QUICK HITS

- ALMOST PERFECT VS. IOWA STATE:** The Longhorns own a 39-1 all-time record against Iowa State since the head-to-head series began in 1997. UT's only blemish came in a April 24, 2005 1-0 loss in Austin, which snapped a 20-game win streak against the Cyclones. Since then, Texas has reeled off 19-straight victories over Iowa State. UT has never lost a game in Ames, Iowa, owning a 15-0 mark.
- ROAD SUCCESS:** Texas is tied for the best record in the nation in true road games with a 6-0 mark. The Longhorns are one of only two teams to be undefeated through at least six true road contests (Louisiana Lafayette is also 6-0). Four of UT's six road wins have been against nationally ranked opponents.
- WATCHING WASHINGTON:** On Wednesday, senior center fielder Brejae Washington was named a Top 25 finalist for the 2014 USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Award. The award is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's collegiate softball and is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country. Prior to the start of postseason play, on May 7 the list will be narrowed to the Top 10 Finalists.
- ACCOLADES FOR THOM:** Senior shortstop Taylor Thom was tabbed the Big 12 Player of the Week for her performance during last week's games against Texas State and Texas Tech. Thom helped the Longhorns go 3-1 on the week by hitting an impressive .727 over the four-game stretch, going 8-for-11 at the dish with seven runs scored. She hit three home runs, including her fifth career grand slam in last Wednesday's game against Texas State, and produced nine RBIs. She is the second Longhorn to be honored by the league this season, joining sophomore Lindsey Stephens (March 4).
- TUNNING'S BAT TUNES UP:** Since starting her Texas career with a .197 batting average through the first 34 games, freshman Devon Tunning is showing signs of becoming the hitter the Texas' coaches foresaw. Over the last six games, Tunning leads the team with an .533 batting average (8-for-15), which is tied with Brejae Washington for the second-most hits during that span. Tunning has two home runs over the stretch, including her first career long ball last week against Texas State, which came in a season-best 3-for-3 night.
- AMONG THE NATION'S BEST:** Texas' .348 batting average is the third-highest in the nation. Senior Brejae Washington is ranked sixth in the nation in sacrifice flies (4), ninth in batting average (.474), 12th in on base percentage (.552) while sophomore Lindsey Stephens is ranked eighth in the country in triples (4).
- SETTING THE TONE:** Since being etched in as Texas' 1-2-3 hitters on the lineup card against Cal Poly on Feb. 20, **Taylor Thom, Brejae Washington** and **Lindsey Stephens** are hitting a combined .458 (110-for-240) and have provided 63 of the team's 143 RBIs and scored 76 of the team's 163 runs during that span.
- GETTING ON:** Sophomore **Lindsey Stephens** holds the program's second-longest streak of games reaching base, which currently stands at 40-consecutive games dating back to the final game of last season. Senior **Brejae Washington** also carries a streak of reaching base in 30-straight games, which is the third-longest in school history.
- SLUGGING STEPHENS:** Stephens is currently ranked in nine offensive categories in the Big 12 this season, including first in triples (4) and RBIs (48).
- ACE OF THE STAFF:** After graduates Blaire Luna and Kim Bruins departed from the program last year, it was unclear who UT's go-to pitcher would be in the 2014 season. Freshman **Tiarra Davis**, who is the first lefthanded pitcher at Texas since three-time National Player of the Year Cat Osterman, has emerged as the ace for the Longhorns. Davis is 11-7 with a 2.37 ERA through 27 appearances. Already, she has 13 complete games and has tossed three one-hitters, including her first shutout on March 17 against Iowa. Opposing teams are hitting just .181 against the southpaw, which is the second-lowest in the Big 12.

DID YOU KNOW?

- In just 17 varsity seasons, Texas has made five Women's College World Series (WCWS) appearances and 14 NCAA Regional trips, including each of the last nine years (2005-13).
- UT made its first WCWS in the program's second year of existence, in 1998, setting an NCAA record for fastest ascension to the sport's marquee event.
- Texas has won a league second-best four regular-season crowns (2002, 2003, 2006 and 2010) and added a conference-best four postseason Big 12 Championship titles (1999, 2002, 2003 and 2005).
- The Longhorns have had 10 Easton All-America selections and 17 National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-America honorees. Texas is also the only program in the NCAA to capture three USA Softball National Player of the Year awards.



