## NOTES AT A GLANCE

- Texas begins its 40th season of Women's Basketball when it plays host to UTSA on Sunday. The Longhorns lead the series with UTSA, 3-0.
- Entering the 2013-14 season, Texas is the seventh-winningest program in NCAA Women's Basketball history with a 935-344 (.731) record through 39 seasons. Since joining the NCAA in 1977, Texas has an 897-329 (.732) record.
- UT is 29-10 (.744) in season openers and 35-4 (.897) in home openers. Under Karen Aston, Texas is 1-0 in both season and home openers.
- The Longhorns have opened the season at home in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- All five starters from the 2012-13 season return for the Longhorns (**Celina Rodrigo, Empress Davenport, Chassidy Fussell, Nneka Enemkpali, Imani McGee-Stafford**).
- Texas has an all-time home record of 470-93 (.835).
- Guard **Chassidy Fussell** has led the Longhorns in scoring in each of the last three seasons, entering her senior year with 1,405 career points (15.6 ppg).
- Sophomore **Imani McGee-Stafford** was named to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team and junior **Nneka Enemkpali** was named Honorable Mention Preseason All-Big 12. Last season the duo co-led UT in rebounding (9.4 rpg) and accounted for 26 double-doubles (13 each).
- Texas is receiving votes in the preseason Associated Press top 25. Big 12 coaches picked Texas fifth in the conference preseason poll.
- Texas adds five newcomers for the 2013-14 season -- guard **Brianna Taylor**, forward **Nekia Jones**, center **Kelsey Lang**, center **Lilley Vander Zee** and junior guard **Krystle Henderson**. Taylor, Jones and Lang are respectively ranked as the Nos. 46, 58 and 91 overall recruits in the class of 2013, according to *ESPN.com*. Henderson is a transfer from Trinity Valley CC, where she led the Cardinals to the 2013 NJCAA Division I title.

AUSTIN, Texas (AP) -- Brittainey Raven was suspended for the first half of Texas' season opener against Texas-San Antonio because she overslept and missed a class this week.

She returned in time to wake up the Longhorns.

Raven scored 11 points and No. 12 Texas rallied for a 71-60 victory Friday night.

"I did oversleep, but as a captain, leader, and a senior, I should have gotten up and gone to class," Raven said. "I apologized to my teammates and it will not happen again."

Ashley Gayle had 12 points and six rebounds for the Longhorns. Ashleigh Fontenette added 10 points and five assists.

With Raven on the sideline for missing a class this week, Texas trailed 31-28 at halftime. But she entered at the 17:56 mark and helped spark a 25-11 run in the first 10 minutes of the second half.

"Brittainey does a great job creating shots for herself, and for others," Texas coach Gail Goestenkor said. "She is great at finding the shooters on the floor."

Amber Gregg had 12 points for Roadrunners (0-1), who shot just 28 percent in the second half. Ashleigh Franklin had 10 points and 12 rebounds and Whitney York also scored 10.

"Texas played extremely well in the second half," UTSA coach Rae Rippetoe-Blair said. "Their zone definitely bothered us. We could not get a shot off."

## UTSA SERIES

- Texas and UTSA will meet for the fourth time on Sunday and the first time since 2009.
- The Longhorns won the previous three meetings against the Roadrunners.
- In the last meeting, No. 12 Texas came back from a 3-point halftime deficit to defeat UTSA, 71-60, in its season opener on Nov. 13, 2009 in Austin. Brittainey Raven scored 11 second-half points (4-4 FG) for UT in the comeback win.

## LONE STAR STATE SUCCESS

- The Longhorns have emerged as the dominant college basketball program in the state of Texas in its 40 years of existence.
- The Horns have posted a 414-97 (.810) record against current NCAA Division I in-state foes in the program's history, including marks of 3-0 against UTSA, 31-0 against TCU, 57-25 against Baylor, 61-27 against Texas Tech and 60-23 against Texas A&M.
- Texas is undefeated against North Texas (12-0), Sam Houston State (7-0), TCU (31-0), Texas A&M-Corpus Christi (5-0), Texas Southern (4-0) and UTSA (3-0).

