HISTORY OF THE "MO" MORIAL

The Texas A&M women's golf "Mo" Morial tournament is named after former Aggie women's golf great Monica Welsh. Welsh, who tragically died in an automobile accident in 1992, was a four-year letter winner for the Aggies from 1978-1982. She was a two-time TAIAW all-state selection and set the then-record for low competitive round (68) in 1981 at the TAIAW State Championship. This marks the Maroon & White's 21st time hosting the "Mo". The Aggies have finished first a "Mo"-best seven times, including a record best 25-stroke victory in 1996, and a comeback win in 2022.
