Wildcat Basketball History

Weber State entered the 2012-13 season with the 23rd best winning percentage in college basketball history. In 50 seasons of Wildcat basketball WSU entered the season with a .634 winning percentage to rank 23rd all-time.

QUICK HITS

- After a four-game road trip the Weber State men's basketball team is back home to begin a four-game homestand Saturday against Southern Utah.
- The Wildcats are 15-5 overall and 10-2 in Big Sky play.
- Weber State has reached 10 Big Sky wins in seven straight seasons.
- Southern Utah comes into the game 10-12 overall and is 8-5 in Big Sky play and alone in third place in the conference. SUU has won five straight games following Thursday's 81-79 overtime win at Idaho State.
- The Wildcats defeated the Thunderbirds 81-74 Jan. 10 in Cedar City.
- Weber State holds a 23-6 all-time series edge over SUU. WSU has won five straight games and is 16-2 all-time against the Thunderbirds in Ogden.
- Saturday's game begins a stretch of four home games in eight days for the Wildcats who will have six of their final eight conference games at home.

WILDCATS ROLL TO WIN AT NORTHERN COLORADO

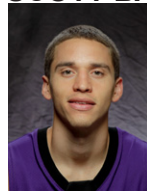
Five players scored in double figures and Weber State shot 60 percent from the field as the Wildcats rolled to an 85-64 win at Northern Colorado Saturday night in Greeley.

After two free throws by Northern Colorado to take a 2-0 lead the Wildcats took over and went on an 8-0 run and led 10-2 with 15:00 to play. They would never trail again. Northern Colorado missed its first 11 shots from the field and the Wildcats led by 20 points, 45-25 at halftime.

The 'Cats continued their strong play in the second half and jumped out to a 30-point lead at 62-32 with 14:12 to play. They led by as many as 32 points in the second half in route to the win.

Weber State finished the game shooting 60.8 percent from the field, their best percentage against a Division I team this season, and held Northern Colorado to 38 percent shooting. WSU also outrebounded the Bears 35-27. They were 8-17 from three-point range and 15-18 from the free throw line.

SCOTT BAMFORTH LEADS THE WILDCATS IN WINS



Weber State senior and team captain Scott Bamforth finished with 20 points to lead the 'Cats in Saturday's win. He was 6-9 from the field, including 4-7 from three-point land in the win. It was the second time this season and the 10th time in his career he has scored 20 or more points in a game. Bamforth has led the Wildcats in scoring five times this year.

On the season the Albuquerque, N.M., native is averaging 13.5 points per game, 10th in the Big Sky. He is averaging 14.8 points a game in Big Sky games. He currently ranks first in the conference and sixth in the country in free throw percentage at 91.4 percent. He has made 42 of 44 free throw attempts in Big Sky games.

Bamforth now ranks 17th in WSU history in career scoring with 1,098 points and is third in career three-point field goals with 203.

FRANK OTIS CONTINUES STRONG PLAY



WSU's other senior, Frank Otis had a terrific weekend in leading Weber State to two road wins, averaging 17.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game and shooting 82 percent from the field. He was 14-17 from the field in the two games and was 7-8 from the free throw line, along with five assists, two steals and two blocks. He had a career-high 20 points and 12 rebounds in Thursday's win at North Dakota and was 8-11 from the field in the game. He followed that up with 15 points and three rebounds, while shooting a perfect 6-6 from the field in Saturday's win at Northern Colorado.

On the season Otis is averaging 9.2 points and 6.0 rebounds a game and leads the Big Sky in field goal percentage at 68.1 percent. He is shooting 72.5 percent in Big Sky games. He currently ranks fourth in the nation in field goal percentage.

10+ BIG SKY WINS IN SEVEN STRAIGHT SEASONS

With Saturday's win Weber State has now won 10 or more Big Sky games in seven straight seasons, becoming the first team in Big Sky Conference history to accomplish that feat. The 'Cats have won at least 10 conference games in all seven of the years under Coach Randy Rahe.

HOME SWEET HOME

Weber State begins a four game homestand this weekend, returning to the Dee Events Center, and will play six of the final eight conference games at home. Weber State is the only team with eight road games through 12 games in conference play.

The Wildcats have won five straight home games, 25 of the last 26, and 32 of the last 34 games. WSU also has a 13-game home winning streak in Big Sky games. Over the last three seasons the Wildcats are 35-3 at the Dee Events Center. In the seven seasons under Coach Randy Rahe the Wildcats are 83-12 in home games, including a 48-4 home record in Big Sky regular season games.

'CATS WINNING BLOWOUT GAMES

With Saturday's win the Wildcats improved to 11-0 in games this season decided by 11 or more points. On the other hand the 'Cats are 4-5 on the year in games decided by 10 points or less, including 2-3 in games of five points or less.

Weber State leads the Big Sky and is 11th in the nation in scoring margin at +15.3 per game.

GET ME TO 80

Weber State improved to 7-0 this season when scoring 80 or more points. The Wildcats lead the Big Sky and are ?? in the nation in scoring at 77.2 points a game. They are 9-0 this season when holding their opponents under 60 points.

