NOTABLES

- **HOLMES NEARS 1,000 POINTS:** Senior forward **Jonathan Holmes** enters Monday's game just 13 points shy of reaching the 1,000-point mark in his career. He will become the 34th player in UT history to reach the milestone.
- SUCCESS AGAINST RICE: Texas has won nine consecutive games against the Owls. The Horns have won 16 of the last 17 and 31 of the last 36 meetings in the series. UT is a perfect 8-0 against Rice during the Rick Barnes era.
- FELIX FINDING THE RANGE: Junior guard Javan Felix has averaged 18.0 points while hitting 13-of-25 (.520) field goals, including 5-of-13 (.385) from three-point range, in 32.0 minutes per game over the last two contests.

RICE SERIES INFO

- Monday's contest marks the 197th meeting between Texas and Rice
- The Horns own a 137-59 advantage in the all-time series, which dates back to a 28-14 UT victory on Feb. 3, 1915 in Austin.
- Rice is UT's third-most common opponent in program history (behind Baylor and Texas A&M).
- Texas has won nine consecutive games against the Owls.
 The Horns have won 16 of the last 17 and 31 of the last 36 meetings in the series.
- UT owns a 75-21 advantage in games played in Austin during the series.
- The Horns are 8-0 against Rice during the Rick Barnes era, including a 66-44 win in Austin last year (Dec. 30, 2013).

LONE STAR STATE SUCCESS

- Since Rick Barnes arrived in Austin prior to the 1998-99 season, the Longhorns have emerged as the dominant college basketball program in the state of Texas.
- The Horns have posted a 142-21 (.871) record against instate foes during the Barnes era entering Monday's game, including marks of 29-8 against Baylor, 30-4 against Texas Tech, 23-7 against Texas A&M and 6-0 against TCU.

HORNS AT HOME

- UT is currently in its 38th season of play at the Frank Erwin Center.
- Texas had its 15-game home win streak snapped in Tuesday's loss to Stanford.
- The Longhorns have registered an all-time record of 457-105 (.813) in the building.
- Since Rick Barnes arrived in Austin, UT has recorded a 232-33 (.875) mark at the Erwin Center, including a 107-24 (.817) record in Big 12 Conference home games.
- Texas is 185-22 (.894) at the Erwin Center in the last 13 seasons (dating to the start of the 2002-03 season).

STANFORD POSTGAME NOTES

- Texas had its 15-game home win streak snapped in the loss.
- UT also had its 54-game home non-conference win streak against unranked (AP) opponents snapped. The streak dated back to a 67-66 loss to Wisconsin on Dec. 29, 2007.

- Texas had its streak of four consecutive overtime victories snapped in the defeat.
- The Horns recorded nine blocks in the game. Texas has posted at least seven blocks in nine of its last 11 contests.
- Stanford became the first UT opponent this year to score more than 70 points (74, had 64 at end of regulation) and convert better than 40 percent from the floor (.433).
- Texas converted 88.2% (15-of-17) from the free throw line. This marked the fifth time this season that UT has hit at least 80% from the stripe.
- **Javan Felix** reached double figures in scoring (19 points) for the fifth time this year and 34th time in his career (70 games). His 19 points marked a season high.
- **Jonathan Holmes** reached double figures in scoring (14 points) for the eighth time this year and 49th in his career (107 games).
- Cameron Ridley set a season high in blocks (four).
- **Kendal Yancy** reached double figures in scoring (14 points) for the second time this year and fifth time in his career (46 games). He set career highs in points and field goals made (6-of-10) and tied his career high in minutes played (34).

CHECK OF THE POLLS

- Texas is ranked No. 9 in the most recent AP poll (Dec. 22) and No. 9 in the most recent USA Today coaches' poll (Dec. 22).
- During the Rick Barnes era, the Horns have spent 187 weeks in The AP Top 25, including 91 in the Top 10.
- Texas was ranked No. 10 in The Associated Press preseason poll. This marked the first time the Horns have appeared in the AP preseason poll since the 2009-10 season, when UT began the year at No. 3.
- Texas has now made 15 appearances in school history in the AP preseason poll. Prior to its four-year absence from the preseason rankings, the Horns were ranked in the AP preseason poll for nine consecutive years (2001-02 through 2009-10).
- UT was ranked No. 10 in the USA Today coaches' preseason poll. This marks the 12th time in the last 14 years that the Horns have been ranked in the coaches' preseason poll. It's the highest preseason coaches' poll ranking for UT since the Longhorns were tabbed No. 3 in 2009-10.

