T-Birds Take On the Aggies as Part of SUU Basketball Doubleheader

SUU SET TO HOST NEW MEXICO STATE

The T-Birds return home this weekend to kickoff an SUU basketball doubleheader by hosting New Mexico State at 5 p.m. on Saturday. The game will be followed by a matchup between the Southern Utah men and San Diego Christian at 7:30. The T-Birds are coming off a trip to the BTI Classic where they went 1-2 while picking up a 76-47 win over the University of New Orleans. New Mexico State brings a record of 4-2 to Cedar City and is currently riding a three-game winning streak after edging UTEP by a final score of 69-68 earlier this week. SUU knocked off the Aggies 58-57 in Las Cruces last season thanks to a last second jumper from Hailey Mandelko. Saturday's game will be broadcast on Power91 and online at SUUTbirds.com.

SUU AT BTI CLASSIC

Southern Utah went 1-2 last week while competing at the BTI Classic in Lubbock, Texas. The Thunderbirds fell by a score of 65-54 to Nicholls State and dropped a 73-54 contest against Texas Tech but also came up with a 76-47 rout of New Orleans. Senior forward Tayler Anderson was named to all-tournament team after averaging 5.7 rebounds per game, 1.3 assists and 6.7 points on 52.9 percent shooting. SUU shot the ball 39 percent from the floor as a team in the three-game set while tallying 12.4 assists and 9.6 steals per game.

BATTLE ON THE BOARDS

The Thunderbirds have proved themselves to be a strong rebounding team and are currently averaging 47.2 boards a game. SUU also holds a +9.2 rebounding margin advantage over its opponents, which is the 35th best mark in the nation. Junior forward Carli Moreland has been the top T-Birds on the glass so far this season with an average of 7.0 rpg.

BALL SKILLS

Southern Utah's Andrea Jones has been very stingy when it comes to turnovers this season. The SUU guard has only given up seven takeaways while dishing out 17 assists. That equates to a assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.43, the 35th best count in the NCAA. Jones has also been dangerous on the defensive end, averaging 1.4 steals per game.

SUU PERFECT IN PRESEASON

Southern Utah wrapped up the preseason with a 71-59 win over Dixie State to finish with a record of 2-0 in exhibition play. Kimie Hawkins led the T-Birds to victory with 17 points and 15 rebounds. The win came two days after SUU opened the year with a 83-62 win over New Mexico Highlands. Sophomore guard Marquelle Funk led Southern Utah with 18 points while connecting on 4-of-5 shots from behind the arc.

SUU ELEVENTH IN PRESEASON POLL

The Southern Utah University women's basketball team has been picked to finish eleventh in its first season a member of the Big Sky Conference. Defending champion Idaho State received eight first place votes to come out on top of the coaches polls followed by Northern Colorado and the University of Montana. Northern Arizona and Weber State were slotted ninth and tenth respectively, just ahead of SUU.

CONFERENCE HONORS

Hailey Mandelko was selected as a member of the Summit League All-Newcomer Team after leading Southern Utah with 14.0 ppg in conference play, an average that ranked eighth among the league's top scorers. She also ranked second with a 41% three-point field goal percentage. Carli Moreland received All-Summit honorable mention honors after ranking fifth in the conference in average rebounds (7.9), seventh in blocked shots (1.3), eleventh in scoring (12.3) and sixth in field-goal percentage (48.1%).

T-BIRDS ADD TO COACHING STAFF

Southern Utah University has announced the hiring of new assistant coach Jill Mahoney who will join the Thunderbird women's basketball program for the upcoming season. Mahoney comes to SUU from Western State College of Colorado where she helped the Mountaineers to a top four finish in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

SUU HAS SOMETHING 'BRUIN'

Southern Utah adds three JC transfers this year, all of whom were teammates at Salt Lake Community College over the past two seasons. Sofia Hepworth (G) was the Bruins leading scorer with 14.9 ppg, Marissa Robbins (G) ranked second on the team with 10.7 ppg and Nicole Newbold (F) shot over 53% from the floor for SLCC.