#### 40TH SEASON OF WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- Texas Women's Basketball tips off its 40th season of intercollegiate basketball when it plays host to UTSA on Sunday, Nov. 10, 2013.
- Texas holds an all-time record of 935-344 (.731) in its previous 39 years of competition.
- UT has had just four head coaches over a 40-year span -- Rod Page (1974-76), Jody Conradt (1976-2007), Gail Goestenors (2007-12) and Karen Aston (2012-present).
- In the 31 years Women's Basketball has been an NCAA-sanctioned sport, Texas has made 26 NCAA tournament appearances, three Final Fours and won one NCAA title (1986).
- The Longhorns have won 12 conference regular season titles and 10 conference tournament titles.
- In the program's first game, Texas defeated Huston-Tillotson, 68-17, on Nov. 26, 1974.
- Entering the 2013-14 season, Texas is the seventh-winningest program in NCAA Women's Basketball history with its 935-344 (.731) record in 39 seasons. Since joining the NCAA in 1977, Texas has an 897-329 (.732) record.

#### SEASON / HOME OPENERS

- In season openers, Texas is 29-10 (.744) all-time, including a 13-4 (.765) mark since 1996-97 (Big 12 era).
- In home openers, Texas is 35-4 (.897) all-time, including a 14-3 (.824) mark since 1996-97 (Big 12 era).
- The Longhorns have opened the season at home in nine of the last 10 seasons.
- When Texas Women's Basketball was established in 1974-75, the Longhorns began with 10 consecutive season-opening wins (1974-83) and 16 consecutive home-opening wins (1974-89).
- UT has won six of the last seven season and homeopeners, respectively.
- Under Karen Aston, Texas is 1-0 in both season and home openers.
- Last season, UT opened the season with a 70-60 win over No. 14/13 St. John's (11/9/12) at the WBI Tip Off Classic in Daytona Beach, Fla., and opened the home schedule with an 80-53 victory over Jackson State (11/20/12).

#### EXHIBITION NOTES

- Texas defeated Midwestern State by 44 points, 119-75, in an exhibition game on Oct. 31 in Austin.
- Six Longhorns scored in double figures, including Chassidy Fussell's game-high 24 points (8-12 FG, 4-7 3FG) in 28 minutes.
- The Longhorns scored 41 points off the bench and out-scored MSU 23-to-1 in second-chance points and 54-to-22 in points in the paint.
- Texas held MSU to 32.1 percent shooting from the field (17-53 FG), while shooting 59.4 percent on the offensive end (41-69 FG).
- GiGi Mazonite came off the bench to record a double-double of 17 points (10-13 FT) and 14 rebounds in 25 minutes.
- Nneka Enemkpali scored 18 points (8-9 FG) and six rebounds in just 13 minutes.
- Celina Rodrigo dished out a game-high 10 assists.

#### TAU ADDED AS A WALK-ON

- Senior walk-on Helen Tau was added to the roster on Oct. 30, 2013.
- Tau served as a manager for UT during the 2012-13 season. The Lake Jackson, Texas native was a four-year letterwinner at Brazoswood High School and former president of Students for Texas Athletics at UT.
- Tau is on track to graduate from the McCombs School of Business in May of 2014.

#### ENEMKPALI, MCGEE-STAFFORD EARN PRESEASON ALL-BIG 12 HONORS

- The Big 12 coaches selected of sophomore Imani McGee-Stafford to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team and junior Nneka Enemkpali as Honorable Mention Preseason All-Big 12.
- Last season, McGee-Stafford was named Big 12 Freshman of the Year and All-Big 12 Honorable Mention after setting a Texas record for blocks by a freshman (75) and leading the team in total rebounds (281) and field goal shooting percentage (.483, 138-286 FG). The Los Angeles product registered 13 double-doubles while averaging 11.1 points and 9.4 rebounds per game.
- Enemkpali was named All-Big 12 Honorable mention after the 2012-13 season, in which she recorded 13 doubles-doubles and set a Texas record for most consecutive double-doubles (six) in the first six games of the season. The Pflugerville, Texas native led Texas in total points (377), while averaging 13.0 points and 9.4 rebounds per game.
- Baylor's Odyssey Sims was named Preseason Player of the Year, Oklahoma State's Marisha Wallace was awarded Preseason Newcomer of the year and Baylor's Ileshia Small was tabbed Preseason Freshman of the Year.
- Texas was picked to finish fifth in the Big 12 coaches poll.

