



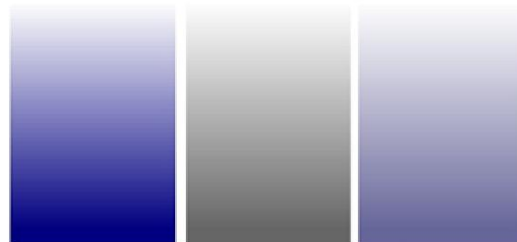

CHAMPIONSHIP SITE:

The 2009 Summit League Cross Country Championship will take place October 31st, 2009 at the Cedar Ridge Golf Course (back nine) in Cedar City, Utah. The event is hosted by Southern Utah University.

COURSE INFORMATION:

Cedar Ridge Golf Course is located in Cedar City, Utah in the foothills at the base of Cedar Mountain. The course is primarily flat with a few rolling hills and ninety percent grass. Team officials will enter the course from the parking area off 900 North. Signs will be posted. Please see appendices for a map of the course.

TEAM PARKING:

Team parking will be located at Cedar Ridge Golf Course in the general parking lot area located on 900 North.

LOCKER ROOMS:

Locker rooms and showers are only available upon request. Please contact Tami Melton at 435-865-8263 for arrangements.

CHAMPIONSHIP HEADQUARTERS HOTEL INFORMATION:

The designated headquarter hotel for the 2009 Cross Country Championship is the Crystal Inn located at 1575 West 200 North Cedar City, Utah, off Exit 59 from I-15. The reservation contact is Dolly Trujillo-Wean, who can be reached at 435-586-8888. Crystal Inn features a full hot breakfast and room rates are \$69.00 per night (double occupancy)

COACHES' MEETING:

A championship meeting for head coaches will be held on the campus of Southern Utah University in the Hunter Conference Center, Yankee Meadows Room 112 (map located in appendix). The meeting will take place on Friday, October 30 at 7:30 pm or immediately following the banquet. The Summit League championship liaison will chair the meeting. Additional meeting attendees will include representation from race officials, sports information, sports medicine, event management, and championship management.

CHAMPIONSHIP BANQUET:

The 2009 Cross Country Championship Banquet will be held on the campus of Southern Utah University in the Hunter Conference Center, Great Hall 203 (map located in appendix). The banquet will be held on Friday, October 30 at 6:30 pm (MST). The dress code for the banquet will be casual business.

The banquet is complimentary for members of each institutions travel party. Parents, fans, or anyone else over and above the travel party may purchase a ticket to the banquet for \$18.00. *If an institution needs additional banquet tickets, it must RSVP the number of additional tickets to Tami Melton (435-865-8263 or melton@suu.edu) by Monday, October 26, 2009.*

MEDICAL AND TRAINING SERVICES:

The athletic training room is located on 1150 West on the bottom floor of Eccles Coliseum (see campus map in appendix, building number 12). The hours of operation will be Friday October 30th from 10:00 am - 6:00 pm. Visiting teams should coordinate with the host sports medicine staff if use of the training room is needed outside of normal operating hours. On event day training services will be designated on the course area with signage.

Teams traveling without a Certified Athletic Trainer are required by Summit League bylaw to bring a written request for treatment of a student athlete. For athletes receiving additional treatments outside of ice and hot packs, the written request should include a list of desired treatments. Special treatment and taping instructions should be included in the written request.

The following modalities will be available in the athletic training room: Ice, whirlpools, hydro collator packs, ultrasound and muscle stimulation. On the course, the following equipment will be available: Ice and heat packs.

OFFICIAL TEAM PARTY LIST:

The official squad size for The Summit League Cross Country Championship may include up to 14 persons (student-athletes, coaches, managers, trainers, etc.). The official team party count does NOT include Administrators.

For the league championship, the host team shall be limited to the same number of entrants permitted for travelling teams.

