LAST TIME OUT

In their last outing against the Northern Colorado Bears, the Thunderbirds had a late surge, but ultimately came up short to move to 1-7 on the year.

The Bears jumped out to an early 14-0 lead over the T-Birds, but the Thunderbirds struck before the end of the first quarter to trail 14-8 after 15 minutes of play.

In the second quarter the two teams both knocked in a field goal, but the Bears scored a last-second touchdown from 35 yards away to take a 24-11 lead into the break.

The Bears added 10 quick points to start the second half before the T-Birds were able to get on the board with a 74-yard bomb from Tyler Skidmore to Landen Measom to pull SUU back within 35-18.

After the Bears scored one last touchdown the Thunderbirds scored 21-unanswered points, but it ultimately wasn't enough as they fell to the Bears 42-39.

STRONG DEBUT

After Austin Ewing got the start in Saturday's game and went out with an apparent injury, true freshman Tyler Skidmore was pushed into action and appeared in his first collegiate football game.

Skidmore threw for 330 yards in his debut, including a 74-yard touchdown to Measom. He finished the day 27-of-43 from the air.

The freshman out of Roy, Utah joined the Thunderbirds following a two-year church mission.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS

After another big day on the ground Jay Green Jr. now has 698 yards rushing on the season, and has broken into the endzone five times for the Thunderbirds. Freshman running back Karris Davis has matched Green Jr.'s touchdown number, as he's also racked up five touchdowns this season. Half of SUU's rushing touchdowns this season belong to either Green Jr. or Davis.

Landen Measom leads the receiver group in both number of catches and yards with 39 and 525 respectively, for an average of 65.6 per game. He also has accounted for one touchdown this season. Ty Rutledge has caught 33 passes for 394 yards and two touchdowns for the season.

DEFENSIVE LEADERS

Chinedu Ahanonu continues to lead the team in total tackles with 65, and tackles for loss with 8.5 so far this season. He's also compiled two sacks.

Fellow senior linebacker Taylor Nelson is second on the team in both categories, with 48 tackles and seven tackles for loss. Nelson also leads the nation in fumble recoveries with four.

AJ Stanley is third on the team with 46 tackles, to go along with three tackles for loss, a sack and an interception. He's also forced two fumbles for the T-Birds.

SALUTE TO SERVICE

Saturday will be Southern Utah's 'Salute to Service' game. For the festivities, those with a valid Military ID can will receive free tickets, and the various branches of the military will be recognized during halftime.

In addition, 1,000 U.S. flags will be handed out to the early arriving Thunderbird fans, and those in attendance are encouraged to wear black.

OPPONENT PREVIEW: MONTANA (4-4, 2-3 Big Sky)

The Montana Grizzlies will head to Cedar City on a three game slide, falling to Portland State, North Dakota and UC Davis in their previous three matchups.

In their most recent contest, the league-leading Aggies of UC Davis topped the Griz 49-21. Dalton Sneed threw for 230 yards on 25 completions and two touchdowns, but was also picked off by the Aggies three different times during the contest.

Sneed is both Montana's leading passer and rusher this season. In total, he's completed 186 passes for 1,826 yards and 12 touchdowns through the air. On the ground, he's carried the ball 90 times for 473 yards and five touchdowns.

Samuel Akem has been Sneed's top target through the air, catching 42 passes for 513 yards and eight touchdowns.

Defensively, Dante Olson has had a huge season for Montana. He's racked up 119 tackles, 10.5 tackles for loss and six sacks. He's also had two interceptions this season.

LAST TIME v MONTANA

The last time the Thunderbirds and Grizzlies squared off it was a battle of ranked teams, as No. 11 Montana topped No. 24 Southern Utah in Missoula during the 2016 season.

Former T-Bird running back Malik Brown had a big day on the ground for the T-Birds, rushing for 114 yards on 15 carries. Quarterback Patrick Tyler completed 16 passes for 160 yards and three touchdowns. Mike Sharp was the recipient of all three touchdowns for the Thunderbirds, catching seven passes for 78 yards.

