Setting the Stage

- The second half of conference basketball begins on Thursday night with the SWOSU Men's team in Russellville to face Arkansas Tech
- The Bulldogs are looking for their second-ever win in Russellville and first as GAC foes when they travel to Tucker Coliseum for the 7:30 pm tipoff
- SWOSU is just 2-10 against Arkansas Tech as members of the Great American Conference, and they have lost five straight games in Russellville since earning a 52-50 win at Tucker in the opening game of the 2003-04 season (Nov. 15, 2003)
- The Bulldogs have had success away from home this season with a 4-1 record on the road and they enter the game with a three-game winning streak
- SWOSU is currently in fourth place in the league standings, one game behind East Central for third place and two games out of the top spot, which is being held by Harding and Ouachita
- After playing seven of their first 11 conference games at home, the schedule flips on the Bulldogs, who are 20-9 in road games since Bob Battisti became the head coach
- Arkansas Tech enters the game at 9-8 overall and 4-7 in league play, tied for eighth in the current conference standings

The Opponent

Arkansas Tech (9-8, 4-7 GAC)

- Have dropped six straight games after opening the conference season with a 4-1 record that had them near the top of the standings heading into January
- Three of their last four defeats have come on their home floor, Tucker Coliseum, where they are 3-4 this season
- Won eight straight games earlier this season after suffering an 88-63 setback against the Bulldogs in Weatherford
- Ranked sixth in the league in scoring offense, averaging 76.8 points per game while allowing their opponents to score 75.9 points per contest
- ATU has the second-best field goal percentage defense in the league by holding opponents to 42.5% shooting, trailing only SWOSU (41.8%)
- Three players average better than 10 points per game for the Wonder Boys, who are led by Marquis Yates with 16.7 points per game
- Post player Tobe Okafor is ranked second in the league in blocked shots with 27, an average of 1.6 per game

The Coaches

SWOSU: Bob Battisti (44-29, 3rd season; 453-325 career, 27th season)

- In his third season as the head coach of the Bulldogs, having led SWOSU to back-to-back winning seasons in his first two years at the helm
- Has coached three players at SWOSU that earned All-GAC distinction, including one GAC Player of the Year and one GAC Defensive Player of the Year
- Previously spent 25 years at Northwestern Oklahoma State, coaching the men's basketball team for 21 seasons before taking over as the school's athletic director
- In 26 years as a head coach, Battisti has a career record of 453-325 (.581) and he is 2-4 against Arkansas Tech as the head coach at SWOSU

Arkansas Tech: Doug Kline (22-23, 2nd season)

- Named the 22nd head coach in Arkansas Tech men's basketball history in June of 2014 after serving as an assistant coach at ATU for three seasons
- Led Arkansas Tech to a GAC Tournament Championship and NCAA Division II Tournament appearance in his first season
- Previously spent five seasons as the head coach at Frank Phillips College in Texas, leading the Plainsmen to an overall record of 90-60 and one conference championship

Last Time Out

- Martell Collins, Markeise Champion and Juwan Newmen all scored career-highs, combining for 67 points in SWOSU's 82-70 victory over Oklahoma Baptist on Saturday
- SWOSU went on an 11-0 run in the second half after falling behind briefly and controlled the final eight minutes to finish off the victory
- Collins scored 29 points, setting a new career-high for the second straight game, while Newmen has a huge double-double with 16 points and 19 rebounds

SWOSU Notes

- Martell Collins became the first Bulldog this season to be named GAC Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 26.3 points and 6.3 rebounds per game and helping SWOSU go 3-0 against in-state foes last week
- The Bulldogs averaged 87.0 points per game last week after being held to 65 points or less in three of their previous four games
- Juwan Newmen has led the Bulldogs in rebounding in five straight games and he now ranks second in the league with 122 rebounds (8.1/game) for the year
- Markeise Champion is second on the team with 15.6 points per game and he's ranked sixth in NCAA Division II with 61 made three-pointers, an average of 3.6 per game
- Nick Shoemaker had his streak of games with multiple three's made snapped at five on Saturday, but he remains SWOSU's third-leading three-point shooter with 26 made this year
- SWOSU maintains a slim lead on the rest of the GAC with 73 blocked shots, an average of 4.3 per game, behind Ayo Ojo (22 blocks), Newmen (16) and Emeche Wells (11)

