Tarleton WR Zimari Manning leads all of college football with 19 receiving TDs this season. Manning recently became Tarleton's all-time leader in TDs in a season (19) and in a career (30).

NO. 3 TEXANS LOOK TO CLINCH SECOND STRAIGHT OUTRIGHT LSC TITLE AT WESTERN NEW MEXICO

THE GAME

No. 3 Tarleton will travel to Silver City, New Mexico to close out the regular season with a matchup against Western New Mexico on Saturday, Nov. 16 at 1 p.m. CST at Ben Altamirano Field. The Texans can clinch the outright Lone Star Conference title and go undefeated in the regular season for the second straight season with a win. The Texans enter the game with the highest ranking in school history at No. 3 and 10-0 on the year. The Texans are also the No. 1-ranked team in the Super Region 4 rankings for the third straight week. Western New Mexico enters the game 1-9 on the season and 1-6 in the Lone Star Conference.

ABOUT THE TEXANS

Tarleton enters week 11 as the No. 3-ranked team in the nation after a 10-0 start. They're also the No. 1-ranked team Super Region 4 regional rankings for the third straight week, which puts the Texans in line for a first-round bye and hosting rights throughout the regional tournament. The Texans have been ranked in the top five for 11 straight weeks and the top 10 for 17 straight weeks. The Texans received two first-place votes in the AFCA poll for the eighth consecutive week. The Texans rank in the top 20 in the nation in five major categories: Total Offense: 2nd, 552.5 yards; Total Defense: 13th, 273.9 yards; Rushing Offense: 6th, 284.6 yards; Scoring Offense: 2nd, 48.3 points per game; and Defensive Touchdowns: 1st, 7 TDs. The Texan offense has accounted for at least 420 yards in all ten games, including seven 500-yard games and four 600-yard games in wins over SFA (673 yards), UT Permian Basin (632), Doane (609 yards), and William Jewell (school-record 682 yards). Defensively, the Texans have yet to allow a first quarter touchdown since week one against SFA and have outscored opponents 157-20 in the opening quarter this season. The Texans enter week 11 with a 20-game regular season winning streak and lead the nation with 13 straight home wins dating back to 2018. The Texans have also won 15 straight Lone Star Conference games since 2018. The Texans have also had road success, winning nine straight regular season road games since 2018. The Texans are averaging 48.3 points and holding teams to 15.1 points while out-gaining teams in total yards 552-273 per game. Ben Holmes comes in ranked second in the LSC with 2,613 passing yards and an LSC-leading 29 TD's, despite playing only the first half in five lopsided wins. Holmes' top targets have been Zimari Manning, who is third in the nation with 1,179 yards and leads all of college football at any level with 19 TD's, and J.F. Thomas (699 yards, 6 TD). Daniel McCants, Khalil Banks, Ryheem Skinner and Thomas McDonald lead a four-headed rushing attack with all four backs over 150 yards. McCants leads the way with 1,445 yards and 15 TD's on a national-leading 9.3 yards per carry. McCants now has back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons, making him the second player in school history to accomplish that milestone (Derrick Ross). Banks has 598 yards and 9 TD's. Skinner (311 yards, TD) and McDonald (183 yards, TD) have also been weapons out of the backfield. Defensively, B.J. Jefferson leads the team with 79 tackles and leads the nation with 21.5 tackles for a loss and 7.5 sacks. Jai Edwards and Ronnell Wilson are right behind with 60 and 58 tackles, respectively. Prince Robinson and Benjie Franklin lead the team with four interceptions while Robinson has three interception returns to lead the nation and Franklin is right behind with two INT returns. Tre Johnson and Jordan Wells each have a defensive TD this season with fumble returns.

SERIES HISTORY

Tarleton and Western New Mexico are meeting for the seventh time in program history since they first played in 1991. The Texans lead the series 4-2 over the Mustangs and won last season's matchup 58-0.

