On The Aggies

- Texas A&M is coming off of a thrilling 98-90 overtime win over Texas Tech that featured 22 lead changes and eight ties
- The Aggies are looking to start 3-0 for the fourth straight year and 10th time in the past 11 seasons
- Danni Williams has scored 25+ points in each of her games this season, and ranks fourth in the nation in scoring so far
- Texas A&M's guards have only committed six turnovers this season, led by Curtyce Knox who has a nation-leading 10.50 assist-to-turnover ratio
- Knox has had 10+ assists in each of her games this season. The Aggies have won the last five games she has started.
- Khaalia Hillsman has posted a double double in both games this season. Anriel Howard has 10+ points in both games this season.
- The Aggies rank 24th in the USA Today Coaches' Poll
- Texas A&M is looking to qualify for its 12th straight NCAA Tournament in 2016-17, and currently holds the eighth-longest active streak of going to the NCAA Tournament
- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies are 2-0 at home in this season, and have gone 44-7 since the start of the 2013-14 season at Reed Arena. The Aggies are 134-4 against unranked teams at home since Feb. 2005.
- The Aggies went 22-10 in 2015-16, marking the program's 11th straight 20+ win season. It is the second-longest streak in the SEC and the longest in Texas A&M history
- Texas A&M went 11-5 in SEC play in 2016, finishing in a tie for second. The Aggies have finished second in the SEC twice in the past three seasons.
- Texas A&M head coach & Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Gary Blair is 14th all-time and eighth among active coaches with 719 career wins

Player/Coach Trends

- Khaalia Hillsman - Has posted two straight double doubles ... Her two double doubles tie for second in the nation in the early going
- Curtyce Knox - Leads nation with a 10.5 assist-to-turnover ratio ... Posted 10+ assists in each of her last two games ... Has 5+ assists in six straight starts, dating back to 2015 and eight of her 10 career starts ... Texas A&M has won each of her last five starts
- Danni Williams - Has back-to-back 25+ point games ... Ranks fourth in the nation and second in the SEC with 28.5 points per game
- Gary Blair - 14th all-time and 8th among active coaches in career wins with 719

What To Watch For...

- If Texas A&M wins - The Aggies would start 3-0 for the fourth straight year and 10th time in the past 11 years ... Texas A&M would improve to 45-7 at home since the start of 2013-14 ... The Aggies would improve to 136-4 against all unranked foes at home since Feb. 2005 ... It would be Texas A&M's 65th straight win against a mid-major at home
- Danni Williams - Would be the first Aggie with back-to-back 30+ point games since Danielle Adams from Feb. 9-12, 2011 if she scores 30+ ... Would be the first Aggie with three straight 20+ point games since Courtney Walker had four straight from Jan. 31-Feb. 11, 2016 if she scores 20+

Texas A&M Defeats Texas Tech 98-90 In Thrilling Overtime Game (Nov. 17)

- In a game that featured 22 lead changes and eight ties, Texas A&M knocked off Texas Tech 98-90 in overtime
- The game featured three lead-altering shots in the last seven seconds of regulation, including a go-ahead 3-pointer by Danni Williams with 2.7 seconds left
- Williams led the five Aggies in double figures with 32 points against the Lady Raiders
- The 98 points were the most points scored by Texas A&M since scoring 105 against ULM on Jan. 4, 2011
- Texas A&M has now won four straight overtime games and six of their last seven overtime games

Ball Security

- Texas A&M's guards have take care of the ball this season, only committing six turnovers through two games.
- Curtyce Knox leads the nation with a 10.5-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio
- As a team, the Aggies rank sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (which counts the 16 turnovers for forwards), and 25th in total turnovers
- Danni Williams has four assists on the season, but has not yet committed a turnover. She needs to average three assists per game to qualify for the NCAA leaderboard.

Aggies Roll Central Arkansas In Opener

- Texas A&M rolled on Nov. 13, posting a 74-49 win over Central Arkansas, a team that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, on opening day, marking the Aggies' 11th season-opening win in 12 years.
- Danni Williams had a then-career-high 25 points, and was joined in double figures by Khaalia Hillsman (14) and Anriel Howard (11)
- Hillsman had her third career double-double, adding in 11 rebounds.
- Curtyce Knox had a career-high 11 assists

What Comes Back In 2016-17

- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies return two starters, SEC All-Freshman pick Anriel Howard, and Khaalia Hillsman, who started every game in 2015-16
- Overall, six players return for 2016-17

- Texas A&M lost five seniors from the 2015-16 team, including All-Americans Jordan Jones and Courtney Walker, All-SEC pick Courtney Williams, SEC Sixth Woman of the Year Chelsea Jennings and Rachel Mitchell
- The 2016 senior class had a 97-39 record, made four NCAA Tournament Appearances, won the 2013 SEC Tournament and advanced to the 2014 Elite Eight
- Courtney Walker holds Texas A&M's career scoring record, Courtney Williams ranks 9th on that list. Jordan Jones ranks third in career assists and Rachel Mitchell ranks fifth in career blocks

