had back-to-back undefeated seasons in 1961 and 1962, and built a 22-game unbeaten streak.

Though the streak ended in the 1963 opener, that team won its final eight games, posting the season's biggest win with a 22 – 18 upset of Temple in the season finale.

Garrett went on to coach in the World Football League (WFL), at Columbia University and was a scout with the Dallas Cowboys from 1987-2004. His son, Jason, played 12 seasons in the NFL and is the Cowboys' head coach. Two other sons - John and Judd- have also served on the Dallas staff.

ON THE MARK

In 2000, Mark Bartosic started a four-year career and rewrote the Susquehanna, MAC and NCAA record books for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns. 2012 SU Hall of Famer.

In four seasons, Bartosic caught 275 passes for 4,733 yards and 55 touchdowns, all MAC records. He ranks in the top five in Division III history in career receiving yards, touchdown catches and receiving yards per game. Most significantly, Bartosic became the first player at any level of NCAA football to reach 1,000 yards receiving in four consecutive seasons.

TRADITIONS

As one would expect, tradition runs deep in a program with a history as rich as Susquehanna's.

Two pieces of that history have been established into annual "trophy" games against rivals Lycoming College and Juniata College. From 1993-2009, Susquehanna battled Lycoming for the "Stagg Hat Trophy," which is an actual bronzed fedora worn by Amos Sr. while he coached at Susquehanna. The rivalry was renewed for the 2014 campaign and continues this year.

The hat was given by the elder Stagg to 1954 Susquehanna graduate and former assistant coach Rich Young '54, who donated it to the Sunbury Kiwanis Club to be bronzed and made into a trophy. From 1960-1978, the Kiwanis Charities Festival was Susquehanna's first home game, and the winner took possession of the trophy for one year.

After the Kiwanis game was discontinued, the "Old Hat" was returned to the trophy case at Susquehanna, where it remained until Susquehanna and the Lycoming began playing for it on an annual basis until 2009. The series was interrupted for five years before returning in 2014.

Susquehanna and Juniata have battled for the "Goal Post Trophy" since 1953. It is a piece of the goal post taken from Susquehanna's University Field by Juniata fans following their team's 12-7 upset win on Nov. 1, 1952.

THE ROCK

The practice field, Douglas Arthur '49 Field, was dedicated in 2001 in honor of former player and longtime supporters of the university, the late Doug Arthur '49 and his wife Lucille. At the dedication, an engraved rock was placed next to the field to recognize the Arthurs' contributions.

FOOTBALL RING OF HONOR

Founded in 2018, the SU Football Ring of Honor annually recognizes a group of former players, coaches, and/or staff members whose service, success, spirit and advocacy on behalf of the SU Football program and in the community are deemed worthy of recognition by their peers.