#### RETURNING ALL FIVE STARTERS

- All five starters from the 2012-13 season return for the Longhorns (Celina Rodrigo, Empress Davenport, Chassidy Fussell, Nneka Enemkpali, Imani McGee-Stafford).

#### INJURY REPORT

- Due to injury, the two players are sidelined and one is listed as questionable for Sunday's season opener against UTSA.
- Freshman Brianna Taylor (out) sustained a right ankle injury on Sept. 14 and will be reevaluated by doctors next week.
- Freshman Nekia Jones (out) sustained a right foot injury on Sept. 24 and will be reevaluated by doctors next week.
- Senior Ashley Roberts (questionable) is nearing the end of rehab after sustaining an articular cartilage injury on a previously ACL-reconstructed left knee last season (Jan. 19, 2013 at OU). Roberts has been released for sport-specific activities on a limited basis.

Karen Aston returned to the institution where she originally carved her reputation as an energetic leader and relentless recruiter in 2012, becoming just the fourth Texas Women's Basketball head coach in program history.

In year-one as head of the Texas program, Aston laid the foundation for the Longhorns' return to national prominence. Her first recruiting class at UT featured three starters and the 2013 Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Imani McGee-Stafford.

Aston, an eight-year assistant to Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame coach Jody Conradt, was instrumental in the Longhorns' trip to the 2003 NCAA Women's Basketball Final Four and a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in 2002 and 2004.

She returned to the Forty Acres in 2012 after five years of experience reviving the women's basketball programs at Charlotte and the University of North Texas.

Aston tripled the Mean Green's victory total in one season, as UNT went 15-16 during the 2011-12 season under her direction after winning just five games the previous year. At Charlotte, Aston led the program to record-breaking heights, with 86 victories in four seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 2010-11.

Aston led the 49ers to four-straight postseason appearances and the 2009 Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship en route to the school's second ever NCAA Tournament appearance. In her final season at Charlotte, Aston's squad advanced to the WNIT Final Four.

While on Conradt's Texas staff from 1998-2006, Aston saw the Longhorns post a 173-83 (.676) record during that span, with seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two trips to the "Sweet 16" and a march to the 2003 Final Four. The Longhorns also captured the 2003 Big 12 regular season and tournament titles, and UT shared the 2004 Big 12 regular season title. Aston was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach in July of 2000 after serving as UT's assistant coach for two seasons.

Aston spearheaded UT's signing of 25 nationally-recognized recruits, including seven McDonald's High School All-Americans and seven WBCA/Nike All-Americans. Two of those high school All-Americans - Tiffany Jackson and Erika Arriaran - were named National High School Players of the Year. All eight of the recruiting classes Aston attracted were nationally ranked, including the No. 1 class in the nation in 2005-06.

Aston originally came to Austin from the University of North Texas, where she served as an assistant coach for two seasons (1996-98). Prior to joining the North Texas staff, Aston was an assistant coach at Baylor for two seasons (1994-96).

Following Aston's stint on the Forty Acres, she was named associate head coach at Baylor during the 2006-07 season. With Aston on board, the Lady Bears won 26 games and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Before entering the collegiate coaching ranks, Aston was recognized as one of the top high school women's coaches in the south. She coached five years at Vilonia

High School (1988-93) in Vilonia, Ark., and one year at Fort Smith Northside (1993-94) in Fort Smith, Ark. She guided Fort Smith Northside to a 24-10 record and a fifth-place finish in Class 4A. For her efforts, she was named the Arkansas Northwest Region Coach of the Year.

While at Vilonia, Aston was not only the head basketball coach but also the head cross country and track coach. In 1992-93, she was named the Arkansas Basketball Coach of the Year after leading Vilonia to a 36-1 record and a Class 2A State Championship. Aston's cross country teams also claimed back-to-back state titles in 1991 and 1992.

A native of Benton, Ark., Aston was a two-time first-team all-state selection at Bryant High School. She capped her high school career by leading Bryant to the 1982 Arkansas Class 4A State Championship. Aston earned a Bachelors of Arts degree in physical education from Arkansas-Little Rock in 1987. She played two seasons of basketball at UALR after transferring from Ouachita Baptist.
