GAME PREVIEW

• SWOSU Football continues on its search for the first win of the season when they travel down I-40 to face Southern Nazarene on Saturday in what will be the first afternoon kickoff of 2023.

• The Bulldogs have lost the last two matchups with the Crimson Storm, and three of the last four.

• Despite this, SWOSU continues to lead the all-time series, 8-3 -- having racked up six consecutive years' worth of victories from 2012-17 when GAC play began and adding another win over them in 2003.

• The two question marks going into Saturday will be can SWOSU move the ball on offense to put up points, and can they stop the SNU rushing attack spearheaded by 2022 GAC Player of the Year and All-American quarterback Gage Porter.

THE OPPONENT

• Southern Nazarene enters the week ranked second in Division II in rushing, averaging 291 yards per game and over six yards per rush.

• After falling to a nationally ranked Harding squad in week one, they've bounced back with two-straight wins and now sit 2-1 on the year.

• The Crimson Storm score points, but also give up plenty of points. In two wins, they are averaging 40.0 points per game but are also allowing 37.7 points on the year.

• QB Gage Porter's 495 yards on the ground and eight touchdowns ranks him second in Division II in both of those statistics.

• When they can get to third down, the Crimson Storm defense has held offenses to a 9-of-31 conversion rate which is a league leading 29% -- SNU's problem has come on the first two downs where they have allowed greater chunks of yardage to be gained.

SWOSU OFFENSIVE NOTES

- SWOSU was held under 200 yards of total offense for a second time this season against East Central. In three games in 2023, the Bulldogs best offensive output came against UAM in week two when they finished with exactly 250 yards on offense.
- Ethane Hyche ran the ball 21 times for 44 yards but punched in a pair of scores. He now has a team leading three rushing touchdowns on the year.
- Making his first start at QB, Calvin Cloud finished 4-of-12 for 91 yards and an interception. Cloud is projected to start again against SNU in place of an injured Scott Pfeiffer.

SWOSU DEFENSIVE NOTES

- The Dawgs were opportunistic against ECU thanks to an interception from Logan Monroe and a fumble recovery from Richard Silva (forced by Mason Daugherty) that allowed SWOSU to take its first lead of the game in the third quarter.
- It was the first time this season SWOSU forced multiple turnovers in a game. However, they have had at least one turnover in all three contests so far this year.
- SWOSU tallied four first half sacks against ECU and finished the game with five. They now have 10 on the season, ranking them third in the GAC.
- Monroe and Silva are not slowing down their production at linebacker. They have combined for 61 tackles, 8.5 TFL, and 2.5 sacks and rank second and third in the league respectively in total tackles.

HEAD COACH RUZELL MCCOY

Ruzell McCoy was elevated to Interim Head Coach effective January 4, 2023.

"We are excited to announce Ruzell McCoy as the Interim Head Coach for SWOSU Football," said SWOSU Athletic Director Todd Helton. "Coach McCoy is a Bulldog through and through who has done an outstanding job as both an assistant and coordinator at SWOSU since 2019. We are confident he is ready and able to continue the momentum we have built in the football program."

McCoy, a former All-American linebacker at SWOSU, had just concluded his first year as Defensive Coordinator prior to his appointment as Interim Head Coach after spending the past three years as the Defensive Line Coach.

McCoy patrolled the field for the Bulldogs from 2005-08, recording 283 tackles and 44.5 tackles for loss, marks that both rank third at SWOSU in the NCAA Division II era. He was a two-time First Team All-Lone Star Conference selection and the North Division Linebacker of the Year after ranking second in the conference with 107 tackles during his senior season. That same year, McCoy was selected a First Team All-American by the Don Hansen Football Gazette and he went on to be named SWOSU's Male Athlete of the Year for the 2008-09 school year.

After graduation from SWOSU in 2010, McCoy began his coaching career alongside former Bulldog Head Coach Ryan Held at Highland Community College, where he served as the Scotties' Defensive Coordinator from 2012-2015. He then moved on to Coffeyville Community College as Defensive Coordinator/Linebackers Coach during the 2016-17 seasons and coached last season as the Associate Head Coach/Defensive Coordinator at McPherson College. Most recently, McCoy was named the Defensive Coordinator at Ellsworth Community College in 2019.



A native of Frederick, Okla., McCoy holds two degrees from SWOSU, having completed a bachelor's degree in Parks & Recreation in 2009 before finishing a master's degree in Sports Management in 2010. He resides in Weatherford with his wife, Sara, and their three children: Kynna, Trey and Zella.
