LEADING OFF

The No. 7 Texas A&M Aggies host the No. 9 Louisville Cardinals for College Station Super Regional play on Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park. The Maroon & White are trying to earn their seventh trip to Omaha. All three games air on the ESPN family of networks with Friday on ESPNU, Saturday on ESPN2 and Sunday to be determined. Mike Monaco (play-by-play) and Chris Burke (color) handle the call.

It marks the ninth Super Regional appearance for the Aggies, which ranks 14th on the NCAA Division I list. Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park is hosting a Super Regional for the fourth time. Texas A&M has advanced to the College World Series in two of their three times hosting - 1999 & 2017.

With a Super Regional win, Aggie head coach **Jim Schlossnagle** would join a distinguished list of 13 prior coaches to lead multiple schools to a College World Series. He is also looking to become the 30th head coach to reach the CWS on six occasions. He would become the fifth Aggie coach to earn a Omaha trip, joining Beau Bell (1951), Tom Chandler (1964), Mark Johnson (1993 & 1999) and Rob Childress (2011 & 2017).

AGAINST THE FIELD

Texas A&M is 6-4 against the teams headed to the Super Regional. The Maroon & White claimed series against Arkansas (2-1) and Ole Miss (2-1) and dropped a series against Auburn (1-2). Texas A&M also won a midweek game against Texas.

The Aggies entered the tournament with a 15-8 mark against the 63 other teams in the NCAA Championship field this season. It includes SEC series against Arkansas (2-1), Auburn (1-2), Georgia (2-1), LSU (2-1), Ole Miss (2-1) and Vanderbilt (2-1) along with two SEC Tournament games against Florida (1-1). Texas A&M also played midweek games against Dallas Baptist (1-0), Texas (1-0) and Texas State (1-0).

VERSUS RANKED OPPONENTS

The Aggies are 12-4 this season against teams ranked in the USA Today Coaches Top 25, including 7-3 against teams in the top 10. Most recently, the Aggies clinched the regional title with a 15-9 win over then-No. 23 TCU. In week 11, Texas A&M won 2-of-3 in a road series at then-No. 22 Vanderbilt. The prior week, the Aggies won 2-of-3 in a home set against then-No. 3 Arkansas. The Maroon & White took 2-of-3 in road series at then-No. 8 LSU and then-No. 10 Georgia. They also claimed a road midweek win against then-No. 8 Texas. The Aggies won home midweek games against then-No. 15 Texas State and No. 25 Dallas Baptist.

Texas A&M has outscored ranked opponents 138-85, slashing .304/.424/.502 in the 16 games with 30 doubles, three triples and 25 home runs. **AUSTIN BOST** is batting .467 (28-for-60) with 14 walks, 18 runs, three doubles, three homers, 12 RBI and a .579 on-base percentage. **JACK MOSS** is hitting .417 (30-for-72) with 14 runs, six doubles, one triple, two homers and 18 RBI. **DYLAN ROCK** is hitting .328 (19-for-58) with 23 runs, four doubles, seven home runs, a .759 slugging percentage, .506 on-base percentage and 22 RBI. **LOGAN BRITT** and **RYAN TARGAC** each have four home runs and **TROY CLAUNCH** has added 20 RBI.

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WINNING TRADITION

With their 40-18 overall record, the Aggies have post their 16th consecutive winning season. Texas A&M has registered a winning record in 60 of the last 62 campaigns.

AGGIE SUPER REGIONAL TRIPS

Texas A&M is making its ninth Super Regional appearances. The Aggies advanced out of a Super Regional on three occasions, including 1999 (vs. Clemson), 2011 (vs. Florida State) and 2017 (vs. Davidson). Texas A&M is a combined 8-12 in Super Regional. They have won the opening game on three occasions, winning the Super Regional on all three occasions. The Aggies are 2-2 in rubber matches.

This marks the fourth time the Maroon & White are hosting a Super Regional. On Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park, they topped Clemson in 1999 and Davidson in 2017. The dropped the 2016 College Station Super Regional to TCU. Aggies are 5-3 in Super Regional home games.

COACH SCHLOSSNAGLE AT SUPER REGIONALS

Texas A&M head coach **Jim Schlossnagle** is making his making his eighth Super Regional appearance. He is 5-2 in his prior trips to the Super Regional, all coming at TCU. His career record in Super Regionals is 11-8. Schlossnagle is 5-2 in the opening game of Super Regional, winning the trip to Omaha all five times he won the lid-lifter. He is 4-1 in Super Regional rubber matches, losing his initial game three at Texas in 2009 before rattling off wins against Texas (2010) and Pepperdine (2014) and a pair against Texas A&M (2015 & '16).

