#### **Setting the Stage**

- Coming off an emotional road victory on Saturday at Harding, the Lady Bulldog basketball team is back at the Pioneer Cellular Event Center for two games this weekend, beginning on Thursday evening against Arkansas-Monticello
- SWOSU is looking to avenge a close, 74-71 defeat earlier this season in Monticello, their second straight road defeat against the Blossoms
- The Lady Bulldogs enter February having alternated wins and losses in their past four games, but they finished the month of January with an 8-2 record
- In Great American Conference play, SWOSU is 7-2 against Arkansas-Monticello, including a perfect mark of 4-0 in home contests
- Both teams are battling for conference positioning, with SWOSU currently tied for third place in the standings while Arkansas Monticello is just two games behind in a share of seventh place
- SWOSU is 9-4 on their home floor this season, with nine consecutive wins after starting the season with four straight defeats, while UAM is just 2-5 on the road this year with three straight losses

#### **The Opponent**

Arkansas-Monticello (9-8, 6-7 GAC)

- Led by the GAC's top scorer, senior Jordan Goforth, who averages 21.3 points per game this season and earlier this year surpassed the 1,000-point scoring mark for her career
- UAM snapped a four-game losing slide on Saturday with a 67-63 victory over East Central on their home floor
- Goforth also leads the team in rebounding (7.6/game), assists (69) and steals (31) and she's second on the team with nine blocked shots
- Nikki Mullen is UAM's other top scoring threat, averaging 11.0 points per game while shooting 40.1% from the field
- Blossoms rank ninth in the league in scoring, averaging 67.5 points per game while holding opponents to 68.9 points per contest

#### The Coaches

SWOSU: Kelsi Musick (102-87; 7th season)

- Two-time GAC Coach of the Year has been the model of consistency, winning GAC Tournament titles in two of the last four years and earning back-to-back NCAA Division II National Tournaments during the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons
- Earned her 100th victory as head coach of the Lady Bulldogs on January 18th, 2016 against Northwestern Oklahoma State
- A great developer of talent, Musick has coached one All-American and 12 All-GAC selections, including one Player of the Year recipient
- Musick has also spent time as an assistant coach at Fresno State, where they won two Western Athletic Conference regular season and tournament titles, as well as qualified for the NCAA Division I National Tournament in the 2008-09 season
- Has a record of 7-2 against Arkansas-Monticello as the head coach of the Lady Bulldogs, including 4-0 record in games played in Weatherford

Arkansas-Monticello: Tanya Ray (48-75; 5th season)

- In her fifth season at Arkansas-Monticello after being named the seventh head coach in program history prior to the 2011-12 season
- Her program captured their 29th winning season in program history last year by finishing 14-13 and advancing to the GAC Tournament
- Came to UAM after serving as an NCAA Division I assistant coach for the previous 11 seasons, spending time at Arkansas State and Oklahoma State

#### **Last Time Out**

- After losing a 17-point lead in the first half, SWOSU scored seven of the final nine points to defeat Harding 79-77 on a buzzer-beating lay in by Janae Coffee
- Kylie Franz hit four three-pointers in the fourth quarter, keeping the Lady Bulldogs within striking distance during a sequence that saw the teams trade three's on four straight possessions
- Hailey Tucker led SWOSU with 24 points, tying her career high, while Morgan Vogt scored 17 points in a season-high 38 minutes

#### **SWOSU Notes**

- Hailey Tucker tied her career-high with 24 points on Saturday at Harding, the fourth 20-point game of her freshman season, and she's ranked 12th in the GAC with a team-leading 13.6 points per game
- Janae Coffee was limited to four rebounds against Harding, her lowest number in six games, but she maintains the team lead and ranks third in the GAC with 8.6 per game
- SWOSU maintains the top spot in NCAA Division II with 35.0 offensive rebounds per game while ranking third overall with 47.9 rebounds per contest
- Jessica Penner continues to lead the GAC in field goal percentage, shooting 66.7% (64-for-96) from the field for the year
- Morgan Vogt scored a season-best 17 points while playing 38 minutes against Harding and tied her career-high with her fifth assist, the game-winner to Coffee as time expired
- The Lady Bulldogs have scored 70 or more points in 15 of their last 17 games, upping their scoring average to 78.6 points per game, the second-best mark in the league
- With an assist:turnover ratio of 2.9:1, SWOSU's Kylie Franz is second in the GAC and ranks eighth nationally in that category
- SWOSU also leads the GAC in field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 35.3% shooting from the field

#### **Looking Ahead**

- SWOSU is back at home on Saturday afternoon, looking for a season-sweep of Southern Arkansas in a game that will tipoff at noon
- Following this weekend's games, SWOSU is on the road for five of their final seven contests to conclude the regular season

#### **KELSI MUSICK - HEAD COACH**

Kelsi Musick has rebuilt the Southwestern Oklahoma State University women's basketball program with an exciting brand of basketball that has led the Lady Bulldogs to two NCAA Division II National Tournament appearances in the past three seasons. She enters her seventh season as the head coach of the Lady Bulldogs in 2015-16 with a career record of 90-80.

