Game 10: T-Birds Open Big Sky Play on the Road

SUU Travels to North Dakota

BIG SKY OPENER

It's a historic week for Thunderbird Basketball as Southern Utah (5-4) travels to North Dakota (4-4) for its first game in the Big Sky Conference. North Dakota is also new to the BSC and is trying to protect a four-game winning streak. SUU has won three-straight and will be looking to avenge an early loss against UND from last season. That meeting between the two teams turned into a tightly contested matchup that saw 10 lead changes and a 5-0 T-Bird rally in the last two minutes that came up just short as North Dakota held on to win by a final score of 62-61. ABOUT NORTH DAKOTA

After starting the season 0-4, North Dakota has bounced back by winning four in a row, most recently taking a 63-49 win at home over Jamestown. UND has a pair of post players who are currently scoring in double figures led by Megan Lauck with 11.0 ppg and Madi Buck who is averaging 10.5 ppg. Head Coach Travis Brewster took over the reins this season after serving nine years as an assistant in the program. North Dakota's 62-61 win over SUU at New Mexico State's Aggie Hotel Encanto Thanksgiving Classic last season marked the first all-time meeting between the two schools.

T-BIRDS PULL AWAY FROM HBU

After getting off to a slow start Southern Utah got things going in the second half to take a 79-58 win over visiting Houston Baptist. The Thunderbirds trailed by three at halftime but outscored the Huskies 53-29 down the stretch to pick up their third straight win and improve to 5-4 on the year. SUU shot almost 54 percent from the floor in the second period to up its field goal mark to 45.7 percent for the game. Sophomore guard Marquelle Funk led the T-Birds with 14 points in the game.



Marquelle Funk is averaging 15.0 ppg on 13-18 shooting while also pulling down 6.0 rpg in Southern Utah's last two outings.

RECORD NIGHT LIFTS SUU PAST SJSU

The Southern Utah University Women's basketball team matched its school record by knocking down 15 three-point field goals in a 93-82 win at San Jose State earlier this season. The T-Birds shot over 57 percent from downtown to go along with a season-high field goal mark of 49.3 percent. Sophomore guard Hailey Mandelko led the way by hitting five three-pointers to set a new career high with 27 points. Marquelle Funk also set a new career-mark by scoring 16 and SUU

dominated the glass, posting a 43-27 rebounding advantage which included 20 offensive boards.

LIGHTING UP THE "SCORE-BIRD"

The T-Bird offense has been putting up big numbers this season, twice eclipsing 90 points and averaging 72 points a game. That number puts SUU in the top 40 among the nation's scoring offenses. Southern Utah also ranks in the top 25 in the NCAA with a team three-point field goal percentage mark of 37.8%.

SHARP SHOOTER

Sophomore guard Hailey Mandelko has hit 19 of her first 40 attempts from three to start the season, including a 6-10 performance in Southern Utah's 93-82 win at San Jose State. Mandelko's three-point shooting percentage currently sits at 47.5 percent, which ranks 13th in the country. She is also averaging 3.17 makes a game from the outside, a mark that puts her in the top 11 in the NCAA. Mandeko's hot shooting helped her to be named the Big Sky Player of the Week on Dec. 10.

BATTLE ON THE BOARDS

The Thunderbirds have proved themselves to be a strong rebounding team and are currently averaging 45.4 boards a game. SUU also holds a +8.5 rebounding margin advantage over its opponents, which is the 30th best mark in the nation. Senior forward Kimie Hawkins has been the top T-Bird on the glass so far this season with her average of 8.3 rpg putting her among the top 140 players in the NCAA.

SUU ELEVENTH IN PRESEASON POLL

The Southern Utah University women's basketball team has been picked to finish eleventh in its first season a member of the Big Sky Conference. Defending champion Idaho State received eight first place votes to come out on top of the coaches polls followed by Northern Colorado and the University of Montana. Northern Arizona and Weber State were slotted ninth and tenth respectively, just ahead of SUU.

