# ED LAMB

## BRIGHAM YOUNG, 1996 FIFTH SEASON AT SUU



A 2010 Eddie Robinson Award finalist, Ed Lamb is entering his fifth season as head coach of the Thunderbird football program.

In his first four years overseeing the program, Coach Lamb has guided the team on a path that has seen it improve from the 0-11 squad he inherited to back-to-back winning seasons in 2010 and 2011, including the 2010 Great West Conference championship team.

During his first year at SUU Coach Lamb turned around a program which had been mired in a 19-game slide, and while the 2008 team finished with just four wins, those were four more than the program had in any of the previous three seasons. SUU also broke through with its first road-win in four years when it stopped Southland Conference champion and 22nd-ranked Texas State, 34-30, in 2008.

That same season Lamb oversaw a program which put 11 players on the all-Great West Conference squad, including seven first-team selections as well as its special teams player of the year. The Thunderbirds finished the 2008 season ranked among the nation's top-20 teams in punting and punt returns, passing offense and tackles-for-loss last year as well.

The improvement continued in 2009 when the team finished with a 5-6 mark, its best record since 2004. The team ranked among the nation's top-20 programs in passing, pass efficiency, total offense, scoring offense and punt returns in addition to leading the nation on net punting.

The Thunderbirds had two all-Americans in 2009, placed 12 players on the all-conference squad and had 14 academic all-conference selections. SUU had individuals ranked among the nation's top 10 in pass receptions, receiving yards, total offense, punt returns and scoring as well.

In 2010 the team continued its ascent, as the T-Birds claimed their first Great West championship with a perfect 4-0 mark in conference games, posted an overall 6-5 record, the team's first winning record since 2004, and finished the season ranked among the nation's top-30 in both the coaches and the media polls. Among the team's five losses, only one came by more than eight points.

SUU matched 2010's 6-5 record in 2011, a season which included the team's first win over a FBS-level team in 14 seasons and only its second ever, a 41-16 win at UNLV. Although the team went through a three-game GWC skid midway through the year, SUU closed the season winning three of four games, including a win over UC Davis and victories at future Big Sky rivals Weber State and Northern Arizona, with the only setback a loss at then-No. 5 Northern Iowa.

SUU dominated the all-GWC teams the last two years, with 14 selections in each season. In 2010 SUU had 10 first-team selections, four on the second-team and three more earning honorable mention. SUU wide receiver Tysson Poots was the GWC's offensive player of the year in 2010 as well as a consensus first-team All-American.

In 2011 SUU swept the GWC's individual awards, as QB Brad Sorensen was named offensive player of the year, DE

Tyler Osborne earned defensive player of the year honors, RB/KR Austin Minefee was the special teams player of the year and WR/PR Brady Measom was the newcomer of the year. In addition to those honors, SUU had nine first-team and five second-team all-GWC selections, while Osborne and Minefee both earned all-America honors.

Coach Lamb came to SUU from the University of San Diego, where he served as special teams coordinator, recruiting coordinator and defensive backs coach for three years.

A 1996 graduate of Brigham Young University, Lamb helped guide the University of San Diego to three consecutive Pioneer League championships as well as back-to-back NCAA Division I-AA Mid-Major National Championships in 2005 and 2006. In 2007 the USD special teams ranked first or second in the Pioneer League in every statistical category and the defense finished 2006 ranked fourth nationally after the Toreros completed an 11-1 season. While at USD Coach Lamb's responsibilities included serving as the team's budget manager and recruiting in addition to his on-field responsibilities.

Prior to joining the Toreros in 2005, Lamb spent two seasons as defensive coordinator at the University of Idaho where his 2003 team finished second in the Sun Belt Conference in scoring defense. As part of his duties as coordinator, his primary responsibility was with the Vandal secondary.

Coach Lamb spent the 2001 season on the BYU staff as a defensive assistant working with the linebackers. While with the Cougars he helped the squad to a 10-2 record and a Mountain West Conference title.

Lamb served as defensive coordinator and linebackers coach at the University of Redlands from 1998 through 2000, where his teams went 21-6 overall and boasted the Southern California Intercollegiate Athletic Conference's top scoring defense every year he was with the program. He also served as the Bulldogs' recruiting coordinator.

Prior to becoming defensive coordinator at Redlands Lamb spent one season as a graduate assistant working with the defensive line.

As a student-athlete, Lamb played linebacker and defensive end from 1992-96 on Brigham Young University and BYU-Idaho teams which combined to win four conference championships.

Lamb and his wife, Sarah, are the parents of three daughters: Anna, Amelia and Summer, and son Claude Edward IV.