TEAM NOTES

- In its first two games of the year Southern Utah is averaging 15.0 steals, a significant jump from last season's mark of 5.8 spg.
- The Thunderbirds have attempted 63 free throws in their first two games, converting on 40 of those tries. Last year SUU averaged 21.4 attempts per game and shot over 72% from the line.
- Southern Utah currently holds a +5.0 advantage in rebounding margin so far and outrebounded Southern Oregon by a count of 56-39.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Forward Carli Moreland recorded the first double-double of the season for SUU with an 11 point and 13 rebound performance against SOU. The game marked Moreland's tenth career double-double.
- SUU returns three different players who finished last season with a double-digit scoring average including, Hailey Mandelko (13.1 ppg), Carli Moreland (11.1) and Andrea Jones (10.6).
- Sophomore guard Hailey Mandelko has connected on five of her first 13 three-point field goal attempts this year for a 3FG% mark of 38 percent.

HEAD COACH JR PAYNE



JR Payne is set to lead the Thunderbirds into the Big Sky Conference as she begins her fourth season at Southern Utah. Since taking over the program on April 20, 2009, she has led the T-Birds to a combined record of 29-60 as well as an appearance in the 2011 Summit League Tournament.

Under Payne's direction the 2011-12 season saw the emergence of a talented young group of players led by standouts Hailey Mandelko and Carli Moreland. Mandelko started at the point as a true freshman and finished the season as the T-Birds leading scorer (13.1 PPG) to earn all-newcomer honors in the conference. Moreland received honorable mention honors after ranking fifth in the league in rebounding (7.9 RPG) and eleventh in scoring (12.3 PPG). SUU also placed six student-athletes on the Summit League Academic All-League teams.

Payne's tenure at Southern Utah has been highlighted by the 2010-11 season when the team posted a record of 16-14, its best mark in the past seven years. The 2011 squad also had one of their best seasons as a member of the Summit League, posting a 10-8 record to finish fifth in the conference. Under Payne's guidance, forward Challis Pascucci produced one of the best individual performances in SUU history, earning a spot on the All-Summit League first team after finishing third in the conference in scoring (17.7 PPG), second in rebounding (9.7 RPG) and sixth in blocks (23). Pascucci finished the 2011 season as the Thunderbirds all-time leader in career rebounds (929) and fourth in scoring (1,328).

Prior to coming to SUU, Payne served as the top assistant at Santa Clara University under first-year head coach Jennifer Mountain for the 2008-09 season.

Payne also served as an assistant coach at Boise State University and Gonzaga University. During her time in Boise, the Broncos enjoyed a wealth of success, winning conference titles two of the three years and advancing to the NCAA postseason. BSU posted back-to-back 24-8 seasons, including a perfect 14-0 mark at home during the 2007-08 season. Payne began her career at Gonzaga University, serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Kelly Graves. Payne was an integral part of the Bulldogs turnaround as the team posted a five-win season during the staff's first year then went to a 28-win season during the 2004-05 season, including an undefeated run in the West Coast Conference. Payne was a part of the process that brought Gonzaga's first All-American to campus in guard Shannon Mathews.

As a player, Payne was a four-year letter winner at St. Mary's College (Calif.), helping the Gaels earn their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in school-history during the 1998-99 season. The former point guard was an All-West Coast Conference first team selection and was also named to the West Coast Conference All-Tournament first team twice.

Southern Utah closed out its appearance at the BTI Classic with a 65-54 loss to Nicholls State on Sunday. The Thunderbirds made a late push in the second half after falling behind early on, but were unable to catch the Colonels who held on for the win.

Nicholls State put up the first five points of the game, but SUU came back to tie the score at 7-7 on a basket by Tayler Anderson five minutes in. The Colonels would then mount another run take a 17-10 lead on a pair of free throws from LiAnn McCarthy just past the midpoint of the opening period.