T-BIRDS ADD TO COACHING STAFF

Southern Utah University added new assistant coach Jill Mahoney during this past offseason. Mahoney comes to SUU from Western State College of Colorado where she helped the Mountaineers to a top four finish in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

SUU HAS SOMETHING 'BRUIN'

Southern Utah brought in three JC transfers this year, all of whom were teammates at Salt Lake Community College over the past two seasons. Sofia Hepworth (G) was the Bruins' leading scorer with 14.9 ppg, Marissa Robbins (G) ranked second on the team with 10.7 ppg and Nicole Newbold (F) shot over 53% from the floor for SLCC.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Junior Forward Carli Moreland recorded the first double-double of the season for SUU with an 11 point, 13 rebound performance against Southern Oregon. She then followed that up with a 16 point, 13 rebound outing against New Mexico State for her 11th career double-double.
- SUU returns three different players who finished last season with a double-digit scoring average including, Hailey Mandelko (13.1 ppg), Carli Moreland (11.1) and Andrea Jones (10.6).

HEAD COACH JR PAYNE



JR Payne is set to lead the Thunderbirds into the Big Sky Conference as she begins her fourth season at Southern Utah. Since taking over the program on April 20, 2009, she has led the T-Birds to a combined record of 29-60 as well as an appearance in the 2011 Summit League Tournament.

Under Payne's direction the 2011-12 season saw the emergence of a talented young group of players led by standouts Hailey Mandelko and Carli Moreland. Mandelko started at the point as a true freshman and finished the season as the T-Birds leading scorer (13.1 PPG) to earn all-newcomer honors in the conference. Moreland received honorable mention honors after ranking fifth in the league in rebounding (7.9 RPG) and eleventh in scoring (12.3 PPG). SUU also placed six student-athletes on the Summit League Academic All-League teams.

Payne's tenure at Southern Utah has been highlighted by the 2010-11 season when the team posted a record of 16-14, its best mark in the past eight years. The 2011 squad also had one of its best seasons as a member of the Summit League, posting a 10-8 record to finish fifth in the conference. Under Payne's guidance, forward Challis Pascucci produced one of the best individual performances in SUU history, earning a spot on the All-Summit League first team after finishing third in the conference in scoring (17.7 PPG), second in rebounding (9.7 RPG) and sixth in blocks (23). Pascucci finished the 2011 season as the Thunderbirds' all-time leader in career rebounds (929) and fourth in scoring (1,328).

Prior to coming to SUU, Payne served as the top assistant at Santa Clara University under first-year head coach Jennifer Mountain for the 2008-09 season.

Payne also served as an assistant coach at Boise State University and Gonzaga University. During her time in Boise, the Broncos enjoyed a wealth of success, winning conference titles two of the three years and advancing to the NCAA postseason. BSU posted back-to-back 24-8 seasons, including a perfect 14-0 mark at home during the 2007-08 season. Payne began her career at Gonzaga University, serving as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under head coach Kelly Graves. Payne was an integral part of the Bulldogs' turnaround as the team posted a five-win season during the staff's first year then went to a 28-win season during the 2004-05 season, including an undefeated run in the West Coast Conference. Payne was a part of the process that brought Gonzaga's first All-American to campus in guard Shannon Mathews.

As a player, Payne was a four-year letter winner at St. Mary's College (Calif.), helping the Gaels earn their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in school-history during the 1998-99 season. The former point guard was an All-West Coast Conference first-team selection and was also named to the West Coast Conference All-Tournament first-team twice.

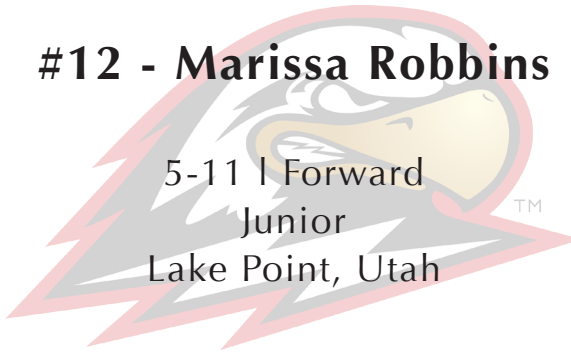

After getting off to a slow start Southern Utah got things going in the second half to take a 79-58 win over visiting Houston Baptist (2-10) on Monday. The Thunderbirds trailed by three at halftime but outscored the Huskies 53-29 down the stretch to pick up their third straight win and improve to 5-4 on the year.