UP NEXT FOR TARLETON

Tarleton is geared up for another NCAA Playoff run for the second straight season. The NCAA Selection Show is on Sunday, Nov. 17 at 4 p.m. on NCAA.com and will announce the Super Region postseason teams and matchups. If Tarleton remains the No. 1 seed like they've been the last three weeks, the Texans will receive a first-round bye and its first playoff game would be at Memorial Stadium on Nov. 30.

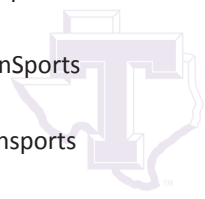

MEDIA INFORMATION

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Requests for working media credentials must be made through the Tarleton Athletics Communications office. Requests must be submitted online at TarletonSports.com/Credentials and received at least 24 hours in advance of the game to be covered.

The Tarleton Sports Network and the recognized visiting radio station will be provided a broadcast booth. Other reserved seating will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Season credentials will be delivered prior to the first game. Thereafter, credentials may be picked up at the Media Will Call entrance on the West side of Tarleton Memorial Stadium on a game-by-game basis.

Sideline passes are given primarily to just photographers on assignment for accredited publications. Visit TarletonSports.com/Media for Media Information.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

All photographers covering a game must display appropriate credentials at all times and are expected to comply with any instructions given by game officials or Tarleton sports information employees. NCAA rules prohibit photographers from being in the team areas between the 25-yard lines, and the use of tripods is restricted to the ends of the field.

PRESS BOX SERVICES

There are 10 seats available in the home press box for media coverage. Wifi and ethernet ports will be available to use.

Pregame meals will be served at least 30 minutes prior to kickoff and refreshments will be available throughout the contest as supplies last.

Individual and team statistics are provided both at halftime and after the game, plus a scoring summary, running play-by-play and all other statistical breakdowns are distributed at the conclusion of each contest. In addition, live stats are available to view on laptop computers and various tablets. Laptops and tablets will not be provided.

INTERNET ACCESS

Internet access is available in the press box. Access to wireless internet requires a proper authorization code which will be provided before kickoff. The Press Box also has a number of Ethernet ports available for wired connection, however, media members are required to provide their own Ethernet cables.

BROADCAST SERVICES

One courtesy line is provided for use by the visiting team's radio station. The courtesy line is located in the visiting radio booth in the press box, which has ample room for a two-person crew. There is no fee for using the line, but all line charges are the responsibility of the visiting station. The visiting radio courtesy number is (254) 918-7600.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Members of the media wishing to interview players or coaches must work through the Tarleton Assistant AD for Media Relations, Ryan Cox, to set up a convenient time for both parties. Post-game interviews are available outside the Tarleton locker room following a 10-minute "cooling off" period. If assistance is needed, contact a member of the Tarleton athletics communications department.

TARLETON IN THE LSC PRESEASON POLL

Tarleton Football is picked to finish atop the conference in the preseason poll and defend its title at the Lone Star Conference Football Media Day at McKinney ISD Stadium, the home of the 2019 NCAA Division II National Championship. The Texans received 217 votes and 19 first-place votes from the media, head coaches and sports information directors in the conference. It's the first time since 2014 the Texans were picked first in the LSC preseason poll. Midwestern State was picked second, followed by Texas A&M-Commerce. Eastern New Mexico (4), Angelo State (5), West Texas A&M (6), Texas A&M-Kingsville (7), UT Permian Basin (8) and Western New Mexico (9) round out the conference preseason poll

NATIONAL PRESEASON RANKINGS

Tarleton was ranked No. 7 in the AFCA poll to open the season. The Texans were ranked in four different polls, including the AFCA. They've been ranked No. 4 by D2Sports, No. 5 by D2Football.com, and No. 13 by College Football American.