NOTEWORTHY VICTORY AT UCONN

- UT's 55-54 win in Storrs (Nov. 30) snapped a 44-game win streak by the Huskies against non-conference opponents at Gampel Pavilion. The streak dated back to a UConn loss to Detroit-Mercy in the 2001 NIT (March 18, 2001).
- The last time UConn had lost a regular season non-conference game in Gampel to a ranked (AP) opponent came on Feb. 6, 1993 to No. 12 Florida State.
- Prior to the win by Texas, UConn had not lost an on-campus, non-conference game played in November/December since a 91-85 defeat to Holy Cross on Dec. 5, 1973.

2K CLASSIC CHAMPIONS

- Texas captured the 2K Classic benefitting Wounded Warrior Project championship with back-to-back wins against nr/#25 Iowa (71-57) and Cal (71-55) at Madison Square Garden.
- UT captured its first November neutral-site tournament title since the 2009 CBE Classic in Kansas City.

A CONSISTENT DANCER

Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 15 of Rick Barnes' first 16 seasons in Austin. UT has made a total of 31 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (35-34 record). The Horns have earned a bid to the NCAA tourney 23 times in the last 26 years.

AN "ELITE" PROGRAM

Texas has reached the NCAA Elite Eight twice in the last nine years and three times in the last 12 seasons. During the Barnes era, the Horns have made trips to the regional final in 2003 (beat Michigan State to advance to the Final Four), 2006 (lost to LSU in overtime) and 2008 (lost to Memphis). UT has advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight a total of seven times in program history (1939, 1943, 1947, 1990, 2003, 2006 and 2008).

IN "SWEET" COMPANY

Texas has advanced to at least the NCAA Sweet 16 a total of five times in the last 13 years. The Longhorns have advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 a total of 13 times in program history (1939, 1943, 1947, 1960, 1963, 1972, 1990, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008).

DEFENSE WINS

Solid defense has been a trademark of the Texas program under Rick Barnes. Since Barnes arrived in Austin, the Horns have held 274 of their 560 opponents to under 40% FG shooting. **Texas sports a 247-27 (.901) mark in the Barnes era when accomplishing the feat (10-1** mark in 2014-15).

- UT has held its first 12 opponents to an average of 55.1 ppg on a combined 32.5% FG shooting (231-of-711), including a 29.2% mark from three-point range (64-of-219). Texas ranks third nationally in FG percentage defense (.325) through games of Dec. 27.
- The Horns have held 11 of their first 12 opponents to under 70 points **AND** 40% FG shooting.
- Texas limited No. 24/22 Connecticut (Nov. 30) to 54 points on 30.4% FG shooting (17-of-56), including a 3-of-16 (.188) mark from three-point range.
- UT held Saint Francis (Nov. 25) to 46 points on 31.0% FG shooting (18-of-58).
- Texas limited Cal (Nov. 21) to 55 points on 31.3% FG shooting (20-of-64). The Horns held the Golden Bears to 21 points on 24.1% FG shooting (7-of-29) in the first half.
- UT held No. nr/25 Iowa (Nov. 20) to 57 points on 29.6% FG shooting (16-of-54), including a 4-of-14 (.286) mark from three-point range.
- Texas held Alcorn State (Nov. 16) to 53 points on 29.7% FG shooting (19-of-64).
- Texas limited North Dakota State (Nov. 14) to 50 points on 27.4% FG shooting (17-of-62).

HISTORICALLY GOOD DEFENSE

- Texas held each of its first seven opponents to below 60 points. The streak was snapped in UT's 63-51 loss at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- The last time UT held its first seven opponents under 60 points to open a season was 1950-51. Texas held all 27 of its opponents that year to below 60 points.