"We looked like we hadn't played in nine days," stated SUU head coach JR Payne. "But eventually we played the way we are capable of playing. When you show that you have type of basketball in you, you should just play like that all of the time."

Junior guard Sofia Hepworth put up the first two baskets of the game for the T-Birds, but Houston Baptist was able to take an early 9-6 lead behind seven quick points from Shanice Steenholdt.

The two sides continued to trade baskets as the visitors held onto a slight advantage through most of the opening period, eventually pushing the lead to five as Rachel Arthur connected on a three near the nine-minute mark. The Thunderbirds quickly bounced back with back-to-back baskets from Lori Parkinson and Marquelle Funk to pull back within one at 19-18.

Southern Utah came back to take the lead in the closing minutes as Ashleigh Munns hit a corner three to put SUU up 26-25, but the Huskies scored the last four points of the half to take a 29-26 edge into the locker room.

SUU came out of the break firing, starting the second half with a 21-7 run to open up an 11-point lead. Funk helped to get the streak going with a lay-up then capped it off with transition basket to make the count 47-36 with 13-minutes left to play. The sophomore guard also chipped in a deep three during the stretch to help the T-Birds pull in front.

Southern Utah heated up in the second half, hitting 5-of-11 shots from the outside. Sofia Hepworth dropped in the fifth three to push the margin to 25 with the score at 72-47. The Thunderbirds then cruised through the final four minutes before coming away with a 79-58 victory.

SUU shot almost 54 percent from the floor in the second period to up its field goal mark to 45.7 percent for the game. The T-Bird defense held HBU to just 8-of-33 on field goals attempts down the stretch and 29.4 percent shooting for the game. Southern Utah also posted a 51-39 rebounding advantage, which included 23 offensive boards.

13 different players scored in the game for Southern Utah, led by Funk with 14, Hepworth at 12 and Hawkins with 11. Steenholdt finished with 20 for the Huskies and also pulled down 10 rebounds.

The Southern Utah University Women's basketball team matched its school record by knocking down 15 three-point field goals in a 93-82 win at San Jose State on Saturday. The T-Birds shot over 57 percent from downtown to go along with a season-high field goal mark of 49.3 percent. Sophomore guard Hailey Mandelko led the way by hitting five three-pointers to set a new career high with 27 points and help SUU improve to 4-4 on the season while dropping the Spartans to 3-5.

The Thunderbirds opened the game on an 11-2 run as Sofia Hepworth and Andrea Jones got things going from the outside. Mandelko would then knock down her first three ball of the afternoon halfway through the period to push the advantage into the double-digits as SUU stretched its lead to 24-14.

Southern Utah closed out the half shooting 50 percent from the floor to take a 48-37 lead into the break. Six different T-Birds connected from behind the arc in the early going, helping SUU start the game 6-13 from downtown.

Mandelko opened the second half with two more quick threes to push the margin to 15 with the score at 56-41. Then near the 12-minute mark she heated up again, draining three-straight from the outside to make it 76-61 near the halfway point of the final period.

The Spartans battled back within ten on a layup by Riana Byrd with just over eight minutes to play, but Jones answered with another three to push the SUU advantage back into the double-figures for good as Southern Utah went up by a count of 80-70.

Marquelle Funk hit the record-tying three in the closing minutes, and Brenna Gates and Tayler Anderson added scores down the stretch to help the T-Birds come away with the 93-82 victory.

Mandelko's 27 points are the most by any Thunderbird this season, while Funk also set a new career-mark by scoring 16 and Jones added 14 points by shooting 4-6 from the outside. Byrd finished with 24 to lead the Spartans, who got another 18 from Ta'Rea Cunnigan. SJSU shot 46.2 percent from the floor, but just 3-11 from three.

