On The Aggies

- Anriel Howard was named SEC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 13 after averaging 14.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.5 steals in two Texas A&M wins
- Knox leads the nation with 9.3 assists per game, the most assists per game of any player since Gonzaga's Courtney Vandersloot (10.3) in 2010-11
- Khaalia Hillsman has scored 10+ points in every game this season. Hillsman ranks sixth in the SEC in scoring and teammate Danni Williams ranks fourth.
- The Aggies are 11-2 in Knox's last 13 starts at point guard, dating back to 2015-16
- Anriel Howard ranks second in the nation in rebounds per game (12.7)
- Howard had 20 points, 10 rebounds, five assists and five steals against A&M-Corpus Christi, the first SEC player with a 20-10-5-5 game since Candace Parker of Tennessee in 2008
- Howard has nine straight 10+ rebound games, the longest such streak in the Gary Blair era
- Five Aggies scored in double figures against Southern, including Hillsman and Jasmine Lumpkin, who had career-highs. Taylor Cooper, Howard & Knox joined them in double figures.
- Four student-athletes signed NLI's in the early signing period to play for Texas A&M in 2017-18, giving the Aggies the No. 9 recruiting class in the nation
- Texas A&M is looking to qualify for its 12th straight NCAA Tournament in 2016-17, and currently holds the eighth-longest active streak
- The Aggies are 5-1 at home in this season, and have gone 47-8 since the start of the 2013-14 season at Reed Arena. The Aggies are 139-5 against unranked teams at home since Feb. 2005.
- Texas A&M went 11-5 in SEC play in 2016, finishing in a tie for second. The Aggies have finished second in the SEC twice in the past three seasons
- Texas A&M head coach & Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Gary Blair is 14th all-time and eighth among active coaches with 725 career wins

Player/Coach Trends

- Taylor Cooper - Has made a 3-pointer in eight of her nine games this season ... Texas A&M is 8-0 when she makes a 3-pointer, and 0-2 when she does not
- Khaalia Hillsman - Has 10+ points in all 10 games this season ... Has posted four double-doubles this season, which is fourth in the SEC ... Ranks ninth in the SEC in points per game
- Anriel Howard - Ranks second nationally with 12.9 rebounds per game ... First Aggie with eight straight 10+ rebound games in the Gary Blair era (since 2003-04) ... Ranks fourth nationally with six double doubles ... Ranks fifth at Texas A&M in career rebounds per game
- Curtyce Knox - Leads the nation in assists/game (9.3) and ranks 10th in assist/turnover ratio (3.44) ... Leads the SEC in assist/turnover ratio and ranks fourth in steals per game ... Her current total of 9.3 assists per game would be the most for any Division I player since Gonzaga's Courtney Vandersloot in 2010-11 (10.2) ... Ranks fifth among active SEC players in career assists
- Danni Williams - Ranks fourth in the SEC with 17.4 points per game ... Ranks second in the SEC with 36.0 minutes per game ... Her 86.8 free throw percentage ranks sixth in the SEC
- Gary Blair - 14th all-time and 8th among active coaches in career wins with 725

What To Watch For...

- If Texas A&M wins both games - Would give the Aggies five straight wins ... Texas A&M would have double-digit non-conference wins for the fifth straight year ... A win vs. Syracuse would give Texas A&M its first ranked win of the year
- Anriel Howard - Would be the first Aggie with 10 straight 10+ rebound games in the Gary Blair era with 10+ rebounds vs. Dayton

Three Double Doubles, Five In Double Figures Lead Texas A&M To Win Over Southern

• Khaalia Hillsman, Anriel Howard and Curtyce Knox had double doubles, while Taylor Cooper and Jasmine Lumpkin scored in double figures to give Texas A&M a 81-58 win against Southern in Houston's Campbell Center

• It was the second time this season Texas A&M had at least two double doubles in the same game and the second time Texas A&M had five players in double figure scoring, both of which previously happened exactly one month prior, Nov. 17 vs. Texas Tech

Howard Named SEC Co-Player Of The Week (Dec. 13)

• Anriel Howard was named SEC Co-Player of the Week on Dec. 13 after averaging 14.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.5 steals in Aggie wins against TCU and A&M-Corpus Christi

• She had 20 points, 10 rebounds, five assists and five steals against A&M-Corpus Christi, becoming the first SEC player with at least 20 points, 10 rebounds, five assists and five steals in a single game since Candace Parker against LSU in 2008

• She had 11 rebounds against TCU, helping the Aggies to a 75-67 win. She added a key steal with 2:30 remaining at TCU, giving the Aggies possession after TCU had closed the margin to five points, the closest the Frogs would get in the second half.