RECORD-SETTING DEFENSE

- Texas limited Texas State (Dec. 13) to 27 points on 21.6% FG shooting (11-of-51).
- The 27 points marked the fewest points Texas has allowed since Dec. 6, 1946 (53-23 home win against Houston YMCA).
- It marked the first time UT had held an opponent below 30 points since Feb. 25, 1948 (32-29 home victory against Baylor).
- UT held the Bobcats to just nine points on 16.0% FG shooting (4-of-25) in the first half. **This marked the fewest points allowed in a half by the Longhorns since the start of the 1949-50 season** (as far back as the school has box scores and records in a half). The previous mark for fewest points allowed in a half was 10 (2nd half vs. Nicholls State on Dec. 13, 2011; 2nd half vs. Baylor on Jan. 21, 1984). The previous mark for fewest points allowed in a first half was 11 (vs. Arkansas-Monticello on Nov. 18, 2007).
- The 21.6% FG shooting marked the third-lowest FG percentage allowed by UT in a game since the start of the 1949-50 season.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Texas sports a +14.6 rebound margin (44.3-29.8) through the first 12 games this year and has outrebounded its opponent in 11 of its first 12 contests. The rebound margin (+14.6) ranks second nationally through games of Dec. 27.
- UT has posted double-digit rebound margins in nine of its first 12 games this season.
- The Horns posted a +27 rebound advantage (55-28) against Lipscomb.
- Texas recorded a +24 rebound margin (45-21) against Texas State (Dec. 13).
- The Horns registered a +11 rebound margin (42-31) at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5). The Wildcats entered the game with a +14.6 rebound margin.
- Texas posted a +27 (52-25) rebound margin against UT Arlington (Dec. 2). The Horns grabbed more offensive boards (28) than UTA had total rebounds (25).

BLOCK PARTY

UT ranked 11th nationally in total blocked shots (206) and 14th nationally in blocks per game (5.9 bpg) last year. **The Horns set a single-season team record with 206 blocks in 2013-14** (previous mark: 203 in 1997-98).

- UT has averaged 7.8 blocks per contest in its first 12 games this year (93 total blocks). Texas ranks third nationally in blocks per game (thru games of Dec. 27).
- The Horns have posted at least seven blocks in nine of their last 11 contests.
- UT set a single-game record for most blocked shots in a half (10) during the first half against Lipscomb (Dec. 16). The Horns recorded 11 blocked shots for the game.
- Texas tied a single-game school record with 13 blocks in the win against UT Arlington (Dec. 2). The Horns also blocked 13 shots vs. UTSA on Dec. 29, 2004 and vs. Cal on Nov. 15, 2000.
- UT recorded eight blocked shots at No. 24/22 UConn (Nov. 30).
- Texas registered 10 blocks against Cal (Nov. 21). Six different Longhorns recorded a blocked shot during that contest.

CENTURY CLUB SUCCESS

- Texas topped the 100-point mark (106-61 win) against Lipscomb (Dec. 16) for the 109th time in school history. UT improved to 100-9 all-time when reaching the century mark, including a 65-1 mark in home games.
- The Horns reached the 100-point plateau for the first time since Nov. 15, 2011 (100-90 home win against UT Arlington).

BALANCE AND DEPTH

- Seven UT players in the current rotation (NOT including the injured Isaiah Taylor) are averaging at least 5.8 points per game through the first 12 contests.
- Five players reached double-figure scoring against Long Beach State (Dec. 20).
- All nine scholarship players who were active for the Lipscomb game (Dec. 16) scored at least five points.
- Five different UT players scored at least 20 points in a game during the 2013-14 season (Javan Felix, Demarcus Holland, Jonathan Holmes, Cameron Ridley and Isaiah Taylor).

HOLMES LEADS BY CONSISTENT EXAMPLE

The lone scholarship senior on this year's roster, forward **Jonathan Holmes** is in his fourth year as a starter in the frontcourt. In his career, Holmes has reached double figures in scoring 49 times and in rebounds 11 times and has six career double-doubles.

- Holmes leads the team in scoring (12.6 ppg) and ranks third in rebounding (6.4 rpg) in 25.8 mpg while hitting 21-of-46 (.457) from three-point range and 34-of-44 (.773) free throws.
- Holmes registered 17 points (4-of-8 FG, 7-of-7 FT), six boards and three blocks in 18 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- He tied his career high in rebounds (16) and blocks (three) against UT Arlington (Dec. 2). Nine of his 16 boards came on the offensive glass.
- Holmes set a career high with five assists against Saint Francis (Nov. 25).
- He recorded 15 points (5-of-6 FG, 2-of-3 threes, 3-of-3 FT) and six boards in 15 minutes against North Dakota State (Nov. 14).