Southern Utah held on to defeat Utah Valley for a sixth-consecutive time by a final score of 71-66. The Thunderbirds built a big lead early before the Wolverines battled back to trail by just two at the half. The score remained close during the second period before SUU eventually pulled away and held on for the win.

The Thunderbirds' first big play of the game came on the defensive end as Sofia Hepworth came from the weak side to reject an inside shot by the Wolverines Sammie Jensen. On offense SUU started the game with six-straight lay-ups to hold a 12-7 edge just five minutes in.

The T-Birds then pushed the lead to 19-9 with a 7-2 run. Andrea Jones got things going with a three-pointer from the wing, with Hawkins and Moreland adding two more scores from the inside to put SUU up by ten. Hailey Mandelko would then heat up from the outside, hitting a pair of shots from the outside as Southern Utah pushed the margin to 29-13 halfway through the opening period Utah Valley rallied from there however, outscoring SUU 18-2 in the final minutes of the half to trail by just two with the score at 33-31 at the break. Senior forward Kaycee Mansfield tallied eight points during that stretch for the Wolverines to bring her overall total to 14.

Utah Valley kept the run going in the second half, coming back to take its first lead of the night at 35-34. The two teams then traded baskets for the next several minutes with neither side being able to gain an advantage until Marquelle Funk hit a straightaway three approaching the nine-minute mark to go up 48-44. She then added another three-point play with a basket and a foul to push the score to 52-46 with seven minutes left to play.

The Wolverines kept it close down the stretch, closing within two on an outside shot from Taylor Huber with 2:01 left on the clock. Andrea Jones then earned a trip to the foul line to put the Thunderbirds back up by four at 64-60.

Jensen made another lay-up to bring it back to a single possession game with just over a minute to play, but Desiree Jackson answered with a jumper and Hawkins dropped in two free throws to help Southern Utah pull away for good and eventually come away with the 71-66 victory.

Hawkins recorded her first double-double of the season for the T-Birds, finishing the game with 15 points and 14 rebounds. Mandelko added 11 more for SUU, including a couple of shots from behind the arc. Jensen posted totals of 19 and 15 for UVU while going 10-10 from the free throw line.

The Thunderbirds shot 38.3 percent from the field while holding the Wolverines to a mark of 32.8 percent. Utah Valley held a narrow edge on the glass, outrebounding Southern Utah 45-41, but the T-Birds made up the difference by turning 11 steals into 20 points off of UVU turnovers.

Southern Utah took a 14-point halftime over New Mexico State in its second home game of the season Saturday night, but then saw the visiting Aggies rally late to pull out a 70-68 win in the game's final seconds. SUU led the game from two minutes in until the final minute, but the Aggies battled back for the improbable win to improve their record 5-2 while dropping the T-Birds to 2-4. Southern Utah was the first to get on the board first after Kimie Hawkins earned a trip to the line with a strong drive and knocked down both free throws for the first points of the game. Sofia Hepworth then took a steal the length of the court and was fouled on her way up for another trip to the line and two more points to put Southern Utah up 4-0.

The T-Birds continued to add to their lead and eventually doubled up NMSU at 26-13 near the nine-minute mark as Marquelle Funk connected on a jumper from the outside. The Thunderbirds went on to take a 43-29 lead into the break after Sofia Hepworth hit a pull-up jumper in the closing seconds of the half.

The Aggies started the second half with two quick baskets and a pair of free throws, but Mandelko found her range from the outside again, hitting a three from the wing to push the lead back into the double-digits at 46-36.

The Aggies refused to go away however, and pulled back within a single basket as Gilbreath scored inside to make it 64-62 with four minutes remaining. The score remained tight down the stretch as the two sides traded baskets while the Thunderbirds held onto for 68-66 edge as the clock wound down to the final 60 seconds of play.

