

Setting the Stage

- With four straight wins to their credit, the SWOSU Women's Basketball team returns to action on Thursday evening when they host Henderson State at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center
- While the Lady Bulldogs have won four straight games, only one of those wins was a Great American Conference contest, leaving SWOSU at 1-3 in league play
- Henderson State is one of three teams tied atop the GAC standings with a perfect 4-0 mark in league play, but the Reddies have a 5-5 overall record that mirrors that of SWOSU
- The two teams split their regular season series last season with each team winning on their home court, including a 116-108 SWOSU victory over the Reddies at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center in the highest-scoring game in GAC history
- SWOSU is 3-0 in their current six-game home stand and 4-4 overall on their home court this season

The Opponent

Henderson State (5-5, 4-0 GAC)

- Had a three-game winning streak snapped their last time out, falling 73-61 at Texas A&M-Commerce in non-conference play
- Unblemished in league play with victories over Southern Nazarene, Oklahoma Baptist, East Central and Southeastern Oklahoma State
- Ranked fourth in the league in scoring offense, averaging 72.1 points per game while their opponents have scored an average of 73.0 points per game against HSU
- Shooting 34.3% from three-point range as a team, having made 57-of-166 attempts from long range this season for the second-best percentage in the league
- Led by senior forward Dulincia Keener, who ranks fifth in the GAC in scoring (16.9 ppg) and fourth in rebounding (8.5 rpg)
- In eight career meetings against SWOSU, Keener is nearly averaging a double-double with 10.3 points and 9.8 rebounds per game
- Other top scorers for the Reddies include Victoria Stewart at 13.2 points per game and Haleigh Henson at 12.1 ppg

The Coaches

SWOSU: Kelsi Musick (95-85; 7th season)

- Two-time GAC Coach of the Year has been the model of consistency, winning GAC Tournament titles in two of the last four years and earning back-to-back NCAA Division II National Tournaments during the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons
- Her high-energy style of play has led the Lady Dawgs to rank in the top four in the nation in scoring, and top ten in three points made in three of the last four seasons
- A great developer of talent, Musick has coached one All-American and 12 All-GAC selections, including one Player of the Year recipient
- Musick has also spent time as an assistant coach at Fresno State, where they won two Western Athletic Conference regular season and tournament titles, as well as qualified for the NCAA Division I National Tournament in the 2008-09 season
- Has a record of 7-4 against Henderson State as the head coach of the Lady Bulldogs, including a perfect mark of 4-0 at home

Henderson State: Jill Thomas (28-36; 3rd season)

- In her third season leading the Henderson State women's basketball program, helping the Reddies to records of 10-17 and 13-14 in her first two years
- Coached two-time GAC Defender of the Year Aungelique Sledge, who was also an all-region selection and Academic All-American
- Previously spent four years as the head coach at Pfeiffer University in North Carolina from 2009-13, earning the 2013 Conference Carolinas Coach of the Year award after guiding the Lady Falcons to their first-ever NCAA Regional Tournament win

Last Time Out

- The Lady Bulldogs led wire-to-wire as they opened up 2016 with a 90-58 win over Science & Arts last Saturday afternoon in Weatherford
- SWOSU scored the first 13 points of the game and led 32-15 after one period and they kept the Drovers doubled up 56-28 at halftime
- Jessica Penner led the Lady Dawgs with 19 points for the second straight game while Hailey Tucker and Morgan Vogt added 12 points apiece

SWOSU Notes

- Jessica Penner became the second Lady Bulldog to be named GAC Player of the Week, earning the honor on Monday after averaging 19.0 points per game on 18-for-21 field goal shooting in two games last week
- SWOSU is averaging 84.8 points per game during their four-game winning streak, upping their season scoring average to 78.0 points per game
- Hailey Tucker was previously named GAC Player of the Week in December after scoring a career-high 24 points against Cameron in non-conference play
- Tucker is SWOSU's leading scorer during their current winning streak, averaging 14.5 points per game over the past four contests
- Jade Jones scored 10 points against USAO to snap a two-game stretch of scoring in single digits, but she continues to lead the team in scoring at 12.6 points per game
- Kylie Franz has started six straight games for SWOSU and ranks second on the team with 33 assists and seven steals while averaging 5.1 points per game
- Janae Coffee ranks third on the team in scoring with 10.4 points per game and her 81 rebounds (8.1/game) ranks fifth in the GAC
- SWOSU leads all of NCAA Division II with an average of 35.0 defensive rebounds per game

Looking Ahead

- The Lady Bulldogs stay at home to face their other GAC foe from Arkadelphia on Saturday, with tipoff at 1:00 pm against Ouachita Baptist
- SWOSU will host East Central next Thursday before playing their first road game of 2016 on January 16 at Southern Nazarene

KELSI MUSICK - HEAD COACH

Kelsi Musick has rebuilt the Southwestern Oklahoma State University women's basketball program with an exciting brand of basketball that has led the Lady Bulldogs to two NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances in the past three seasons. She enters her seventh season as the head coach of the Lady Bulldogs in 2015-16 with a career record of 90-80.