HOLMES NEARS 1,000-POINT MILESTONE

Jonathan Holmes enters Monday's game against Rice just 13 points shy of reaching the 1,000-career point milestone. Holmes has played in 107 career games (89 starts) and recorded 987 career points (9.2 ppg). He will become the 34th player in UT history to join the 1,000-point club.

LAST-SECOND HEROICS FOR HOLMES ... AGAIN

Jonathan Holmes connected on the game-winning three-pointer from the left corner with 2.2 seconds left during the win at No. 24/22 Connecticut (Nov. 30). This marked Holmes' second collegiate game-winning shot, either at the buzzer or within the final three seconds of regulation. Last year (Jan. 21, 2014), he converted a three-pointer from the right corner as time expired to lift Texas to a 67-64 home win against No. 22 Kansas State. In addition,

Holmes also hit a game-tying three-pointer with three seconds left in regulation to force overtime in a home contest against West Virginia (Jan. 9, 2013) during his sophomore campaign.

HOLMES SHINES IN THE BIG APPLE

Jonathan Holmes claimed 2K Classic Tournament MVP honors, averaging 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game while hitting 13-of-23 (.565) field goals, including 4-of-8 (.500) threes, and 10-of-13 (.769) free throws during the two contests at Madison Square Garden.

- Holmes also earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week (Nov. 24) accolades for his performance in New York City.
- He had a team-high 19 points (7-of-12 FG, 3-of-5 threes) and five boards in 31 minutes against No. nr/25 Iowa (Nov. 20). Holmes scored 17 of his 19 points in the second half (6-of-8 FG, 3-of-4 threes in final 20 minutes).
- Holmes tallied a game-high 21 points (6-of-11 FG, 8-of-10 FT), 13 rebounds and two blocks in 32 minutes against Cal (Nov. 21) in the title game.

HOLLAND IS THE GLUE

Junior **Demarcus Holland** has played in all 81 career games (59 starts) in his first three seasons. Holland has started the last 47 games. He earned the team's Most Outstanding Defensive Player award in each of his first two seasons. In his career, Holland has reached double figures in scoring 16 times and in rebounds three times.

- Holland leads the team in assists (32) and minutes (31.1 mpg) and is tied for fourth in scoring (8.3 ppg) while hitting 32-of-62 (.516) field goals, including 10-of-19 (.526) from three-point range, and 26-of-34 (.765) free throws.
- He set a career high with eight assists against just two turnovers while adding nine points in 28 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- Holland registered 10 points (5-of-5 FT), four rebounds (three offensive), five assists against one turnover and two steals in 38 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- He had 11 points (7-of-7 FT) and five rebounds in 35 minutes during the 2K Classic title game against Cal (Nov. 21).

TURNER OFF TO SOLID START

Freshman forward **Myles Turner** leads the team in blocked shots (35 total, 2.92 bpg) and ranks second in scoring (11.7 ppg) and rebounding (6.8 rpg) through the first 12 contests. He has converted 44-of-49 (.898) free throws while averaging 20.9 mpg coming off the bench.

- Turner has made 20 consecutive free throws entering Monday's game. The streak dates back to the UTA game (Dec. 2).
- He has recorded at least five blocked shots in four of his first 12 contests.
- Turner tallied a season-high 26 points (9-of-15 FG, 7-of-7 FT), nine boards and six blocks in 23 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).

- He posted 18 points (14-of-17 FT), 10 rebounds (six offensive) and five blocks in 22 minutes against UT Arlington (Dec. 2).
- He had 10 points (4-of-7 FG), seven boards and six blocks in 20 minutes against Alcorn State (Nov. 16). His six blocks were one shy of the UT freshman mark (shared by Chris Mihm and Tristan Thompson).
- Turner tallied 15 points (6-of-8 FG, 3-of-4 FT), six rebounds and two blocks in 20 minutes against North Dakota State (Nov. 14). The 15 points were just five shy of the UT record for most in a collegiate debut (20 by Kevin Durant in 2006-07).
- Turner has been named (along with Isaiah Taylor) to the John R. Wooden Award presented by Wendy's Preseason Top 50 (Nov. 17) and the Naismith Trophy Men's 50 Watch List (Dec. 3).