SEASON TRENDS

The Wildcats are also 14-0 this season when outrebounding their opponent and are 14-2 when leading in field goal percentage. WSU is also 13-2 when leading in assists and 13-2 when leading in blocked shots. The 'Cats are 14-0 when leading with 5:00 to play in regulation.

WILDCATS IN THE NATIONAL RANKINGS

Weber State ranks fourth in the nation in field goal percentage at 50.5 percent. They are also fourth in the country in three-point field goal percentage (41.8) and fifth in three-point field goal percentage defense at 26.8 percent. WSU also ranks, 11th in scoring margin (+15.3) and the Wildcats are 20th in scoring offense at 77.2 points per game.

Individually, Frank Otis ranks fourth in the nation in field goal percentage at 68.1 percent and Scott Bamforth is sixth in free throw percentage (.914). Jordan Richardson is 18th in the nation in assist to turnover ratio (2.7) and Joel Bolomboy is 84th in blocked shots at 1.8 per game.

ABOUT SOUTHERN UTAH



The Thunderbirds of Southern Utah enter Saturday's game with a 10-12 overall record and an 8-5 mark in Big Sky play, currently alone in third in the league standings. After losing five straight, the Thunderbirds have now won five straight conference games, including an 81-79 overtime win at Idaho State

Thursday night. They are 2-7 on the road this season.

Southern Utah leads the Big Sky in rebounding at 38.4 per game and is second in rebounding margin. They are second in the league in field goal percentage defense and rank third in free throw percentage. They are last in the Big Sky in turnover margin at -4.7.

SUU is led by senior Damon Heuir who is tied for first in the Big Sky in scoring at 16.8 points per game. He was named conference Player of the Week last week and scored 23 on Thursday night. He also ranks fifth in the league in three-pointers made per game. Senior Jackson Stevenett is third in the conference in scoring at 16.7 per game and ranks sixth in rebounding at 6.2 per game.

HEAD COACH NICK ROBINSON

SUU is coached by Nick Robinson who is in his first season as a head coach. Prior to coming to Southern Utah Robinson spent three seasons as an assistant coach at LSU and two years at Stanford. He is a Stanford graduate and played in 110 career games for the Cardinal before beginning his coaching career.

SERIES HISTORY

The Wildcats hold a 23-6 all-time series lead over Southern Utah and have won six straight games against the Thunderbirds, including an 81-74 win on Jan. 10 in Cedar City. In games played in Ogden, Weber State has a 16-2 all-time series advantage and the 'Cats have won four straight and 12 of the last 13 games. WSU head coach Randy Rahe is 6-1 in against Southern Utah.

JAN. 10, 2013 - CEDAR CITY - WSU 81, SUU 74

Four Wildcats scored in double figures as Weber State defeated Southern Utah 81-74 Jan. 10 in Cedar City for its sixth straight win. In a very physical game the two teams combined to shoot 76 free throws. The Wildcats held a 30-29 advantage at halftime.

SUU retook the lead to start the second half and held a 38-37 advantage with 15:00 to play when Weber State responded with a 16-4 run over the next 5:21 and never trailed again. WSU led by as many as 15 in the second half and made 25 free throws in the second half to seal the win.

For the game the Wildcats were 36-49 from the free throw line, including 25-32 from the line in the second half. There were 59 fouls called in the game. Weber State shot 39 percent from the field and held SUU to 35 percent shooting.

AROUND THE BIG SKY

Montana won its 13th straight game and improved to 13-0 in Big Sky play win a win over Northern Colorado Thursday night. The Grizzlies have won 24 straight Big Sky games, tying the conference record set by Weber State in the 1960's. Montana also became the first team to clinch a conference tournament berth. Weber State is second at 10-2 with Southern Utah now alone in third at 8-5. Montana State and North Dakota are tied for fourth at 7-6.

50 YEARS OF DIVISION I BASKETBALL

This season marks the 50th anniversary of Division I basketball at Weber State. The Wildcats began competing as a four-year school and a Division I member in the 1962-63 season. A celebration commemorating 50 years of Division I basketball is planned March 7-9, 2013.

BIG SKY RANKINGS

The Wildcats lead the Big Sky in 10 statistical categories. WSU is first in scoring offense, scoring defense, scoring margin, field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense, three-point field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage defense, rebounding defense, rebounding margin, and defensive rebounds.

Individually, Davion Berry ranks sixth in the league in scoring at 14.3 per game with Scott Bamforth 10th at 13.5. Freshman Joel Bolomboy is now third in rebounding at 8.2. Frank Otis leads the Big Sky in field goal percentage at .681. Bamforth leads the conference in free throw percentage at 91.4 percent. Jordan Richardson is first in assist to turnover ratio and is third in 3-point field goal percentage.

50TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

This season marks the 50th anniversary of Division I basketball at Weber State. The WSU Athletic Department and Wildcat Club are hosting a 50th anniversary celebration March 8-9 to honor the success of the Wildcat basketball program. The 50 Greatest Players from the past 50 years will also be named. Weber State has won 19 Big Sky titles and advanced to 14 NCAA Tournaments. WSU has the 23rd best winning percentage in the college basketball history.
