SETTING THE SCENE

- Bulldog Football crosses the Arkansas state line for the final time in the 2017 season this Saturday for a trip to Searcy to face Harding
- SWOSU is coming off a 38-21 defeat against Arkansas Tech last Saturday in Weatherford that dropped the Bulldogs to 2-5 on the year
- Harding, meanwhile, is the hottest team in the Great American Conference with four consecutive wins after starting the season 0-3
- SWOSU has not won in Searcy since the formation of the GAC, dropping all four meetings on the road against the Bisons by an average of 31 points per game
- This marks the second straight season that SWOSU has visited First Security Stadium in Searcy, where they were defeated 42-27 by Harding last season
- SWOSU is searching for their second win of the year on Arkansas soil after going 0-6 against GAC foes from The Natural State in 2016

THE SERIES

- SWOSU and Harding have met 12 times on the gridiron in a series that dates back to the 1994 season
- The Bulldogs and Bisons met in six consecutive seasons from 1994-99, splitting the series in that span before starting the series back up in 2011 at the formation of the Great American Conference
- Harding leads the all-time series 7-5, including a 4-2 mark against the Bulldogs as members of the GAC
- SWOSU has not defeated Harding in Searcy since 1999 and they are 0-4 in trips to Harding as GAC foes

THE COACHES

SWOSU: Dan Cocannouer, 36-58 (9th Season)

- Has announced that he will retire following the 2017, his ninth as the head coach at his alma mater
- Earned four Coach of the Year Awards following the 2015 season, including: Great American Conference, AFCA Region 4, HERO Sports Region 3 and OklahomaSports. Net Small College
- Ranked fourth in SWOSU Football history for coaching victories with 36, three shy of Bob Mazie (39-37-2; 1978-85) for third place on the list
- Has a record of 2-4 against Harding as the Bulldogs head coach, including a mark of 0-4 against the Bisons in Searcy

Harding: Paul Simmons, 4-3 (1st Season)

- Became the 13th head coach in Harding Football history and sixth since the university restarted in football in 1959 after taking over prior to the 2017 season
- Previously spent 11 seasons as an assistant coach at Harding, where he has coached the Bisons in six postseason games - including the 2012, 2014 and 2016 NCAA Division II Playoffs

THE LAST MEETING (OCT. 29, 2016)

- SWOSU gave #5/10 Harding one of their toughest tests of the season before the Bisons scored with 2:23 to play and secured a 42-27 victory last Saturday in Searcy
- Harding led 28-13 at the break and scored early in the third quarter to go up 35-13, but the Bulldogs slowed the Bisons the rest of the second half and got within one score late in the game
- The Bisons offense rushed for 506 yards against the Bulldogs while totaling 560 yards of offense, but SWOSU countered with 335 passing yards, the most against Harding this season
- Marc Evans was 20-for-33 passing for 335 yards and two touchdowns, both to D.J. Jones who finished with four receptions for 136 yards
- Dominic Blue led SWOSU with 13 tackles while Deric Robertson added 12

LAST TIME OUT (OCT. 14, 2017)

- SWOSU junior running back Karltrell Henderson rushed for a season-best 127 yards and two touchdowns against Arkansas Tech, but it was the Golden Suns leaving ASAP Energy Field with a 38-21 victory on Saturday afternoon
- ATU scored the first 21 points of the game on three rushing touchdowns and the Wonder Boys led 21-6 at halftime
- SWOSU got rushing touchdowns from Henderson and Casey Freeman in the second half but it was not enough to overcome the early deficit
- Henderson became SWOSU's career rushing leader for the NCAA Division II era in the win - passing Jimmy Jenkins for the top spot on the list
- Arkansas Tech outgained SWOSU with 440 yards of total offense compared to 276 for the Dawgs
- Austin Loomis had a team-high eight tackles for SWOSU while Dominic Blue added seven tackles and 1.5 tackles for loss

CHECKING THE STANDINGS

- Southeastern Oklahoma State suffered their first conference defeat last Saturday against Henderson State, but the Savage Storm remain atop the league standings at 6-1
- One game behind Southeastern is a trio of teams at 5-2: Arkansas Tech, Ouachita and Southern Arkansas
- Sharing fifth place in the standings at 4-3 are Arkansas-Monticello, Harding and Henderson State, all of which have won at least two straight games
- Northwestern Oklahoma State and Southern Nazarene dropped under .500 with losses last weekend and they're tied for eighth at 3-4
- SWOSU maintains their spot in 10th place in the GAC standings at 2-5, one game ahead of East Central at 1-6 and two games ahead of winless Oklahoma Baptist in the cellar

SWOSU OFFENSIVE NOTES

- Karltrrell Henderson rushed for a season-best 127 yards against Arkansas Tech, moving to the top of SWOSU's NCAA era Career Rushing list in the process
- Henderson now has SWOSU's records for Career Rushing Yards (2,137) and Rushing Touchdowns (32) in less than three full seasons with the Bulldogs
- SWOSU currently ranks 10th in the Great American Conference in Scoring Offense (21.6 points per game) and 11th in Total Offense (353.4 yards per game)
- Casey Freeman has completed 54.9% (129-of-235) of his pass attempts for the year and he's ranked third in the league with 212.9 passing yards per game
- SWOSU completed a season-low 13 pass attempts against Arkansas Tech, with Dylan Power and Karltrrell Henderson leading the way with three receptions each
- The Bulldogs offensive line has allowed at least one sack in each game this season, totaling a league-leading 22 sacks allowed on the year