SEARCH FOR SIX

Texas A&M head coach **Jim Schlossnagle** is looking to become the 30th coach to make six College World Series appearances. He would become the sixth coach to have the four wins come at two or more schools.

MOSS THE BOSS

JACK MOSS has been the Aggies most consistent hitter, batting a team-high .388 to go with a .448 on-base percentage and .537 on-base percentage. He has reached base in 55 of the 58 games this season. In 2022, he has a team-high 32 multi-hit games. In addition to batting average, he leads the team in hits (94) and doubles (16). Moss leads the SEC and ranks ninth in the nation with 94 hits. His batting average ranks second in the SEC and 25th in the nation.

Moss has stepped up his game in the postseason, earning all-tournament recognition at the SEC Tournament and the NCAA College Station Regional. He also collected Most Valuable Player distinction at the College Station Regional.

Moss hit .643 (9-for-14) at the regional, logging five runs, one double, five RBI and one stolen base. He batted .500 (6-for-12) at the SEC Tournament with one run and one RBI. He has recorded multiple hits in all six Aggie postseason games in 2022.

THE ROCK

The Aggies boast one of the nation's most experienced hitters in **DYLAN ROCK**. The UTSA transfer ranks 18th among active NCAA Division I players with 861 at-bats. He ranks third among active players in runs (212), 9th in total bases (453) and walks (136), 11th in hits (279), 13th doubles (58), 20th in RBI (167) and 20th in games played (232).

Rock was named SEC Co-Player of the Week in week 8, helping the Aggies win three games – two against Kentucky and one versus No. 8 Texas State. He reached base in 12-of-20 plate appearances, including 10-of-15 against Kentucky. He batted 5-for-10 against the Wildcats with five walks, six runs, one double, one triple, one home run and four RBI.

This year, Rock leads Texas A&M in runs (65), home runs (18), stolen bases (16), slugging (.680) and on-base percentage (.483). Rock also has 13 doubles and one triple on the year. He ranks in the top 10 in the SEC in on-base percentage (2nd), hit by pitch (4th), walks (5th), slugging percentage (6th), runs (7th), RBI (7th) and home runs (7th).

In 30 league games, Rock led the SEC with 42 runs. He ranked second in on-base percentage (.503) and slugging percentage (.773), third in RBI (34), walks (31) and total bases (85) and fourth in home runs (13).

Among the players on the 16 teams headed to Super Regionals, Rock leads the pack in career runs scored and he ranks second in at-bats, total bases, walks and at-bats. He ranks third among active Super Regional players in games, hits, doubles and RBI.

SEPARATION SIXTH

The Aggies have made the most hay in the sixth inning when the Maroon & White are outscoring opponents, 69-17. Texas A&M is hitting .305 in the sixth inning with a .425 on-base percentage and .494 slugging percentage. **JACK MOSS** is hitting .520 (13-for-25) with a .581 on-base percentage, three walks, two HBP, three doubles, two home runs and 10 RBI in the sixth and **BRETT MINNICH** is batting .385 (10-for-26) with 10 runs, six walks, one HBP, a .515 on-base percentage, one double, two home runs and eight RBI. The pitching staff owns a 2.33 ERA in the sixth, holding foes to a .175 batting average (36-for-206), including just six doubles, one triple and one home run as the lone extra-base hits in 58.0 innings.

The Maroon & White are also outscoring foes 67-33 in the fifth inning, for a combined 136-50 in the fifth and sixth frames.

CLAUNCH EARNS NO. 12

TROY CLAUNCH has earned the right to wear the revered No. 12 for the 2022 campaign, Texas A&M baseball head coach **JIM SCHLOSSNAGLE** announced leading up to the season.

"The number 12 obviously is very near and dear to Texas A&M," Schlossnagle said. "I thought it would be appropriate to only award number 12 to someone who truly defines the core values of our university and Aggie baseball – Respect, Excellence, Leadership, Loyalty, Integrity and Selfless Service. This will be something that we attempt to do each year as we move the program forward.

"Troy has earned the respect of his teammates, our coaching staff and all of our support staff. Although we have several players that have tremendous character, Troy has stood out as the player who has earned the privilege of wearing 12 for the 2022 baseball season."

Claunch is in his first season at Texas A&M after a brilliant four-year career at Oregon State. He earned All-Pac 12 First Team in 2021, batting .305 with 26 runs, seven doubles, four home runs and 30 RBI. He played 124 games for OSU including 92 starts, batting .290 with 46 runs, 13 doubles, 10 home runs and 62 RBI. He was a member of the Beavers' 2018 national championship squad.

