

#### **Setting the Stage**

- Conference play resumes for the SWOSU Men's Basketball team on Thursday evening as the Bulldogs host Henderson State at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center
- SWOSU, coming off a victory over Hillsdale Baptist last weekend, remains unblemished in Great American Conference play this season at 4-0 while the Reddies enter the contest 1-3 in league games
- The Bulldogs are 8-2 overall and tied with Arkansas Tech for the best 10-game record in the conference and SWOSU is 5-2 on their home court so far this season
- Henderson State is 0-3 in true road games this season while also 0-2 in neutral site games, leaving them winless away from their home venue
- SWOSU has won four straight meetings against the Reddies and they are 5-3 in league play against Henderson State since the formation of the Great American Conference

#### **The Opponent**

Henderson State (2-7, 1-3 GAC)

- Have won three of their last five games, including an exhibition victory over College of the Faith, after starting the year 1-5
- Beginning a four-game road trip on Thursday and the Reddies are still in search of their first victory away from home this season
- HSU is one of five teams tied for eighth in the GAC standings at 1-3, but they were victorious in their last conference game against Southeastern Oklahoma State on December 5th
- Among the lowest scoring teams in the conference, averaging 68.7 points per game while opponents score an average of 71.4 points per game against the Reddies
- The top three-point shooting team, percentage wise, in the Great American Conference as Henderson State knocks down 41.9% (65-of-155) of their attempts from deep
- The Reddies take care of the ball well and have forced 16.0 turnovers per game for a +2.1 turnover margin, the second-best mark in the league
- Junior guard Kevin Kozan leads the Reddies in scoring at 16.9 points per game while Tavian Pomlee is also averaging double figures with an even 10.0 points per contest
- HSU's post defender, Alioune Mboup, ranks third in the GAC with 13 blocked shots, an average of 1.4 per game

#### **The Coaches**

SWOSU: Bob Battisti (41-25, 3rd season; 450-321 career, 27th season)

- In his third season as the head coach of the Bulldogs, having led SWOSU to back-to-back winning seasons in his first two years at the helm
- Has coached three players at SWOSU that earned All-GAC distinction, including one GAC Player of the Year and one GAC Defensive Player of the Year
- Previously spent 25 years at Northwestern Oklahoma State, coaching the men's basketball team for 21 seasons before taking over as the school's athletic director
- In 26 years as a head coach, Battisti has a career record of 450-321 (.585) and he is 4-0 against Henderson State while coaching the Bulldogs

Henderson State: Jimmy Elgas (2-7, 1st season)

- In his first season at Henderson State after being named the 28th head coach in HSU men's basketball history in April of 2015
- Had served as the top assistant coach at NCAA Division I program Evansville since 2007, helping the Aces to four postseason appearance in his final five seasons
- Previous coaching stops included assistant positions at Kansas State, Texas State and Lincoln (III.) College

#### Last Time Out

- SWOSU led wire-to-wire as they defeated Hillsdale Baptist 92-75 for their first win of the calendar year last Saturday at home
- The Bulldogs scored the first eight points of the game and led by as much as 16 on multiple occasions in the first half before taking a 41-30 lead to the break
- Hillsdale got within five at one point in the second half before the Bulldogs broke the game open and took a lead of 23 in the waning moments
- Markeise Champion scored a team-best 20 points in his first start of the season, while Wesley Franklin tallied new career-highs with 13 points and five rebounds in just 11 minutes of action

#### **SWOSU Notes**

- Junior point guard Markeise Champion leads the GAC and is ranked sixth in all of NCAA Division II with 39 made 3-pointers this season, good for an average of 3.9 per game
- Martell Collins has scored at least 12 points in each game this season and he ranks 13th in the GAC in scoring with an average of 15.2 points per game
- Emeche Wells is also a conference leader and he ranks 13th in NCAA Division II with 25 steals, an average of 2.5 per game for the year
- The Bulldogs have the top scoring margin among league teams, averaging 78.2 points per game while allowing 70.9 points per game, good for a margin of +7.3, exactly two points better than Arkansas Tech in second place
- Thursday's game will match strengths of the two teams as Henderson State leads the GAC in 3-point field goal percentage (41.9%) while SWOSU is tied for the league lead in 3-point defense (30.2%)
- Ayo Ojo leads SWOSU with 14 blocked shots, while Wells has 11 and Juwan Newmen has 9 as the Bulldogs have blocked more shots (47) than any other team in the league

