ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Tarleton owns the all-time lead in the series 5-3, including a 3-1 mark in Stephenville. Tarleton and Northeastern State first met in 1993 with the game in Tahlequah, Oklahoma. The Texans five straight meetings from 2003-09. Northeastern State won the most recent meeting in 2010, a 31-23 victory in Stephenville.
- Todd Whitten is 2-1 all-time against Northeastern State as head coach of the Texans. Whitten has won the last two meetings against the Riverhawks, which came in a 52-14 road win in 2004 and a 48-44 OT win in Stephenville in 2003.

QUICK HITS

- Tarleton is coming off a 33-21 homecoming victory over longtime LSC rival Midwestern State. It marked the third straight victory over the Mustangs. The Texans ran for 231 yards and had a pair of 100-yard rushers in Khalil Banks (135) and Ryheem Skinner (102). Quarterback Steven Duncan also threw for three touchdowns - two of which went to Tariq Bitson, who also had 83 yards receiving.
- Todd Whitten enters the game as Tarleton's all-time wins leader (83). While every new victory is a milestone, the win against New Mexico State on Feb. 21 made him the first Texan coach in school history to reach 80 career victories for the purple and white.
- Todd Whitten recently passed legendary coach W.J. Wisdom for the most games coached in Tarleton State University history with his 122nd game on the sidelines for the purple and white. Whitten and Wisdom are the only two coaches in program history with over 100 career games spent as the head coach.
- Saturday is the annual Legends Game where Tarleton will recognize the 1994 Texan football team. This was the first NCAA team in program history when Tarleton transitioned to NCAA Division II back in 1994. The 1994 team was coached by Ronnie Roemisch.

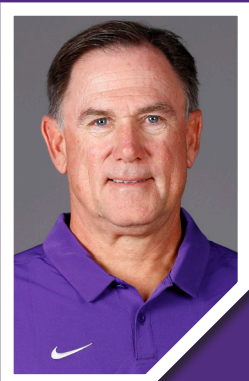

TARLETON CRACKS NATIONAL TOP 25 POLL AFTER ROUT OF NM STATE

The thrashing of FBS New Mexico State opened the eyes of national voters as the Texans debuted at No. 22 in the Stats Perform FCS Top 25 ranking for the first time in school history. In the national rankings, Tarleton joins the ranks of FCS elite – including a familiar foe, McNeese State, who debuted at No. 19. Tarleton fell out of the rankings the following week, but have received votes in the media poll every week since.

TARLETON MAKES AFCA NATIONAL POLL DEBUT

Tarleton is wasting no time in opening the eyes of national voters across the country in their debut season at FCS Division I as the Texans moved to No. 24 in the latest National Top 25 poll released by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Tuesday. Tarleton is 4-2 on the season after their rout of longtime rival Midwestern State on Homecoming in Stephenville last weekend. The Texans have defeated Division I foes Dixie State and FBS New Mexico State this season.

STATS PERFORM FCS NATIONAL TEAM OF THE WEEK

The Texans were named the Stats Perform FCS National Team of the week after defeating New Mexico State on Feb. 21 in El Paso. Tarleton earned their first win as a Division I institution and their first win ever against an FBS-level opponent. The Texans totaled 501 yards of offense while the Texan defense held New Mexico State to 241 yards for the afternoon. Tarleton forced three interceptions – two by Donovan Banks and one from Benjie Franklin on the opening drive of the second half.

WAC-ASUN CHALLENGE

WAC-ASUN AGREE TO PARTERSHIP FOR QUALIFYING PROGRAMS IN FALL

Officially titled the WAC-ASUN Challenge, the Western Athletic Conference and ASUN Conference have agreed on a football scheduling alliance that will allow for the seven institutions to be eligible for an automatic qualification into the 2021 NCAA FCS Playoffs.

WHAT COMMISSIONER HURD IS SAYING ABOUT THE CHALLENGE

"I am very pleased the WAC and ASUN were able to work through various issues and compromise on the elements of a mutually-beneficial scheduling alliance for the upcoming football season," said WAC Commissioner Jeff Hurd. "The fact that it came together in a relatively short period of time is a credit to the administrators and coaches of all the involved institutions."

