## Opening Tips

- Wednesday will see the first meeting between the Aggies and the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles on the hardwood.
- Texas A&M is coming off a solid showing at the 2015 Battle4Atlantis where the Aggies defeated Texas and No. 10 Gonzaga before falling to Syracuse in the tournament's title game.
- Seniors **Danuel House** and **Jalen Jones** were named to the Battle4Atlantis All-Tournament team ... House led the Aggies with a 17.7 point-per-game scoring average during the event, while Jones contributed a game-high 23 points in the title contest.
- The win over Gonzaga stood out as the Aggies' first over a top-10 opponent since defeating No. 10 Texas on Jan. 30, 2008, inside Reed Arena as well as the first over any ranked opponent since a 70-68 win over No. 20 Missouri in College Station on Feb. 7, 2013.
- Texas A&M moved up to No. 18 in this week's Associated Press poll as well as entered the USA Today Coaches Poll this week at No. 20 ... Last week's appearance in the AP poll marked the first time A&M has been ranked since Dec. 12, 2011, when it was No. 22 in both the AP and USA Today Coaches' Poll.
- Statistically, sophomore **Tonny Trocha-Morelos** ranks third in the NCAA in 3-point FG percentage at 11-for-15 (73.3%), among players with at least 10 3-point field goal attempts ... Senior **Alex Caruso** leads the SEC in steals with 15 while ranking 21<sup>st</sup> nationally and freshman **Tyler Davis** is third in the SEC in free-throws made (31).
- Texas A&M also stands out as one of 16 teams nationally to rank in top 30 in both adjusted offensive and defensive efficiency (according to kenpom.com). The list includes (*AP Rankings*) - No. 1 Kentucky, No. 3 Michigan State, No. 4 Kansas, No. 5 Iowa State, No. 6 Oklahoma, No. 7 Duke, No. 8 Villanova, No. 9 North Carolina, No. 10 Virginia, No. 11 Purdue, No. 12 Xavier, No. 13 Gonzaga, No. 16 Vanderbilt, No. 18 Texas A&M, No. 25 Baylor and (RV) Iowa.

## Ags Turn Heads with Runner-Up Showing at Battle4Atlantis

Playing against one of the best fields of any in-season tournament in front of national TV audience, the Battle4Atlantis (Paradise Island, Bahamas) stood out as a huge stage for Texas A&M to make an impression on the college basketball world. The Aggies did not disappoint, winning a pair of games to reach the event's title game and turning heads of national media pundits along the way.



After opening the event by defeating rival Texas 84-73 on Nov. 25, the Aggies returned to the court on Nov. 26 where they downed No. 10 Gonzaga 62-61. The win stood out as the program's first over a top-10 opponent since a 80-63 victory over Texas on Jan. 30, 2008.

Following the win over the Zags, the Aggies received praise from the national media on twitter.

**@JonRothstein (Jon Rothstein, CBS Sports):** Texas A&M with a statement win over Gonzaga in the Bahamas. Aggies are FOR REAL. Legitimate challenger in the SEC. Advance to title game.

**@ESPNAAndyKatz (Andy Katz, ESPN):** Well now. That was an NCAA type game. Aggies defended Kyle Wiltjer and Zags well on last possession.

**@franfraschilla (Fran Fraschilla, ESPN):** Not a classier guy in coaching than Texas A&M's @Coach\_Kennedy. Very solid program win over Gonzaga. Terrific nucleus for 15-16 & future.

Despite a 74-67 loss to Syracuse in the championship game, Texas A&M generated a significant amount of buzz at the Battle4Atlantis and signaled that it would be a team to be reckoned with on the national scene this season.

## Aggies Topple No. 10 Gonzaga for first Top-10 Win since '08

A final shot from the Zags' guard Silas Melson rimmed out during the closing seconds of a 62-61 win over No. 10 Gonzaga on Nov. 26 at the Battle4Atlantis to give the Aggies a signature win during the campaign's opening month, as well as their first over a top-10 opponent in eight seasons.

The victory was the Aggies' first over a top-10 opponent (AP rankings) since a 80-63 victory over Texas on Jan. 30, 2008, as well as the first over any ranked opponent since a 70-68 win over #20 Missouri in College Station on Feb. 7, 2013

## A&M Returns to the Top 25

Entering the season with high aspirations, Texas A&M got off to a hot start and racing out to a 4-0 record allowing them to climb back into the Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> edition of the *Associated Press* rankings at No. 25.

It marked the first time the Aggies have appeared in the rankings since they were No. 22 in the AP rankings on Dec. 12, 2011.