Howard Posts First 20+ Point, 10+ Rebound, 5+ Assist and 5+ Steal Game For SEC Player Since 2008

• Anriel Howard became the first SEC player since Candace Parker in 2008 to have 20+ points, 10+ rebounds, 5+ assists and 5+ steals in a single game against A&M-Corpus Christi (Dec. 10)

• Howard was also the first Texas A&M player with 20+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ assists in a game since Jaynetta Saunders in 2001

• Howard's 20 points, five assists, and five steals were all career-highs

Aggies Pick Up 75-67 Win At TCU

• Texas A&M never trailed in the second half, picking up a 75-67 road win against TCU

• Danni Williams scored 19, Khaalia Hillsman 17 and Curtyce Knox had a career-high 16.

• The Aggies are 2-0 this season against Big 12 foes

Knox & Double Digit Assists

• Curtyce Knox has six career double-digit assist games, all this season, which ranks fifth for a career at Texas A&M since 2000-01

Furious Rally Falls Short At SMU

• Despite falling into a 16-point hole, and trailign 29-13 at halftime, Texas A&M rallied all the way back to take a potential go-ahead shot at SMU (Dec. 5)

• The Aggies had the ball with 12.5 to play, down a point, but did not score

Close Misses

• The Aggies' two losses have come down to the final minute.

• The Aggies had two free throws to tie against USC with 22 seconds left, but did not score

• Texas A&M had the ball down a point against SMU with 12.5 seconds left, but could not make a shot in time

Knox is 11-2 In Last 12 Starts

• Despite a 1-4 start to her career as a starter, Curtyce Knox has helped Texas A&M to an 11-2 record since, dating back to 2015-16.

Texas A&M Defeats Abilene Christian With Massive Fourth Quarter Run

- Texas A&M finished the game on a 22-2 run, with ACU's only basket coming with 34 seconds to play, to put away the Wildcats in a 71-45 win at Reed Arena
- Curtyce Knox stuffed the stat sheet in that game, with eight points, 12 assists and seven steals, the most steals by a Texas A&M player since Sydney Carter had eight in 2011-12

Aggies Use Strong Defense, Third Quarter Run, To Propel To Victory Over Little Rock

- Texas A&M held Little Rock to 37 points, the fewest Texas A&M has allowed since Jan. 10, 2016 against LSU, as the Aggies won 55-37 in its first road game of the year
- The Aggies outscored Little Rock 20-4 in the third quarter to take control of the game.
- The 37 points are the fewest Little Rock has ever scored in a home game

Aggies Use Strong Second Half To Down SFA

- Texas A&M outscored Stephen F. Austin 41-29 in the second half, shooting 50% from the field, to down the Ladyjacks 63-48 on Nov. 20
- Danni Williams bounced back from a 1-of-7 start from the field to shoot 8-of-11 the rest of the game

Texas A&M Defeats Texas Tech 98-90 In Thrilling Overtime Game (Nov. 17)

- In a game that featured 22 lead changes and eight ties, Texas A&M knocked off Texas Tech 98-90 in overtime
- The game featured three lead-altering shots in the last seven seconds of regulation, including a go-ahead 3-pointer by Danni Williams with 2.7 seconds left
- Williams led the five Aggies in double figures with 32 points against the Lady Raiders
- The 98 points were the most points scored by Texas A&M since scoring 105 against ULM on Jan. 4, 2011
- Texas A&M has now won four straight overtime games and six of their last seven overtime games