RECENT SERIES HISTORY

The Thunderbirds and Grizzlies have squared off three times since becoming members of the same conference. The T-Birds won the first matchup as Big Sky foes in 2012, when they beat Montana 30-20.

The Griz have claimed the two most recent matchups, both in 2014 and 2016.

BIG SKY AT A GLANCE

Another week has come and gone in the Big Sky Conference, and the Aggies of UC Davis remain on top of the league with a perfect 5-0 record in BSC play, and a 7-1 overall record. Eastern Washington, Weber State and Idaho State all sit with a 4-1 record.

In the STATS FCS Poll the Wildcats came in at No. 4, the Eagles sit at No. 5 and the Aggies will enter this weekend at No. 6. In the FCS Coaches Poll the Eagles are No. 4, followed by the Wildcats at No. 5 and Aggies at No. 9.

WORDS FROM COACH WARREN

Demario Warren on the quarterback situation leading into this week...

"We've got a lot of good players, and we lean on Justin Walterscheid a lot to make sure that our guys are ready to go, and obviously you can see that no matter who goes in they're well prepared and ready to execute," he said.

Tyler Skidmore on playing his first game in nearly four years...

"I think I just needed to trust my role and trust my o-line," Skidmore said. "I think I got out of the pocket a little too much and forced some throws that weren't great and did some things that I wasn't supposed to, but the game didn't seem too fast."

Chinedu Ahanonu on the team's mindset moving forward...

"We just want to go 3-0 in our last three games," he said. "Of course we play pretty well at home, and those last two wins would put us above .500 at home. But just going out and fighting for each other. Fighting for the guys around us, the seniors, the younger players. I've always had really good seniors around to help me and I want to be that guy for players in the future."

2018 THUNDERBIRD COACHES



Head Coach Demario Warren Third Season as Head Coach 16-15 Overall, 13-8 Big Sky 10th Season @ Southern Utah

In just his second season as head coach of the Thunderbird football team, Demario Warren led the Thunderbirds to their second Big Sky Conference Championship in 2017 and to their third FCS Playoff appearance in school history.

Finishing the season 9-3, which marked the most Division I victories in a single season for the program, Warren led the Thunderbirds to their first ever trip to the Second Round of the FCS Playoffs when the team received a BYE in the opening round. The Thunderbirds also reached their highest ranking in both major FCS Polls, ending the season No. 13 in the FCS Coaches Poll and No. 14 in the STATS FCS Top 25.

Following the season, Warren was named AFCA Region 5 Coach of the Year and Co-Coach of the Year in the Big Sky Conference. This was his first time earning each of these accolades.

Under Warren's leadership, the T-Birds had 22 players named to the various Big Sky All-Conference Teams. Zach Larsen was named to a number of All-American teams, Landen Measom and Jalen Russell were named Freshman All-Americans, Mike Needham Earned All-American status from major outlets and Needham and Taylor Nelson were named to the 2017 FCS ADA Academic All-Star Team.

The 2017 Thunderbird football team also shattered previous attendance records, as 11,811 fans packed Eccles Coliseum to watch the Thunderbirds play in the Second Round of the FCS Playoffs.

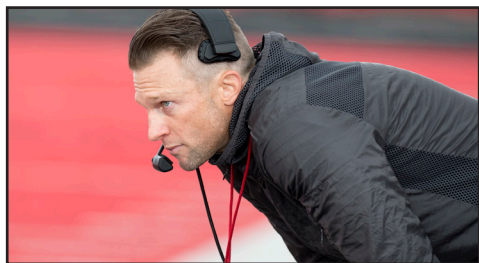
Under Warren's direction in 2016, Southern Utah football finished first in the Big Sky Conference in both interceptions, with 20 on the season, along with punting, as Big Sky All Conference First Team punter Tate Lewis finished the season averaging 45.4 yards per punt. The Thunderbirds also led the conference in kickoff coverage, allowing a conference low 355 return yards and a conference high of 40 touchbacks. SUU's kickoff net average was almost two yards higher than the next team's at 44.8. The team also finished second in the BSC in turnover margin.

