SETTING THE SCENE

- Homecoming at Southwestern Oklahoma State University will be this Saturday, culminating with a rivalry game between the Bulldogs and the Rangers of Northwestern Oklahoma State
- Both teams enter the game following a pair of setbacks and the teams have matching records of 4-6 heading into the season finale
- SWOSU is looking to snap a two-game slide and even their record at home to 3-3 after they went unbeaten at ASAP Energy Field last season
- The Bulldogs are 5-1 against Northwestern Oklahoma State since joining NCAA Division II, but the Rangers won the last meeting between the teams in Weatherford, a 28-6 victory in the final game of the 2014 season
- The winner of Saturday's game will finish in seventh place in the GAC standings

THE SERIES

- The longtime rivalry between SWOSU and Northwestern Oklahoma State dates back to 1907, making it the Bulldogs oldest rivalry among GAC foes
- The teams have faced off 83 times on the gridiron, with SWOSU holding an advantage of 51-28-4 in the all-time series
- SWOSU has won 10 of the last 12 meetings against Northwestern Oklahoma State, dating back to 1992 and they have a 5-1 advantage during the NCAA Division II era
- Since Northwestern joined the GAC in 2013, SWOSU holds a series edge of 2-1, but the Rangers victory came in the 2014 season finale in Weatherford

THE COACHES

SWOSU: Dan Cocannouer, 33-53 (Eighth Season)

- Has been the head coach at his alma mater since 2009, leading the Bulldogs to two winning seasons in the past three years
- Earned four Coach of the Year Awards following the 2015 season, including: Great American

- After the victory over Oklahoma Baptist on October 20, Cocannouer is now alone in sole possession of fourth place on SWOSU's all-time win list with 33 victories
- Has a record of 3-1 against Northwestern Oklahoma State as the Bulldogs head coach, including an 0-1 mark against the Rangers in Weatherford

Northwestern Oklahoma State: Matt Walter, 7-14 (2nd Season)

- In his second season as the head coach and offensive coordinator at Northwestern Oklahoma State, his alma mater
- Standout athlete at NWOSU in the late 1990's and early 2000's, where he was a member of the 1999 NAIA National Championship team and an honorable mention All-American in 2000
- Previously served as the offensive coordinator at Emporia State for six seasons, helping the Hornets turn around their program and reach the NCAA Division II playoffs in 2013

THE LAST MEETING (NOV. 14, 2015)

- Big plays helped the SWOSU Football team build a 21-3 halftime advantage, but the Bulldogs still had to hold off the rival Rangers of Northwestern Oklahoma State for a 31-17 victory in the regular season finale
- Kenneth Martey and Karltrell Henderson each broke off long touchdown runs and finished with over 100 yards rushing as SWOSU controlled the ground game with 299 rushing yards
- Trevon Hartfield finished with a career-high 14 tackles, including 13 solo stops as the Rangers passing attack continually tried to test the Bulldogs star cornerback
- The Bulldogs defense was swarming and finished with seven sacks, better than a quarter of their total number of sacks for the season
- SWOSU finished the regular season with a six-game winning streak and their best single-season record since they transitioned to NCAA Division II in 1997

LAST TIME OUT (NOV. 5, 2016)

- Two SWOSU turnovers in the fourth quarter were turned into 10 points for Arkansas Tech and the Wonder Boys held off the Dawgs for a 24-20 victory on Saturday at ASAP Energy Field
- SWOSU took a 20-14 lead on a one-yard touchdown plunge from Karltrell Henderson in the third quarter, but Tyler Peterson's extra point was blocked to keep it a six-point game
- Arkansas Tech converted a SWOSU fumble into the go-ahead touchdown with 7:46 to play and added a field goal after an interception to make it 24-20 with 1:13 to play
- The Bulldogs moved into position for another last-second victory and had two chances from the four-yard line with seven seconds to play but threw two incompletions in the final seconds
- Marc Evans completed 25-of-46 passes for 371 yards and two touchdowns with D.J. Jones (139) and JR Omigie (106) each going over 100 yards receiving
- Conner Bays made a team-high 14 stops while Colton Wright 11 and Kevin Joseph and Deric Robertson each added nine tackles

