LEADING OFF

The No. 11 Texas A&M Aggies look to continue the outstanding play of their six-game win streak, which includes a series sweep at Kentucky in which the Maroon & White outscored the Wildcats 31-11. The Aggies raised their batting average 13 points over the weekend, batting .350 (43-for-123) at Kentucky with 11 doubles, two triples and five home runs.

BRADEN SHEWMAKE's recent performance has been player of the week worthy, including batting .625 (10-for-16) in the series sweep at Kentucky with five runs, one double, two home runs and nine RBI. He hit 5-for-6 in the finale. After batting just .185 (5-for-27) the first eight games of 2019, Shewmake has caught fire the last 18 contests, hitting .388 (31-for-80) with 21 runs and 26 RBI.

TY COLEMAN and **JONATHAN DUCOFF** have also heated up recently. After starting the season batting .214 (6-for-28) with five runs and seven RBI in the Aggies' first 14 games (through March 3), Coleman is hitting .386 (17-for-44) in the last 12 contests, logging 12 runs and 15 RBI. Through 20 games, Ducoff was batting just .148 (4-for-27) with five runs and nine RBI. In the last six contests, he is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with three runs and 11 RBI.

Texas A&M pitchers are holding opponents to a .186 batting average with runners in scoring position, striking out 78 of the 240 batters they have faced in the situation. The Aggies are holding opponents to a .163 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

TEXAS A&M/LAMAR SERIES NOTABLES

Texas A&M and Lamar have met 41 times previously, with the Aggies holding the all-time series advantage 34-7. The Maroon & White are playing Lamar for the first time since 2006 with the Aggies owning a seven-game win streak.

The most recent meeting was a nail-biter with Texas A&M earning win, 6-5, in 10 innings with a walk-off solo blast from Blake Stouffer. Kyle Thebeau earned the win, retiring the side in the top of the tenth, while Stouffer batted 3-for-5 with the 10th-inning dinger.

SUSTAINED EXCELLENCE

The Texas A&M Aggies are one of only four schools to appear in each of the last 12 NCAA Division I Baseball Championships. The Maroon and White's 12-season NCAA postseason string is the second-longest in the SEC trailing only Vanderbilt (13 years). It's also the longest active string among Texas schools.

Austin (2/19), yielding one run on five hits and one walk while striking out four in 4.0 innings... pitched in 11 games in his first season in Aggieland, including two starts... posted a 3.32 ERA and 15 strikeouts in 19.0 innings... pitched in three SEC games, logging a 3.18 ERA and two strikeouts in 5.2 innings... worked in seven games for the Madison Mallards of the Northwoods League, including six starts... posted a 1-1 record with a 4.44 ERA and 29 strikeouts in 26.1 innings for the Mallards... four-year letterwinner for head coach Gabe Perez at Corpus Christi King High School... tabbed THSBCA Class 5A All-State Second Team as a senior in 2017... named Collin Street Bakery/TSWA Class 5A All-State Honorable Mention as a senior... notched a 7-4 record with a 1.19 ERA and 133 Ks in 76.1 innings in 2017... selected All-District 30-5A First Team as a senior... logged a 9-1 record with a 0.58 ERA and 124 Ks in 73.0 innings as a junior in 2016... selected THSBCA Class 6A All-State First Team and Collin Street Bakery/TSWA Class 6A All-State Honorable mention in 2016... honored as the District 28-6A MVP as a sophomore... named All-District 28-6A First Team as a sophomore in 2015.

FOURTH INNING SEPARATION

The Aggies are outscoring opponents 35-4 in the fourth inning. Texas A&M's offense clicks best in the fourth frame, posting a .374 batting average. **LOGAN FOSTER** leads the way batting .769 (10-for-13) with three doubles, five runs and three RBI. **BRYCE BLAUM** is hitting .625 (5-for-8) with one walk and six runs. **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** his batting .545 (6-for-11) with double, one triple, two home runs, one HBP, eight RBI and six runs. **JONATHAN DUCOFF** has two doubles, one home run and seven RBI in nine fourth-inning plate appearances.

On the mound, the Aggies are holding opponents to a .165 batting average (15-for-91) with just one extra-base hit over the 26.0 innings.

NON-CONFERENCE HOME DOMINANCE

The Aggies are 89-7 in regular-season non-conference home games since 2015, including 19-1 in 2018. The highlight of the current run came in 2015 when Texas A&M went 22-0 against non-conference foe at Blue Bell Park in regular-season play. They went 18-1 in 2016 and 18-2 in 2017. Sam Houston State accounted for two of the losses, including 5-0 in 2016 and 8-2 in 2017. The other losses are against Pepperdine (2-1) in 2017, UT Arlington (5-1 - 18 inn.) in 2018 and both UIC (7-2) and Incarnate Word (6-5) in 2019.

