SETTING THE SCENE

- SWOSU Women's Basketball (5-2, 3-1 GAC) takes its three-game winning streak on the road to faceoff against Oklahoma Christian in non-conference competition
- Tipoff between the teams is scheduled for 7:00 pm in Edmond from inside Dave Smith Athletic Center
- Last year, SWOSU beat the Lady Eagles 92-69 in the two's first matchup since 2004
- The Lady Bulldogs lead the overall series 15-10 against Oklahoma Christian dating back to the 1977-78 season
- This week marks the final week before SWOSU will take more than three weeks off from outside competition due to Christmas Break

THE OPPONENT

Oklahoma Christian (3-6)

- OC finished last year with a 14-15 overall record and 11-7 record in league play before losing to St. Mary's in the opening round of the Heartland Conference Tournament to end their season
- The Lady Eagles were picked to finish third in the Heartland Conference in the preseason coaches' poll for the 2016-17 season
- Currently, Oklahoma Christian is 3-6 to begin the new season but have not started playing conference games yet in their league
- OC has three double-digit scorers led by Addy Cliff's 16.1 points per game, Sarah Parker's 14.9 points per game and 8.3 rebounds per game, and McKenzie Stanford's 12.6 points per game and 6.8 rebounds per game

THE COACHES

SWOSU: Kelsi Musick (115-93, 8th season)

- Coach Musick is a two-time GAC Coach of the Year, winning back-to-back honors for the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons
- A great developer of talent, Musick has coached one All-American and 15 All-GAC selections, including one Player of the Year recipient
- She earned her 100th win as a head coach last season against rival Northwestern Oklahoma State on January 18, 2016
- Musick has won GAC Tournament Championships in two of the last five years, and made consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 2012-13 and 2013-14
- Coach Musick has also spent time as an assistant coach at Fresno State, where they won two Western Athletic Conference regular season and tournament titles, as well as qualified for the NCAA Division I National Tournament in the 2008-09 season

Oklahoma Christian: Stephanie Findley (589-394, 32nd season)

- Set the state record for Oklahoma four-year college wins in women's basketball during the 2011-12 season
- Two-time NAIA District Coach of the Year and four-time Sooner Athletic Conference Coach of the Year
- Coached OU's head coach Sherri (Buben) Coale and OU assistant coach Jan Ross at OC

CHECKING THE STANDINGS

- Harding and Henderson State sit atop the GAC standings with 4-0 records in league play
- SWOSU, Arkansas Tech, and Southeastern are next in the rankings with 3-1 records in the conference
- Ouachita and Northwestern hold 2-2 records while Arkansas-Monticello, East Central, and Southern Arkansas have won a single game and hold 1-3 slates
- Southern Nazarene and Oklahoma Baptist round out the standings with 0-4 league records

SWOSU NOTES

- After their 71-61 win over Southern Arkansas last Saturday, SWOSU now has a three-game winning streak since returning from Thanksgiving Break
- Shalie McAlister gave the Lady Dawgs a spark against SAU, scoring a career-high nine points all in the fourth quarter
- Tyra Aska also totaled a career high in assists against SAU, collecting eight on the afternoon
- The Lady Bulldogs are shooting 41% (188-of-456) as a team from the field including 31% (54-of-174) from beyond the arc and 67% (102-of-152) from the free-throw line
- Hailey Tucker leads the offensive attack averaging a GAC-best 18.6 points per game while also ranking second in the league in rebounding at 9.1 boards per game
- Tucker also leads the Dawgs in three-point shooting, shooting the deep ball at a 37% clip (14-of-38)
- Through seven games, Hayden Priddy ranks third in the conference in both assists and steals totaling 37 and 15 respectively, averaging more than five assists and two steals per contest
- Defensively, SWOSU tops the league in both the blocked shots (37, 5.3 bpg) and steals (69, 9.9 spg) categories
- Taylor Hedrick has gotten to the foul line a team-best 36 times so far this season, but has only knocked 56% (20-of-36) of her shots down at the stripe

LOOKING AHEAD

- Saturday will mark the final game before the Lady Bulldogs take more than three weeks off for Christmas Break, when they host the defending national champion Lubbock Christian at 1:00 pm inside the Pioneer Cellular Event Center
- SWOSU won't play again until January 2 when they take on Science & Arts (USAO) at 5:30 pm in more non-conference action

KELSI MUSICK - HEAD COACH

Kelsi Musick has rebuilt the Southwestern Oklahoma State University women's basketball program with an exciting brand of basketball that has led the Lady Bulldogs to two NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances and three 20-win seasons. She enters her eighth season as the head coach of the Lady Bulldogs in 2016-17 with a career record of 110-91.

The fast-paced play of the Lady Bulldogs has helped SWOSU rank in the top ten nationally in scoring offense in four of the past five seasons, averaging better than 80 points per game in three of those seasons. Additionally, the Lady Bulldogs have ranked in the top ten of NCAA Division II for three-pointers made three times in the past five seasons, including ninth (8.0/game) in 2011-12 and second (9.5) in 2013-14.

