### Texas A&M Aggies

(1-0, 0-0 SEC)

#### On The Aggies

- The Aggies host former conference foe Texas Tech, for the 75th meeting in the series, the third-most played series in Texas A&M history
- Danni Williams scored 25 points to lead the Aggies in a 74-49 season-opening win over 2016 NCAA Tournament team Central Arkansas
- The Aggies are looking to start 2-0 for the 11th time in the past 12 seasons
- The Aggies rank 24th in the USA Today Coaches' Poll
- Texas A&M head coach Gary Blair holds two degrees from Texas Tech, where he briefly played baseball
- Texas A&M is looking to qualify for its 12th straight NCAA Tournament in 2016-17, and currently holds the eighth-longest active streak of going to the NCAA Tournament
- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies were 13-4 at home in 2015-16, and have gone 43-7 since the start of the 2013-14 season at Reed Arena. The Aggies are 134-4 against unranked teams at home since Feb. 2005.
- The Aggies went 22-10 in 2015-16, marking the program's 11th straight 20+ win season. It is the second-longest streak in the SEC and the longest in Texas A&M history
- Texas A&M went 11-5 in SEC play in 2016, finishing in a tie for second. The Aggies have finished second in the SEC twice in the past three seasons.
- Anriel Howard returns after earning SEC All-Freshman Team honors in 2015-16. She had 27 rebounds against Missouri St. in the NCAA First Round, setting an NCAA Tournament and a school single-game record.
- Khaalia Hillsman is the Aggies' other returning starter, after starting all 32 games last season. She averaged 7.3 points, 5.3 rebounds, and ranked fifth in SEC play with 1.5 blocked shots per game.
- Curtyce Knox has 5+ assists in 7 of her 10 career starts. The Aggies have won each of her last four starts.
- Texas A&M head coach & Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Gary Blair is 14th all-time and eighth among active coaches with 718 career wins

## Player/Coach Trends

- Khaalia Hillsman - Finished fifth in SEC games in blocks (1.5)
- Anriel Howard - Led all freshmen in total rebounds during SEC play in 2015-16 (103), and ranked T-14th among all players
- Curtyce Knox - Has 5+ assists in five straight starts, dating back to 2015 and seven of her 10 career starts ... Texas A&M has won each of her last four starts
- Danni Williams - Has posted her two highest-scoring games in the 2015-16 and 2016-17 season openers ... coming off her first career 20+ point game
- Gary Blair - 14th all-time and 8th among active coaches in career wins with 718

## What To Watch For...

- If Texas A&M wins - The Aggies would start 2-0 for the 11th time in the past 12 years ... Texas A&M would improve to 44-7 at home since the start of 2013-14 ... The Aggies would improve to 135-4 against all unranked foes at home since Feb. 2005 ... It would be Texas A&M's seventh straight win vs. Texas Tech in College Station and fifth straight win overall in the series

## Aggies Roll Central Arkansas In Opener

- Texas A&M rolled on Nov. 13, posting a 74-49 win over Central Arkansas, a team that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, on opening day, marking the Aggies' 11th season-opening win in 12 years.
- Danni Williams had a career-high 25 points, and was joined in double figures by Khaalia Hillsman (14) and Anriel Howard (11)
- Hillsman had her third career double-double, adding in 11 rebounds.
- Curtyce Knox had a career-high 11 assists

## What Comes Back In 2016-17

- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its re-bounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies return two starters, SEC All-Freshman pick Anriel Howard, and Khaalia Hillsman, who started every game in 2015-16
- Overall, six players return for 2016-17

## What The Aggies Lost From 2015-16

- Texas A&M lost five seniors from the 2015-16 team, including All-Americans Jordan Jones and Courtney Walker, All-SEC pick Courtney Williams, SEC Sixth Woman of the Year Chelsea Jennings and Rachel Mitchell
- The 2016 senior class had a 97-39 record, made four NCAA Tournament Appearances, won the 2013 SEC Tournament and advanced to the 2014 Elite Eight
- Courtney Walker holds Texas A&M's career scoring record, Courtney Williams ranks 9th on that list. Jordan Jones ranks third in career assists and Rachel Mitchell ranks fifth in career blocks

## Texas A&M Entered Season With 87 Starts

- The Aggies entered the season with players who have made 87 career starts at Texas A&M
- Of the 87 starts, 76 of them have come at the center (Hillsman) and power forward (Howard, Lumpkin) positions.
- Three of Texas A&M's departing starters had at least 87 starts in their career individually, Courtney Walker (136), Courtney Williams (110) and Jordan Jones (91)

## Returners With Improved Stats While Starting

- While Texas A&M only returns 87 starts, the returning players have featured improved stats when presented with the opportunity to start

## About the Exhibition Win

- All five Texas A&M starters scored in double figures as the Aggies won 75-65 against Oklahoma City on Nov. 5
- Curtyce Knox had 13 assists, which is a Texas A&M exhibition game record, and would have been a career-high if it came in a regular game.
- Anriel Howard set a Texas A&M exhibition game record with 17 rebounds. Howard had averaged 20.0 re-bounds over the final two games of the 2015-16 season.
- Danni Williams scored 19 points the most in a Texas A&M exhibition game
- Taylor Cooper came off the bench to add five steals

- Including the game where she took over for an injured Jordan Jones in 2015, Knox has averaged 7.0 points, 4.6 assists and 3.4 rebounds in those nine games.

