• **Riding a 14-match win streak and a 11-0 start in Big 12 Conference action, Texas is once again ranked No. 1 in the AVCA Division I Coaches Poll ...** the ranking marks Texas' fourth-consecutive appearance at No. 1 in the 2013 regular season poll ... Saturday's win over then-No. 24 Kansas boosted Texas' record against ranked opponents to 6-1 ... **in addition to their top ranking in the AVCA poll, the Longhorns check in at No. 1 in the NCAA Women's Volleyball RPI as of Nov. 11.**

• **Haley Eckerman won her 13th career Big 12 weekly award with Offensive Player of the Week honors after recording a season-high 25 kills last Saturday against Kansas ...** it also marked her eighth career award in the offensive category ... Eckerman's 25 kills were the most in a four-set match by a Big 12 player this season ... **on Tuesday, Eckerman was tabbed the Sports Import/AVCA Player of the Week for the second time in her collegiate career.**

• **The Longhorns have begun Big 12 Conference action 11-0 three times under head coach Jerritt Elliott (2009, '12, '13) ... Texas is 56-2 in its last 58 Big 12 matches (since Oct. 6, 2010, with a 3-0 win over Colorado), including a 46-match home win streak in conference contests.**

CHECKING IN ON THE CONFERENCE STANDINGS

With five Big 12 Conference matches remaining, UT continues to hold the top spot in the standings with a perfect 11-0 mark in league play ... Iowa State is in sole possession of second place at 10-2, while Kansas checks in third with a 9-3 mark ... the Longhorns are 8-1 this year on the road, while the Red Raiders are 3-7 at home ... **Texas has lost just six sets in league play.**

HORNS KEEP STREAK OF STREAKS ALIVE

Since the 2004 season, Texas has recorded a win streak of at least nine matches every year: 2004 - 16, 2005 - 9, 2006 - 9, 2007 - 23, 2008 - 10 and 13, 2009 - 11 and 18, 2010 - 19, 2011 - 16, 2012 - 17, 2013 - 14 and counting.

PROTECTING THE HOME COURT

The Longhorns have won 46 consecutive Big 12 Conference matches in Gregory Gym ... the streak began with a 3-0 sweep of Texas A&M on Nov. 1, 2008.

OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

The Longhorns have eclipsed the .300 hitting percentage mark seven times this season, including six times in their last 11 matches ... Texas hit a season-high .384 at West Virginia (Oct. 23) ... through 11 Big 12 Conference matches, Texas leads the league in hitting percentage (.306) and opponent hitting percentage (.151).

A NEW BIG 12 DYNASTY

In 17 years of Big 12 Conference play the Longhorns own a **270-73 (.787)** mark in league action ... **Texas' all-time Big 12 record ranks first among current conference members**, and second all-time to Nebraska's conference record (278-22, .927) ... during head coach Jerritt Elliott's 13-year tenure, Texas has posted a **196-47 (.807)** record against Big 12 foes ... in 2011 and 2012, the Longhorns lost just two conference matches.

LONGHORNS IN THE AVCA RANKINGS

Texas was ranked No. 1 in the preseason AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll (Aug. 12) for the first time in program history ... through Week No. 11 of the 2013 season, the No. 1 Longhorns have appeared in the Top 10 of the AVCA poll for 112 of the last 116 weeks ... **Texas has been ranked in the AVCA Top 25 for 151 consecutive weeks, dating back to 2004.**

WEBSTER NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD FINALIST

Senior All-American outside hitter Bailey Webster has been named one of 10 NCAA women's volleyball student-athletes that were selected as finalists for the 2013 Senior CLASS Award ... to be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition ... **fans are encouraged to vote at seniorclassaward.com through Dec. 9.**

COLLINS TABBED BIG 12 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Freshman setter **Chloe Collins** was tabbed the Big 12 Conference Rookie of the Week for matches played Oct. 23-26 ... **Collins' average of 12.00 assists on the week was tied for the league lead** ... against West Virginia, she recorded 26 in two sets before chipping in 34 at Kansas State on Saturday, guiding the Texas offense to a .366 hitting percentage over the two road wins, including a season-best .384 against the Mountaineers ... **in the first two sets at West Virginia, Texas hit .452, including an error-free first set.**