#### **Looking Ahead**

- SWOSU is right back in action on Saturday afternoon, hosting the defending Great American Conference champions from Ouachita at 1:00 pm in the PCEC
- The Bulldogs conclude their six-game home stand next Thursday against East Central before going on the road to Southern Nazarene next Saturday

## **BOB BATTISTI - HEAD COACH**

Bob Battisti enters his third season at SWOSU in 2015-16 after being tabbed as the 14th men's basketball coach in Bulldog basketball history in April 2013. In two years with the Bulldogs, Battisti has guided SWOSU to a record of 33-23, giving him a career record of 442-319 in 26 years as a collegiate head coach.

In his second year at SWOSU, Battisti guided a Bulldog team that again led the Great American Conference in scoring defense, allowing 68.4 points per game while also committing the fewest turnovers in the league at 9.8 per game. SWOSU finished the season with a 16-13 (9-11 GAC) record, tying for seventh place in the regular season standings. In the GAC Tournament, the Bulldogs became the first No. 8 seed earn a quarterfinal victory with a dramatic 71-67 overtime win against league-champion Ouachita Baptist. Martell Collins was named a Second Team All-GAC selection in 2014-15, becoming the third all-league player tutored by Battisti.

Battisti's first team at SWOSU finished as the runner-up in the Great American Conference with a 17-10 (14-6 GAC) record after being picked ninth in the preseason conference poll. Under the direction of Battisti, SWOSU's Rod Camphor blossomed into one of the top players in the Central Region, being named the GAC Player of the Year before earning all-region honors from Daktronics and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and an Honorable Mention All-American selection by the Division II Bulletin. Camphor capped

off his senior season by becoming the first GAC player to be chosen for the Reese's Division II College All-Star Game where he scored 17 points to lead his team.

Defense and ball control helped the Bulldogs have a successful season in Battisti's first campaign. SWOSU led the GAC in blocked shots behind conference Defensive Player of the Year Michael Bradley and they committed the fewest turnovers in NCAA Division II with 243, an average of just 9.0 per game.

Battisti came to SWOSU as no stranger to the collegiate basketball scene in the state of Oklahoma after spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma Christian University in Edmond, helping the Eagles to a record of 40-25. In 2012, OCU won the Sooner Athletic Conference tournament title, giving the program its first postseason basketball title in 30 years, and this past season they reached the National Christian College Athletic Association championship game.

Prior to his stint at OCU, Battisti spent 25 years at Northwestern Oklahoma State, coaching the men's basketball team for 21 seasons before taking over as the school's athletic director for four years.

As the school's athletic director, Battisti launched the 'Vision for Victory' fundraising campaign which netted \$2.4 million for major athletic facility improvements. He also led Northwestern's efforts to seek membership into NCAA Division II.

He took over the men's basketball team at Northwestern in 1986 and quickly turned the program into a consistent winner. Battisti's teams, often known for their intense defensive style, posted a record of 374-265 over his 21-year tenure. He led the Rangers to six conference

titles and finished in the NAIA Top 25 seven times. For his efforts, Battisti was named a conference coach of the year five times and he was selected as the NAIA National Coach of the Year by the Basketball Times in 1994.

His teams also advanced to the NAIA National Tournament on six occasions, including an appearance in the national quarterfinals in 2007. His best year at Northwestern was the 1992-93 season, when Battisti led NWOSU to a 29-2 record and No. 2 national ranking entering the national tournament.

Battisti went to Northwestern after serving two seasons as an assistant at the University of Minnesota on a staff that included veteran NBA coach, Flip Saunders. He went to Minnesota following a stint as the head coach at Lakewood Community College in Minnesota where he posted a record of 35-31 in three seasons. His coaching career started at Bethany Lutheran where he was an assistant coach for three seasons for three seasons from 1978-81.

A native of Warren, Mich., Battisti received his bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education from Minnesota State University-Mankato in 1981 before earning his master's degree in Education from the University of Minnesota-Minneapolis in 1985. He and his wife Shelly have one son, Cooper, 18, who is currently a freshman on the SWOSU basketball team.