The fast-paced play of the Lady Bulldogs has helped SWOSU rank in the top four nationally in scoring offense and the top ten in NCAA Division II in 3-pointers made during three of the past four seasons. SWOSU has averaged over 80 points per game during two of those seasons and ranked third nationally at 79.6 points per game in 2012-13. The 3-point shooting prowess has risen from ninth (8.0/game) in 2011-12 to second (9.5) in 2013-14, helping the Lady Bulldogs score a record 83.1 points per game.

Musick's teams improved their win total in each of her first four seasons as she took the Lady Bulldogs from three wins in her first season to 24 in her fourth year. She is a two-time Great American Conference Coach of the Year and she has led SWOSU to two GAC Tournament Championships and their first two NCAA Division II postseason appearances since the Lady Bulldogs made the transition in 1996-97.

During the 2014-15 season, the Lady Bulldogs featured a young and inexperienced squad that struggled to a 12-15 overall record, including a 9-11 mark that tied for sixth in the Great American Conference. SWOSU was 10-3 on their home court during the year, including a 78-65 upset of No. 20 Harding on February 7 and they finished the year with five consecutive home wins.

Her 2013-14 squad finished 19-11 and tied for second place in the Great American Conference before making a magical run through the conference tournament. The Lady Bulldogs defeated Henderson State and East Central before handing No. 2 Harding just their second loss of the season, 78-74, in the finals of the tournament to earn the GAC's automatic bid to the national tournament.

SWOSU was upended by top-seed and No. 7 Emporia State in the first round of the regional tournament, but the Lady Bulldogs became one of only four teams that have reached the Central Regional in each of the last two seasons. Musick's squad was led by Michelle Fisher, who became the school's all-time leading 3-point shooter and fourth-leading scorer at the conclusion of a stellar career. Fisher was a First Team All-GAC selection for the second straight season while Sarina Sayama earned honorable mention honors in 2013-14.

Through six seasons, Musick has tutored 13 players who have garnered all-conference recognition, including two-time first team selections in Fisher and Sumiya Darden and 2012 GAC Player of the Year Darcie Dick. Dick also became Musick's first All-American at SWOSU after being named an honorable mention selection by the Women's Division II Bulletin. Most recently, Chelsea Bates (Second Team) and Jessica Penner (Honorable Mention) earned All-GAC status following the 2014-15 season.

SWOSU finished second in the GAC in 2012-13 as Musick earned her second straight conference Coach of the Year after leading her squad to a 24-7 record and their first-ever berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament. The Lady Bulldogs earned the No. 7 seed in the regional and defeated second-seeded Central Missouri 73-71 in the Central Regional Quarterfinals before being eliminated by eventual Region Champion and Final Four participant Augustana 68-64 in the semifinals.

Musick earned her first GAC Coach of the Year award after leading the Lady Bulldogs to a 20-9 record and second-place finish in 2011-12 after winning just 12 games the season before. SWOSU stormed through the conference tournament as the No. 2 seed to claim the inaugural GAC Tournament championship 69-58 over No. 4-seed Harding.

Prior to taking over the Bulldogs, Musick was an assistant coach at Fresno State University where she was part of a staff that posted consecutive 20-win seasons. Fresno State won the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) regular-season and tournament titles in each of her last years and finished 24-9 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2008-09 before being eliminated by California.

Previous head coaching experience for Musick came from her hometown of Canton, Okla., where she led the high school girls team starting in 2005. She spent two seasons at CHS and had her team in the Class A regional tournament in 2006-07 before finishing with a 16-9 record.

Musick played collegiately at Cameron where she was a four-year starter for the Aggies from 1998-2002 at point guard. She set school records in career three-point average and assists while remaining a President's Leadership scholar at the school. Her final season in 2001-02, the Aggies set a school record for most wins (25) and made their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II National Tournament.

Musick's family has a strong basketball background. Her mother, Pam Bond, was a longtime head coach at Canton High School and her younger sister, Kenzi, was a star on Oklahoma City University's NAIA Women's National Runner-up teams in 2003, 2004 and 2005.

A native of Canton, Okla., and a 2002 graduate of Cameron University, Musick is married to former SWOSU strength and conditioning coach Josh Musick. The couple resides in Weatherford with their son, Maddox.