TEXAS VS. IOWA STATE

- The Longhorns hold a 39-1 advantage in the 40-game head-to-head series with the Cyclones. UT has won 19 straight since suffering its only setback to Iowa State, a 1-0 loss on April 24, 2005 in Austin after winning the first 20 games in the head-to-head series.
- Texas swept last season's three-game series in Austin, winning by counts of 8-0 (5 innings), 12-4 (5 innings) and 7-2
- UT has never lost a game to the Cyclones in Ames.

LAST TIME THEY MET - APRIL 14, 2013

- Two runs batted in from junior Taylor Thom and two more from senior Kim Bruins carried Texas to a 7-2 victory and series sweep over Iowa State at Red & Charline McCombs Field. Senior Blaire Luna's hitless-innings streak was snapped at 20-and-a-third innings during the contest, but she recorded her 21st victory of the campaign.
- Texas improved to 38-4 with the win, tying the 2006 and 2011 squads for the best 42-game record in program history. The Longhorns also upped their record to 8-0 in Big 12 Conference action for just the second time in UT history, joining the 2011 team.
- Luna (21-1) went the distance for the Longhorns, scattering four hits and surrendering a pair of unearned runs. Luna's streak of consecutive starts allowing three or fewer hits was snapped at 10. Riley Fisher (2-7) threw the first two-and-two-thirds innings for Iowa State, surrendering three runs on five hits and five walks. She also struck out one. Madison Jones came in for the next inning-and-a-third, allowing three runs on three hits and a walk. Taylor Smith completed the pitching effort, throwing two innings, allowing a run on four hits.

LAST TIME OUT - VS. TEXAS TECH (APRIL 6, 2014)

- Texas Softball took the series rubber match from the Texas Tech Red Raiders (28-14, 1-5), winning 7-3, on Sunday at Red & Charline McCombs Field to win its first Big 12 Conference series of the season.
- The Longhorns (23-16, 3-1) offense went off for 10 hits on the afternoon, seven of which were for extra-bases. The seven extra-base knocks tied a season high for Texas. The offense was led by the bottom third of the lineup. Comprised of senior Mandy Ogle, freshman Devon Tunning and sophomore Stephanie Ceo, the trio went 6-for-11, collecting a double, two triples and a home run, which accounted for five runs and four RBIs.
- Starting her third game of the weekend, freshman Tiarra Davis hurled a complete game to notch her 11th win on the season. The southpaw struck out eight Red Raiders, allowed four walks, gave up two earned runs and scattered six hits en route to her 13th complete game of the year. On the weekend, Davis struck out 20 batters and allowed six hits, compiling a 2-0 mark.
- Texas opened the scoring in the first inning to take a 1-0 lead. With the bases loaded and one out, Davis hit into a fielder's choice to score senior Brejae Washington. The Longhorns have now scored at least one run in the opening inning in five-straight games.
- The second inning for Texas belonged to the bottom third of the lineup, as the home team plated two more runs to take a 3-0 advantage.
- Ogle led off the inning with a double to center field and scored on Tunning's ensuing triple into the left-center field gap. Ceo followed with a single through the right side of the infield to score Tunning.
- After Texas Tech got one run back in the third inning, Texas cushioned the lead with two more runs in the fourth inning. Ceo legged out a triple to right-center field to lead off the frame. Washington's infield single scored the sophomore second baseman. Sophomore Lindsey Stephens doubled to the right-center gap, scoring Washington, to give Texas the 5-1 lead.
- Stephens (40) and Washington (30) both extended their career-long reached-base streaks. The streaks account for the second and third longest in program history, respectively.
- Ogle and Tunning created more damage at the plate, contributing to two insurance runs in the fifth inning. With Ogle on second base after her lead-off double of the day, Tunning hit a two-run round-tripper over the right-center field wall to stretch the margin to 7-1 after five.
- Texas Tech attempted to rally in the sixth and seventh innings, but Davis was able to limit the Red Raiders to one run each inning. With two runners aboard in the seventh, Davis struck out her eighth batter of the day for the final out to complete the victory.