Looking Ahead

- SWOSU concludes their weekend road trip in Arkansas on Saturday with a trip up to Searcy to face Harding
- The Bulldogs will play four of their final nine games at home, beginning on February 4th against Arkansas-Monticello

BOB BATTISTI - HEAD COACH

Bob Battisti enters his third season at SWOSU in 2015-16 after being tabbed as the 14th men's basketball coach in Bulldog basketball history in April 2013. In two years with the Bulldogs, Battisti has guided SWOSU to a record of 33-23, giving him a career record of 442-319 in 26 years as a collegiate head coach.

In his second year at SWOSU, Battisti guided a Bulldog team that again led the Great American Conference in scoring defense, allowing 68.4 points per game while also committing the fewest turnovers in the league at 9.8 per game. SWOSU finished the season with a 16-13 (9-11 GAC) record, tying for seventh place in the regular season standings. In the GAC Tournament, the Bulldogs became the first No. 8 seed earn a quarterfinal victory with a dramatic 71-67 overtime win against league-champion Ouachita Baptist. Martell Collins was named a Second Team All-GAC selection in 2014-15, becoming the third all-league player tutored by Battisti.

Battisti's first team at SWOSU finished as the runner-up in the Great American Conference with a 17-10 (14-6 GAC) record after being picked ninth in the preseason conference poll. Under the direction of Battisti, SWOSU's Rod Camphor blossomed into one of the top players in the Central Region, being named the GAC Player of the Year before earning all-region honors from Daktronics and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and an Honorable Mention All-American selection by the Division II Bulletin. Camphor capped

off his senior season by becoming the first GAC player to be chosen for the Reese's Division II College All-Star Game where he scored 17 points to lead his team.

Defense and ball control helped the Bulldogs have a successful season in Battisti's first campaign. SWOSU led the GAC in blocked shots behind conference Defensive Player of the Year Michael Bradley and they committed the fewest turnovers in NCAA Division II with 243, an average of just 9.0 per game.

Battisti came to SWOSU as no stranger to the collegiate basketball scene in the state of Oklahoma after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma Christian University in Edmond, helping the Eagles to a record of 40-25. In 2012, OCU won the Sooner Athletic Conference tournament title, giving the program its first postseason basketball title in 30 years, and this past season they reached the National Christian College Athletic Association championship game.

Prior to his stint at OCU, Battisti spent 25 years at Northwestern Oklahoma State, coaching the men's basketball team for 21 seasons before taking over as the school's athletic director for four years.

As the school's athletic director, Battisti launched the 'Vision for Victory' fundraising campaign which netted \$2.4 million for major athletic facility improvements. He also led Northwestern's efforts to seek membership into NCAA Division II.

He took over the men's basketball team at Northwestern in 1986 and quickly turned the program into a consistent winner. Battisti's teams, often known for their intense defensive style, posted a record of 374-265 over his 21-year tenure. He led the Rangers to six conference titles and finished in the NAIA Top 25 seven times. For his efforts, Battisti was named a

conference coach of the year five times and he was selected as the NAIA National Coach of the Year by the Basketball Times in 1994.

His teams also advanced to the NAIA National Tournament on six occasions, including an appearance in the national quarterfinals in 2007. His best year at Northwestern was the 1992-93 season, when Battisti led NWOSU to a 29-2 record and No. 2 national ranking entering the national tournament.

Battisti went to Northwestern after serving two seasons as an assistant at the University of Minnesota on a staff that included veteran NBA coach, Flip Saunders. He went to Minnesota following a stint as the head coach at Lakewood Community College in Minnesota where he posted a record of 35-31 in three seasons. His coaching career started at Bethany Lutheran where he was an assistant coach for three seasons for three seasons from 1978-81.

A native of Warren, Mich., Battisti received his bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education from Minnesota State University-Mankato in 1981 before earning his master's degree in Education from the University of Minnesota-Minneapolis in 1985. He and his wife Shelly have one son, Cooper, 18, who is currently a freshman on the SWOSU basketball team.