TURNER'S RECORD NIGHT

Myles Turner recorded his first career double-double with 25 points (11-of-12 FG, 3-of-3 threes), 10 rebounds, three blocks, two assists and one steal in 25 minutes during the home win against Saint Francis (Nov. 25).

Turner tied the UT single-game record for highest FG percentage (min. 10 attempts). He converted 11-of-12 (.917) field goal attempts. That tied the mark set by Butch Skeete at SMU on Feb. 6, 1962 (11-of-12 FG).

LAMMERT PLAYING A LARGER ROLE

Junior Connor Lammert has played in all 81 career games (25 starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring 10 times and in rebounds five times and has two double-doubles.

- Lammert leads the team in rebounding (7.5 rpg) and ranks fourth in assists (22) through the first 12 games.
- He recorded his second career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds (one shy of his career high) in 27 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 20).
- Lammert posted 10 rebounds to go along with seven points and two assists in 29 minutes against Texas State (Dec. 13).
- He registered nine rebounds (four offensive) in 34 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- Lammert tallied 11 points (3-of-4 FG, 4-of-4 FT) and six boards in 24 minutes against Saint Francis (Nov. 25).
- He set a career high with seven assists without a turnover to go along with eight points in 17 minutes against Alcorn State (Nov. 16). Six of his seven assists came in the first half.

TAYLOR INJURY UPDATE

Sophomore point guard Isaiah Taylor suffered a left wrist injury during the win against Iowa (Nov. 20). He is out indefinitely (no timetable for his return but this is not a season-ending injury).

TAYLOR TIDBITS

Isaiah Taylor started the first 38 games of his career prior to suffering his wrist injury against Iowa (Nov. 20). Taylor earned All-Big 12 Honorable Mention and Big 12 All-Newcomer Team accolades as a freshman. He led the team in assists (4.0 apg) and minutes (30.1 mpg) and ranked second in scoring (12.7 ppg) and steals (37) last season. Taylor had five 20-point performances and reached double figures in scoring a team-best 27 times as a freshman. He sported a 141-to-83 (1.7-to-1) assist-to-turnover ratio and dished out at least five assists in a game 15 times last year.

- Taylor reached double figures in scoring in each of UT's first three games this year. He averaged 15.0 ppg to go along with 4.0 rpg and 3.0 apg in 25.0 mpg while hitting 16-of-30 (.533) field goals, including 4-of-8 threes, and 9-of-11 (.818) free throws.
- He recorded 15 points (11 in second half) against Iowa (Nov. 20).
- Taylor posted a game-high 18 points (6-of-11 FG, 2-of-3 threes, 4-of-4 FT) and seven rebounds (one shy of career high) in 28 minutes against North Dakota State (Nov. 14). Sixteen of his 18 points came in the second half.
- He appeared on a regional cover of Sports Illustrated in early November. Texas was one of five schools selected for a regional cover in the magazine's annual College Basketball Preview issue, joining Arizona, Duke, Kentucky and Wisconsin.
- Taylor was one of 36 players named to the preseason watch list of candidates for the 2015 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball.
- Taylor has been named (along with Myles Turner) to the John R. Wooden Award presented by Wendy's Preseason Top 50 (Nov. 17) and the Naismith Trophy Men's 50 Watch List (Dec. 3).

THE FELIX FILE

Junior Javan Felix has played in 79 career games (48 starts). In his career, Felix has reached double figures in scoring 34 times, including six 20-point performances.

- He recorded a season-high 19 points (7-of-16 FG, 3-of-4 FT) and two assists without a turnover in 31 minutes against Stanford (Dec. 23).
- Felix tallied a team-high 17 points (6-of-9 FG, 3-of-5 threes), four rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes against Long

- Beach State (Dec. 20).
- He posted 10 points (4-of-6 FG, 2-of-2 threes) and three assists in 24 minutes against Texas State (Dec. 13).

BARNETT MAKING STRIDES

Freshman forward **Jordan Barnett** has played in 10 of the first 12 contests and is averaging 2.3 points and 1.6 rebounds in 10.1 minutes per game.

 Barnett had a season-high 11 points (4-of-5 FG, 3-of-3 threes), four rebounds, one assist and two steals in a season-high 24 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).