Former SUU Director of Athletics Jason Butikofer announced the hiring of head coach Warren on January 11, 2016. Warren took seat atop the Thunderbird program after spending time serving as the defensive coordinator of the Thunderbirds.

Warren has spent the past 10 seasons with Southern Utah University. Before his head coach position, Warren spent two years as the defensive coordinator for one of the top defensive units in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). During his tenure, coach Warren developed three current NFL players in first-team All-American, James Cowser, Miles Killebrew, LeShaun Sims and Dion Turner. Warren has had 19 All-Conference performers in nine years, including nine out of eleven defensive players earning All Big-Sky honors during the 2015 Big Sky Championship season. In 2015, the Thunderbirds' defense led the nation in turnover margin.

Coach Warren and his wife, Amanda, are the parents of four children; Demario, Jr., Jazelle, Daylee and Lenox.

CEDAR CITY, Utah -- The Thunderbird football team opened their 2018 season on Saturday night with a contest against the University of North Alabama, where they fell to the Lions 34-30.

"I'm proud of the guys, they fought hard and fought to the end," SUU head coach Demario Warren said. "But we've got to be better, we made a couple mistakes out there."

Chris Helbig took the first snaps at quarterback for the Thunderbirds, but a promising drive resulted in a punt. The Lions quickly responded with a field goal, taking a 3-0 lead. Neither team scored for the remainder of the opening frame. The Thunderbirds scored their first points of the season with 11:12 to play on the clock when Manny Berz knocked home a 22-yard field goal to tie the contest up 3-3.

The following drive the Lions drove the length of the field to take a 10-3 lead.

SUU responded with a touchdown drive of their own, as Helbig tossed his first touchdown pass to Ty Rutledge from 22-yards away to tie the contest at 10-10.

UNA responded with a drive that resulted in a field goal, going back up 13-10.

With 58 seconds remaining in the opening half the Thunderbirds scored on a rush from Helbig to take a 16-13 lead. They held that lead heading into the halftime break.

At the half Rutledge had 90 yards receiving on three completions.

The Lions opened the second half with a touchdown, as Christian Lopez found Jakobi Byrd from 39 yards out to put the Lions up on top.

The Thunderbirds responded near the end of the third frame, as Helbig found Cockett from 12 yards away. The T-Birds led 23-20 at that point.

In the fourth quarter the two teams traded touchdown drives late. The Lions scored with 4:47 to play to take the lead, but the Thunderbirds quickly responded with a touchdown run from James Felila to cap a 75-yard drive. The Lions scored on the final drive of the game with 12 second to play, on a drive that featured late penalty calls against Southern Utah.

Helbig threw for 316 yards on 28 completions. Rutledge ended the contest with 161 yards on seven receptions. Felila had 83 yards rushing on the ground.

CORVALLIS, Ore. -- The Southern Utah Thunderbird football team fell to the Oregon State Beavers on Saturday evening at Reser Stadium, but showed drastic improvement from the first half to the second half outscoring OSU 18-7 in the second half.

"They came out and fought together," SUU head coach Demario Warren said. "I think the defense did a better job of getting off the field on third downs, which was something we struggled with early. The offense kept fighting. ... We became a team. I think that's something that we needed to do and hopefully we see that if we play together, cheer for each other and have some fun together we'll have a pretty good team. But we didn't come here to lose. We lost the game, and there's no moral victories here and we've got another tough one next week, so we really need to understand what it takes to beat a Pac-12 team and I'm hoping they learned that in the second half."

The Beavers got to work on their opening drive, but the Thunderbirds were able to stop them in the redzone for a field goal. On their next two drives OSU was able to get into the endzone, and took a 17-0 lead into the second quarter.

OSU picked up where they left off in the second period, as they added a touchdown on their first three drives to take a 38-0 lead.

With 4:43 to play in the opening half the Thunderbirds broke through and got on the board as Chris Helbig found Frank Harris III for his first career touchdown.

OSU added a field goal before the break to take a 41-7 lead into the break.