NMSU guard Danesia Williamson then got to free throw line to tie the score at 68-68 with 21 seconds remaining. SUU also earned a trip to the line on its ensuing possession but both attempts from Funk rimmed out and the Aggies took the ball back with 11 seconds left. Williamson took the ball for the visitors again and drove the length of the court before laying a shot off the glass to give New Mexico State the lead.

The Thunderbirds got the ball on the baseline with 2.1 seconds on the clock, but their down-court pass went out of bounds giving possession back to NMSU. SUU fouled on the inbounds pass and took the ball back after two missed free throws, but Anderson's last second heave came up well short of the basket and New Mexico State escaped with the 70-68 come-from-behind victory.

Southern Utah closed out its appearance at the BTI Classic with a 65-54 loss to Nicholls State on Sunday. The Thunderbirds made a late push in the second half after falling behind early on, but were unable to catch the Colonels who held on for the win.

Nicholls State put up the first five points of the game, but SUU came back to tie the score at 7-7 on a basket by Tayler Anderson five minutes in. The Colonels would then mount another run take a 17-10 lead on a pair of free throws from LiAnn McCarthy just past the midpoint of the opening period.

The T-Birds rallied once again however, outscoring their opponents by a count of 6-1 over the next five minutes to narrow the margin to 18-16 with the half winding down. Nicholls then went on to close out the period on 10-2 run, finished off by a three-pointer for KK Babin, to take a 28-20 advantage into the break.

Southern Utah held a 26-15 rebounding edge in the early going, but trailed its opponents in field goal percentage with a mark of 28.6 percent to the Colonels 34.5 percent.

The Thunderbirds finished the half shooting the ball over 46 percent from the floor while holding their opponents to a mark of just 27 percent. SUU also posted a 33-9 rebounding advantage in the early going and was a perfect 2-2 from behind the arc.

It would be more of the same after halftime as SUU opened with six unanswered to push its lead to 20 at 44-24. The margin reached 33 points after freshman Ashleigh Munns sank a three to make the count 62-29 halfway through the period, and eventually went as high as 40 on another outside shot from Munns that brought the score to 73-33 with just over four minutes left to play.

The Privateers worked to narrow the deficit in the final minutes, but the Thunderbirds had the game well in hand as they cruised to the 76-47 victory. The win helps SUU improve its overall record to 2-2 on the year while UNO drops to 1-4.

Freshman Lori Parkinson had a solid outing in her second-straight game, pulling down 12 rebounds to go along with eight points. Sipos finished as the Privateers top-scorer with 15 points.

The Thunderbirds turned in their best shooting performance of the early season, going 5-6 from the three-point line and 29-67 from the floor for a field goal mark of 43.3 percent. SUU also played well on the defensive end holding its opponents to just 16-56 shooting and winning the battle on the boards by a tally of 62-23.

Southern Utah came up short in its opening game at the BTI Classic on Friday night, falling to tournament host Texas Tech by a final score of 73-54. The T-Birds defense held TTU to just 28.6 percent shooting from the floor, but the Lady Raiders made 43 trips to the free throw line where they were able to pick up 30 of their points.

The two sides traded baskets in the early going until Tech guards Christine Hyde and Casey Morris hit back-to-back threes as part of a 10-0 run that saw the Raiders go up by a count of 14-4. SUU then battled back with a jumper by Carli Moreland and a pair of Kimie Hawkins free throws that narrowed the margin to 16-10 halfway through the period.

Texas Tech then put together another big run as it ran off nine-straight points over the next three minutes to push its advantage to 23-10. The Lady Raiders held onto the lead throughout the closing minutes of the half, eventually taking a 34-20 advantage into the break.

SUU opened the second half with a six straight points, including a pair of jumpers from freshman Lori Parkinson, to pull within eight with the score at 34-26. The deficit hung around ten points for the first several minutes of the half until Texas Tech put together 16-2 run near the 12 minute mark to pull ahead 62-38.

The T-Birds made a push to cut into the lead in the final minutes, but were unable to overcome the deficit as Texas Tech held on for the 73-54 victory.