Aggies Roll Central Arkansas In Opener

- Texas A&M rolled on Nov. 13, posting a 74-49 win over Central Arkansas, a team that made the 2016 NCAA Tournament, on opening day, marking the Aggies' 11th season-opening win in 12 years.
- Danni Williams had a then-career-high 25 points, and was joined in double figures by Khaalia Hillsman (14) and Anriel Howard (11)
- Hillsman had her third career double-double, adding in 11 rebounds.
- Curtyce Knox had a then career-high 11 assists

What Comes Back In 2016-17

- Texas A&M is set to return 30.2% of its points, 47.3% of its rebounds and 24.4% of its assists in 2016-17
- The Aggies return two starters, SEC All-Freshman pick Anriel Howard, and Khaalia Hillsman, who started every game in 2015-16
- Overall, six players return for 2016-17

Aggies Made 11th Straight NCAA Tournament In 2015-16

- Texas A&M qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the 11th straight year in 2015-16, giving the Aggies' the eighth longest streak of consecutive tournament appearances
- Texas A&M has received a Top 4 seed in nine of those 11 tournaments, although the current format where the Top 4 seeds host started just last season
- During that run, the Aggies have made five Sweet 16 appearances, three Elite Eights, and won the 2011 National Championship
- A&M head coach Gary Blair ranks 8th among active coaches with 33 NCAA Tournament wins, and 6th among active coaches with 22 NCAA Tournament Appearances

Aggie Traditions

Home of the 12th Man

- Texas A&M is known by sports fans everywhere as the home of the 12th Man
- The tradition was born out of the willingness to serve. This willing spirit has endured, and today the Aggie student body is known as the 12th Man: united in loyalty, united in support and ready to serve when they are called to do so.

Yell Leaders

- Yell Leaders are a team of upperclassmen, three seniors and two juniors, elected each year by the student body. Aggie Yell Leaders still wear white during games and attend all home women's basketball games, plus postseason. The tradition dates back to 1907.

Reveille

- Reveille, the first lady of Aggieland, is a purebred collie and the official mascot of Texas A&M. As a five-star general, she is the highest ranking member of the Corps of Cadets.

Aggie Ring

- The distinctive Aggie Ring serves as the symbolic link to the Aggie network of former students. The ring is not given, it must be earned academically. It was E.C. Jonas, class of 1894, who designed the ring Aggies wear today. Nothing on the ring has changed, except when the university's name changed to Texas A&M University in 1963.

Gig 'Em

- At a yell practice before the 1930 TCU game, a dedicated fan and member of the Texas A&M Board of Regents named Pinky Downs '06 shouted, 'What are we going to do to those Horned Frogs?' Improvising, he borrowed the name of a sharppronged frog hunting tool, called a gig. 'Gig 'em, Aggies!' he said as he made a fist with his thumb extended straight up. With that, the first hand sign in the old Southwest Conference was born.

GARY BLAIR

14th Season at Texas A&M

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame member, Gary Blair, led Texas A&M to the 2011 NCAA Championship and has transformed the women's basketball program into a national power since his appointment as head coach in 2003.

Blair, a two-time national finalist for the Naismith Coach of the Year Award, has guided Texas A&M to 11 straight NCAA Tournament appearances, and to four conference championships, including the 2013 SEC Tournament Championship.

Blair led the Aggies to their first national title in their first-ever trip to the NCAA Women's Final Four and closed out the 2010-11 season with a 33-5 record, the most victories in program history.

The Aggies have made five appearances in the Sweet Sixteen in the past nine years, and reached the Elite Eight in 2008, 2011 and 2014.

Over the course of his 32-year collegiate coaching career, which includes stops at Stephen F. Austin from 1985-93 and Arkansas from 1993-03, Blair has led his teams to 30 winning seasons, 25 20-win seasons, 22 NCAA Tournament appearances and 33 NCAA postseason victories.

Blair has won a championship at every level of his coaching career, including three state championships at Dallas South Oak Cliff High School, two national championships as an assistant coach at Louisiana Tech, a WNIT Championship at Arkansas and an NCAA championship at Texas A&M.


