ON THE ROAD

After back-to-back home wins in Eccles Coliseum, the No. 24 Thunderbirds hit the road in hopes of picking up their first road victory as they take on the No. 11 Montana Grizzlies.

THE POLLS

The Thunderbirds sit No. 24 in the FCS coaches poll as the Grizzlies rank No. 11 in both the FCS media and coaches polls.

LAST MEETING | SERIES HISTORY

The last time the Thunderbirds and the Grizzlies matched up was back in 2014, as Montana captured a 35-15 victory over Southern Utah in Cedar City. As far as all-time series go, Montana leads the series 5-2. Although the Thunderbirds sit 2-4 all-time against the Grizzlies in Montana, SUU captured its last win in Missoula with a 30-20 victory back in 2012.

WORDS FROM COACH WARREN

On Montana: "We're headed into week four, going to Montana and they have a really good team this year. They're number 11 in the country and have only lost one homecoming game in the last 23 years so it will be a big challenge for our guys. We've got to have a great week of practice to be ready for that challenge. This is a game that we always talk about. We talk about if we can win when the schedule is tough. We're not sneaking up on anybody. They know we're a good team and they're a great team, and these are the games that can propel your program. We know what's at stake, this is a great opportunity for our guys to go out there and make a statement, and we know how difficult it's going to be once we get to Missoula."

On the crowd: "We started at Utah so that was a good test. I think we'll be ready for the crowd noise. We only had three penalties at Utah, and one of them was a delay of game that we chose to get, so I think we'll be ready for the crowd. It's going to be something different that our guys haven't experienced yet as far as being at Montana with that atmosphere on homecoming, but we've got a lot of guys that just want to play some football."

FROM MONTANA

The Grizzlies (2-1 overall, 0-1 BSC) suffered their first loss of the season last weekend in California, in a 42-41 slugfest with Cal Poly, who executed the nation's number one rushing attack. Though a loss for the Griz, quarterback Brady Gustafson and receiver Jerry Louie-McGee each broke school records and tied Big Sky conference records for pass completions and receptions. After breaking school records for completions and catches in a game, the Grizzlies bring the No. 12 ranked passing offense in the nation into Saturday's game, with senior QB Brady Gustafson averaging nearly 300 yards passing per-game.

Demario Warren is currently in his first season as the head football coach at Southern Utah University. Warren has spent the past eight seasons with Southern Utah University, the last two serving as the defensive coordinator for one of the top defensive units in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS).

During his tenure, Coach Warren developed four draft rated prospects in first-team All-American, James Cowser, Miles Killebrew, LeShaun Sims and Dion Turner. Warren has had 18 All-Conference performers in eight years, including nine out of eleven defensive players earning All Big-Sky honors during the 2015 Big Sky Championship season. After the conclusion of the 2015 season, James Cowser was named Big Sky Defensive Player of the Year and ADA Defensive Player of the Year. In 2015, the Thunderbirds' defense led the nation in turnover margin. The defensive unit also shutout two teams during the 2015 campaign, and held three more to seven or less points.

Coach Warren arrived to SUU from UC Davis, where he was a three-year letterman at running back before injuries cut short his career during his senior season. Coach Warren earned a starting spot with the Aggies in 2005 as a redshirt freshman when he finished second on the team in rushing.

A native of Fairfield, California, Coach Warren earned his bachelor's degree in African-American studies from UC Davis and earned an MBA degree from the University of Phoenix. Warren and his wife, Amanda, have three children, Demario, Jr. (11), Jazelle (6) and Daylee (2).