TEXAS TECH SERIES NOTES

- Compiled 10 extra-base hits (five doubles, three triples, two home runs), while allowing just three.
- Averaged nine hits per game.
- Texas has hit 10 or more hits in 20 of 39 contests this year.
- 22 of 63 outs were strikeouts.
- **Devon Tunning**
 - Drove in a team-best four RBIs, including her second homer of the season and first career triple.
- **Taylor Thom**
 - Led team with a .625 average (5-8) and eight total bases, while tying the team-high with five hits.
 - Slugged 1.000 with four singles and a home run in five at-bats.
- **Stephanie Ceo**
 - Matched Thom with team-high five hits, going .500 with an RBI.
- **Tiarra Davis**
 - Crafted a 2-0 record in three starts, while striking out 20 Red Raider batters.
 - Pitched two complete games to stretch her team-leading total to 13 CGs on the season.

NEXT UP FOR UT

The Longhorns will continue Big 12 play when they open up a three-game series in Norman, Oklahoma on Thursday, April 17 against defending National Champion Oklahoma at 8:00 p.m. CT on ESPN2.

STATS OF NOTE:

- Texas is 17-0 when scoring six or more runs and is 17-0 when holding opponents to two runs or less.
- Washington started the season with six runs through the first eight games. Since then, she has had 31 runs over the last 31 games.
- Taylor Thom - After one triple in her first three years, she has three this season alone.
- Texas' .348 team batting average is currently the highest in program history and is third-best in the nation.



QUOTABLE

- Taylor Thom on having two home runs vs. Texas State: "I was seeing the ball very well tonight. We had three days off since last Wednesday and I think we all felt refreshed, refocused and ready to attack the opportunities the Texas State pitchers gave us. It was a lot of fun out there."
Brejae Washington on her speed on the basepaths: "Speed always kills. I always tell [my teammates], as soon as I get on base, find me a gap and I promise you I'll score. I think that's become a big threat because the pitchers don't really know how to pitch to our next batter because they know if one of our hitters gets a big hit, that's going to score a run."
Assistant coach Corrie Hill on Brejae Washington: "She brings that outstanding speed. There's only a handful of people that are that fast and have the softball skills to go with it. She has Olympic softball speed, is an excellent slider and an excellent reader on the basepaths."

MOVING UP THE WINS CHART ...

ONE CAREER = AT LEAST ONE BIG 12 CONFERENCE TITLE ...

Texas' Big 12 Conference regular season championship in 2010 gave the senior class its first league title during the student-athletes' four-year careers. It also extended a streak at UT in which every freshman class since 1999 has won at least one Big 12 title during its four years on the Forty Acres. The current senior class is looking to extend the streak by winning its first Big 12 title in 2014.

DAVIS DAZZLES IN THE CIRCLE

Through her first 27 appearances in the circle, freshman Tiarra Davis is 11-7 on the season with an ERA of 2.37. Take a look at how the rookie southpaw has progressed over her first 19 starts.

WASHINGTON IS SURGING

Senior Brejae Washington, who has reached base in each of the last 30 games, has been a consistent hitter for UT all season. Coming into the weekend against Iowa State, Washington leads the Big 12 in hits with 55. Her consistency over the last 18 games has made her one of the more dangerous hitters to face in Texas' lineup this season. Below is breakdown of how she started the season and what she has done over the last 15 contests.

LIKE A LEGEND

Of sophomore Lindsey Stephens' 50 hits, 48 percent have been for extra bases (nine doubles, four triples and 11 home runs). To put it in perspective, former All-American Taylor Hoagland is UT's all-time leader in slugging percentage (.708). During her four-year (2009-12) career, 43 percent of her hits were for extra bases, including 58 home runs.

AN LOOK AT THE RPI

In the latest Rating Percentage Index (RPI) release of the season, Texas is ranked No. 27 in the country. The RPI is a quantity used to rank teams based upon a team's wins and losses and its strength of schedule.

19-RUN EXPLOSION

Against Texas State on April 2, the Longhorns scored 19 runs, the second-most in a game in program history. UT used 15 hits, including a season-high four home runs, to put up its largest run total since Feb. 9, 2012 when it tallied 23 in its 2012 season opener against Cal State Fullerton.