TRIO OF FRESH FACES

- Freshman forward **Jordan Barnett** was tabbed the No. 86 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN following his senior year at Christian Brothers College High School (St. Louis, Mo.). Barnett averaged 20.8 points, 8.2 rebounds and nearly two blocks per game while leading CBC to a 25-7 record and the Missouri Class 5 state championship as a senior. He recorded 43 points, 20 rebounds and three blocks in the 86-77 overtime win against Columbia Hickman in the state title game.
- Junior forward **Shaquille Cleare** (**pronounced CLAIR**) spent his first two years at Maryland before transferring to Texas prior to the fall semester. He will sit out the 2014-15 season due to NCAA transfer rules. Cleare will have two years of eligibility remaining, beginning with the 2015-16 season. He was tabbed the No. 30 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN following his senior year at The Village School (Houston, Texas). Cleare was a high school teammate of UT guard **Isaiah Taylor** during Cleare's senior season (Taylor's junior year).
- Freshman forward **Myles Turner** was tabbed the No. 2 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN following his senior year at Euless Trinity High School (Bedford, Texas). The 16th McDonald's All-American and 11th Jordan Brand All-American in UT history, Turner also was a member of the U.S. team at the Nike Hoop Summit this past spring. He averaged 18.1 points, 12.2 rebounds and 6.8 blocks per game as a senior while leading Trinity to a 24-7 record.

THREE-POINT STREAK

The last time Texas did not convert a three-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC-Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc on that day. **The Longhorns enter Monday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 803 consecutive games.** In fact, UT has converted at least one three-pointer in 931 of 937 games since the trey was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season. The Horns have failed to attempt at least one three-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988; at TCU, 69-55 win).

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

 Texas Basketball has received public recognition awards for its multi-year NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last five years (2010-14). The awards are given to teams scoring in the Top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sport. UT has earned a perfect 1,000 score in each of the last five multi-year APR reports. In addition, Men's Basketball has posted perfect 1,000 APR single-year scores in EVERY season dating back to 2005-06 (eight consecutive years).

- The Men's Basketball team's semester GPA in Spring 2014 was a 3.33 (4.0 scale), the highest single-semester team GPA in program history. The team entered the 2014 Fall semester with a cumulative GPA of 3.20.
- Four UT players earned a spot on the 2014 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team. Connor Lammert was named to the First Team, while Javan Felix, Demarcus Holland and Prince Ibeh were each selected to the Second Team.

SUCCESS IN THE BIG 12 UNDER BARNES

Since head coach Rick Barnes took over the Longhorns in 1998-99, Texas is the second-winningest team in regular season Big 12 Conference games over the last 16 years with 178 wins.

CONSISTENT SUCCESS IN THE BIG 12

Texas has reached the 10-win mark in Big 12 Conference play a total of 11 times in the first 16 seasons under Rick Barnes (the first 13 years featured 16-game league schedules). The Horns have recorded at least nine league wins in all but one of Barnes' 16 seasons in Austin. UT has recorded at least 13 conference victories in six of Barnes' 16 seasons in Austin (13-3 in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11).

BEATING THE BEST

UT's win at No. 2 Kansas on Jan. 22, 2011 equaled the highest-ranked (AP) opponent the Longhorns have defeated in school history. Six of Texas' nine all-time wins against AP Top Three teams have come during the Rick Barnes era.

HORNS REACH 20-WIN MARK ... AGAIN

With their 24-11 mark last year, the Longhorns reached the 20-win mark for the 14th time in 16 seasons under coach Rick Barnes.

UT had a school-record streak of 13 consecutive 20-win seasons snapped in 2012-13. Prior to that streak, the previous school mark for most consecutive 20-win seasons was four (1988-89 to 1991-92). The Longhorns have reached the 20-win plateau of total of 29 times in their previous 108 seasons of basketball.

UT INKS GUARD DUO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Eric Davis (Saginaw, Mich.) and **Kerwin Roach** (Houston, Texas) signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. The guard duo will join the Longhorns for the 2015-16 season.

- Davis (6-3, 172), a guard from Saginaw Arthur Hill High School who plays under coach Greg McMath, is ranked as the No. 41 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 42 by 247Sports and No. 53 by Rivals.com. He averaged 27 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals per game in his junior year while leading Arthur Hill to the Saginaw Valley League championship. Davis earned Michigan Class A Player of the Year honors as a junior.
- Roach (6-3, 160), a guard from Houston's North Shore High School who plays under coach David Green, is ranked as the No. 35 overall prospect in the nation by Rivals.com and No. 71 by 247Sports. He averaged a team-best 16.1 points per game as a junior while leading North Shore to a 33-3 record and the Class 5A state title. Roach also claimed the 5A state championship in the triple jump last May in Austin.