RECORDS ARE ABOUT TO BE BROKEN

4 major offensive records are about to be broken in the final weeks of the season. Zimari Manning needs 4 TD receptions to break WT's Charly Martin's record of 22 set in 2008. Ben Holmes needs 1 TD pass to break Cliff Watkins' record of 29 set in 2003. Daniel McCants needs 115 rushing yards to break Derrick Ross' single season record of 1,560 yards set in 2004 and 185 yards to break Ricky Bush's career record of 3,389 set in 1979-82.

PICK SIX CITY

Tarleton had three players take back four interceptions for a TD in the six seasons prior to Marcus Patton's arrival in 2016. In the last four seasons, Tarleton had taken 11 INTs to the house. Four current Texans have a pick six: Benjie Franklin, Prince Robinson, Jai Edwards, and Devin Hafford all had pick sixes in the last two seasons. Robinson, Tre Johnson, and Jordan Wells also had a fumble recovered for a TD.

WHITTEN IS TARLETON'S BEST

Todd Whitten is back for his fourth season of his third stint as the head coach of Texan Football and is not without an impressive resume. Whitten is in his tenth season as head coach of the Texans and boasts the most victories (78) of a Tarleton head coach in school history. Whitten recently passed W.J. Wisdom for the most wins in school history. Wisdom's record stood for 84 years -- since 1935.

PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

Tarleton Football's Prince Robinson and Zimari Manning were named preseason All-Americans by D2Football.com. It's the second straight season the Texans have had a preseason all-American (Tyrell Thompson). Robinson and Manning join Devin Hafford and Jai Edwards as returning players to earn All-American honors.

TARLETON AS RANKED PROGRAM

Tarleton is in the AFCA National Top 25 poll for the 102nd time in program history. Tarleton is 71-23 all-time when competing as a ranked program, including a 39-9 mark under head coach Todd Whitten.

HEAD COACH TODD WHITTEN



A familiar face made his return to Stephenville as the winningest coach of Tarleton State University's NCAA era, Todd Whitten, joined the Texan sidelines prior to the 2016 season.

In just his third season back with the Texans, Whitten led the biggest turnaround in the country and guided the Texans to their best season in program history. The Texans posted an undefeated regular season en route to the first outright Lone Star Conference title in program history. Tarleton had regular season road wins at No. 7 Texas A&M-Commerce – the defending National Champions – and No. 10 Midwestern State to claim the conference title.

The Texans outscored opponents 45-16 per game and the Texans set numerous program records for total points (585), rushing yards (4,301) and total yards (6,709) to have a top-5 offense in the country.

The Texans earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA regional tournament – the highest seed in program history. The Texans hosted the first two rounds of the NCAA playoffs, coming away with victories over No. 24 Azusa Pacific (58-0) and a rematch with No. 15 Texas A&M-Commerce (34-28). It was the first time in school history the Texans won 12 games in a season and advanced to the NCAA regional finals. Tarleton ended the season with the highest ranking in program history, finishing ranked No. 5 in the AFCA poll.

Whitten coached a record 24 all-conference players in 2018, including the LSC Offensive Back of the Year (Xavier Turner), the Offensive Lineman of the Year (Deon Sheppard) and the Defensive Back of the Year (Devin Hafford). Six Texans were named All-American for the first time in program history: Sheppard (OT), Hafford (CB), Turner (RB), Jai Edwards (FS), Tyrell Thompson (DT), and Jovan Pruitt (OG).

He made an immediate impact in his return by resurrecting a 3-7 season from the year before and led Tarleton into the final two games of the season with a chance to win the Lone Star Conference championship in his first season back. He followed up in 2017 by leading Tarleton to its first winning regular season since 2013 and the fifth bowl game invitation in program history.

In a news conference on December 3, 2015, at 9:30 a.m. Athletic Director Lonn Reisman announced the selection of Whitten as head football coach. Whitten joined Reisman and President Dr. F. Dominic Dottavio at the announcement in the lobby of Wisdom Gym.

