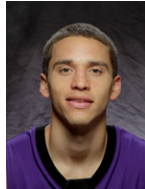

## WILDCATS DOMINATE UND FOR FIFTH STRAIGHT WIN

Four players scored in double figures as Weber State won its fifth straight with a 95-63 victory over new Big Sky member North Dakota Saturday. The Wildcats led 12-8 five minutes into the game when they caught fire and responded with a 26-8 run over the next 10 minutes. They led by as many as 27 points in the first half and held a 46-21 lead at halftime. North Dakota was never closer than 23 points in the second half and the 'Cats led by as many as 35 in route to the win.

Weber State shot 55 percent from the field for the game and held UND to just 30 percent shooting. WSU also outrebounded UND 46-26 and recorded nine blocks and 19 assists. The 32-point win is Weber State's largest Big Sky in win nearly four years.

## SCOTT BAMFORTH EARNS BIG SKY WEEKLY HONORS



WSU senior Scott Bamforth has been named the Big Sky Conference Co-Player of the Week after leading Weber State to two conference victories last week.

Bamforth, a 6-2 senior guard from Albuquerque, N.M., averaged 20.5 points, three assists, 2.5 steals and 1.5 rebounds per game as the Wildcats earned conference wins over Northern Colorado and North Dakota. He was 10-of-15 from 3-point range and 15-of-25 from the floor in the two games.

He scored a season-high 22 points, hitting 5-of-7 3-pointers with three steals and two assists in just 22 minutes in a 79-54 win over Northern Colorado on Thursday. He followed that up with 19 points, hitting 5-of-8 from 3-point range with four assists, two steals and two rebounds in 26 minutes of action in a 95-63 win over North Dakota on Saturday.

On the season Bamforth is averaging 12.8 points per game and shooting 44 percent from three-point range, fifth best in the Big Sky. He currently ranks fourth in Weber State history in career three-pointers with 184. He enters Thursday's game needing just 18 more points to become the 27th player in WSU history to reach 1,000 career points.

This is Bamforth's second career Big Sky Player of the Week honor and he is the fourth different Weber State player to earn the award this season.

## ROAD WARRIORS

This Saturday's game at Southern Utah begins a stretch of six of the next eight games on the road for Weber State. So far this season the Wildcats are 3-2 on the road and 2-0 on the road in Big Sky games. They were 7-7 away from home last season, including a 6-2 conference record.

### KYLE TRESNAK TIES CAREER-HIGH



WSU junior center Kyle Tresnak tied his career-high with 22 points in Saturday's win. He was 7-8 from the field and 8-10 from the free throw line for his 22 points and also pulled down six rebounds and had two blocked shots. Weber State improved to 7-0 this season in games when Tresnak scores in double figures and 1-3 when he does not score in double figures. He has scored in double figures in seven of his last eight games. On the season Tresnak is averaging 11.5 points and 5.3 rebounds a game while shooting 55 percent from the field, fourth best in the Big Sky. He also ranks fifth in the conference in blocks at 1.5 a game.

### 20 POINTS FOR DAVION BERRY

WSU junior Davion Berry posted one of his best games of the season Saturday, finishing with 20 points on 7-11 shooting. He also added a career-high six rebounds and had six assists, along with three steals. Berry has started all 12 games for the Wildcats this season and leads the team in scoring at 13.1 points per game, which ranks 12th in the Big Sky. He is also third in the conference in assists at 3.9 per game and is shooting 48 percent from the field, 10th best in the Big Sky.



### ANOTHER GREAT REBOUNDING PERFORMANCE FOR BOLOMBOY



Weber State freshman Joel Bolomboy had just two points but pulled down 11 rebounds in Saturday's win over North Dakota. Bolomboy, a native of Fort Worth, Texas, has now recorded double digits in rebounding in six of his 12 games played in his career. On the season he is second in the Big Sky in rebounding at 8.4 per game. He also ranks third in the conference in blocks at 1.6 per game after blocking three on Saturday.

### RANDY RAHE WINS IN HIS 200TH CAREER GAME

Saturday's game was the 200th career game for WSU head coach Randy Rahe. In his seventh season Rahe has a career record of 129-71 and is 78-22 in Big Sky games. He needs two more conference wins to move into sixth place in Big Sky history in career conference victories. He has led the Wildcats to three Big Sky Championships and five postseason tournament appearances.

### BLOWOUT CITY

In the last three games Weber State has won by an average margin of victory of 40.7 points per game. They defeated Southwest 110-45 for the largest margin of victory in school history and then beat Northern Colorado by 25 and North Dakota by 32, the largest conference win in nearly four years.

In the four Big Sky games this season Weber State is winning by an average of 20.5 points per game and averaging more than 80 points per game. They are also shooting 53 percent from the field and holding opponents to 37 percent shooting in Big Sky games.

### WILDCATS IN TOP TEN IN NATION IN FOUR CATEGORIES

Weber State now ranks in the top 10 in the country in four statistical categories. The Wildcats are third in the country in three-point field goal percentage at 42.6 percent. They are also fifth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage defense, holding their opponents to 25.6 percent shooting from three-point land. The Wildcats are also sixth in the nation in field goal percentage at 51 percent and seventh in scoring margin at 19.3 points per game.