"The number 12 is an integral part of the rich history of this university," Claunch said. "Being given the honor to wear 12 this season is a great privilege that I take very seriously. Every day I put that jersey on will be a reminder to live up to the traditions and core values of Texas A&M. I am eager to uphold the legacy of the number and make Aggieland proud."

NEW STAFF

JIM SCHLOSSNAGLE, a two-time National Coach of the Year, brings an 811-393 (.674) mark to Texas A&M, including five College World Series appearances. He guided TCU to their Omaha debut in 2010 and four consecutive CWS trips from 2014-17. Schlossnagle earned National Coach of the Year honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association in 2010 and Baseball America in 2016.

Renowned pitching coach and 2017 D1Baseball Assistant Coach of the Year **NATE YESKIE** is in his first season in Aggieland as associate head coach. He arrives in the Brazos Valley after two seasons on Jay Johnson's staff at Arizona, including the 2021 CWS campaign. He also coached 11 seasons at Oregon State with his tenure culminating in a College World Series title in 2018.

New assistant coach **NOLAN CAIN** is nationally recognized as one of the top recruiters in the nation. Three of his last four recruiting classes at LSU were ranked in the Top 5, including a No. 1 rating by Baseball America for his 2020 class. During Cain's eight season the LSU staff, the Tigers earned five NCAA Tournament national seeds, two CWS appearances and four SEC crowns.

Hitting coach **MICHAEL EARLEY** has built a reputation for developing hitters with his most notable work being the rise of Spencer Torkelson to the No. 1 overall pick in the 2020 MLB Draft. In the 2020 draft, four of Earley's hitters were selected as Arizona State.

OUCH

AUSTIN BOST tied a school single-game record when he was hit by a pitch three times in the Aggies' game at Rice. It equaled the mark set by Mitchell Nau in a Texas A&M home win against UT-Pan American in 2015. On the season, Bost has been hit by pitch on 11 occasions, along with drawing 31 walks. He sports a .368 batting average .462 on-base percentage which both rank second on the squad.

CYCLES

The Aggies have a pair of cycles on the season with **JACK MOSS** recording one at No. 8 Texas on March 29 and **RYAN TARGAC** adding one 12 days later against Kentucky.

Moss had a 5-for-5 game, hitting for the Aggies' first cycle since 2018 in A&M's 12-9 win at Texas. He singled in the first and fourth innings, smashed a two-run home run in the third and roped a double in the sixth. Moss legged out a triple in the eighth to seal the cycle. He also accounted for one of the team's two grand slams on the season, launching the four-ribbie dinger against Rice.

Targac batted 4-for-5 in the series finale, logging three runs and five RBI. The switch-hitter logged two hits from each side of the base. He hit a single (4th inning) and double (8th inning) from the right side of the plate. He homered (5th inning) and tripled (6th inning) from the left side.

NEW, BUT EXPERIENCED, BLOOD

The Aggies hit the transfer portal to find eight Division I transfers to fill spots for departed players. The list includes four hitters and three pitchers. In the field, infielders **KOLE KALER** (Hawaii) and **JACK MOSS** (Arizona State), catcher **TROY CLAUNCH** (Oregon State) and outfielder **DYLAN ROCK** (UTSA) give the coaching staff four veteran starters to bolster the lineup. On the mound, **MICAH DALLAS** (Texas Tech), **XAVIER LOVETT** (Mississippi State) and **JACOB PALISCH** (Stanford) provide a young group of returners with valuable experience to lean on.

FIRST SEC TEAM TO 2,800 WINS

In the Aggies' 23-9 victory over Georgia on April 16, Texas A&M became the first SEC team to reach the 2,800-win mark. Texas A&M's all-time winning percentage of .640 also leads the SEC and ranks 15th among NCAA Division I schools. The Aggies' are the 11th NCAA Division I program to reach the 2,800-win plateau and they enter Tuesday action with a 2,817-1,576-43 all-time mark.

TEXAS A&M/LOUISVILLE NOTABLES

The only prior meeting came at the 2017 College World Series. With 2017 MLB Draft No. 1 Overall Pick Brendan McKay on the mound, Louisville won 8-4. The Cardinals scored five runs in the second inning and the Aggies were unable to make up the deficit. Blake Kopetsky led the Aggies, going 3-for-4 with a double, two runs and one RBI.

BULLPEN NUGGETS

JOSEPH MENEFEE leads the nation in strikeouts per nine innings (13.92) among active NCAA Division I pitchers with at least 100.0 innings of work in their career. Menefee also ranks 18th in fewest hits allowed per nine innings (6.58) and 45th in relief appearances (77). For his career, 13-6 with two saves, a 4.31 ERA, .196 opponent batting average, 1.33 WHIP and 184 strikeouts in 117.1 innings. This season, he is 6-2 with a 5.67 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 46.0 innings.

