**Texas A&M Aggies**  
(5-0, 0-0 SEC)

#### On The Aggies

- The Aggies are 5-0 for the fifth straight year and seventh time in the past nine seasons
- This is the Aggies' annual Elementary School Day. Texas A&M is 3-0 all-time on Elementary School Day and ranks fifth nationally in average attendance for this promotion.
- Curtyce Knox leads the nation with 8.8 assists per game. She is eighth in assist/turnover ratio (4.0)
- The Aggies re-entered the AP Top 25 this week at 25th. The Aggies rank 19th in the USA Today Coaches' Poll
- Texas A&M has not allowed a fast break point since Nov. 20, a total of 83:45 of game time.
- Danni Williams has scored 10+ points in each of her games this season, and ranks second in the SEC in scoring
- The Aggies have won the last seven games Curtyce Knox has started, dating back to the 2015-16 season.
- Khaalia Hillsman has scored in double figures in each game this season. Hillsman is 10th in the SEC in both points (16.0) and rebounds (7.4) per game.
- Anriel Howard ranks third in the nation in rebounds per game (12.8)
- Texas A&M is looking to qualify for its 12th straight NCAA Tournament in 2016-17, and currently holds the eighth-longest active streak of going to the NCAA Tournament
- Texas A&M returns 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies are 4-0 at home in this season, and have gone 46-7 since the start of the 2013-14 season at Reed Arena. The Aggies are 138-4 against unranked teams at home since Feb. 2005.
- Texas A&M went 11-5 in SEC play in 2016, finishing in a tie for second. The Aggies have finished second in the SEC twice in the past three seasons.
- Texas A&M head coach & Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Gary Blair is 14th all-time and eighth among active coaches with 720 career wins

**Player/Coach Trends**

- **Khaalial Hillsman** - Has 10+ points in all five games this season ... Has posted three double-doubles this season, which ties for 21st in the NCAA ... Ranks 10th in the SEC in rebounds per game and 10th in the SEC in points per game
- **Anriel Howard** - Has either 10+ points or 10+ rebounds in every game this season ... Ranks third nationally with 12.5 rebounds per game ... Ranks fifth at Texas A&M in career rebounds per game ... Has posted three double-doubles this season, which ties for 21st in the NCAA
- **Curtyce Knox** - Leads the nation in assists/game (8.8) and ranks eighth in assist/turnover ratio (4.0) ... Texas A&M has won each of her last eight starts
- **Danni Williams** - Has five straight 10+ point games to start the season ... Ranks 39th in the nation and 2nd in the SEC with 20.0 points per game
- **Gary Blair** - 14th all-time and 8th among active coaches in career wins with 722
- **Texas A&M** - has gone 83:45 without giving up a fast break point

**What To Watch For...**

- **If Texas A&M wins** - The Aggies would start 6-0 for the first time since 2014-15 ... Would match the fourth-best start in school history

**Elementary School Day**

- Texas A&M hosts its fourth annual Elementary School Day on Nov. 30, where schoolchildren from across the Brazos Valley, will be in attendance to watch the Aggies take on Southern Cal
- The Aggies have averaged 7,635 fans in its three editions of Elementary School Day, making it the fifth-largest event of its kind in Division I
- Texas A&M is 3-0 on Elementary School Day
- All three Elementary School Day Games have featured 7,000+ fans and increasing attendance

**Aggies Ranked 25th in Associated Press Poll; 19th in USA Today Coaches' Poll**

- The Aggies entered the AP Poll this week at No. 25. The Aggies have been ranked 213 times, which is 28th all-time
- Texas A&M ranks 19th in the USA Today Coaches' Poll

**Knox's Winning Streak**

- Despite a 1-4 start to her career as a starter, Curtyce Knox has helped Texas A&M to wins in each of her last eight starts, dating back to 2015-16.

**Not So Fast, My Friend!**

- Texas A&M has not allowed a fast break point in 83:45 of game time, dating back to the fourth quarter of the Stephen F. Austin game
- The Aggies have held three opponents, Central Arkansas, Little Rock and Abilene Christian to no fast break points.

**Run It, Run It**

- Texas A&M has used massive second-half runs that have lasted over seven minutes to put away each of their last two games
- The Aggies went on a 16-0 run in the third quarter to take a 37-23 lead to blow open the game against Little Rock
- Texas A&M closed the game on a 22-0 run against Abilene Christian, only having the run snapped with a Wildcat basket with 34 seconds remaining.