## #4 Brad Sorensen 6-5, 235, Sr, QB Grand Terrace, California

**At SUU, 2011:** Was named the Great West Conference's Offensive Player of the Year. Earned first-team all-GWC honors from both the coaches and media for the second straight season and also was a Payton Award Watch finalist. Completed 288-of-425 passes for 3,143 yards and 17 touchdowns. He set an SUU record with his 425 attempts, while his 288 completions are fourth-most in a season at SUU, the 3,143 yards are second (behind his own record 3,163 set in 2010) and the 17 TD passes are tied for the sixth-most in school history. He also finished the season with the second-highest total plays in a season at SUU, 495, and 3,094 yards of total offense, which ranks third, behind Casey Rehner's 3,439 yards in 2004 and Sorensen's own 3,170 yards in 2010. Career-wise, Sorensen moved into first place on the SUU career completions list last year, with 549, and he is in second place in three more categories: his 37 TD passes are two shy of Rick Robins' SUU record, his 6,306 passing yards are 1,135 behind Robins and his 815 career pass attempts are 208 fewer than Robins had from 1992-95. He also broke the SUU a single-game record for completions in a game with 38, against North Dakota, and he had seven additional marks that rank among the school's top-10 single-game efforts during the 2011 season. He threw a touchdown pass in all but three games. Earned four College Football Performance Awards honor roll recognitions during the season, including the games vs UT-San Antonio, vs. North Dakota, at South Dakota and at Northern Arizona. Against UTSA he completed 20-of-28 passes for 287 yards and three touchdowns, and four incompletions were drops. Against UND he completed 38-of-54 passes for 353 yards and three touchdowns. The 54 attempts tie his personal-high and are the second-most in school history. The 353 yards are the seventh-most by an SUU quarterback and Sorensen's third-highest total in a single game. At South Dakota he completed 32-of-44

passes for 303 yards and two touchdowns, and at Northern Arizona he completed 29-of-41 passes for a season-high 389 yards and two touchdowns. The 389 passing yards at NAU are the fifth-most in a game at SUU. **At SUU, 2010:** Earned first-team all-Great West Conference honors from both the coaches and the media and was the only unanimous choice by the media. Completed 261-of-390 passes for a school-record 3,163 passing yards and 21 touchdowns. His 261 completions were the second-most in school history, his 390 attempts were third most and the 21 scoring strikes are tied as the third-most in a season at SUU. Was named National Player of the Week by College Football Performance Awards as well as the Great West Player of the Week following the UC Davis game in which he completed 30-of-36 passes for 397 yards and five touchdowns and ran for another score. The five TD passes tied the SUU single-game record, as did the six TDs he was responsible for. He also earned honorable mention honors from CFPA following the Cal Poly, North Dakota and Dixie State games. Against Cal Poly, when he was also named GWC Player of the Week, Sorensen averaged 14 yards per completion, completing 18-of-22 passes for 253 yards and a touchdown with no interceptions. He finished the Cal Poly game with a career-best efficiency rating of 193.42. Against North Dakota he completed 35-of-46 passes for 413 yards and two TDs, while against Dixie State he completed 19-of-23 passes for 245 yards and three touchdowns before exiting the game with the team holding a 35-0 lead with 6:13 to play in the first half. Sorensen had three games in 2010 worthy of the SUU record books, and all three came on the road. At North Dakota the 35 completions tied the existing SUU single-game record, set by Cade Cooper vs. Eastern Washington in 2009, while the 413 yards rank third in the SUU record books. His 46 attempts at UND are tied for ninth on the list. He also notched his name into the SUU record books in five single-game categories at Texas State. His 49 pass attempts rank fourth at SUU; his 352 passing yards and 29 completions rank seventh, while the 399 total yards rank seventh (fifth at the time); and his 57 plays are tied for seventh on the total plays list. At UC Davis, in addition to his five touchdowns tying the single-game record, the yards are the fourth-best total in SUU single-game history, and the 30 completions and 400 total yards rank sixth. In the team category, the 35, 30 and 29 completions rank tied for first, sixth and seventh, respectively.

**Prior to SUU:** Spent the 2009 season as a redshirt at Brigham Young University. Played one season at San Bernardino Valley College, where he earned first-team all-Foothill Conference honors after completing 177-of-296 passes for 2,280 yards and 17 touchdowns with just four interceptions. Earned conference's offensive player of the week an astounding seven times during the one season as a Wolverine, playing for coaches Pat Meech and Jason Brown.

**Personal:** Prepped at Colton (Calif.) High School where he earned first-team all-league and all-county honors following both his junior and senior seasons. Completed 73 percent of his passes his senior year when he threw for 2,119 yards and 27 touchdowns as well as rushing for 109 yards and three TDs with seven 2-point conversions. Threw for 1,275 yards and nine scores as a junior when he helped Coach Harold Strauss' Yellowjackets to a Citrus Belt League championship. Served as a team captain and was MVP of the offense his senior year as well. Also lettered in basketball, earning first-team all-league honors. Parents are Roxann and Kory Sorensen. Served an LDS church mission to Malaja, Spain.