Texas A&M is currently ranked No. 18 by the *Associated Press* and No. 20 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

## House & Jones Named to Battle4Atlantis All-Tournament Team

Following a strong showing in the Bahamas, seniors Danuel House and Jalen Jones were named to the Battle4Atlantis All-Tournament team. House led the Aggies with a 17.7 point-per-game scoring average during the event, while Jones contributed a game-high 23 points in the title contest.



## SERIES HISTORY: FGCU

### First Meeting

- Wednesday's contest will mark the first contest between the Aggies & Eagles on the hardwood.
- Texas A&M's Billy Kennedy has never faced off against FGCU but is 5-2 all-time against current members of the Atlantic Sun Conference (Jacksonville [2-0], Stetson [2-2] & USC Upstate [1-0]).
- Kennedy compiled a 17-15 record in conference play as a coach in the Atlantic Sun (then the Trans America Athletic Conference) during his time at Centenary.
- The Aggies have already hosted an Atlantic Sun Conference school at Reed Arena this season, defeating USC Upstate 104-64 on Nov. 13 during the season-opener.
- While not having faced the Aggies at FGCU, Eagles' head coach Joe Dooley is familiar with Texas A&M from his 10 seasons as assistant coach Kansas (2003-2013), during which the Jayhawks made five visits to College Station.

The field for the annual tournament, dedicated to legendary UCLA coach John Wooden who delivered 10 national championships, includes UCLA (Pac-12), Cal State Northridge (Big West), Dayton (Atlantic 10), Nebraska (Big Ten), New Mexico (Mountain West), Portland (West Coast), Texas A&M (Southeastern) and Virginia Tech (Atlantic Coast).

The tournament will be played on Nov. 24-25 in Cal State Fullerton's Titan Gym with the final day of play on Nov. 27 at the Honda Center in Anaheim.

### House Selected to Wooden Award Watch List

Coming off an impressive debut season in Aggieland, Texas A&M senior guard Danuel House has been selected to the watch list for the 2016 John R. Wooden Award, presented annually to the collegiate basketball's player of the year.

House is already off to a hot start this season, scoring 62 points (15.5 points per game) while adding 19 rebounds, 12 assists, two steals and a block in just four games. During the Aggies' win over Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 16, House scored 20 points to reach the 20-point plateau for the eighth time in his A&M career.

Already this season, House has been named First Team Preseason All-SEC by the league's coaches and media voters who cover the league, while earning a spot on the watch list for the 2016 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.

### Aggies Hit Century Mark; Freshmen Shine in Season Opener

Texas A&M rode 66.7 percent shooting to its lopsided 104-64 home victory South Carolina Upstate on Nov. 13. The 104-point output was the second most of the Billy Kennedy era, falling just short of a 109-point performance against Northwestern State during last season's opener (Nov. 14, 2014).

Six different Aggies scored in double figures in the lopsided opening win -- led by 6-7 freshman sharpshooter D.J. Hogg, a former Plano West High School teammate of Tyler Davis, who scored 20 points off the bench. Davis and freshman guard Admon Gilder tallied 16 points apiece, while senior forward Danuel House (15 points), Trocha-Morelos (12 points) and 6-9 freshman power forward Elijah Thomas (11 points)

### Keeping it 100 for a Second Straight Game to Start the Season

For the second straight contest the Aggies needed a third digit on the scoreboard at Reed Arena as they defeated Southeastern Louisiana 100-58 on Nov. 16.

The scoring outburst marked the first time A&M has scored 100 or more points in back-to-back games since 1989-90 when it accomplished the feat Feb. 21 at Arkansas and Feb. 24 at Rice under interim head coach John Thornton. It also marked the first time scoring 100+ in multiple games in a season since 2007-08.

The last time Texas A&M opened the season scoring 100+ in first two games was 1975-76 when the Aggies did it four consecutive games.

Additionally, the 42-point win over SLU is the biggest margin of victory during the Billy Kennedy era and marked the Aggies' second win by 40-points or more, following a win over USC Upstate in the season-opener.

### Reed Arena Success

- The Aggies are 4-0 on their home court this year and are now 212-76 (.736) all time in 18 seasons at Reed Arena ... the Aggies were 41-41 the first six years at Reed and are 171-35 since.
- In the last three seasons, Texas A&M is 35-7 (.833) on its home floor.
- A&M has won 84 of its last 100 home games against unranked opponents (31 of last 43 in league play).
- Texas A&M is 4-0 in non-conference games at Reed Arena this season ... the Aggies are 130-13 (.909) all-time in non-conference games inside the facility, which hosted its first basketball game in the fall of 1998 ... a loss to Rice on Dec. 22, 2011, snapped A&M's 67-game non-conference home win streak at Reed Arena (which dated back to the start of the 2005-06 season) and 80-game regular-season, non-conference home win streak (which dated back to 2003), both school records.