This marked the 28th head coaching change in the history of Tarleton football, as Whitten is one of 24 different men to lead the Texans. He now joins legendary coach W.J. Wisdom as one of two coaches with three different tenures as Tarleton's head football coach.

"I'm coming home," said Whitten. "I'm very excited to be back at Tarleton. This is a very special place and it's an incredible job. I'm very thankful to be chosen."

Whitten, a 29-year veteran at the collegiate coaching level, has been a head coach for 13 years, including eight at Tarleton (1996, 2000-04, 2016-17) and five seasons at NCAA Division I Sam Houston State.

He currently boasts an NCAA coaching record of 81-63, including a record at Tarleton of 56-35, which gives him the second-most total wins in school history behind Wisdom (71). He also has a career record of 32-13 at Memorial Stadium in Stephenville.

"I am very confident in Todd Whitten's ability to win football games and reestablish our program into a contender – not just in the Lone Star Conference, but on the national level," said Reisman. "In his career, Whitten has shown the ability to rebuild programs and make them very competitive."

"He brings a wealth of experience as a head coach at the Division I and Division II levels," continued Reisman. "He is an innovator, he is creative, and he has one of the most tremendous offensive minds in the country. I have all the confidence in the world that Todd will bring enthusiasm and energy to our football program."

During his first two stints at Tarleton, Whitten was no stranger to awards and championships.

Before taking over the program in 1996 for one season, Tarleton had a record of 4-16-1 since joining the NCAA in 1994. Whitten turned things around following a 1-10 season in 1995 by leading the Texans to a 5-5 record in his first season, which was enough to garner him the LSC Coach of the Year award for that season.

After a three-year hiatus as the offense coordinator for Wyoming and Sam Houston State, Whitten made his return to Stephenville to build Tarleton into a national powerhouse.

Whitten came back in 2000 and turned Tarleton around once again with a 6-5 record to open the new century.

In his second season, Whitten's Texans entered uncharted territory with a 10-3 mark to claim the school's first Lone Star Conference championship and division championship en route to their first trip to the NCAA playoffs. He would go on to boast a record of 17-6 over the next two seasons, each of which garnered him his third and fourth LSC Coach of the Year awards, and Tarleton returned to the NCAA playoffs in 2003.

Whitten is a four-time Lone Star Conference Coach of the Year after winning the award in 1996, 2001, 2002, and 2003. He was also named the D2Football.com West Region Coach of the Year in 2001 after guiding Tarleton to the national playoffs for the first time in school history.

Before becoming a coach, Whitten was a star athlete at Dallas Kimball High School and Stephen F. Austin University – where he was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2001. He was a three-year starter at quarterback and a three-year starter in the outfield during baseball season.

He was drafted in the 17th round of the 1983 Major League Baseball Draft by Philadelphia out of Kimball High School, but declined to make his way to Stephen F. Austin. After his dual-sport career with the Lumberjacks, Whitten signed a free agent contract to play quarterback for the New England Patriots in 1987.

After playing for the Patriots in 1987, Whitten traded the helmet for the headset as he went back to school as a graduate assistant coach at Texas Tech to begin his coaching career. He earned his first full-time coaching job at New Mexico State in 1990, where he spent four seasons before heading to El Paso, where he spent two seasons at UTEP.

Whitten left UTEP for his first head coaching position at Tarleton in 1996 before leaving for Wyoming the following year.

After his second stint at Tarleton from 2000-04, Whitten returned to Sam Houston State for his first Division I head coaching opportunity. He spent five seasons with the Bearkats. From there, he spent two seasons at Lamar, one year at Arlington Heights High School, and the last three years at UTEP before coming back to Tarleton in December 2015.

Whitten earned a bachelor's degree in education from Stephen F. Austin in 1987 and a master's degree in sports administration from Texas Tech in 1990. He resides in Stephenville with his wife, Dana. The couple has three sons – Brady, Blaze, and Tate – and a daughter, Maddie.