The T-Birds rallied once again however, outscoring their opponents by a count of 6-1 over the next five minutes to narrow the margin to 18-16 with the half winding down. Nicholls then went on to close out the period on 10-2 run, finished off by a three-pointer for KK Babin, to take a 28-20 advantage into the break.

Southern Utah held a 26-15 rebounding edge in the early going, but trailed its opponents in field goal percentage with a mark of 28.6 percent to the Colonels 34.5 percent.

The Thunderbirds got the first points of the second half as Anderson knocked down another jumper to bring SUU within six with the score at 28-22, but the Colonels used another run to push their lead to a game-high 17 after Alisha Allen scored a basket to make the count 51-34 near the six-minute mark.

Hailey Mandelko sank a three to bring SUU back within ten with three minutes left on the clock and Andrea Jones added another after a Nicholls basket to make the score 58-49 with just over a minute to play, but the Colonels would go 5-6 from the free throw line in the final seconds to hold on for the 65-54 win.

Southern Utah went 18-52 from the field for an overall shooting percentage of 34.6 percent while Nicholls State shot the ball 23-55 for a mark of 41.8 percent. SUU outrebounded its opponent 41-33 but gave up 21 turnovers.

The Colonels had three players score in the double-figures, led by McCarthy and Babin who each had 16. Mandelko was the Thunderbirds top-scorer with 12 points and went 3-6 from the three-point line. Anderson and Jones also each chipped in eight for SUU.

Senior forward Tayler Anderson was also named to the all-tournament team after averaging 5.7 rebounds per game, 1.3 assists and 6.7 points on 52.9 percent shooting.

Southern Utah shot the ball a season-high 43.3 percent from the floor to run away with a 76-47 win over the University of New Orleans in its second outing of the BTI Classic on Saturday. In a performance similar to their first win of the season, the Thunderbirds used a balanced offensive attack that saw a dozen players come up with a basket. Leading the way were Sofia Hepworth and Tayler Anderson who each had 10 points in the win.

SUU came out firing as junior guard Andrea Jones knocked down a three in the games opening possession to spark a 20-7 game-opening run that ended with Desiree Jackson driving in for a lay-up that put the T-Birds up by 13 near the 12 minute mark.

Southern Utah continued to score the ball well throughout the half pushing its lead to as many as 17 in the final minute of the period. New Orleans beat the buzzer with a three from Mirjam Sipos to make the score 38-24 at the break.

The Thunderbirds finished the half shooting the ball over 46 percent from the floor while holding their opponents to a mark of just 27 percent. SUU also posted a 33-9 rebounding advantage in the early going and was a perfect 2-2 from behind the arc.

It would be more of the same after halftime as SUU opened with six unanswered to push its lead to 20 at 44-24. The margin reached 33 points after freshman Ashleigh Munns sank a three to make the count 62-29 halfway through the period, and eventually went as high as 40 on another outside shot from Munns that brought the score to 73-33 with just over four minutes left to play.

The Privateers worked to narrow the deficit in the final minutes, but the Thunderbirds had the game well in hand as they cruised to the 76-47 victory. The win helps SUU improve its overall record to 2-2 on the year while UNO drops to 1-4.

Freshman Lori Parkinson had a solid outing in her second-straight game, pulling down 12 rebounds to go along with eight points. Sipos finished as the Privateers top-scorer with 15 points.

The Thunderbirds turned in their best shooting performance of the early season, going 5-6 from the three-point line and 29-67 from the floor for a field goal mark of 43.3 percent. SUU also played well on the defensive end holding its opponents to just 16-56 shooting and winning the battle on the boards by a tally of 62-23.

Southern Utah came up short in its opening game at the BTI Classic on Friday night, falling to tournament host Texas Tech by a final score of 73-54. The T-Birds defense held TTU to just 28.6 percent shooting from the floor, but the Lady Raiders made 43 trips to the free throw line where they were able to pick up 30 of their points.

The two sides traded baskets in the early going until Tech guards Christine Hyde and Casey Morris hit back-to-back threes as part of a 10-0 run that saw the Raiders go up by a count of 14-4. SUU then battled back with a jumper by Carli Moreland and a pair of Kimie Hawkins free throws that narrowed the margin to 16-10 halfway through the period.