The official travel party form will be distributed electronically to the coaches by the league office. The travel party rosters are also available online at www.thesummitleague.org by clicking on Members, then Forms, and finally travel party rosters. The completed form must be e-mailed to Assistant Commissioner Greg Walter by 12 pm CST on Monday, October 26, 2009.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

On-line entries will open Wednesday, October 14th at 8:00 am. On-line entries can be done through the following link: <http://www.suu.edu/ath/xcchamp/>. Entry deadline is Tuesday, October 27th at midnight. There is no limit on the number of entrants on the initial entry form. A maximum of nine student-athletes per institution may compete, and the coach shall declare the nine permissible entrants at the coaches' meeting. Mark Walton is the official entry coordinator and can be reached at 435-817-0942.

PRACTICES:

The golf course shall be closed during practice times. Southern Utah University shall make the championship course available by 12 noon on the day prior to the championship. Competitors shall be allowed to practice on the course during this time or at other times as designated with the Championship Manager in consultation with the League Office. Practice time is Friday, October 30th from 11:00 am - 5:00 pm.

RACE TIMES:

Race times are subject to change due to inclement weather.

OFFICIALS/CHAMPIONSHIP STAFF:

The Championship Manager in consultation with the League Office shall determine the adequate number of course officials required to successfully conduct the championship. The number of officials staffing the 2009 Cross Country Championships will be two.

The host will provide a championship referee, chute marshals, clerk of the course, course marshals, FAT operator, finish recorders, gate controllers, head course umpire, inspectors, judges of the finish, place finish recorders, scorers, starters, timers, time recorders, course umpires, and any other staff outlined in Section 14 of the Cross Country Championship Regulations.

RACE RULES:

NCAA Cross Country rules shall be used for all championship competition unless modified in any way by League policy. The current edition of the NCAA Cross Country/Track & Field Rule Book will be available at the race. **Any ties shall remain ties.**

GAMES COMMITTEE:

The Games Committee shall consist of the Championship Manager, Summit League Administrator, and the Meet Referee. If the host institution is involved in an issue to be resolved by the Games Committee, the Championship Manager will recuse him/herself from the discussions.

UNIFORMS:

All uniform articles must conform to the NCAA and Summit League regulations. Each participant's singlet must be plainly visible and be of the school issue and color. All members must wear identical outer garments. Any visible garment worn under the singlets shall be of an identical color as those worn by other members of the team. Hats and gloves may be worn by the student-athletes as long as the articles are incidental to the uniform.

Two numerals, large enough to enable ready identification, shall be securely pinned on the front and back of each student-athlete's uniform so as to be plainly visible. The Summit League name shall appear on the front number.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS:

Immediately following the men's race, an awards ceremony will take place on the golf course. The following awards will be presented separately in Men's and Women's Cross Country:

1. One Team Championship Award
2. One Team Runner-Up Award
3. One Newcomer of the Championship Award
4. One Championship MVP Award
5. One Coach of the Year Award
6. Championship Medallions for the Members of the Travel Party
7. Fourteen All-League Awards (7 first-team, 7 second-team)

AWARD SELECTION:

At the coaches' meeting, Coach of the Year ballots will be distributed. The ballots are due immediately following the second race.

The Newcomer of the Championship shall be the highest placing true freshman (an academic freshman). The First Team All-League shall be the individual finishers placing 1-7. The Second Team All-League shall be the individual finishers placing 8-14. The Championship MVP shall be the individual champion.

SPECTATOR INFORMATION:

Parking: Spectator parking is located in the golf course parking lot off 900 west.

Entrances: Spectator will be directed with posted signage.

Ticket Prices: No charge

Merchandise: A limited amount of championship T-shirts will be available for sale at the championship. Coaches are encouraged to pre-order T-shirts for their teams.

MEDIA SERVICES:

PHOTOGRAPHY:

The Summit League will provide a photographer for all championship matches and the awards ceremony. Copies of photographs will be submitted to the League office and distributed to respective sports information offices.

