Setting the Scene

- SWOSU Volleyball carries a five-game winning streak into a pair of home matches late this week at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center
- The Bulldogs face Southeastern Oklahoma State on Thursday, looking to avenge an earlier defeat against the Savage Storm in Durant, before looking to finish off a home-and-home sweep of Southwestern Christian on Friday evening
- The Bulldogs have won nine of their last ten matches to improve to 16-8 on the year, setting a new single-season school record for wins while also clinching the first winning season in program history
- With their two league wins last weekend, the Bulldogs clinched their spot in the GAC Tournament, which will be held November 19-21 in Hot Springs, Arkansas

The Opponents

Southeastern Oklahoma State (5-19, 3-8 GAC)

- Snapped an eight-game losing streak on Saturday with a 3-0 win over Arkansas-Monticello in Durant, their third Great American Conference victory of the season
- Previously defeated the Bulldogs 3-1 in Durant on September 29
- Ranked sixth in the league in hitting percentage (.181) while opponents are hitting .231 against the Savage Storm
- Top offensive threats are Abby Jameson, who leads the team with 290 kills, and Julia Benford, who has added 219 kills this season
- Setter Alissa Benson is ranked sixth in the GAC with 771 assists (9.18/set) for the year

Southwestern Christian (12-19)

- Enter the week with a 12-19 overall record with three matches remaining in the regular season
- SWOSU defeated the Eagles in straight sets on October 15 in Bethany
- Tory Sharp leads the team with 463 kills (4.08/set) while four other players have put down more than 150 kills so far this season

The Coaches

SWOSU: Josh Collins (50-68, 4th season)

- Named second head volleyball coach in SWOSU history on January 1, 2012
- Has coached six All-GAC selections and one GAC Freshman of the Year in three seasons
- His teams have earned two AVCA Team Academic Awards and one GAC Sportsmanship Award
- Added the duties of Director of Gameday Operations at SWOSU in the fall of 2014.

SE: Brianna Barry (23-33, 2nd season)

- Led SE to an 18-14 overall mark and third-place finish in the GAC in her first season
- Was a four-year starter at Florida State before a three-year professional playing career overseas

SCU: Kristen Coventon (23-40, 2nd season)

- Second year head coach at Southwestern Christian, where she led the Eagles to an 11-21 mark in 2014
- Previously spent two seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma City after a playing career at Central Oklahoma

Checking the Standings

- SWOSU is currently tied with Southern Nazarene for third place in the GAC standings at 8-3
- Both teams, along with Arkansas Tech, have already clinched their spot in the GAC Tournament

Last Time Out

- SWOSU won all four of their games at home last week, sweeping Langston and Panhandle State in non-conference action with league wins against Ouachita Baptist (3-2) and Henderson State (3-0)

SWOSU Notes

- Junior outside hitter Carly Zak was named the GAC Offensive Player of the Week on Tuesday for the second time this season
- Zak recorded the 1,000th kill of her career on Friday against Ouachita Baptist and she now needs just 15 kills to break the all-time school record of 1,036, held by Kasandra Gurtner (2005-07)
- Jill Green had two of her top offensive performances during Saturday's triangular, putting down a career-high 15 kills against Henderson State with 14 and zero hitting errors against Panhandle State
- Kayla Hebert surpassed the 800-assist mark last week and she currently has 803 assists (9.91/set) for the year, a mark that ranks fourth in the GAC
- A two-time GAC Setter of the Week, Hebert is on for the second-best assists per set mark in SWOSU Volleyball history
- Kelsi Schmidtberger set a new career-high with 15 kills against and tied her season-best with eight blocks against Ouachita Baptist
- Schmidtberger ranks for the Bulldogs with 62 blocks and she's hitting a team-best .321 with 172 kills, second-most on the team
- Kaila Lancaster continues to extend her lead in career digs at SWOSU, entering the week with 1,641, a mark that ranks among the top 25 in active players in NCAA Division II
- Paige Holt leads the Bulldogs with 64 blocks (11 solo, 53 assist) and she's ranked third with 149 kills while hitting .197 for the year
- SWOSU leads the GAC in service aces with 155 (1.8/set) for the year. Kayla Hebert leads SWOSU with 36 aces, which is approaching the single-season school record of 43, held by Tiffany Shedrock (2006)
- Ariana Olson set a new career-high with 24 digs against Ouachita Baptist, giving her 89 for the year as she's approaching 400-dig plateau for her career

HEAD COACH JOSH COLLINS

Josh Collins became the second head volleyball coach in SWOSU Volleyball history on January 1, 2012 and he enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Bulldogs in 2015. Additionally, Collins added the duties of Director of Gameday Operations in the fall of 2014.

His 2014 team finished 8-19 overall and tied for eighth place in the Great American Conference standings, advancing to the GAC Tournament for the third consecutive season. His squad ranked among the league leaders in both digs and blocks, setting a new school record by averaging better than 2.0 blocks per set. The Bulldogs were led by sophomore Carly Zak, a second team all-conference selection for the second straight season.

Collins has tutored six players who have earned All-Great American Conference honors in his first three seasons, including middle hitter Alison Cole, who became just the second First Team All-Conference player in the history of SWOSU Volleyball in 2013. That same year, Carly Zak added another first for the program after being named the GAC Freshman of the Year following a stellar first year with the Bulldogs. Zak and Joey Collins both earned second team all-conference honors, giving SWOSU three honorees on an all-conference team for only the second time in school history.

The Bulldogs finished tied for fourth in the GAC standings in 2013 with an 8-6 conference mark and they completed their season with 13 victories for the second straight season, matching the second-highest win total in program history. In addition, some of their numbers stack up against the best in SWOSU history, including the most single-season blocks (249) and the second-most kills (1,525), attack percentage (.170), assists (1,429) and digs (2,037).

His first team faced a daunting non-conference schedule before coming together in Great American Conference play. The Bulldogs had an overall four-win improvement from 2011, finishing 13-19 with a fourth-place finish in the GAC at 10-4. SWOSU finished ahead of the other four Oklahoma-based schools in the conference standings by at least two games.

At the GAC Tournament, SWOSU defeated Ouachita Baptist in the quarterfinals, earning the first postseason victory in program history. In the semifinals, SWOSU went toe-to-toe with conference champion and tournament-host Harding, taking the Lady Bisons to five sets before succumbing 15-11.

Collins mentored two players – Alison Cole and Lindsay Dusin – who earned all-conference honors in 2012. Cole was a second team selection at middle hitter while Dusin was honorable mention as a setter. Dusin was also named to the GAC All-Tournament team.

While 2012 was his first season as the head volleyball coach, Collins is certainly no newcomer to Southwestern Oklahoma State University. He arrived in Weatherford in 2004 from Clarendon College and he served as an assistant men's basketball coach under Scott Reed in 2004-05 and later with current athletic director and former basketball coach Todd Thurman during the 2006-07 season.

Starting in 2005, Collins worked as a dual assistant for SWOSU, assisting with basketball while also helping Pagliasotti start the volleyball program. He served as an assistant volleyball coach for seven seasons before taking over prior to the 2012 season.

Collins, a native of Hedley, Texas, holds two degrees from Southwestern Oklahoma State University. He earned his bachelor's degree in 2006 before completing his master's degree in Sports Management in 2008. He and his wife, Jamie, were married in June 2012 and reside in Weatherford.