The Thunderbirds found their momentum in the third quarter on both sides of the ball. After a Manny Berz field goal, Helbig capped off a 70-yard drive with a short pickup on the ground to put six more on the board for the T-Birds. The score was 41-16 in favor of the Beavers going into the fourth quarter.

SUU scored another Berz field goal and a Jay Green Jr. touchdown in the closing half, leaving the Beavers with a 48-25 victory.

Helbig threw for 340 yards on 31 completions on Saturday night, with three touchdowns to his credit including one on the ground. Landen Measom caught seven passes against the Beaver secondary for 67 yards. Logan Parker grabbed six for 73. On the ground James Felila finished with 51 yards while Green Jr. added 49 of his own.

Defensively Chinedu Ahanonu led the team in tackles with 10. AJ Stanley had eight tackles, while Taylor Nelson, Jalen Russell and Taelin Webb all had six. Lehi Afatasi had a sack and two tackles for loss.

"The offense did a great job of controlling the football in the first half, I think we had their defense tired and worn out, but we couldn't stop them tonight," SUU head coach Demario Warren said. "Khalil Tate had a great game, and we made some mistakes we can't have, and that's on me as a defensive coach to make sure that they're more prepared. But we've got to move forward. The guys are always going to keep fighting, which I love about them, but I've got to do a better job as a head coach and defensive coordinator to be able to stop some teams that are doing what they need to do to win games."

The Thunderbirds opened the game with a promising drive, which resulted in a missed 32-yard field goal attempt that give the Wildcats possession. The home team wasted no time getting going, putting seven points on the board on their opening drive.

On Arizona's next offensive drive the T-Birds were able to force a turnover, as Jalen Russell caused a fumble and Taylor Nelson hopped on top of it. After an impressive drive by SUU Manny Berz connected on a 33-yard field goal attempt to make it 7-3 in favor of Arizona. However, on the ensuing kickoff the Wildcats returned the kick for a touchdown to take a 14-3 lead.

Southern Utah's next drive was a 13-play, 75-yard one that resulted in their first touchdown of the night from Jay Green Jr. on the ground. The following drive by Arizona resulted in a field goal after a strong stand from the defense, giving them a 17-10 lead.

SUU's next drive also resulted in seven, as they went 75 yards in 13 plays to tie the contest up at 17-17. Helbig scored for SUU from two yards out on the ground.

Right before the break the Wildcats added another touchdown as Khalil Tate found Sun Brown from 11 yards away to put the home team up 24-17 at half.

Unfortunately for the Thunderbirds, the third quarter was all Wildcats. Arizona outscored Southern Utah 24-0 in the third frame to take a 48-17 lead.

The Thunderbirds scored two more touchdowns in the final quarter of play. Helbig got in on the ground for a second time and found Frank Harris III for his second-career touchdown to put 14 more points on the scoreboard, but ultimately fell to Arizona 62-31.

Things started relatively slow for the Thunderbirds, as they weren't able to strike in the opening 15 minutes. The Lumberjacks got on the board once in the opening frame to take a 7-0 lead into the second quarter.

With 10:46 to play in the second frame T-Bird starting quarterback Chris Helbig broke into the endzone on a quarterback keeper, which tied the game at 7-7. NAU added a second touchdown before the break, giving them a 14-7 lead going into the break.

Unfortunately for the Thunderbirds, Helbig left the game late in the first half with an apparent injury and did not return. Aaron Zwahlen took over quarterback duties in place of Helbig.

In the third quarter, the T-Birds found their momentum. After forcing a three-and-out the Thunderbirds drove the field and Jay Green Jr. punched it in to tie the contest at 14-14. On their following drive, the T-Birds added a Manny Berz field goal from 31 yards away to take a 17-14 lead.

After the Lumberjacks responded with a field goal of their own to tie the game at 17-17, Zwahlen found Nick Colson for a touchdown to regain a 23-17 lead after a blocked PAT. Unfortunately for the SUU, that would be the last time they'd score on Saturday night.

The Lumberjacks scored with 2:10 left in the third quarter and with 5:36 to go in the fourth to pull away with a 31-23 victory.