### Aggies Made 11th Straight NCAA Tournament In 2015-16

- Texas A&M qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the 11th straight year in 2015-16, giving the Aggies' the eighth longest streak of consecutive tournament appearances
- Texas A&M has recieved a Top 4 seed in nine of those 11 tournaments, although the current format where the Top 4 seeds host started just last season
- During that run, the Aggies have made five Sweet 16 appearances, three Elite Eights, and won the 2011 National Championship
- A&M head coach Gary Blair ranks 8th among active coaches with 33 NCAA Tournament wins, and 6th among active coaches with 22 NCAA Tournament Appearances

### Michalke, Texas A&M Corps Commander In 2015-16, Makes Team As Walk-On

- Senior Alyssa Michalke, the Commander of the Texas A&M Corps of Cadets in 2015-16, walked on the basketball team in October.
- Michalke was the first female to be Corps Commander in the Corps' 140-year history at Texas A&M

### Howard Shattered NCAA Tournament Record With 27 Rebounds

- Anriel Howard had 27 rebounds in her NCAA Tournament debut against Missouri State in 2016, shattering the previous record of 23
- The 27 rebounds easily set the Texas A&M single-game record, which previously stood at 21. In fact, no A&M player has had 18+ rebounds in a game since 1993.
- According to ESPN Stats and Info, Howard had more rebounds in the NCAA First Round than five entire teams (Iona, Robert Morris, San Francisco, Middle Tennessee, BYU)
- The previous Texas A&M NCAA Tournament Record was 15 rebounds in one game. Howard had bested that mark less than two minutes into the second half

### Walker, Jones Selected In WNBA Draft

- Two of Texas A&M's outgoing seniors were selected in the WNBA Draft over the summer.
- Courtney Walker was invited to the WNBA Draft in Uncasville, Conn., and was selected No. 16 overall by Atlanta in the second round. Walker was the fourth Aggie to be selected No. 16 overall, which marks the second-highest draft position of any A&M player in the draft.
- Jordan Jones was selected No. 34 overall in the third round by Chicago. Her selection marked the fourth time two Aggies were selected in the same WNBA Draft.

### Aggies Picked Sixth By SEC Media, Eighth By Coaches

- Texas A&M was picked to finish sixth in the SEC by a select panel of media who cover the league, and eighth by the leagues' coaches

## Texas A&M vs. Texas Tech Series Info

- This is the first meeting between the two schools since 2012. The Aggies have won four straight in the series and seven straight at home
- This is Texas A&M's third-most played opponent, trailing just the 86 matchups with Baylor and the 85 games with Texas
- Two of Texas A&M's most historical wins have come against Texas Tech:
- The Aggies upset No. 4 Texas Tech 67-64 in 1994, the Aggies' highest ranked win until 2009, and propelling the Aggies into the Top 25 for the first time in school history
- Texas A&M knocked off No. 7 Texas Tech 72-68 in the 1996 Southwest Conference Tournament championship game, the last SWC game ever played and the first conference championship for Texas A&M

# GARY BLAIR

## 14th Season at Texas A&M

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member, Gary Blair, led Texas A&M to the 2011 NCAA Championship and has transformed the women's basketball program into a national power since his appointment as head coach in 2003.

Blair, a two-time national finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, has guided Texas A&M to 11 straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and to four conference championships, including the 2013 SEC Tournament Championship.

Blair led the Aggies to their first national title in their first-ever trip to the NCAA Women's Final Four and closed out the 2010-11 season with a 33-5 record, the most victories in program history.

The Aggies have made five appearances in the Sweet Sixteen in the past nine years, and reached the Elite Eight in 2008, 2011 and 2014.

Over the course of his 32-year collegiate coaching career, which includes stops at Stephen F. Austin from 1985-93 and Arkansas from 1993-03, Blair has led his teams to 30 winning seasons, 25 20-win seasons, 22 NCAA Tournament appearances and 33 NCAA postseason victories.

Blair has won a championship at every level of his coaching career, including three state championships at Dallas South Oak Cliff High School, two national championships as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech, a WNIT Championship at Arkansas and an NCAA championship at Texas A&M.

- Blair is a member of six Hall of Fames, including the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame

- Blair ranks T-11th all-time and is seventh among active coaches with 34 NCAA Tournament victories
- Blair has won 20+ games in 25 seasons which is 11th all-time
- Seven of Blair's former players and assistants have gone on to become head Division I women's basketball coaches.
- Blair has won a total of 17 conference and conference tournament championships between the Southland Conference, Big 12, and SEC

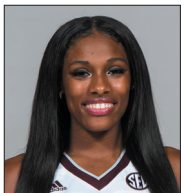