WHAT THIS MEANS

Due to the Southland Conference asking the #Texas4 schools – Abilene Christian, Lamar, Stephen F. Austin and Sam Houston State – to leave the league a year ahead of schedule and the WAC welcoming their new programs with open arms, the league needed to get creative in offering an opportunity for an automatic qualifier (AQ) into the FCS playoffs.

The NCAA requires a league to have seven eligible football programs in their league to qualify for the AQ. The WAC will be reinstating football this summer and only the #Texas4 newcomers are eligible football teams because their are out of transition. Tarleton and Dixie State are not eligible while serving their four-year transitions to NCAA Division I. Southern Utah is expected to join the WAC in Summer 2022 and UTRGV is expected to add football in 2024. By the fall of 2024, the WAC is expected to boast at least 8 eligible football programs – Tarleton, Dixie, ACU, LU, SHSU, SFA, SUU, and UTRGV – with Tarleton and Dixie State no longer serving their transition time.

NOTES

STOUT TEXAN DEFENSE

When Todd Whitten tasked defensive coordinator Marcus Patton in taking over the stop troops in 2016, he inherited a defense that ranked last nationally in nearly every statistical category. As the Texans prepare to enter the Division I ranks, they'll do it as one of the elite defenses in the entire country - returning three All-Americans and five seniors with key roles in the turnaround. Tarleton is coming off back-to-back seasons in which they ranked among the top 10 in the nation in scoring defense. The Texans return three All-Americans - Ronnell Wilson, Devin Hafford and Jordan Wells. Wilson and Hafford, as well as Chris Radford, Erick Willis and Tre Johnson, still remain from the first recruiting class of the Whitten/Patton era.

THE PATTON EFFECT

When Marcus Patton accepted the job as Tarleton's defensive coordinator in the spring of 2016, he inherited a Texan defense that had given up 296.3 rushing yards, 263.3 passing yards and 559.6 total yards per game - last in the nation at the D2 level. Over the 2018-19 seasons, Tarleton had cut those numbers essentially in half. While boasting a 23-2 record over the last two years, Patton's defense is allowing 102.0 rushing, 193.5 passing, and 295.6 total yards per game.

FROM D2 DESPAIR TO D1 DEFENSE

When Todd Whitten returned to Tarleton as head coach following the 2015 season, his first hire was defensive coordinator, Marcus Patton. The request was simple: fix the nation's worst Division II defense. Tarleton ranked last or near the bottom of every defensive statistical category in the nation in 2015. Whitten and Patton went to work in recruiting the type of players that could turn things around - enter Ronnell Wilson, Devin Hafford, Tre Johnson and Erick Willis. Those four Texans signed on as part of Tarleton's 2016 recruiting class and have since turned Tarleton into one of the nation's most feared defenses in Division II during the last two undefeated regular seasons and now will take the field for Tarleton at the NCAA Division I level.

300 THROUGH THE AIR

QB Steven Duncan threw his first 300-yard passing game for the purple and white against Dixie State. His 347 yards against Dixie State were not only a career best for this time at Tarleton, but his collegiate career. It was his second collegiate 300-yard passing performance, topping a 304-yard effort on August 29, 2019 against Central Arkansas while he was at Western Kentucky.

NOBODY BETTER IN TEXAS

Since the start of the 2018 football season, there has not been a better scholarship football program in the entire state of the Texas than Tarleton State University. The Texans enter Saturday's game with 26 wins since the start of 2018, which is tied with Texas A&M for the most wins in the state by an NCAA Division I or II program. Tarleton has a chance to take the lead in the category with one more victory this season since the Big XII has already completed a full season. WILSON, HAFFORD NAMED DAVE CAMPBELL'S TEXAS FOOTBALL 2020 PRESEASON ALL-TEXAS SMALL COLLEGE

Tarleton Football senior All-American defenders Ronnell Wilson and Devin Hafford were named to Dave Campbell's Texas Football 2020 Preseason All-Texas Small College team last June.