POST-SEASON STREAK CONTINUES HEADING INTO 2019

Prior to the arrival of head coach **ROB CHILDRESS**, Texas A&M had never appeared in the NCAA Tournament more than four consecutive years. Last year's regional bid extended the Aggies' current string to 12 consecutive years, something that had never happened before in the program's 116-year history.

Childress has led the Aggies to the postseason each of the last 12 seasons, topping the previous-high water mark of four-straight trips, a feat that had happened only twice before at Texas A&M. Former head coach Tom Chandler led his squad to the NCAA Regionals each season from 1975 to 1978 and 11 years later the Aggies enjoyed a similar four-year run from 1986-89 under the direction of head coach Mark Johnson.

TOP 20 PITCHING

The Aggies rank in the top 20 in the nation in numerous pitching categories, including **Strikeouts Per Nine Innings** (2nd - 11.5), **K-to-BB Ratio** (4th - 3.92), **Shutouts** (7th - 4), **WHIP** (7th - 1.07), **ERA** (7th - 2.61), **Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings** (9th - 6.70) and **Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings** (13th - 2.92).

Individually, **ASA LACY** ranks 3rd in the nations in Wins (5), 6th in Strikeouts (56), 7th in Strikeouts Per Nine Innings (14.40), 22nd in Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings (4.63).

JOHN DOXAKIS ranks 22nd in the nation K-to-BB Ratio (9.00), 44th in strikeouts (45) and 50th in Walks Allowed Per Nine Innings (1.29).

Individually, **KASEY KALICH** ranks 14th in the nation with six saves.

PICKING UP STEAM

After stumbling out of the gate and hitting just .185 (5-for-27) and one RBI in the first eight games, **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** has started to heat up at the plate. In the last 18 games, Shewmake is batting .388 (31-for-80) with five doubles, one triple, three home run and 26 RBI. He has put in two four-RBI efforts and two three-RBI games. He has recorded multiple hits in 11 of the last 18 games. In the series sweep at Kentucky, Shewmake batted .625 (10-for-16) with five runs, one double, two home runs and 11 RBI.

WINNING TRADITION

Heading into the 2019 campaign, the Aggies have 12 consecutive winning seasons. Texas A&M has posted a winning record in 56 of the last 58 years.

WHAT'S BACK IN 2019: OFFENSE

The Aggies bring back five position players who started at least 50 percent of the games (31 of 62) for last season's team – **ZACH DELOACH** (61), **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** (61), **LOGAN FOSTER** (55), **HUNTER COLEMAN** (49), **WILL FRIZZELL** (49) and **ALLONTE WINGATE** (31). Two other field returnees started games in 2018, including **AARON WALTERS** (22), **CAM BLAKE** (12), **CHANDLER MORRIS** (9) and **COLE TAYLOR** (1).

TOUGH TESTS SPANGLE THE 2019 SCHEDULE

The Aggies will face 12 different opponents who made the 2018 NCAA Championship for a total of 28 games, including Arkansas (3), Auburn (3), Gonzaga (3), LSU (3), Mississippi State (3), Ole Miss (3), South Carolina (3), Vanderbilt (3), Baylor, Dallas Baptist, Houston and Texas.

Thirty-six of Texas A&M's games will be against teams that finished in the top 100 of the final RPI rankings in 2018, including 13 games against teams which finished in the RPI top 25. The Aggies play seven games against College World Series squads from 2018, including three against runner-up Arkansas.

The Aggies have done well in traffic one the mound, holding opponents to two hits (.091 - 2-for-22) and a .130 on-base percentage (3-for-23) while striking out eight in 23 plate appearances with bases loaded. **CHANDLER JOZWIAK** has been in nine bases-loaded situations, allowing one hit and one walk

FIRST SEC TEAM TO 2,700 WINS

The Aggies own the most wins of any SEC program with 2,700 victories, which ranks 11th nationally. Texas A&M enters play with a 2,716-1,510-42 mark. On February 20, 2019, the Aggies became the first SEC team to reach the 2,700-win mark with a 9-1 win against Prairie View A&M. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .641 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools.

STIRRING THE DRINK

BRYCE BLAUM has blossomed as the Aggies' leadoff hitter. The Houston native and Ole Miss transfer is batting .327 (34-for-104) with a .421 on-base percentage in the top spot in the lineup. He leads the team with 32 runs, four home runs and eight stolen bases. Blaum has led off three games with home runs in 2019. He has added four doubles, two triples and 13 RBI.

When leading off an inning, Blaum has reached base in 26 of 52 opportunities (.500).

PRESEASON HONORS FOR DOXAKIS AND SHEWMAKE

JOHN DOXAKIS and **BRADEN SHEWMAKE** were named to the Preseason All-SEC team as voted on by the conference's coaches.

The duo were both named to the All-SEC Second Team. The pair have each hauled in Preseason All-America recognition with Doxakis earning a spot on the D1Baseball.com All-America Second Team and Shewmake named to the Rawlings/Perfect Game All-America Third Team.