Both players, along with fellow senior Jalen Jones, garnered All-SEC accolades from various media outlets after last season with House (1<sup>st</sup> Team) and Jones (2<sup>nd</sup> Team) recognized by the league's coaches and Caruso selected honorable mention all-league from the *Associated Press*.

Kentucky Tops Preseason SEC Media Poll; Aggies Third

Kentucky was predicted to win the 2016 Southeastern Conference men's basketball championship in voting by a select panel of both SEC and national media members.

The Wildcats are the overall preseason favorite for the 11th time since the 1998-99 season.

LSU freshman Ben Simmons was the choice of the media for SEC Men's Basketball Player of the Year. Simmons becomes just the second freshman chosen as preseason player of the year by the media, joining Kentucky's Julius Randle in 2013-14. Florida's Dorrian Finney-Smith, Kentucky's Tyler Ulis, Texas A&M's Danuel House and Vanderbilt's Damian Jones also received votes in the Player of the Year voting.

House, Jones, Simmons and Ulis were each All-SEC First Team selections along with Kentucky's Skal Labissiere and Ole Miss's Stefan Moody.

## House & Hogg Named to National Watch List

A pair of Aggies garnered national recognition as senior Danuel House was named to the watch list for the 2016 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and freshman D.J. Hogg (pronounced HOEG [rhymes with rogue]) received a spot on the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award watch list.

Named after Hall of Famer and 1959 NCAA Final Four Most Valuable Player Jerry West, the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award is in its second year and recognizes the top shooting guard in Division I men's college basketball.

Meanwhile, the Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award presented by University of Massachusetts is also in its second year. Named after Hall of Famer and 11-time NBA All-Star Julius Erving, the honor recognizes the top small forward in Division I men's college basketball.

By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for both the 2016 Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award and Julius Erving Small Forward of the Year Award will be narrowed to just 10. In March, five finalists will be presented to each awards' respective selection committee.

The winners of the 2016 Jerry West Award and Julius Erving Award will be presented at the ESPN College Basketball Awards Show live from Club Nokia in Los Angeles, Calif., on April 8, 2016.

## Aggies Enjoy August EuroTrip to Italy & Greece

The Texas A&M men's basketball team got a jump start on the 2015-16 campaign this summer when the squad embarked on a 10-day tour of Italy and Greece in mid-August.

The trip spanned from Aug. 13-23 and saw the Aggies visit the Italian cities of Rome, Latina, Sorrento and Pompeii before concluding the voyage in Athens, Greece. Four games against local competition highlighted the trip as Texas A&M earned three wins on the court.

## Collins Joins Aggies after Four-Year run at USF

The Aggies added another veteran ball-handler to the roster during the offseason as graduate transfer Anthony Collins joined the program after a four-year career at South Florida.

The 6-foot-1 guard missed a total of 24 games during the 2013-14 season due to injury, qualifying for a medical redshirt. Collins is on track to graduate from USF in May and will be immediately eligible at Texas A&M for the 2015-16 campaign as a fifth-year senior working toward a master's degree.

During his four seasons in Tampa, Collins drew the starting assignment in 98 of 101 games played after joining the Bulls' starting lineup early during his freshman campaign in 2011-12. He averaged 33.9 minutes per outing during his tenure and stood out as a solid scorer, averaging 8.1 points per contest including a career-best 9.0 average his freshman season when he shot 50.8 percent from the floor.

As a rookie, Collins reached double-digit scoring in 10 of USF's final 11 games to help lead the Bulls to the third round of 2012 NCAA Tournament.

Collins dished out 569 assists during his USF career, including an American Athletic Conference-leading 167 dimes last season, ranking 34th nationally with a 5.2 assist-per-game average. He dished out 10 or more assists three times a year ago and finished with the eighth-most in USF single season history.

An outstanding free throw shooter, Collins maintained a 78.0 percent clip at the charity stripe during his time with the Bulls.

## Caruso Continues to Climb All-Time Career Steals & Assists Lists

With three steals against Gonzaga on Nov. 26, Caruso passed former Aggie standout Todd Holloway (1983-87) for second on Aggie basketball's list of all-time steals. Up next is all-time leader David Edwards, who notched 228 steals from 1983-87.

Additionally, Caruso dished out five assists on Nov. 27 against Syracuse to move past Holloway into fifth place all-time at Texas A&M. The College Station native currently has 495 during his A&M career.