Southern Utah showed a marked improvement in the second half, shooting the ball 40 percent from the floor while holding TTU to just 31 percent down the stretch. The Thunderbirds also battled back on the boards trailing the Raiders by a single rebound with the count favoring the home team at 22-21 in the final period. SUU also held a 11-9 advantage in assists for the game and scored 32 points in the paint to Texas Tech's 20.

Parkinson turned in her best game so far as a T-Bird, scoring 11 points on 5-7 shooting while also pulling down five rebounds. Kimie Hawkins grabbed 10 boards for SUU to go along with seven points. The Lady Raiders had three players finish in the double-figures including Morris with 18, Hyde at 16 and Kelsi Baker who had 13.

"Sofia did exactly what we expect her to do for us, she is instant offense," explained SUU head coach JR Payne. "She is also a great teammate and brings a terrific spirit to this team."

SUU guard Hailey Mandelko opened the game with a three pointer from the left wing, but the Raiders quickly answered with a driving score by Ashley Claussen that started a 6-0 run to go up 6-3. The Thunderbirds came back with four straight to retake the lead at 7-6.

The Raiders narrowed the margin to one at 40-39 in the closing minutes of the period, but the Thunderbirds put up six points in final 60 seconds, capped by a put-back lay-up by Lori Parkinson just before the horn to take a 46-39 advantage into the locker room.

Mandelko opened the second half the same way she started the game as she knocked down another three-pointer to push the SUU advantage into the double-digits. She then put up four more points as the Thunderbirds started the period on a 15-4 run that pushed the margin to 18 points with the score at 61-43.

The SUU lead would grow to as much as 32 points in the closing minutes before the Thunderbirds eventually took the game by a final score of 99-71.

The Southern Utah offense started the season strong recording its highest scoring total since the 2010-11 season while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor. The T-Birds also held a 56-39 rebounding advantage and went 30-45 from the foul line.

Five Thunderbirds turned in double-digit scoring performances including Hepworth with 21, Mandelko at 18, Moreland with 11 and Hawkins and Jones who each had 12. Moreland also pulled down 13 rebounds to start the year with a double-double. Sweat finished with 26 for the Raiders who got another 13 from forward Alexi Smith.

"I thought we played really well in spurts," commented Payne. "Overall it was a great win and it was good that everyone got to play."

Southern Utah got on the scoreboard first after Desiree Jackson drew contact on a drive on the Thunderbirds second possession and hit both free throws to put SUU up 2-0. The Utes came back with a three-point play by Taryn Wicijowski. After a three from Hailey Mandelko and a pair of Desiree Jackson free throws the score was knotted up again at 7-7.

The two sides traded scores in the closing minutes of the half until SUU took possession with four seconds left on the clock. Andrea Jones took the inbounds pass and quickly dribbled the length of the court before firing off a runner from the right side that beat the buzzer to make the score 35-28 heading into the break.

Utah opened the second half with a 16-0 run capped by a three from Rodrigues, to push its lead to 51-28. Mandelko knocked down a three to stop the streak and Marissa Robbins added four straight as SUU narrowed the margin to 57-37. The Thunderbirds then continued to cut away at the deficit as they outscored the Utes 18-10 over a five-minute stretch to bring the tally to 61-46.

The Utes took back momentum Paige Crozon hit a pair free throws that pushed the lead to 70-52, but the Thunderbirds came back with another Mandelko three that started a 9-0 run to bring the score to bring SUU within nine at 70-61 with just over four minutes left to play.

Four-straight free throws and a lay-up by Rodrigues would then push the Utah lead to 76-61 with under two minutes left in the game. The Utes added on a few more free throws in the closing moments to eventually hold on for the 79-61 victory.

The Utes got big performances from Rodrigues who scored 20 points and Wicijowski who finished with 20 points and 15 rebounds. Robbins was the Thunderbirds top-scorer with 10 points, but 10 different players scored for SUU. Utah held a slight edge on the glass, outrebounding Southern Utah 46-40, and a significant advantage from the foul line where it connected on 25 attempts to the T-Birds 10 makes.