In 2018, Doxakis posted an 8-5 record with a 2.70 ERA, .212 opponent batting average while striking out 92 in his 93.1 innings of work.

The Houston native shined in the postseason, notching a 2-0 record, 0.68 ERA and 22 strikeouts over 13.1 innings in his two starts. At the SEC Tournament, Doxakis outpitched Auburn's Casey Mize, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2018 MLB Draft, by yielding just one run on two hits while striking out 10 in 7.1 innings. In regional play, he worked 6.0 innings against Indiana, allowing one unearned run on one hit and two walks while striking out 12.

Last season, Shewmake earned All-SEC First Team recognition as a shortstop. He played in 61 games, notching a .327 batting average with 43 runs, eight doubles, four triples, five home runs, 45 RBI and 12 stolen bases.

As a freshman, Shewmake filled up his trophy case playing second base. In addition to earning the Aggies' first SEC Freshman of the Year honor, he was named All-America First Team by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association and All-America Second Team by the American Baseball Coaches Association and D1Baseball.com. Collegiate Baseball named him National Freshman of the Year and the NCBWA christened Shewmake the District VII Player of the Year.

He was the only Aggie to start all 64 games in 2017. As a rookie, he batted .328 with 90 hits, 47 runs, 18 doubles, two triples, 11 home runs, 69 RBI and 11 stolen bases. Shewmake logged a .529 slugging percentage. His 34 RBI in SEC play ranked third in the league. He hit .307 with 15 runs, five doubles and seven home runs in conference action.

STACKING UP WINS

The Aggies are one of just five teams to log 40 or more wins in every season since 2015. The other four squads are Dallas Baptist, Florida, Florida State and Louisville.

Closer **KASEY KALICH** is holding opponents to a 1-for-11 mark with two walks, one HBP and six strikeouts in 14 RISP situations. **JOSEPH MENEFFEE** is 2-for-19 with seven strikeouts in RISP situations.

With runners in scoring position and two outs, the opponent average drops to .163 (16-for-98).

KLOSING TIME

It is early in the season, but closer **KASEY KALICH** is on pace to threaten the Aggies' single-season saves record. The A&M mark of 14 was set by Jason Jester in 2013 and matched by Nolan Hoffman last season.

Kalich is a perfect 6-for-6 in save opportunities. He enters the week with a 1-0 record, 0.73 ERA, 0.73 WHIP and 18 strikeouts in 12.1 innings over 10 appearances.

WEEKEND WARRIORS

The Aggies' weekend rotation has been one of the nation's best through the first five weekends. **JOHN DOXAKIS**, **ASA LACY**, **JONATHAN CHILDRESS** and **CHRISTIAN ROA** have combined for a 2.00 ERA, .188 opponent batting average, 0.93 WHIP and 4.80 K-to-BB ratio in their weekend starts.

SHRINERS CLASSIC CHAMPS

For the second time in the last three trips, the Aggies claimed the title at the Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic. The Maroon & White earned victory against two Top 25 teams, including No. 18 Baylor (5-2) and No. 17 TCU (1-0). They capped off the 3-0 performance with a 3-2 victory over Houston.

Texas A&M's pitching staff allowed just three earned runs on the weekend, holding opponents to a .126 batting average. The Aggies registered a 4.00 K-to-BB ratio, 0.74 WHIP and 12.00 strikeouts per nine innings. **JOHN DOXAKIS** equaled a career high with 12 strikeouts in the opener against Baylor, holding the Bears to one run on four hits. On Saturday, **ASA LACY**, **BRYCE MILLER**, **JOSEPH MENEFEE** and **KASEY KALICH** held TCU to one hit. On Sunday, **JONATHAN CHILDRESS** worked 3.0 hitless innings before the bullpen had to take over. CHANDLER JOZWIAK, Miller, Menefee and **CHRISTIAN ROA** combined to allow one earned run over 6.0 innings.

BRYCE BLAUM had a pair of home runs and **ZACH DELOACH** batted .375 (3-for-8) on the offensive end.

Four Aggies earned All-Tournament Team recognition at the Classic, including Doxakis, Foster, Lacy and Shewmake.

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Texas A&M's varsity athletic teams are wearing tribute helmet decals or uniform patches to honor the memory of George H.W. Bush, the 41st President of the United States and a great friend to Texas A&M's Department of Athletics. The tribute patch artwork is representative of the shield element from the official President Bush 41 logo. Additionally, as approved by the Bush family, the patch will incorporate Texas A&M University's official colors of maroon and white to celebrate President Bush's life and service while expressing the 12th Man's love for him.

One of the most memorable moments at Blue Bell Park came on March 5, 2016 prior to a game against Yale when President Bush threw out the first pitch as the Maroon & White faced his alma mater.