CHECKING THE STANDINGS

- Harding clinched the 2016 Great American Conference Championship outright with their victory at Northwestern Oklahoma State last Saturday
- The Bisons are perfect at 10-0, two games ahead of Southern Arkansas and Henderson State at 8-2
- Three teams are tied for fourth place at 6-4, with SWOSU among three teams tied for seventh with a 4-6 league record
- SWOSU and Northwestern are both tied at 4-6, meaning the winner of Saturday's game will finish seventh in the league standings

SWOSU OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Mark Evans enters his final collegiate game with 5,455 yards and 43 touchdowns as the Bulldogs quarterback, marks that rank third at SWOSU in the NCAA era
- Evans is three passing touchdowns away from tying Steve Day (46, 2005-09) for third on the career touchdowns list
- SWOSU's running game has been limited to 43 rushing yards in back-to-back games, dropping their season average to 145.0 yards per game
- Karltrell Henderson is the seventh-leading rusher in the GAC with 822 yards (82.2 yards per game) but he's tied for the conference lead with 17 rushing touchdowns this season

- Henderson is fourth in career rushing yards at SWOSU for the NCAA era with 1,651 and he's already set the rushing touchdowns record with 28
- D.J. Jones has caught 110 passes for 1,769 yards and 14 touchdowns as a Bulldog, ranking him fifth in career receiving yards and second in receiving touchdowns at SWOSU
- Jones had his fourth 100-yard receiving game of the season and seventh of his career against Arkansas Tech and he is now within 82 yards away from surpassing Ryan Corbin (1,850, 2009-13) for fourth place on the career yardage list

SWOSU DEFENSIVE NOTES

- Conner Bays recorded his 15th career game with 10 or more tackles against Arkansas Tech, moving him into a tie for second place on SWOSU's NCAA era tackles list with 283 stops
- Bays leads the GAC and ranks sixth in NCAA Division II with 116 tackles (70 solo, 46 assist) this season and he enters his final collegiate game seven stops away from tying Michael Hart (290, 2002-05) for the most tackles at SWOSU in the NCAA era
- SWOSU's other safety, Deric Robertson, has had at least six tackles in six consecutive games and he's the Bulldogs second-leading tackler with 61 stops (39 solo, 22 assist)
- Michael Adefolarin is the Bulldogs third-leading tackler with 56 stops (33 solo, 23 assist) for the year and he leads SWOSU while ranking second in the GAC with 11.0 tackles for loss
- Colton Wright set a new career-high with 11 tackles against Arkansas Tech, giving him 52 tackles (35 solo, 17 assist) for the year to rank fourth on the team
- SWOSU is ranked sixth in the GAC with 10 interceptions, led by three apiece from Robertson and Kevin Joseph
- The Bulldogs had 9.0 tackles for loss against Arkansas Tech, the sixth consecutive game that He SWOSU's defense has recorded at least seven tackles for loss
- Navajo Smith has a team-leading 4.0 sacks while SWOSU has 17 sacks for the year

SWOSU SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- Tyson McDaniel broke a 72-yard kickoff return against ATU, upping the Bulldogs season average to 21.7 yards per return for the year, which ranks fourth in the GAC
- Dalton Jackson averaged 41.3 yards per punt on three attempts against Arkansas Tech and he's now averaging 37.4 yards per punt on 35 attempts for the year
- Tyler Peterson missed an extra point for the second straight game making him now 35-for-39 on extra points and 4-for-6 on field goal attempts this season



HEAD COACH DAN COCANNOUER

SWOSU alum Dan Cocannouer enters his eighth season as the head coach of the Southwestern Oklahoma State football team in 2016. The Bulldogs are coming off record-setting 2015 season that included an 8-4 record and the Bulldogs first-ever NCAA Postseason appearance in the Live United Texarkana Bowl. Cocannouer, who returned home to lead his alma mater in 2009, has a career record of 29-47 at SWOSU.

