## SETTING THE SCENE

- SWOSU Volleyball has earned the No. 7-seed in the 2017 Great American Conference Tournament, which begins on Thursday at the Bank of the Ozarks Arena in Hot Springs
- The Bulldogs will be matched up against the tournament's No. 2-seed, Harding, who finished as the runner-up in the GAC with a 13-3 mark in league play
- This will mark the third time that SWOSU has faced Harding in the GAC Tournament, with both prior meetings being won by the Lady Bisons
- SWOSU has been the No. 7-seed in the tournament once prior, falling to Harding in straight sets in the quarterfinals of the 2011 GAC Tournament in Russellville, Arkansas
- The Bulldogs are 3-3 all-time in the tournament quarterfinals, with back-to-back wins against Northwestern in 2015 and Arkansas Tech in 2016
- In six prior GAC Tournaments, the No. 2-seeded teams are 6-0 against the No. 7-seed, with No. 2 Ouachita needing five sets to defeat No. 7 Arkansas-Monticello last season

# 2017 BULLDOG VOLLEYBALL NOTES • GREAT AMERICAN CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT

## THE OPPONENT

### (2) Harding (25-5)

- The Lady Bisons enter the tournament having dropped two of their last three matches during the regular season, including a five-set thriller against GAC Champion Arkansas Tech
- Harding finished in second place in the GAC by two games over Oklahoma Baptist with a 13-3 league mark
- Harding ranks second in the GAC in both hitting percentage (.241) and opponent hitting percentage (.137)
- HU is led by middle hitter Zoe Hardin, who led the GAC in blocks (1.19/set) while ranking 10th in kills (2.96/set) and fifth in hitting percentage (.323)
- Harding's setter Rachel Heussner is the league leader in assists, averaging 10.9 per set with 1,155 to her credit this season

## THE COACH

### SWOSU: Josh Collins (82-108, 6th season)

- Led the Bulldogs to the best season in program history in 2015, winning 22 games and the GAC Tournament Championship
- Has coached 12 All-GAC selections, one GAC Freshman of the Year and two AVCA All-Central Region selections in four seasons
- His teams have earned two AVCA Team Academic Awards and one GAC Sportsmanship Award
- Became the winningest coach in SWOSU Volleyball history on November 10th, 2016 with a three-set win at Northwestern

## HEAD COACH JOSH COLLINS

Josh Collins is in his sixth season as the head coach of the SWOSU Volleyball team, while also serving as the Athletic Department's Director of Gameday Operations.

Collins – who became SWOSU Volleyball's winningest coach on November 10th, 2016 – enters the 2017 season with a career record of 70-89 (.440) and he has led the Bulldogs to a top-four finish in the Great American Conference three times in his five seasons leading the program. He also guided SWOSU to the 2015 GAC Tournament Championship, the program's first conference crown, and a berth in the NCAA Division II national tournament for the first time.

Collins has tutored 12 players who have earned All-Great American Conference honors in the past five seasons, including First Team selections Alison Cole (2013) and Carly Zak (2015-16). Zak also became the program's first GAC Freshman of the Year in 2013 and the first All-Central Region selection, earning the honor in 2015 (Second Team) and 2016 (First Team). Additionally, Collins' teams have earned the AVCA Team Academic Award on two occasions (2012, 2014) and they won the GAC Sportsmanship Award in 2014.

In addition to improved play on the court, fan support has continued to increase for the Bulldog Volleyball program since moving into the Pioneer Cellular Event Center prior to the 2014 season. SWOSU's attendance has ranked first (2015) and second (2016) in the GAC the past two seasons, marks that put the Bulldogs among the top 35 schools in NCAA Division II.

SWOSU finished the 2016 season with a record of 14-17, which included a sixth-place finish in the GAC at 9-7. The Bulldogs advanced to the semifinals of the GAC Tournament with a 3-1 victory over Arkansas Tech in the opening round, improving to 4-2 in the postseason over the past two seasons. For the second straight year, the Bulldogs had three players earn postseason recognition, led by First Team All-GAC and All-Central Region selection Carly Zak, who graduated as the GAC's all-time leader in kills. Kayla Hebert and Kelsi Schmidtberger also garnered All-GAC Honorable Mention during their senior seasons.

The 2015 season was a breakthrough campaign for the SWOSU Volleyball program. The Bulldogs recorded the first winning season in program history by setting a new single-season record with 22 wins. SWOSU finished fourth in the Great American Conference with a 10-6 mark and entered the GAC Tournament as the No. 3-seed and defeated Northwestern Oklahoma State, Southern Nazarene and Southern Arkansas to claim the program's first-ever GAC Championship. The win also earned the Bulldogs their first-ever trip to the NCAA Division II Tournament, where they met the top-ranked team in the country, Concordia-St. Paul.

SWOSU was led by a trio of All-GAC performers in 2015. Carly Zak was named a First Team All-GAC selection and became the program's first All-Central Region performer when she earned a second team all-region selection by the Division II Conference Commissioners Association (D2CCA). Kayla Hebert was a Second Team All-GAC selection and was named the GAC Tournament's Most Valuable Player, while Kelsi Schmidtberger earned All-GAC honorable mention and was picked to the GAC All-Tournament Team.

While 2012 was his first season as the head volleyball coach, Collins is certainly no newcomer to Southwestern Oklahoma State University. He arrived in Weatherford in 2004 from Clarendon College and he served as an assistant men's basketball coach under Scott Reed in 2004-05 and later with current athletic director and former basketball coach Todd Thurman during the 2006-07 season.

Starting in 2005, Collins worked as a dual assistant for SWOSU, assisting with basketball while also helping Pagliasotti start the volleyball program. He served as an assistant volleyball coach for seven seasons before taking over prior to the 2012 season.

Collins, a native of Hedley, Texas, holds two degrees from Southwestern Oklahoma State University. He earned his bachelor's degree in 2006 before completing his master's degree in Sports Management in 2008. He and his wife, Jamie, were married in June 2012 and reside in Weatherford.