**Texas A&M Defeats Abilene Christian With Massive Fourth Quarter Run**

- Texas A&M finished the game on a 22-2 run, with ACU's only basket coming with 34 seconds to play, to put away the Wildcats in a 71-45 win at Reed Arena
- Curtyce Knox stuffed the stat sheet in that game, with eight points, 12 assists and seven steals, the most steals by a Texas A&M player since Sydney Carter had eight in 2011-12

**Aggies Strong Defense, Third Quarter Run, To Propel To Victory Over Little Rock**

- Texas A&M held Little Rock to 37 points, the fewest Texas A&M has allowed since Jan. 10, 2016 against LSU, as the Aggies won 55-37 in its first road game of the year
- Despite a 1-point halftime deficit, the Aggies outscored Little Rock 20-4 in the third quarter to take control of the game. Texas A&M had a 16-0 run in the quarter that lasted nearly 8 minutes
- The 37 points are the fewest Little Rock has ever scored in a home game

**Aggies Use Strong Second Half To Down SFA**

- Texas A&M outscored Stephen F. Austin 41-29 in the second half, shooting 50% from the field, to down the Ladyjacks 63-48 on Nov. 20
- Danni Williams bounced back from a 1-of-7 start from the field to shoot 8-of-11 the rest of the game

**Texas A&M Defeats Texas Tech 98-90 In Thrilling Overtime Game (Nov. 17)**

- In a game that featured 22 lead changes and eight ties, Texas A&M knocked off Texas Tech 98-90 in overtime
- The game featured three lead-altering shots in the last seven seconds of regulation, including a go-ahead 3-pointer by Danni Williams with 2.7 seconds left
- Williams led the five Aggies in double figures with 32 points against the Lady Raiders
- The 98 points were the most points scored by Texas A&M since scoring 105 against ULM on Jan. 4, 2011
- Texas A&M has now won four straight overtime games and six of their last seven overtime games

**Aggies Roll Central Arkansas In Opener**

- Texas A&M rolled on Nov. 13, posting a 74-49 win over Central Arkansas, a team that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, on opening day, marking the Aggies' 11th season-opening win in 12 years.
- Danni Williams had a then-career-high 25 points, and was joined in double figures by Khaalia Hillsman (14) and Anriel Howard (11)
- Hillsman had her third career double-double, adding in 11 rebounds.
- Curtyce Knox had a career-high 11 assists

**What Comes Back In 2016-17**

- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies return two starters, SEC All-Freshman pick Anriel Howard, and Khaalia Hillsman, who started every game in 2015-16
- Overall, six players return for 2016-17

- Texas A&M lost five seniors from the 2015-16 team, including All-Americans Jordan Jones and Courtney Walker, All-SEC pick Courtney Williams, SEC Sixth Woman of the Year Chelsea Jennings and Rachel Mitchell
- The 2016 senior class had a 97-39 record, made four NCAA Tournament Appearances, won the 2013 SEC Tournament and advanced to the 2014 Elite Eight
- Courtney Walker holds Texas A&M's career scoring record, Courtney Williams ranks 9th on that list. Jordan Jones ranks third in career assists and Rachel Mitchell ranks fifth in career blocks

**Aggies Made 11th Straight NCAA Tournament In 2015-16**

- Texas A&M qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the 11th straight year in 2015-16, giving the Aggies' the eighth longest streak of consecutive tournament appearances
- Texas A&M has received a Top 4 seed in nine of those 11 tournaments, although the current format where the Top 4 seeds host started just last season
- During that run, the Aggies have made five Sweet 16 appearances, three Elite Eights, and won the 2011 National Championship
- A&M head coach Gary Blair ranks 8th among active coaches with 33 NCAA Tournament wins, and 6th among active coaches with 22 NCAA Tournament Appearances

# GARY BLAIR

## 14th Season at Texas A&M

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member, Gary Blair, led Texas A&M to the 2011 NCAA Championship and has transformed the women's basketball program into a national power since his appointment as head coach in 2003.

Blair, a two-time national finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, has guided Texas A&M to 11 straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and to four conference championships, including the 2013 SEC Tournament Championship.

Blair led the Aggies to their first national title in their first-ever trip to the NCAA Women's Final Four and closed out the 2010-11 season with a 33-5 record, the most victories in program history.

The Aggies have made five appearances in the Sweet Sixteen in the past nine years, and reached the Elite Eight in 2008, 2011 and 2014.

Over the course of his 32-year collegiate coaching career, which includes stops at Stephen F. Austin from 1985-93 and Arkansas from 1993-03, Blair has led his teams to 30 winning seasons, 25 20-win seasons, 22 NCAA Tournament appearances and 33 NCAA postseason victories.

Blair has won a championship at every level of his coaching career, including three state championships at Dallas South Oak Cliff High School, two national championships as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech, a WNIT Championship at Arkansas and an NCAA championship at Texas A&M.