The breakthrough season of 2015 came with accolades as Cocannouer was named the Great American Conference Coach of the Year and the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Region 4 Coach of the Year after leading the Bulldogs to a five-win turnaround and second-place finish in the GAC after being picked to finish seventh. SWOSU ended the season with a defeat at the Live United Texarkana Bowl, which was just the eighth postseason game in Bulldog football's 107-year history.

Resilience was the key for SWOSU in 2015 as the Bulldogs bounced back from starting the season 2-3 to win six straight games and earn their postseason appearance. The winning streak is the longest by the Bulldogs as members of the NCAA and helped break a postseason draught of nearly 20 years. SWOSU's offense set records for scoring as they went undefeated at ASAP Energy Field and earned their best Great American Conference finish since the formation of the league.

SWOSU had seven players earn GAC postseason honors as well as Cocannouer being named the conference Coach of the Year. Leading the honors were First Team All-GAC cornerback Trevon Hartfield and return specialist D.J. Jones, who also become SWOSU's ninth All-American of the NCAA Division II era, earning First Team honors as a return specialist from the D2CCA and second team Associated Press Little All-America honors as an all-purpose player.

The resume for Cocannouer added another significant honor in the spring of 2015 as it was announced that he would be inducted into the Oklahoma Coaches Association (OCA) Hall of Fame as part of the Class of 2015. He is one of 13 inductees from across the state of Oklahoma to be selected for induction following his storied coaching career at the prep level.

Cocannouer has led the Bulldogs to a winning record in two of the past three seasons and he is alone in seventh-place for all-time wins at SWOSU, just two wins shy of moving into the top-five on the career wins list. He bettered the Bulldogs win-loss total in each of his first three seasons, improving his team from 1-10 in his inaugural season to 5-6 in 2011, their first season in the GAC.

Prior to coming back to SWOSU, Cocannouer had spent 25 seasons as a high school head coach in the state of Oklahoma, establishing a reputation as one of the most prominent and well-respected coaching leaders in the state. He came to SWOSU after eight years at Edmond Santa Fe High School where he compiled a 70-26 record (.729 winning percentage) and led the Wolves to the Class 6A finals in 2003.

His other high school stops included lead high school programs at John Marshall, Chandler, Alva, Pauls Valley and Walters High Schools. All total, he has coached more than 36 years, including the last 30 as a head coach. He led five different schools to the state playoffs and served on the Oklahoma Football Coaches Association (OFCA) Advisory Board for several years and he is a past President of the Oklahoma Coaches Association (OCA) and the OFCA. With his prep success came the opportunity to coach in numerous all-star games, including the Oklahoma All-State game (1988), Jim Thorpe

Classic (2000, 2002), Oil Bowl (1997-98) and Enid Shriner All-Star Game (1992-96).

Cocannouer played at SWOSU from 1974-77 under legendary head coach Otis Delaporte, helping the Bulldogs to conference titles in 1974 and 1977. He was a senior leader on the Bulldog team that won a school-record 11 games and finished as the NAIA National Runner-up in 1997 after playing in the Apple Bowl at the Seattle Kingdome. By returning to lead his alma mater, he became the first SWOSU graduate to lead the Bulldogs since Joe Metcalf did the same from 1952-57.

Cocannouer holds two degrees from SWOSU. He earned a bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education in 1978 before serving as a graduate assistant for the Bulldog football team while until he earned a master's degree in Education in 1983. He also later obtained

a secondary administrative certificate from Northwestern Oklahoma State in 1996.

Dan is a native of Tuttle, Oklahoma. The Cocannouer family lost their beloved wife and mother, Jeri Lyn, in early August 2015. She now has the best seat in all stadiums to cheer on the Bulldogs! They have two adult daughters and son-in-laws Cory and Janie Pence of Weatherford, and Colton and Josie Blackburn of Edmond.
