Setting the Scene

- Eight long days after being eliminated from the Great American Conference Tournament, the SWOSU Baseball team was selected to compete in the 2016 NCAA Division II Central Region Championships on Sunday night
- The Bulldogs earned the No. 7 seed in the regional, which will pit them against No. 2-seed Central Missouri, who is ranked 12th in the final NCBWA Top 25 poll
- SWOSU and UCM will be the first two teams to take the field at the regional, with first pitch scheduled for 10:00 am on Thursday morning in St. Cloud, Minnesota
- The regional is being hosted by St. Cloud State, who earned the top seed in the Central Region for the second straight season

The Opponent

(2) #12 Central Missouri (38-13)

- Regular season and tournament champions of the MIAA, winning the season title by five games before defeating Missouri Western 16-14 in the tournament championship game
- UCM went 0-3 against the Great American Conference during the regular season, suffering one-run defeats against Henderson State (6-5), Arkansas-Monticello (5-4) and Southern Arkansas (4-3)
- The Mules were 4-4 against teams from the state of Oklahoma in the regular season: Oklahoma Christian (1-0), Central Oklahoma (2-2), Northeastern State (1-2)
- Ten UCM players were named to the All-MIAA team, led by First Team pitchers Ethan Westphal and Grant Gavin, and Kyle Crookes was named the MIAA Coach of the Year
- Central Missouri's offense is ranked seventh in the MIAA with a .310 batting average and their 68 home runs is the fourth-most in the league
- UCM's pitching staff is the best in the MIAA with a league-leading 3.95 ERA, 38 wins and seven saves while holding opponents to a .244 batting average

The Coaches

SWOSU: Zack Saunders (135-100, 5th season)

- Two-time Great American Conference Coach of the Year, winning the award in 2013 and 2016
- In the midst of his second 30-win season as the head coach of the Bulldogs, where he has led SWOSU to four winning seasons while tutoring 24 all-conference players
- Earned his 100th career victory at SWOSU against Northwestern Oklahoma State on April 24, 2015
- Was named the GAC Coach of the Year in 2013 and he has tutored 14 players who have earned All-GAC status, including four first-team selections, one All-Central Region honoree, one regional gold glove award winner and one MLB draftee
- Previously served as an assistant at SWOSU for six seasons under former Bulldog coaches



2016 BULLDOG BASEBALL WEEKLY NOTES • CENTRAL REGION CHAMPIONSHIPS

Charles Teasley and Scott Selby

- Played collegiately at Kansas State following two seasons at Connors State playing on nationally-ranked junior college teams
- Has a record of 135-100 while leading the Bulldogs, including 7-10 record against Arkansas Tech and an 0-6 mark at the Great American Conference Tournament

Central Missouri: Kyle Crookes (68-35, 2nd season)

- Named the MIAA Coach of the Year this season in his second year as UCM's Head Coach and fourth year overall with the Mules after two years as an assistant coach
- Prior to coming to Warrensburg, Crookes spent the previous eight seasons as the head coach at Hutchinson Community College, compiling a 292-164 overall record while leading the Blue Dragons

Postseason Honors

- SWOSU had eight players named to the 2016 All-GAC Baseball list on Thursday, while head coach Zack Saunders was named the GAC Coach of the Year for the second time (2013)
- Earning First Team All-GAC honors were starting pitcher Jon Chidester, outfielders Korbin Polston & Jacob Spring and designated hitter Zach Barton
- Second Team All-GAC selections included starting pitcher Gunnar Cook and outfielder Tanner Dearman while relief pitcher Quintin Dougherty and second baseman CJ Faddis received honorable mention
- Polston and Barton added selections to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Teams, becoming the first such honorees from SWOSU Baseball since 2004

SWOSU in the Postseason

- SWOSU has been an NCAA Division II program since 1998 and they will be making the programs first-ever appearance in the Division II Baseball Championship tournament
- Since joining NCAA Division II, SWOSU is 1-14 in postseason baseball with the lone win coming against Texas A&M-Kingsville in the 2011 Lone Star Conference Tournament
- The Bulldogs are 0-8 in four GAC Tournament appearances, including an 0-2 mark this season when they were eliminated by Arkansas Tech

SWOSU Notes

- The Bulldogs had a six-game win streak -- their longest of the season -- snapped in the GAC Tournament against Arkansas Tech and they now look to bounce back in their first meeting against UCM since 2001
- SWOSU has only faced three teams in the NCAA Central Regional field (Arkansas-Monticello. Central Missouri, Emporia State) since joining NCAA Division II and they are 1-1 against the Mules after the teams split a doubleheader in Weatherford on February 25, 2001

Looking Ahead

- The winner of Thursday morning's contest advances to play the winner between (3) Minnesota Duluth and (6) Emporia State on Friday at 8:30 pm
- The losing team will return to action on Friday at 1:30 pm to face the loser between UMD and ESU in an elimination contest

HEAD COACH ZACK SAUNDERS

Zack Saunders is in his sixth season as the head coach of the Southwestern Oklahoma State Baseball team and he is leading the Bulldogs to their first-ever NCAA Division II Regional appearance in 2016.

Saunders is a two-time Great American Conference Coach of the Year, having earned the honor in 2013 and 2016. His team claimed their first-ever GAC regular season title this season and the program's first conference crown since 1992 by finishing one game ahead of the field during the 2016 season. His team had a program-best eight players earn All-GAC distinction, led by four first team selections. Additionally, SWOSU had two players named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District team, becoming the first players since 2002 to earn the honor.

Saunders, who earned his 100th victory at SWOSU on April 24, 2015 against Northwestern Oklahoma State, has led the Bulldogs to a winning record in four of his five seasons with four trips to the Great American Conference Tournament

during his five seasons. In addition, he has tutored 24 players who have earned All-Great American Conference status, including nine first-team selections, one player who garnered All-Central Region accolades, one who earned the regional Gold Glove award and one Major League Baseball draft pick.

The Bulldogs suffered their first non-winning season under Saunders as they struggled to a 19-27 record, including a 12-18 mark in GAC play in 2015. Despite missing the conference tournament for the first time, the Bulldogs had two players earn all-conference recognition, including starting pitcher Jon Chidester, a first team selection after becoming the first player in league history to be named Pitcher of the Week three times in one season.

His 2014 squad finished with a winning record at 25-23 and entered the GAC Tournament as the fifth seed after tying with Harding for fourth place in the standings. SWOSU was led by senior pitcher Jonathan Johnson, who ranked among the national leaders in complete games and earned second team All-GAC honors after finishing 6-6 with a 2.53 ERA. Johnson was joined on the second team by shortstop Dalton Daniels, who was also named to the Rawlings/American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Central Region Gold Glove team.

The 2013 edition of SWOSU baseball had one of the most successful seasons for the program as an NCAA Division II member. The Bulldogs completed the season with a 31-16 record and placed second in the Great American Conference with a 21-9 conference record. Saunders was rewarded by being named the 2013 GAC Coach of the Year – the first such award of his career – as SWOSU remained in contention for their first NCAA Division II postseason bid until the final week of the season.

Starting pitcher Shane Martin and utility player Kevin Cantrell earned All-GAC first team honors at the conclusion of the 2013 season while Calyn Young was a second team choice. Martin's accolades continued as he was selected to three All-Central Region teams before being a ninth-round selection of the Philadelphia Phillies in the 2013 MLB Draft.

Saunders first squad at SWOSU finished 27-19 (14-10 GAC) and claimed third place in the Great American Conference standings. The Bulldogs had four players earn All-GAC honors, led by first teamers Andre Yates (second base) and Jeremy Soliday (third base).