POST-RACE INTERVIEWS:

Coaches will be given a ten minute cooling off period before post-race interviews. The championship media coordinator will arrange post-race interviews with the visiting sports information director. If a team travels without a sports information director, the championship media coordinator will work with the head coach directly.

WHAT TO DO...

FIRES

- Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station
- Everyone in the building should proceed to the nearest unobstructed exit

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- When the fire alarm is activated, evacuation is mandatory
- Do not use elevators
- Take personal belongings (ID, keys, purses, wallets, backpacks)
- Close doors as you exit
- Move all personnel to a safe area, away from the building in danger

BOMB THREATS

- Remain calm
- Get as much information as possible from the threatening caller
- Call 911
- Follow information on Pg. 5 of Faculty/ Staff Phone directory
- Follow directions from emergency personnel

SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOR

- Do not physically confront the person exhibiting the behavior
- Do not let anyone into a locked room/ building
- Do not block a person's access to an exit.
- Call Public Safety at 435-586-1911

CRIMINAL OFFENSES

- Obtain emergency details at the beginning of all potential or actual situations e.g. exact location, time situation started, list of people involved, details of action, identities and number of participants
- Call 911 and advise
- Advise necessary administrative personnel
- Isolate the incident, containing to one area until police arrive
- Do not let non-essential personnel enter the scene
- Upon their arrival, advise police of the situation and actions taken

.....QUICK REFERENCE.....

SEVERE WEATHER

- Monitor weather and road conditions
- Determine appropriate response e.g. University cancellation, early dismissal, emergency shelter
- Notify SUU employees and students
- If emergency action is taken, broadcast information to the public

UTILITY FAILURE

- Evaluate the problem and contact appropriate utility authority
- Notify faculty/staff and students of any closures
- Wait for official OK to re-enter affected buildings

SUSPICIOUS PACKAGES

- Do not touch or disturb the object
- Evacuate the immediate area
- Call Public Safety at 435-586-1911
- Notify your building administrator, residence hall director or RA

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

- Cardiac Arrest/Heart Attack
 - Assess the scene for danger
 - Check the victim
 - Call 911
 - Perform CPR
- Burns
 - Call 911
 - Do not apply a dressing or creams
- Bleeding
 - Apply firm but gentle pressure to the wound with a clean cloth or tissue
 - Immobilize the body part
 - Keep person lying down
 - Call Public Safety at 435-586-1911

ACTIVE SHOOTERS

- If possible, exit the building immediately and call 911
- If you cannot exit, clear the hallway immediately and/or remain behind closed doors in a locked or barricaded room, if possible.
- Stay away from windows. Remain calm and quietly call Public Safety
- Evacuate the room only when authorities have arrived and instructed you to do so
- Do not leave or unlock the door to see “what is happening”
- Do not attempt to confront or apprehend the shooter, unless as a last resort
- Do not assume someone else has called police or emergency personnel
- Do not sound a fire alarm
- Turn lights out and audio equipment off
- Remain calm and quiet
- If you try to hide, make sure that it is a well hidden space
- If you think you can make it outside safely and you try to run, do not run in a straight line. Put objects between you and the shooter as you run
- If you are unable to run or hide, you may choose to play dead if other victims are around you
- The last option may be to fight back. This is dangerous, but depending on your situation, this could be your only choice.
- If you are caught by the shooter and are not going to fight back, follow their directions and do not look them in the eyes.
- Once police arrive, obey all commands

EARTHQUAKE

- Take cover under heavy furniture or in interior doorways or narrow halls
- Stay away from windows, outside walks, lofts or stairways
- If you are outside, find an open area