To qualify, a player must participate at a four-year institution in Texas that plays below the FBS level. The All-Texas Small College team consist of NCAA FCS Division 1 programs, Division II and Division III.

INDEPENDENT... FOR NOW

Tarleton State University made the jump to NCAA Division I and the Western Athletic Conference last July and is currently in its first year of a four-year transition period. The WAC stopped sponsoring football back in 2012, making Tarleton an independent football program for the spring 2021 season.

However, the WAC has announced an expansion that will bring four football-playing schools into the WAC as early as July 1, 2021 - Lamar, Abilene Christian, Sam Houston State and Stephen F. Austin. This move will bring football back to the Western Athletic Conference at the FCS Level.

TARLETON VS. D1 TEAMS

Since joining the NCAA in 1994, Tarleton played 17 games against NCAA Division I opponents and have seven wins in those games, including wins this season over FBS New Mexico State and FCS Dixie State. Todd Whitten has four wins against D1 competition during his tenure at Tarleton.

FIRST-YEAR TRANSITION VS FBS

According to the available data on NCAA.com, Tarleton is the first program in their first-year of transition to defeat an FBS program (NM State on Feb. 21, 2021).

MAKING 20 STOPS

HEAD COACH



The all-time winningest head coach in the history of Tarleton Football Todd Whitten is set to begin his 11th season as the leader of the Texans when the 2020 season kicks off. It will be Whitten's 16th season as an NCAA head coach and his 33rd season of coaching football at any level.

Whitten is coming off back-to-back undefeated regular season Lone Star Conference Championships and will now lead the Texans into NCAA Division I competition at the FCS level. The Texan legend agreed to a six-year contract extension after the 2019 football season to guide the Texans to the next level of football competition.

In 2019, Whitten guided the Texans to their second consecutive undefeated regular season and Lone Star Conference Championship to earn his fifth LSC Coach of the Year award. On September 29, Tarleton blasted UT Permian Basin in Odessa 49-7 to deliver Whitten's 72nd career coaching win to break W.J. Wisdom's school record of 71 that had stood tall since 1935. Tarleton boasted the fourth-best scoring offense in the country (45.0 ppg) and had 10 different players named to five different All-America teams, including WR Zimari Manning who made a clean sweep with five, first-team All-America honors.

Whitten's Texans set a new program standard by moving up to the No. 3 ranking in the country by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). The Texans finished the season ranked No. 9 in the country.

In just his third season back with the Texans (2018), Whitten led the biggest turnaround in the country and guided the Texans to their best season in program history. The Texans posted the first of two straight undefeated regular seasons en route to the first outright Lone Star Conference title in program history. Tarleton had regular season road wins at No. 7 Texas A&M-Commerce - the defending National Champions - and No. 10 Midwestern State to claim the conference title. The Texans outscored opponents 45-16 per game and the Texans set numerous program records for total points (585), rushing yards (4,301) and total yards (6,709) to have a top-5 offense in the country.

Tarleton earned the No. 2 seed in the NCAA Division II football playoffs - the highest seed in program history. The Texans hosted the first two rounds of the NCAA playoffs, coming away with victories over No. 24 Azusa Pacific (58-0) and a rematch with No. 15 Texas A&M-Commerce (34-28). It was the first time in school history the Texans won 12 games in a season and advanced to the NCAA regional finals. Tarleton ended the season with the highest ranking in program history, finishing ranked No. 5 in the AFCA poll. Tarleton boasted a school-record 24 all-conference players that season, including six All-Americans.

In just his final two seasons in NCAA Division II and the Lone Star Conference, Whitten's Texans were not without their fair share of league, region and national accolades. Tarleton had 45 all-LSC selections in those two seasons, including the 2019 LSC Offensive Player of the Year (QB Ben Holmes), 2019 LSC Receiver of the Year (WR Zimari Manning), 2019 LSC Defensive Player of the Year (DE B.J. Jefferson), 2019 LSC Defensive Lineman of the Year (DT Jordan Wells), 2018 LSC Offensive Lineman of the Year (OT Deon Sheppard) and back-to-back LSC Offensive Backs of the Year (RBs Xavier Turner and Daniel McCants) and LSC Defensive Backs of the Year (CBs Devin Hafford and Prince Robinson). Tarleton had 16 All-Americans in those two seasons, all of which earned regional acclaim in addition to the national. In 2019, Zimari Manning had the highest finish by a WR in the Harlon Hill voting since 1991 by finishing third in the race for the best player in NCAA Division II.