SWOSU DEFENSIVE NOTES

- An eight-tackle performance against Arkansas Tech has given senior linebacker Austin Loomis 240 career tackles, needing 10 more to move into the Top 5 on SWOSU's Career Tackles list for the NCAA Division II era
- Loomis is the Bulldogs leading tackler and he's ranked eighth in the Great American Conference with 52 stops (31 solo, 21 assist) for the year
- SWOSU had a season-high 9.0 tackles for loss against Arkansas Tech, getting 1.5 each from Dominic Blue, Colten Buie and Gerald White
- The Bulldogs are ranked ninth in the GAC in Scoring Defense (34.0 points per game) and seventh in Total Defense (399.0 yards per game)
- SWOSU is ranked third in the GAC with 14 takeaways for the year - including seven fumbles recovered and seven interceptions

SWOSU SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

- JR Omigie has handled the bulk of kickoff return duty the past two weeks, averaging 17.5 yards per return on Saturday against Arkansas Tech
- SWOSU's kick return of 22.7 yards per return is the second-best mark in the conference but the Dawgs have struggled on punt returns with an average of 1.9 yards per return
- SWOSU is ranked 10th in the conference net punting average of 28.6 yards per punt while the kickoff coverage is 12th in the league with a net of 28.3 yards per kickoff

LOOKING AHEAD

- SWOSU heads to Shawnee, Okla., next Saturday for a meeting with Oklahoma Baptist - the first of three in-state showdowns to conclude the 2017 season
- Homecoming and Senior Day will be Saturday, November 4th when the Bulldogs host Southern Nazarene before closing out the year at Northwestern Oklahoma State on November 11th

HEAD COACH DAN COCANNOUER



SWOSU alum **Dan Cocannouer** enters his ninth season as the head coach of the Southwestern Oklahoma State football team in 2017, where he has led his alma mater to a record of 34-53 since returning in Weatherford prior to the 2009 season.

Cocannouer earned three Coach of the Year awards in 2015 after leading the Bulldogs to the Live United Texarkana Bowl, garnering the award from the Great American Conference, American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) for Region 4 and OklahomaSports.Net for all small colleges throughout the state. He enters

the 2017 season with 34 career wins, which ranks him fourth all-time among SWOSU Football coaches.

Cocannouer has led the Bulldogs to a winning record twice in his tenure, going 6-5 in 2013 and 8-4 in 2015, and his teams have won at least five games in four of his eight seasons. He bettered the Bulldogs win-loss total in each of his first three seasons, improving his team from 1-10 in his inaugural season to 5-6 in 2011, their first season in the GAC.

Prior to coming back to SWOSU, Cocannouer had spent 25 seasons as a high school head coach in the state of Oklahoma, establishing a reputation as one of the most prominent and well-respected coaching leaders in the state. He came to SWOSU after eight years at Edmond Santa Fe High School where he compiled a 70-26 record (.729 winning percentage) and led the Wolves to the Class 6A finals in 2003.

His other high school stops included lead high school programs at John Marshall, Chandler, Alva, Pauls Valley and Walters High Schools. All total, he has coached more than 36 years, including the last 30 as a head coach. He led five different schools to the state playoffs and served on the Oklahoma Football Coaches Association (OFCA) Advisory Board for several years and he is a past President of the Oklahoma Coaches Association (OCA) and the OFCA. With his prep success came the opportunity to coach in numerous all-star games, including the Oklahoma All-State game (1988), Jim Thorpe Classic (2000, 2002), Oil Bowl (1997-98) and Enid Shriner All-Star Game (1992-96).

Cocannouer played at SWOSU from 1974-77 under legendary head coach Otis Delaporte, helping the Bulldogs to conference titles in 1974 and 1977. He was a senior leader on the Bulldog team that won a school-record 11 games and finished as the NAIA National Runner-up in 1997 after playing in the Apple Bowl at the Seattle Kingdome. By returning to lead his alma mater, he became the first SWOSU graduate to lead the Bulldogs since Joe Metcalf did the same from 1952-57.

Cocannouer holds two degrees from SWOSU. He earned a bachelor's degree in Health and Physical Education in 1978 before serving as a graduate assistant for the Bulldog football team while until he earned a master's degree in Education in 1983. He also later obtained a secondary administrative certificate from Northwestern Oklahoma State in 1996.

Dan is a native of Tuttle, Oklahoma. The Cocannouer family lost their beloved wife and mother, Jeri Lyn, in early August 2015. She now has the best seat in all stadiums to cheer on the Bulldogs! They have two adult daughters and son-in-laws: Cory and Janie Pence of Dallas, and Colton and Josie Blackburn of Edmond along with two grandsons.