Zwahlen finished the contest with 15 completions for 139 yards and a touchdown. On the ground Green Jr. had 16 carries for 101 yards and a touchdown. The T-Birds had 224 yards through the air and 218 on the ground.

Chinedu Ahanonu had nine tackles on Saturday night, while Webb had seven with two pass breakups.

The Thunderbirds will take their bye week next week before another Big Sky matchup on the road against the Eagles of Eastern Washington.

"We're not good enough, and that starts and ends with me. We've got to find a way to get better as a football team and that starts on Sunday all over again."

Hitting the field without starting quarterback Gage Gubrud, the Eagles struck quickly to start the contest and built a 14-0 lead with 7:39 to play in the opening quarter.

The Thunderbirds eventually got on the board with a 42-yard Manny Berz field goal with 1:33 to play in the first frame. In the second quarter the Eagles continued to build their lead, and built a 24-3 advantage with 13:17 left in the first half following a fumble recovery in the endzone.

The T-Birds bounced back on their next drive, however, as Aaron Zwahlen found Ty Rutledge with a pass to the corner of the endzone to cut the Eagle lead to 14.

Eastern Washington would add another touchdown and field goal before the end of the first half and took a 34-10 advantage into the halftime break.

As the second half got started the Eagles didn't slow down, and scored three touchdowns on three consecutive drives to take a 55-17 lead.

With 25 seconds remaining in the third quarter the Thunderbirds were able to get back on the scoreboard, as Jay Green Jr. charged into the endzone to make the score 55-17 in favor of the Eagles.

Unfortunately for the Thunderbirds, that'd be the last time they'd score in the contest. But they also held the Eagles scoreless to end of the contest at 55-17.

Zwahlen finished the contest 30-of-48 passing with 296 yards in the air and a touchdown. Ty Rutledge caught seven of those passes for 93 yards and a touchdown. Landen Measom and Daniel Bell both caught five passes for SUU. On the ground Jay Green Jr. rushed 30 times for 103 yards and a touchdown.

Chinedu Ahanonu led the team with 10 total tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss. Jordan Walker finished with nine total tackles.

CEDAR CITY, Utah -- In front of 10,424 fans, the Thunderbird football team knocked off the Sacramento State Hornets 48-27 picking up their first win of the season on Homecoming.

"I just want to thank Cedar City and southern Utah," SUU head coach Demario Warren said. "The crowd out there was amazing. We've struggled this year but the fans showed out, they were incredible today and really pulled us through this victory."

The contest got off to an incredibly fast start, as the Hornets scored on their opening drive, and the Thunderbirds responded with a Judd Cockett kick return for a touchdown that quickly tied the contest up at 7-7. Unfortunately for the T-Birds, the Hornets added two more touchdowns before the end of the first quarter and held a 21-7 lead after 15 minutes.

The second quarter, however, was all SUU. Karris Davis scored back-to-back touchdowns on back-to-back drives for the Thunderbirds, which also were the first two of his career. He finished the game with 84 yards on the ground.

SUU capped off the second quarter for themselves with a trick play that resulted in Lance Lawson hitting Austin Ewing for a touchdown. After a Hornet field goal to end the quarter, the T-Birds held a 27-24 lead heading into the break.

The T-Birds were the only offense to score in the third quarter, as Jay Green Jr. scored his first touchdown of the night and Austin Ewing snuck into the endzone on the ground to put SUU up 41-24 after three quarters of play.

The Hornets scored to start the fourth quarter, but the T-Birds quickly responded as Green Jr. scored his 19th career touchdown to put SUU up 48-27, which would ultimately be the final score.

Aaron Zwhalen finished the game 22-of-31 through the air for 153 yards. Zwhalen, Lawson and Ty Rutledge all completed a pass for SUU on Saturday.

Green Jr. finished the game with 107 yards on the ground and two touchdowns. Landen Measom had eight catches for 73 yards.

AJ Stanley led the team in tackles with seven. The T-Birds had eight tackles for loss, five pass breakups and four quarter-back hurries.