## A&M Searching for Ninth 20-Win Season in 12 Years

An 80-55 victory over Auburn on Feb. 28 of last season stood out as the team's 20<sup>th</sup> win of the season. The 20-win season was the 14<sup>th</sup> in program history and the first since the 2010-11 campaign. Texas A&M has won 20 or more games in eight of the last 11 seasons.

## Aggies Make Late Addition to 2015 Recruiting Class

The heralded Texas A&M men's basketball 2015 recruiting class received a late boost Wednesday as shooting guard Kobie Eubanks signed on to join the program. A 6-foot-5 prospect, Eubanks is considered a big, talented guard with scoring ability and will join the Aggies at the semester break this December.

Eubanks is regarded as a four-star prospect by ESPN, 247Sports, Rivals.com and Scout.com. A consensus top-100 recruit, Eubanks was listed as the fifth-ranked player in New York and No. 21 in the East Region coming out of high school.

Most recently, Eubanks spent the 2014-15 season at Elev8 Sports Institute in Delray Beach, Fla., where he played for head coach Chad Myers.

Eubanks finished his high school career playing at Our Savior New American School in Centereach, N.Y., for Rev. Ron Stelzer and Eric Jaklitsch. While there, Eubanks averaged 18.5 points while leading Our Savior New American to a 24-3 record as a senior in 2013-14. He scored in double figures in 25-of-27 games, including 13 games with at least 20 points and a pair of 30-point games. He also hit at least one 3-pointer in all 27 games and knocked down multiple 3-pointers in 24-of-27 contests.

A native of Fort Lauderdale, Fla., Eubanks played his first three years of high school basketball at American Heritage School in Plantation, Fla., before heading to New York for his senior year. While at AHS, Eubanks was named MVP of the 2013 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. "Stop the Violence" Basketball Classic after posting 18 points, 11 rebounds and eight assists in a 61-56 win.

## Texas A&M Inks Two Standouts During Early Signing Period

A year after signing a consensus top-10 class, the Texas A&M coaching is continuing its roll on the recruiting trail and is already well on its way to reeling in another outstanding class by inking a pair of impressive athletes during the early signing period.

### J.J. CALDWELL

#### Point Guard • 5-11 • Cypress, Texas (Cypress Woods HS / SATCH)

A 5-foot-11 athlete, Caldwell is regarded by well-known recruiting expert Bob Gibbins as the nation's fifth-ranked point guard recruit as well as the country's No. 30 overall recruit. Additionally, he is a member of the ESPN Top 100, ranking as the No. 84 recruit nationally and listed as a four-star prospect by ESPN, 247 Sports, Rivals.com and Scout.com. Scout also slots him as the 53rd-ranked player in the country.

Caldwell played at Cypress Woods High School as a junior last season where he averaged 13.9 points, 7.6 assists and 6.5 rebounds per contest, earning First-Team All-District 17-5A honors along the way. As a sophomore at CWHS during the 2013-14 campaign, Caldwell was recognized as District 17-5A Newcomer of the Year as he averaged just under 12 points and over 10 assists per contest.

As a senior this season, Caldwell will compete with the SATCH Varsity West Team, under the direction of head coach Ben Perkins. SATCH stands for "Sports Association of Texas Christian Homeschoolers." SATCH is a non-profit organization that began in 2003 as a competitive homeschool basketball organization.

In AAU competition, Caldwell has competed with the Houston Defenders organization, where he averaged 9.3 points, 6.3 assists and 4.8 rebounds per outing.

Additionally, Caldwell turned heads at the NBA Top 100 camp in Charlottesville, Va., over the summer where he stood out as one of the event's top passers and defenders.

### ROBERT WILLIAMS

#### Power Forward • 6-8 • Vivian, La. (North Caddo HS)

Williams is considered a consensus four-star prospect, with ESPN regarding him as a member of its Top 100 as well as the No. 1 player in the Pelican State. Both ESPN and Scout.com slot Williams as the No. 12 power forward prospect nationally with ESPN ranking him as the 48th overall recruit in the country.

A 6-foot-8, 225 forward, Williams plays his prep ball at North Caddo High School in Vivian, La., where he stars for head coach Ron Meikle. As a junior during the 2014-15 campaign, Williams earned First Team All-State accolades from the Louisiana High School Basketball Coaches Association and honorable mention All-State distinction from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association after averaging 21.0 points and 13.4 rebounds per contest.

Last season, Williams helped guide North Caddo to a 29-4 record and a showing in the semifinals of the Louisiana Class 2A playoffs, coming within two wins of a state title. During the summer, he played for Houston Hoops where he contributed 8.1 points and 6.5 rebounds per contest while shooting 63.5 percent. An elite shot blocker, he led the entire Nike EYBL by maintaining a 3.6 block-per-game average.