WEBSTER EARNS SECOND CAREER BIG 12 WEEKLY HONOR

All-American outside hitter **Bailey Webster** earned Big 12 Conference Volleyball Offensive Player of the Week (Oct. 9-12) honors for the second time in five years ... **Webster led the league in kills (4.86) and points (5.07) as the Longhorns collected wins over Texas Tech and Kansas** ... she also hit a combined .455 over the two matches ... against the Red Raiders, she recorded 14 kills with just one error on 22 attempts for a .591 hitting percentage. ... in Lawrence, Webster recorded 20 kills with only 3 errors for a .386 hitting mark.

UNDERCLASSMEN SHINE IN WIN AT BAYLOR

In UT's 3-1 win at Baylor, Texas saw career-high production from a quartet of underclassmen ... freshman setter **Chloe Collins** put up a season-high 46 assists, while fellow rookie **Chiaka Ogbogu** recorded a then-season high 10 kills and hit .471 (10-2-17) in the match ... sophomore middle blocker **Molly McCage** added her own career-high 10 kills and 12.0 points and two-sport athlete **Sara Hattis** notched her own career bests with seven kills and six block assists.

BIG 12 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK PART ONE FOR OGBOGU

Freshman outside hitter **Chiaka Ogbogu** was tabbed the Big 12 Conference Rookie of the Week for matches played Sept. 23-29 ... **Ogbogu recorded a .323 hitting percentage with an average of 2.50 kills as Texas swept conference opponents TCU and Oklahoma to start league play at 2-0** ... the freshman also recorded six blocks and averaged 3.08 points for the Longhorns ... Ogbogu matched her then season high with nine kills in the win over the Sooners.

BIG 12 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK PART TWO

Freshman outside hitter **Chiaka Ogbogu** earned Big 12 Conference Rookie of the Week (Oct. 2-5) honors for the second-consecutive week after recording double-digit kills in matches at Baylor and LSU ... **Ogbogu hit .471 at Baylor and .556 at LSU for a two-match mark of .514, which led the league for the week ... she also tallied eight blocks, including six against the Lady Bears.**

ALLISON ECLIPSES 3K MARK

In Texas' 3-2 win over No. 12 Nebraska (Sept. 22), senior setter **Hannah Allison** became the eighth player in Texas history to surpass the 3,000 career assists mark, as her 29 dishes brought her career total to 3,017 ... **Allison ranks sixth all-time in the Texas record book with 3,285 career assists.**

BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST

Texas owns a 73-36 (.670) record against ranked opponents over the last 10 seasons (2004-13) and a 38-7 (.844) mark against ranked opponents at Gregory Gym during that span ... **the Longhorns' last win over the nation's top-ranked team came Sept. 7, 2013, when Texas toppled Penn State in five games (25-27, 25-17, 13-25, 25-21, 15-10)** ... that match was the largest crowd in Gregory Gym's modern history, as a sell-out audience of 4,373 were in attendance.

HORNS PRESEASON HONORS

Junior outside hitter **Haley Eckerman** was named the Big 12 Conference's Preseason Player of the Year ... Eckerman garnered Texas' sixth-consecutive preseason player of the year honor after senior **Bailey Webster** earned preseason accolades in 2012, while Rachael Adams (2011), Juliann Faucette (2008, 2010) and Destinee Hooker (2009) round out the Longhorns' previous honorees. ... Eckerman, Webster and junior middle blocker **Khat Bell** were also named to the Preseason All-Big 12 team.

TEXAS TABBED NO. 1 IN BIG 12 PRESEASON POLL

Texas was selected to finish first in the 2013 Big 12 Conference race in a vote of league head coaches ... The Longhorns have been chosen at the top of the preseason poll for the past three seasons and six times overall (1996, 2008, '09, '11-'13) ... UT received eight of the possible nine first-place votes, while tallying 64 points overall ... Iowa State earned the remaining first-place vote and came in second in the rankings with 55 points.