MOSCOW, Idaho -- The Thunderbird football team traveled take on the Idaho Vandals this weekend, and fell to their Big Sky foe 31-12. The result moves the T-Birds to 1-6 overall and 1-3 in the Big Sky Conference.

"It's just frustrating, we're not getting the job done," SUU head coach Demario Warren said. "We've just got to continue to work. Every time we do something well, it kind of backfires on us. We can't get off to a quick start and those are things we've been working on. It's a grind, it's a process. It's not fun to be 1-6, but it is what it is. We're going to continue to be the type of program we are. We're going to work hard, take it one day at a time and hope things break our way. But it's got to get better, they've got to improve, they got to believe in it, and we've got to find a way to win on the road which has been difficult his year."

The first three quarters of the contest were all Idaho. The Vandals held a 24-0 lead at the halftime break, and added to that in the third quarter with another touchdown to extend their lead to 31-0.

When the Thunderbirds started rolling offensively, Austin Ewing was at quarterback. He led them on a 16-play, 80-yard drive that culminated in a quarterback keeper for a touchdown to finally put SUU on the board. After a failed two-point conversion, the T-Birds trailed 31-6.

Later in the fourth, Ewing led the T-Birds on a seven-play, 60-yard drive that once again ended with a quarterback keeper ran in for a touchdown by the freshman.

"I think it just shows that no matter what happens we're going to fight until the end," Ewing said following the contest. Ewing ended the game with 210 yards on the ground, and was five-for-six with 37 yards passing. Jay Green Jr. ended the contest with 158 yards rushing for the T-Birds.

Defensively, AJ Stanley led the Thunderbirds with 10 tackles. Taylor Nelson and Jalen Russell both had two tackles for loss in the contest.

The Thunderbirds will return home next weekend to host the Bears of Northern Colorado.

CEDAR CITY, Utah -- The Southern Utah football team fell at home to the University of Northern Colorado Bears on Saturday night, despite the Thunderbirds scoring 21-unanswered points to close out the contest.

“Everybody can see that we fight, we fight until the end,” SUU head coach Demario Warren said. “They bust their butts, and it’s on me and the coaching staff to make sure we’re doing the right things at the right time to be able to score more points than the other team.”

The Thunderbirds gave up a touchdown on UNC’s first drive, as the Bears drove the field 72 yards in four plays. Northern Colorado scored on their second drive of the night as well, going 55 yards in eight plays to go up 14-0. SUU scored with 4:04 left in the first quarter, as Karris Davis broke into the endzone after a drive led by Tyler Skidmore. The T-Birds completed a two-point conversion to pull within 14-8.

The second quarter opened up with a Bear field goal, putting them up 17-8.

The T-Birds added a Manny Berz field goal with 3:48 to play in the opening half, cutting the lead back to 17-11. Unfortunately for the T-Birds, the Bears added a last-second touchdown before the break to take a 24-11 lead into the half.

The Bears scored twice, once with a field goal and again with a touchdown, to start the second half.

With 6:36 to play in the third quarter Skidmore hit Landen Measom with a 74-yard bomb to pull the T-Birds a little closer, but in less than a minute the Bears struck again with a touchdown of their own.

On the ensuing drive the Thunderbirds struck again with Davis on the ground to pull back within 17.

Both Davis and Skidmore scored on the ground in the fourth quarter, but Southern Utah wasn’t able to get the final three points they needed to force overtime and fell to the Bears 42-39.

Skidmore finished the game with 330 yards through the air and a touchdown. Jay Green Jr. led the team in rushing with 70, while Davis had 51 yards and three touchdowns. Measom had five catches for 154 yards and the 74-yard connection with Skidmore.

“The first play was a successful play, and it boosted my confidence a lot,” Skidmore said about getting his first collegiate playing time. “After that it was just going well, I had all the time in the world. We didn’t start fast enough, which has been the trend this whole season, but it was fun.”

Defensively the T-Birds were led by Taylor Nelson who finished the game with 10 tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss. AJ Stanley and Chinedu Ahanonu both finished the game with six tackles, and Stanley had an interception for the T-Birds.