Whitten made his return to the Tarleton on December 3, 2015 and was tasked with turning around the program. This marked the 28th head coaching change in the history of Tarleton football, as Whitten became one of 24 different men to lead the Texans. He joined legendary coach W.J. Wisdom as one of two coaches with three different tenures as Tarleton's head football coach.

"I'm coming home," said Whitten. "I'm very excited to be back at Tarleton. This is a very special place and it's an incredible job. I'm very thankful to be chosen."

He made an immediate impact in his return by resurrecting a 3-7 season from the year before and led Tarleton into the final two games of the season with a chance to win the Lone Star Conference championship in his first regular season back. He followed up in 2017 by leading Tarleton to its first winning regular season since 2013 and the fifth bowl game invitation in program history.

Whitten, a 32-year veteran at the collegiate coaching level, has been a head coach for 15 years, including 10 at Tarleton (1996, 2000-04, 2016-19) and five seasons at NCAA Division I Sam Houston State.

He currently boasts an NCAA coaching record of 104-65, including a record at Tarleton of 79-37, which gives him the most total wins in school history. He also has a career record of 45-14 at Memorial Stadium in Stephenville.

During his first two stints at Tarleton, Whitten was no stranger to awards and championships.

Before taking over the program in 1996 for one season, Tarleton had a record of 4-16-1 since joining the NCAA in 1994. Whitten turned things around following a 1-10 season in 1995 by leading the Texans to a 5-5 record in his first season, which was enough to garner him the LSC Coach of the Year award for that season.

After a three-year hiatus as the offense coordinator for Wyoming and Sam Houston State, Whitten made his return to Stephenville to build Tarleton into a national powerhouse. Whitten came back in 2000 and turned Tarleton around once again with a 6-5 record to open the new century.

In the second season of his return stint, Whitten's Texans entered uncharted territory with a 10-3 mark to claim the school's first Lone Star Conference championship and division championship en route to their first trip to the NCAA playoffs. He would go on to boast a record of 17-6 over the next two seasons, each of which garnered him third and fourth LSC Coach of the Year awards, and Tarleton returned to the NCAA playoffs in 2003.

Whitten is a five-time Lone Star Conference Coach of the Year after winning the award in 1996, 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2019. He was also named the D2Football.com West Region Coach of the Year in 2001 after guiding Tarleton to the national playoffs for the first time in school history.

Before becoming a coach, Whitten was a star athlete at Dallas Kimball High School and Stephen F. Austin University - where he was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2001. He was a three-year starter at quarterback and a three-year starter in the outfield during baseball season. He was drafted in the 17th round of the 1983 Major League Baseball Draft by Philadelphia out of Kimball High School, but declined to make his way to Stephen F. Austin. After his dual-sport career with the Lumberjacks, Whitten signed a free agent contract to play quarterback for the New England Patriots in 1987.

After playing for the Patriots in 1987, Whitten traded the helmet for the headset as he went back to school as a graduate assistant coach at Texas Tech to begin his coaching career. He earned his first full-time coaching job at New Mexico State in 1990, where he spent four seasons before heading to El Paso, where he spent two seasons at UTEP.

Whitten left UTEP for his first head coaching position at Tarleton in 1996 before leaving for Wyoming the following year.

After his second stint at Tarleton from 2000-04, Whitten returned to Sam Houston State for his first Division I head coaching opportunity. He spent five seasons with the Bearkats. From there, he spent two seasons at Lamar, one year at Arlington Heights High School, and the last three years at UTEP before coming back to Tarleton in December 2015.

Whitten earned a bachelor's degree in education from Stephen F. Austin in 1987 and a master's degree in sports administration from Texas Tech in 1990. He resides in Stephenville with his wife, Dana. The couple has three sons - Brady, Blaze, and Tate - and a daughter, Maddie.