UT's 2012 ALL-AMERICANS

Four members of the Texas Volleyball program earned 2012 AVCA All-American status. **Bailey Webster** and **Haley Eckerman** earned first team honors while **Khat Bell** and Sha'Dare McNeal earned honorable mention recognition.

HORNS CLAIM 2012 BIG 12 HONORS

Haley Eckerman was named 2012 Big 12 Player of the Year, becoming the fourth straight Texas player to earn the honor. Eckerman earned All-Big 12 First Team honors, along with **Khat Bell**, Sha'Dare McNeal and **Bailey Webster**. **Molly McCage** was named to the All-Freshman Team.

HOME SWEET HOME

Success on their home court is nothing new for the Longhorns ... dating back to the 1974 season, Texas has won 82.6 percent of its matches in Austin, sporting an overall record of 498-104-1 ... the Horns are even more successful in Gregory Gym, boasting a winning percentage of .861 (317-51) ... **since the 2007 season, Texas has lost only four matches in Gregory Gym.**

HEAD OF THE (RECRUITING) CLASS

Head coach **Jerritt Elliott** has landed a top-five ranked recruiting class in each of the last eight seasons (PrepVolleyball.com) ... Elliott brought in the nation's No. 1-ranked recruiting class in 2011, its second-ranked recruiting class in 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2012, while adding the nation's No 5 class in 2009, 2010 and 2013.

FAB 50 INVADES AUSTIN

Of the 15 members of the Texas Volleyball team, 10 of them are former *Volleyball Magazine* Fab 50 recruits ... seniors **Bailey Webster** and **Hannah Allison**, juniors **Khat Bell** and **Haley Eckerman**, sophomores **Nicole Dalton**, **Sara Hattis**, **Molly McCage** and **Amy Neal**, and freshmen **Chloe Collins** and **Chiaka Ogbogu** were named to the prestigious list following their senior seasons.

GREGORY GYM IS THE PLACE TO BE

UT has ranked in the top 10 nationally in attendance average in each of the last nine seasons (6th in 2009 and 2011, 7th in 2010, 9th in 2004, 2006-07 and 10th in 2005, 2008 and 2012) ... in 2009, Texas welcomed a UT record 3,035 fans per-match into Gregory Gym, marking the highest season attendance average in program history ... **4,373 fans packed Gregory Gymnasium on Sept. 7, 2013, to watch Texas defeat No. 1 Penn State (3-2), marking the largest crowd to witness a volleyball match in Gregory Gymnasium's current configuration** ... there have been eight sell-outs in program history, with the last occurring Oct. 19, 2013, vs. Iowa State.

THE JERRITT ELLIOTT FILE

Head coach **Jerritt Elliott** is in his 13th season at the helm of the Longhorns Volleyball program ... Elliott has compiled a 313-81 (.794) record at Texas to go with his 15-year career record of 363-93 (.796) ... **in 2012, Elliott was named AVCA Division I National Coach of the Year for the first time in his career after leading the Longhorns to their third national championship** ... Elliott is the only coach in the country to lead his team to the NCAA Regional finals in each of the last seven NCAA Championship (2006-12) ... with a 3-0 victory against Texas Tech on Nov. 14, 2007, Elliott recorded both his 200th career victory and his 150th career UT victory ... with a 3-2 win at Illinois on Sept. 14, 2013, Elliott recorded both his 350th career victory and his 300th career UT victory ... **Elliott is one of just five coaches all-time to lead two different programs to the NCAA Semifinals after accomplishing the feat three times at Texas (2008-10, 2012) and once as the interim head coach at USC (2000).**

HORNS' HOUSE

After an eight-year renovation that was completed in 1998, Gregory Gym returned as the home for the Texas Volleyball program ... UT has averaged over 2,000 fans annually since 2005 with the 2009 season boasting a school-record average of 3,035 fans ... with a capacity of 4,000, the 2013 season marks the second with a brand-new, state-of-the-art Daktronics scoreboard located on the west end of the gym.