The fast-paced play of the Lady Bulldogs has helped SWOSU rank in the top four nationally in scoring offense and the top ten in NCAA Division II in 3-pointers made during three of the past four seasons. SWOSU has averaged over 80 points per game during two of those seasons and ranked third nationally at 79.6 points per game in 2012-13. The 3-point shooting prowess has risen from ninth (8.0/game) in 2011-12 to second (9.5) in 2013-14, helping the Lady Bulldogs score a record 83.1 points per game.

Musick's teams improved their win total in each of her first four seasons as she took the Lady Bulldogs from three wins in her first season to 24 in her fourth year. She is a two-time Great American Conference Coach of the Year and she has led SWOSU to two GAC Tournament Championships and their first two NCAA Division II postseason appearances since the Lady Bulldogs made the transition in 1996-97.

During the 2014-15 season, the Lady Bulldogs featured a young and inexperienced squad that struggled to a 12-15 overall record, including a 9-11 mark that tied for sixth in the Great American Conference. SWOSU was 10-3 on their home court during the year, including a 78-65 upset of No. 20 Harding on February 7 and they finished the year with five consecutive home wins.

Her 2013-14 squad finished 19-11 and tied for second place in the Great American Conference before making a magical run through the conference tournament. The Lady Bulldogs defeated Henderson State and East Central before handing No. 2 Harding just their second loss of the season, 78-74, in the finals of the tournament to earn the GAC's automatic bid to the national tournament.

SWOSU was upended by top-seed and No. 7 Emporia State in the first round of the regional tournament, but the Lady Bulldogs became one of only four teams that have reached the Central Regional in each of the last two seasons. Musick's squad was led by Michelle Fisher, who became the school's all-time leading 3-point shooter and fourth-leading scorer at the conclusion of a stellar career. Fisher was a First Team All-GAC selection for the second straight season while Sarina Sayama earned honorable mention honors in 2013-14.

Through six seasons, Musick has tutored 13 players who have garnered all-conference recognition, including two-time first team selections in Fisher and Sumiya Darden and 2012 GAC Player of the Year Darcie Dick. Dick also became Musick's first All-American at SWOSU after being named an honorable mention selection by the Women's Division II Bulletin. Most recently, Chelsea Bates (Second Team) and Jessica Penner (Honorable Mention) earned All-GAC status following the 2014-15 season.

SWOSU finished second in the GAC in 2012-13 as Musick earned her second straight conference Coach of the Year after leading her squad to a 24-7 record and their first-ever berth in the NCAA Division II Tournament. The Lady Bulldogs earned the No. 7 seed in the regional and defeated second-seeded Central Missouri 73-71 in the Central Regional Quarterfinals before being eliminated by eventual Region Champion and Final Four participant Augustana 68-64 in the semifinals.

Musick earned her first GAC Coach of the Year award after leading the Lady Bulldogs to a 20-9 record and second-place finish in 2011-12 after winning just 12 games the season before. SWOSU stormed through the conference tournament as the No. 2 seed to claim the inaugural GAC Tournament championship 69-58 over No. 4-seed Harding.

Prior to taking over the Bulldogs, Musick was an assistant coach at Fresno State University where she was part of a staff that posted consecutive 20-win seasons. Fresno State won the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) regular-season and tournament titles in each of her last years and finished 24-9 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2008-09 before being eliminated by California.

Previous head coaching experience for Musick came from her hometown of Canton, Okla., where she led the high school girls team starting in 2005. She spent two seasons at CHS and had her team in the Class A regional tournament in 2006-07 before finishing with a 16-9 record.

Musick played collegiately at Cameron where she was a four-year starter for the Aggies from 1998-2002 at point guard. She set school records in career three-point average and assists while remaining a President's Leadership scholar at the school. Her final season in 2001-02, the Aggies set a school record for most wins (25) and made their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Division II National Tournament.

Musick's family has a strong basketball background. Her mother, Pam Bond, was a longtime head coach at Canton High School and her younger sister, Kenzi, was a star on Oklahoma City University's NAIA Women's National Runner-up teams in 2003, 2004 and 2005.

A native of Canton, Okla., and a 2002 graduate of Cameron University, Musick is married to former SWOSU strength and conditioning coach Josh Musick. The couple resides in Weatherford with their son, Maddox.