### SEASON TRENDS

Weber State improved to 9-0 this season when outshooting its opponents and is 0-3 when trailing in field goal percentage. The Wildcats are also 7-0 this season when scoring 70 or more points in a game and they are 8-0 when outrebounding their opponent and 1-3 when trailing in rebounding. WSU is also 9-0 when leading in blocked shots and 0-3 when trailing in that category.

## ABOUT SOUTHERN UTAH



The Thunderbirds of Southern Utah enter Thursday's game with a 5-8 overall record and a 3-1 mark in Big Sky play. They opened conference play with wins over North Dakota and Northern Colorado and a road win at Northern Arizona before falling 64-59 Monday night at Sacramento State for their first loss.

On the season the Thunderbirds are ninth in the Big Sky in scoring at 64.8 points per game and eighth in scoring defense at 72.4 a game. They are last in the league in three-point field goal percentage at just 28.8 percent and also last in three-point field goal percentage defense at 38 percent. They are also last in turnover margin and assist to turnover ratio. SUU leads the Big Sky in blocked shots and is second in rebounding and second in rebounding margin.

Individually senior Jackson Stevenett ranks second in the conference in scoring at 14.9 points per game and is seventh in the league in rebounding at 6.3 a game. He had 24 points and 12 rebounds against Sacramento State Monday. Senior Damon Heuir is fifth in the league in scoring at 14.4 points per game, including scoring 30 points in Saturday's win at Northern Arizona. Junior Jayson Cheesman leads the Big Sky in blocks at 2.4 a game.

SUU finished last season with a 14-17 overall record and an 8-10 mark in Summit League action under head coach Roger Reid. The Thunderbirds were picked to finish 10th in the Big Sky this season in the preseason polls.

## HEAD COACH NICK ROBINSON

Southern Utah is coached by Nick Robinson who is in his first season as a head coach. Prior to coming to Southern Utah Robinson spent three seasons as an assistant coach at LSU and two years at Stanford. He is a Stanford graduate and played in 110 career games for the Cardinal before beginning his coaching career.

## SERIES HISTORY

The Wildcats hold a 22-6 all-time series lead over Southern Utah and have won five straight games against the Thunderbirds. In games played in Cedar City the Wildcats hold a 6-4 all-time advantage and have won the last two games played in the Centrum. Weber State head coach Randy Rahe is 5-1 in his career against Southern Utah.

## LAST MEETING - 12/10/11 - WSU 84, SUU 66

Weber State beat SUU 84-66 on Dec. 10, 2011 in Ogden in the last meeting between the two teams. The Wildcats shot 56 percent from the field, dished out 20 assists and knocked down nine three-pointers in route to beating the Thunderbirds. Damian Lillard once again led Weber State, finishing with 31 points and dished out a career-high nine assists. Kyle Tresnak added 15 points and Jordan Richardson and Byron Fulton each had 10.

## LAST GAME IN CEDAR CITY - 12/11/10 - WSU 77-71

Weber State defeated Southern Utah 77-71 Dec. 11, 2010 in Cedar City. Damian Lillard led Weber State with 22 points in the final game, which turned out to be his last full game before suffering a season-ending injury six days later at Tulsa. The game was a career night for Darin Mahoney who scored 19 points and pulled down eight rebounds and earned Big Sky Player of the Week honors for his performance.

## 50 YEARS OF DIVISION I BASKETBALL

This season marks the 50th anniversary of Division I basketball at Weber State. The Wildcats began competing as a four-year school and a Division I member in the 1962-63 season. A celebration commemorating 50 years of Division I basketball is planned March 7-9, 2013.

## AROUND THE BIG SKY

Just like it was most of last season Weber State and Montana are on top of the Big Sky standings, both at 4-0. This week Montana travels to North Dakota and Northern Colorado.

## BIG SKY RANKINGS

The Wildcats lead the Big Sky in 11 statistical categories. WSU is first in scoring offense, scoring defense, scoring margin, field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense, three-point field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage defense, rebounding margin, assists, assist to turnover ratio and defensive rebounds.

Individually, WSU Davion Berry ranks 12th in the conference in scoring at 13.1 points per game. Joel Bolomboy is second in rebounding at 8.4. Frank Otis leads the Big Sky in field goal percentage at .636.

## QUOTING WSU HEAD COACH RANDY RAHE

"I was pleased with how we executed our offense and played tough defense in our two games last week. We have been playing well together but we still have several areas where we need to improve.

"We face another very tough team this week in Southern Utah, that has been playing very well. It's always a tough place to play and they are always very good at home. They are a very physical and strong team and we have to be ready to play."

## LOOKING AHEAD

After Thursday Weber State will play at Idaho State on Monday, Jan. 14 before returning home to host Northern Arizona and Sacramento State next weekend.

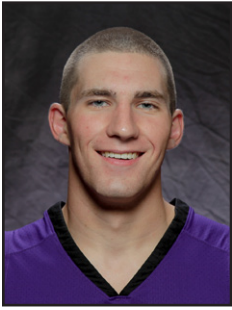