- Brandon Allums served as a practice player for the Texas women's basketball team in 2012-13.
- Jordan Barnett's father, Bob Bonner, played basketball at Midwestern State University (Wichita Falls, Texas) for four years. Jordan and his mom (Karen Barnett) lived in San Antonio, when Jordan was two-to-six years old.
- Shaquille Cleare's father, Brian, played basketball at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma (Chickasha, Okla.). He wears jersey No. 32 to honor his father, who also wore No. 32 during his collegiate playing days. Cleare was high school teammates with Isaiah Taylor at The Village School (Houston), when Cleare was a senior and Taylor was a junior.
- Javan Felix is oldest of four children (has three younger sisters). The Felix family was forced to relocate to Atlanta for four months while Javan was in sixth grade due to Hurricane Katrina (August 2005). The family was able to return to New Orleans in January 2006. Felix has interest in becoming an NBA General Manager following his playing career.
- **Demarcus Holland** moved to Dallas from Tyler when he was in the second grade. He has one older brother, Derrick, Jr., and three younger brothers, Craig, Desmond and Devon.
- Jonathan Holmes' father, Daryl, played football at the University of Nebraska (lettered in 1980 as a defensive end).
- Prince Ibeh was born in London and lived there for his first five years. He moved with his family to Amarillo, Texas at age five and lived there until he was 10 years old. The family then moved to Dallas when Prince was 10. His parents (Francis and Charity) lived in Mbaise, Nigeria before moving to London in 1987. Prince's middle name is Chinenye (pronounced KENyay). The name in Nigerian means "god's gift." Prince has three older brothers and one younger sister.
- Connor Lammert has an older brother, Clark, who is a senior on the basketball team at Texas Tech. His father, Dean Lammert, played basketball at Texas A&I University (now called Texas A&M University-Kingsville) from 1980-83. His mother, the former Christi Scherrey, played volleyball at Texas A&I University from 1979-82.
- Tarale Murry is the cousin of former UT basketball player Ivan Wagner and former UT football player Wane McGarity.
- Isaiah Taylor's uncle, Terrell Lowery, played basketball at Loyola Marymount (1989-92). As a sophomore on the 1990 LMU squad that advanced to the "Elite Eight" in the NCAA Tournament, Lowery also played professional baseball, including stints with the Chicago Cubs (1997-98), Tampa Bay Devil Rays (1999) and the San Francisco Giants (2000).
- Myles Turner wears jersey No. 52 to honor Habram (huh-BRAUM) Rosario, a close friend and middle school teammate who passed away from leukemia when Myles was in ninth grade (Rosario wore No. 52 on the middle school team).
- Kendal Yancy's brother, Terrel Harris, played basketball at Oklahoma State and went on to play professionally with the Miami Heat (2011-2013) and New Orleans Hornets.

Year 17 at Texas

The all-time winningest coach in UT history, Rick Barnes, is in his 17th season at Texas. He has compiled nearly 600 wins in his 27 years as a head coach at George Mason, Providence, Clemson and Texas. During the 2010-11 season, Barnes earned his 500th career victory and became the 12th active Men's Basketball Division I coach to reach the 500-win milestone (counting victories only while at Division I schools). Barnes has guided his teams to a total of 21 NCAA and three NIT trips.

- UT has recorded at least 13 league victories in seven of Barnes' first 16 seasons in Austin (13-3 in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11). The Longhorns have reached the 10-win mark in Big 12 Conference play a total of 11 times in the 16 seasons under Barnes. Texas posted 9-7 conference marks in 2004-05, 2008-09 and 2009-10 and a 9-9 league record in 2011-12. The Horns have recorded at least nine league wins in 15 of Barnes' first 16 seasons in Austin.
- UT owns a 33-18 (.647) mark against AP Top 25 opponents at the Erwin Center under Barnes.
- Barnes had a personal streak of 17 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances snapped during the 2012-13 season. Barnes reached the NCAA tourney in each of his last three years at Clemson (1996-98) and in each of his first 14 seasons at Texas (1999-2012).