Musick's teams improved their win total in each of her first four seasons as she took the Lady Bulldogs from three wins in her first season to 24 in her fourth year. She is a two-time Great American Conference Coach of the Year who has led the Lady Bulldogs to three 20-win seasons. Musick has her teams playing their best in the postseason, where SWOSU has won two GAC Tournament Championships while advancing four GAC Championship games in the league's five-year history. She also led the Lady Bulldogs to NCAA Division II postseason appearances in 2013 and 2014, the first for the program since they made the transition in 1996-97.

SWOSU made an eight-win improvement in 2015-16, finishing 20-12 and tying for third place in the regular season GAC standings with a 14-8 record. The Lady Bulldogs rebounded after starting the season 0-4 and used an nine-game winning to get back into contention near the top of the league standings. SWOSU defeated in-state rivals Southeastern Oklahoma State and East Central to advance to the GAC Tournament Championship game, where they were defeated by No. 15 Arkansas Tech.

The Lady Bulldogs placed three players on the All-GAC teams in 2015-16, led by First Team All-GAC selection Hailey Tucker, who was also named the GAC Freshman of the Year. Janae Coffee was named the GAC's Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-GAC selection while Jennifer Williams garnered all-conference honorable mention.

In seven seasons at SWOSU, Musick has tutored 16 players who have earned all-conference recognition including two-time first team selections in Michelle Fisher and Sumiya Darden. Additionally, she has coached one GAC Player of the Year (Darcie Dick, 2012) and one GAC Freshman of the Year (Hailey Tucker, 2016). Dick became Musick's first All-American at SWOSU, being named an honorable mention selection by the Women's Division II Bulletin in 2012, while Tucker was named to the All-Freshman Team by the same outlet, an honor for only 10 freshman players from all of NCAA Division II.

During the 2014-15 season, the Lady Bulldogs featured a young and inexperienced squad that struggled to a 12-15 overall record, including a 9-11 mark that tied for sixth in the Great American Conference. SWOSU was 10-3 on their home court during the year, including a 78-65 upset of No. 20 Harding on February 7 and they finished the year with five consecutive home wins.

Her 2013-14 squad finished 19-11 and tied for second place in the Great American Conference before making a magical run through the conference tournament. The Lady Bulldogs defeated Henderson State and East Central before handing No. 2 Harding just their second loss of the season, 78-74, in the finals of the tournament to earn the GAC's automatic bid to the national tournament.

SWOSU was upended by top-seed and No. 7 Emporia State in the first round of the regional tournament, but the Lady Bulldogs became one of only four teams that have reached the Central Regional in each of the last two seasons. Musick's squad was led by Michelle Fisher, who became the school's all-time leading 3-point shooter and fourth-leading scorer at the conclusion of a stellar career. Fisher was a First Team All-GAC selection for the second straight season while Sarina Sayama earned honorable mention honors in 2013-14.

SWOSU finished second in the GAC in 2012-13 as Musick earned her second straight conference Coach of the Year after leading her squad to a 24-7 record and their first-ever berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament. The Lady Bulldogs earned the No. 7 seed in the regional and defeated second-seeded Central Missouri 73-71 in the Central Regional Quarterfinals before being eliminated by eventual Region Champion and Final Four participant Augustana 68-64 in the semifinals.

Musick earned her first GAC Coach of the Year award after leading the Lady Bulldogs to a 20-9 record and second-place finish in 2011-12 after winning just 12 games the season before. SWOSU stormed through the conference tournament as the No. 2 seed to claim the inaugural GAC Tournament championship 69-58 over No. 4-seed Harding.

Prior to taking over the Bulldogs, Musick was an assistant coach at Fresno State University where she was part of a staff that posted consecutive 20-win seasons. Fresno State won the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) regular-season and tournament titles in each of her last years and finished 24-9 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2008-09 before being eliminated by California.

Previous head coaching experience for Musick came from her hometown of Canton, Okla., where she led the high school girls team starting in 2005. She spent two seasons at CHS and had her team in the Class A regional tournament in 2006-07 before finishing with a 16-9 record.

Musick played collegiately at Cameron where she was a four-year starter for the Aggies from 1998-2002 at point guard. She set school records in career three-point average and assists while remaining a President's Leadership scholar at the school. Her final season in 2001-02, the Aggies set a school record for most wins (25) and made their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II National Tournament.

Musick's family has a strong basketball background. Her mother, Pam Bond, was a longtime head coach at Canton High School and her younger sister, Kenzi, was a star on Oklahoma City University's NAIA Women's National Runner-up teams in 2003, 2004 and 2005.

A native of Canton, Okla., and a 2002 graduate of Cameron University, Musick is married to former SWOSU strength and conditioning coach Josh Musick. The couple resides in Weatherford with their two sons, Maddox and Titus.