BRAD RUDIS pitched spectacularly in the College Station Regional, appearing in all three games. He retired 11 of the 13 batters he faced in 3.2 scoreless innings, scattering one hit and one walk while striking out two. Rudis picked up a save in Saturday's win against Louisiana. On the season, he has made 23 appearances, including two starts, posting a 3-0 record with 3 saves, a 5.40 ERA and 33 strikeouts in 36.2 innings.

JACOB PALISCH ranks 14th in pitching appearances among active NCAA Division I players with 98. The graduate also ranks 12th among active players with 91 relief appearances. For his career, Palisch is 16-6 with 10 saves, a 3.21 ERA and 167 strikeouts in 184.2 innings. This season, the Stanford-transfer is 5-3 with four saves, a 2.76 ERA and 57 strikeouts in 49.0 innings.

Since March 29, Palisch allowed just four earned runs in 15 appearances, scattering 29 hits and four walks while striking out 38 over 31.1 innings for a 2-0 record, four saves and 1.15 ERA.

A TOAST TO BOST

AUSTIN BOST has emerged as the Aggies top hitter the last 26 games as the Maroon & White have rolled to an 22-6 mark, their best stretch of the season. Since the Aggies' series finale against Kentucky, Bost has raked to the tune of a .438 batting average (46-for-105) with a .534 on-base percentage and .733 slugging percentage. Over the span, Bost has 34 runs, eight doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 29 RBI and 22 walks. He has hits in 25 of the 28 games, including 14 multi-hit efforts. The stretch includes a four-hit game and five three-hit performances. During the run, Bost's batting average has ballooned from .299 to .368.

On the season, Bost is hitting .368 (78-for-212) with 51 runs, 11 doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 42 RBI and a .462 on-base percentage. He ranks second on the Aggies in batting average (.368), runs (51) and on-base percentage (.462).

In 30 league games, Bost ranked second in the SEC with a .385 batting average. He led the SEC in hits (45) over the 10 weekends of league play.

WALKS AS GOOD AS A HIT

KOLE KALER ranks fourth in the SEC and 21st in the nation with his 50 walks. His clip of 0.86 walks per game also ranks fourth in the SEC and 31st in the nation. Kaler has also been hit by two pitches and he's batting .240 (53-for-221) with 51 runs, plus eight doubles, two triples, three home runs, 29 RBI and 10 stolen bases. He sports a .382 on-base percentage.

Kaler is just the sixth Aggie to register 50 or more walks in a season - the first Aggie since John Scheschuk in 1999 to reach the 50-walk mark.

DYLAN ROCK tied a Texas A&M record for walks drawn in a game with five in the series opener against South Carolina. His tally equaled a mark set by Blake Kopetsky against Northwestern State in 2016. On the season, Rock ranks fifth in the SEC and 35th in the nation with 47 walks. Rock has been hit by a pitch on a team-high 14 occasions. His .483 on-base percentage ranks second in the SEC and 38th in the country.

Rock ranks ninth among all active NCAA Division I players with 136 career walks.

BRETT MINNICH has joined the walk parade, ranking seventh in the SEC with his 41 bases on balls.

TAR-GOTCHA

RYAN TARGAC stepped up his play in league action and tournament play. Sporting just a .213 batting average with two doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI in 20 non-conference games, Targac went boom in league play. In 30 SEC games, Targac led the conference with 41 RBI. He boasted a .346 batting average (10th) with five doubles, two triples and 10 home runs in the 10 weekends of league play. He also ranked in the top 10 in the SEC for on-base percentage (4th - .474) and slugging percentage (6th - .710) in league games. In six postseason games, Targac hit .364 (8-for-22) with six walks, two doubles, one home run, seven runs, one home run, four RBI, two stolen bases and a .500 on-base percentage.

Overall, Targac ranks second on the team with 14 home runs, 56 RBI and 11 stolen bases.

The Aggies have smashed 78 home runs during the 2022 campaign. It marks Texas A&M's highest dinger tally since hitting 85 during the 2009 season. The Aggies only hit the 70-tater mark once since 2009, hitting 70 in 2015.

The Aggies have swiped 77 bases during the 2022 campaign. It marks Texas A&M's highest stolen base mark since registering 85 during the 2013 season.

40 DAWGS

With their victory to claim the College Station Regional, the Aggies secured their first 40-win season since 2018 and the 25th in school annals. With the win, head coach **Jim Schlossnagle** passed Mark Johnson (1985 - 39-16) for most wins by a first year Aggie skipper. It marks Schlossnagle's 14th 40-win season. He logged 12 at TCU and one each at UNLV and Texas A&M.