Aggies Made 11th Straight NCAA Tournament In 2015-16

- Texas A&M qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the 11th straight year in 2015-16, giving the Aggies' the eighth longest streak of consecutive tournament appearances
- Texas A&M has recieved a Top 4 seed in nine of those 11 tournaments, although the current format where the Top 4 seeds host started just last season
- During that run, the Aggies have made five Sweet 16 appearances, three Elite Eights, and won the 2011 National Championship
- A&M head coach Gary Blair ranks 8th among active coaches with 33 NCAA Tournament wins, and 6th among active coaches with 22 NCAA Tournament Appearances

- Michalke was the first female to be Corps Commander in the Corps' 140-year history at Texas A&M

- Khaalia Hillsman and Anriel Howard were named to the All-Texas College Preseason Team by Dave Campbell's Texas Basketball magazine

Walker, Jones Selected In WNBA Draft

- Two of Texas A&M's outgoing seniors were selected in the WNBA Draft over the summer.
- Courtney Walker was invited to the WNBA Draft in Uncasville, Conn., and was selected No. 16 overall by Atlanta in the second round. Walker was the fourth Aggie to be selected No. 16 overall, which marks the second-highest draft position of any A&M player in the draft.
- Jordan Jones was selected No. 34 overall in the third round by Chicago. Her selection marked the fourth time two Aggies were selected in the same WNBA Draft.

Aggies Picked Sixth By SEC Media, Eighth By Coaches

- Texas A&M was picked to finish sixth in the SEC by a select panel of media who cover the league, and eighth by the leagues' coaches

Howard Shattered NCAA Tournament Record With 27 Rebounds

- Anriel Howard had 27 rebounds in her NCAA Tournament debut against Missouri State in 2016, shattering the previous record of 23
- The 27 rebounds easily set the Texas A&M single-game record, which previously stood at 21. In fact, no A&M player has had 18+ rebounds in a game since 1993.
- According to ESPN Stats and Info, Howard had more rebounds in the NCAA First Round than five entire teams (Iona, Robert Morris, San Francisco, Middle Tennessee, BYU)

Aggie Traditions

Home of the 12th Man

- Texas A&M is known by sports fans everywhere as the home of the 12th Man
- The tradition was born out of the willingness to serve. This willing spirit has endured, and today the Aggie student body is known as the 12th Man: united in loyalty, united in support and ready to serve when they are called to do so.

Yell Leaders

- Yell Leaders are a team of upperclassmen, three seniors and two juniors, elected each year by the student body. Aggie Yell Leaders still wear white during games and attend all home women's basketball games, plus postseason. The tradition dates back to 1907.

Reveille

- Reveille, the first lady of Aggieland, is a purebred collie and the official mascot of Texas A&M. As a five-star general, she is the highest ranking member of the Corps of Cadets.

Aggie Ring

- The distinctive Aggie Ring serves as the symbolic link to the Aggie network of former students. The ring is not given, it must be earned academically. It was E.C. Jonas, class of 1894, who designed the ring Aggies wear today. Nothing on the ring has changed, except when the university's name changed to Texas A&M University in 1963.

Gig 'Em

- At a yell practice before the 1930 TCU game, a dedicated fan and member of the Texas A&M Board of Regents named Pinky Downs '06 shouted, 'What are we going to do to those Horned Frogs?' Improvising, he borrowed the name of a sharp-pronged frog hunting tool, called a gig. 'Gig 'em, Aggies!' he said as he made a fist with his thumb extended straight up. With that, the first hand sign in the old Southwest Conference was born.

GARY BLAIR

14th Season at Texas A&M

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member, Gary Blair, led Texas A&M to the 2011 NCAA Championship and has transformed the women's basketball program into a national power since his appointment as head coach in 2003.

Blair, a two-time national finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, has guided Texas A&M to 11 straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and to four conference championships, including the 2013 SEC Tournament Championship.

Blair led the Aggies to their first national title in their first-ever trip to the NCAA Women's Final Four and closed out the 2010-11 season with a 33-5 record, the most victories in program history.

The Aggies have made five appearances in the Sweet Sixteen in the past nine years, and reached the Elite Eight in 2008, 2011 and 2014.

Over the course of his 32-year collegiate coaching career, which includes stops at Stephen F. Austin from 1985-93 and Arkansas from 1993-03, Blair has led his teams to 30 winning seasons, 25 20-win seasons, 22 NCAA Tournament appearances and 33 NCAA postseason victories.

Blair has won a championship at every level of his coaching career, including three state championships at Dallas South Oak Cliff High School, two national championships as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech, a WNIT Championship at Arkansas and an NCAA championship at Texas A&M.