Sofia Hepworth came off the bench to lead Southern Utah to a 99-71 win over Southern Oregon in the team's regular season opener on Saturday night. The junior transfer player had 21 points in a game that saw the Thunderbird reserves record 60 points.

"Sofia did exactly what we expect her to do for us, she is instant offense," explained SUU head coach JR Payne. "She is also a great teammate and brings a terrific spirit to this team."

SUU guard Hailey Mandelko opened the game with a three pointer from the left wing, but the Raiders quickly answered with a driving score by Ashley Claussen that started a 6-0 run to go up 6-3. The Thunderbirds came back with four straight to retake the lead at 7-6.

The Raiders narrowed the margin to one at 40-39 in the closing minutes of the period, but the Thunderbirds put up six points in final 60 seconds, capped by a put-back lay-up by Lori Parkinson just before the horn to take a 46-39 advantage into the locker room.

Mandelko opened the second half the same way she started the game as she knocked down another three-pointer to push the SUU advantage into the double-digits. She then put up four more points as the Thunderbirds started the period on a 15-4 run that pushed the margin to 18 points with the score at 61-43.

The SUU lead would grow to as much as 32 points in the closing minutes before the Thunderbirds eventually took the game by a final score of 99-71.

The Southern Utah offense started the season strong recording its highest scoring total since the 2010-11 season while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor. The T-Birds also held a 56-39 rebounding advantage and went 30-45 from the foul line.

Five Thunderbirds turned in double-digit scoring performances including Hepworth with 21, Mandelko at 18, Moreland with 11 and Hawkins and Jones who each had 12. Moreland also pulled down 13 rebounds to start the year with a double-double. Sweet finished with 26 for the Raiders who got another 13 from forward Alexi Smith.

"I thought we played really well in spurts," commented Payne. "Overall it was a great win and it was good that everyone got to play."

After falling behind by as many as 23 points in its road-opener at Utah on Tuesday, SUU came back to cut the margin into the single digits in the game's closing moments. The Thunderbird rally would come up just short however as the Utes were able to hold on for the 79-61 victory.

Southern Utah got on the scoreboard first after Desiree Jackson drew contact on a drive on the Thunderbirds second possession and hit both free throws to put SUU up 2-0. The Utes came back with a three-point play by Taryn Wicijowski. After a three from Hailey Mandelko and a pair of Desiree Jackson free throws the score was knotted up again at 7-7.

The two sides traded scores in the closing minutes of the half until SUU took possession with four seconds left on the clock. Andrea Jones took the inbounds pass and quickly dribbled the length of the court before firing off a runner from the right side that beat the buzzer to make the score 35-28 heading into the break.

Utah opened the second half with a 16-0 run capped by a three from Rodrigues, to push its lead to 51-28. Mandelko knocked down a three to stop the streak and Marissa Robbins added four straight as SUU narrowed the margin to 57-37. The Thunderbirds then continued to cut away at the deficit as they outscored the Utes 18-10 over a five-minute stretch to bring the tally to 61-46. The Utes took back momentum Paige Crozon hit a pair free throws that pushed the lead to 70-52, but the Thunderbirds came back with another Mandelko three that started a 9-0 run to bring the score to bring SUU within nine at 70-61 with just over four minutes left to play.

Four-straight free throws and a lay-up by Rodrigues would then push the Utah lead to 76-61 with under two minutes left in the game. The Utes added on a few more free throws in the closing moments to eventually hold on for the 79-61 victory.

The Utes got big performances from Rodrigues who scored 20 points and Wicijowski who finished with 20 points and 15 rebounds. Robbins was the Thunderbirds top-scorer with 10 points, but 10 different players scored for SUU. Utah held a slight edge on the glass, outrebounding Southern Utah 46-40, and a significant advantage from the foul line where it connected on 25 attempts to the T-Birds 10 makes.