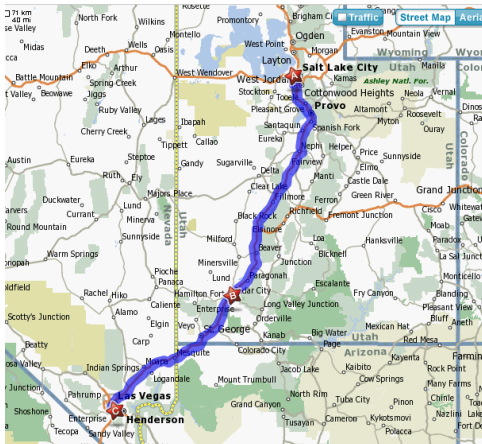

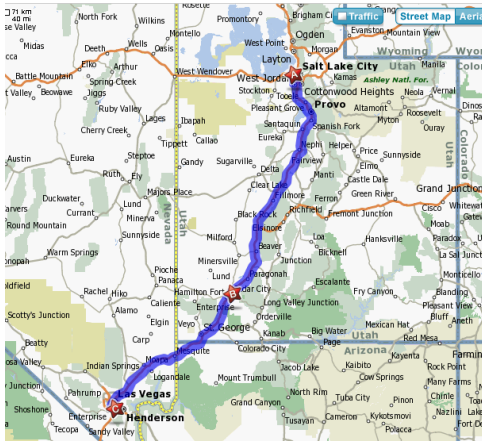

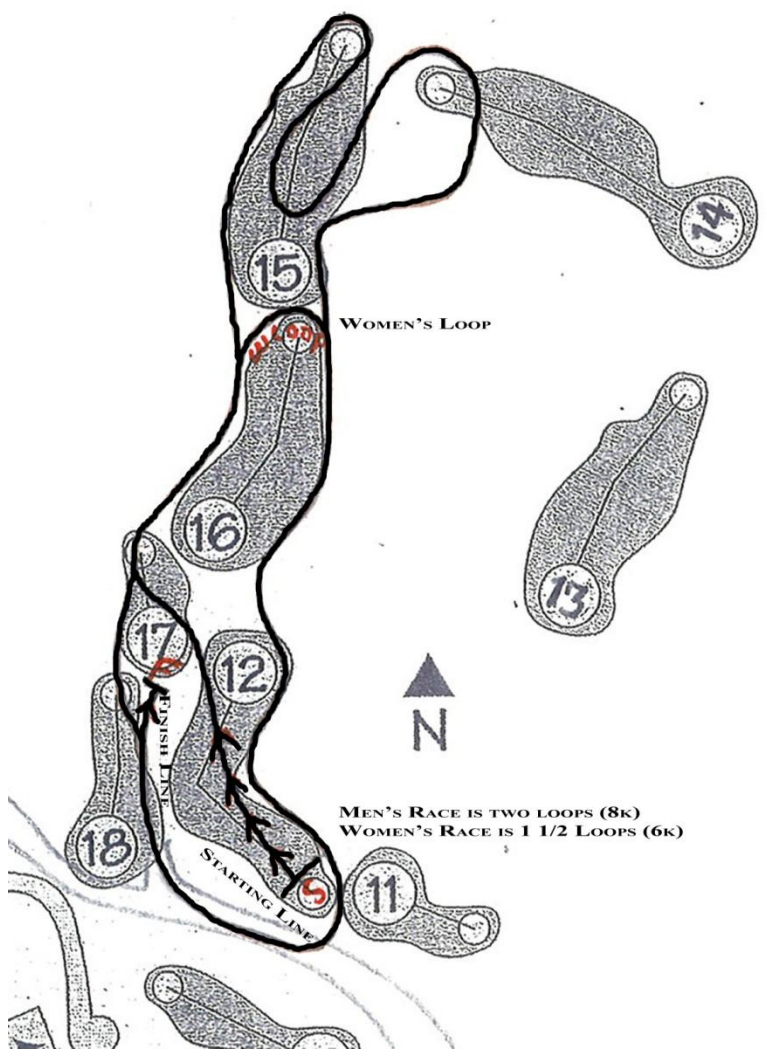