RECORD BREAKERS

As seniors Taylor Thom and Brejae Washington are closing out their careers at Texas, they are leaving their imprint on the program by overtaking several of the school's all-time records. Washington, who has held the school's record for stolen bases since last season, is one sacrifice hit away from the most all-time. She is also 10 hits away from breaking the UT record for hits in a career. Thom, who set the program record for RBIs in a Texas career, is only seven doubles away from having the most ever while playing on the Forty Acres.

CLARK ECLIPSES 700-WIN MILESTONE

Head coach Connie Clark, a 1986 NCAA Champion as a pitcher at Cal State Fullerton, has led the Longhorns since the program began in 1996 and owns a 719-309-3 (.699) record. With Texas', 7-3, win over No. 13/15 Louisiana Lafayette on Feb. 8, 2014, she collected her 700th career win.

- ▶ She became the 55th head coach in NCAA Division I softball to reach the milestone.
- ▶ Clark ranks 34th among active NCAA Division I coaches in wins.
- ▶ She ranks second among current Big 12 coaches in all-time wins. Only Oklahoma's Patty Gasso has more.

AN ALL-AMERICAN RETURNS FOR HER FINAL SEASON ...

Senior shortstop Taylor Thom is coming off an All-America selection. The Cedar Park product was a Third Team NFCA All-America pick in 2013. She set the UT single-season record with 66 runs batted in while hitting .382 with 71 hits and 15 home runs. On the program's all-time charts, Thom enters the Judi Garman Classic ranked second in runs batted in (151), tied for fourth in doubles (40), fifth in runs scored (144), eighth in home runs (30) and eighth in stolen bases (55).

THOM ON "WATCH LIST" FOR COLLEGIATE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Coming off All-America honors a year ago, senior Taylor Thom came into the 2014 season as one of 50 players in the nation to be named to the Amateur Softball Association of America's "Watch List" for the 2014 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Award. The award is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's collegiate softball and is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country. Former Texas pitcher Cat Osterman won the award three times (2003, 2005 and 2006).

FLYING AROUND THE BASES ...

Senior outfielder **Brejae Washington** stole the 100th base of her UT career this season on Feb. 7, 2014 against Louisiana Lafayette. She entered the year already owning the Texas record for career stolen bases with 97. The San Bernardino, Calif., native moved ahead of Desiree Williams' 62 with a steal of second base May 1, 2013 at Baylor. As a rookie in 2011, Washington set the single-season record with 38 swipes before adding 27 as a sophomore and 32 last season. Already this season, she has 27, which runs her career total up to 124 during her UT career.

NEW FACES

Seven freshmen: **Tiarra Davis** (Henderson, Texas), **Kelli Hanzel** (Houston, Texas), **Mickenzi Krpec** (Fulshear, Texas), **Taylor McAllister** (McKinney, Texas), **Lauren Slatten** (Cincinnati, Ohio), **Devon Tunning** (Montgomery, Texas) and **Stephanie Wong** (Austin, Texas) are on the roster this season. All seven have appeared in at least one game this season.

PRESEASON CONFERENCE SURVEY SAYS ...

In addition to starting the year standing No. 10 in both national preseason polls, the Longhorns were predicted to finish third in the Big 12 Conference preseason coaches poll. UT has been in the league's top three for four-straight preseason polls. In the 15 editions of the league's preseason poll, the Longhorns have never been predicted to finish lower than fifth.

Last season, Texas spent just one week outside the top nine in the NFCA poll. The only time the Longhorns were in the top nine for the entire season was in 2006, when the squad ranked No. 5 or higher each week. The only other year UT has been in the NFCA's top nine each week but one was in 2003.

RETURNING TO THE WORLD SERIES ...

UT enters the 2014 campaign after making its fifth Women's College World Series trip. For UT, it was its 14th NCAA Tournament trip, ninth consecutive and fourth showing in the super regional round of 16.

THE INNINGS ADVANTAGE ...

During the entire 2013 season, Texas outscored its opponents 356-118. The Longhorns held the scoring advantage in every inning... UT was particularly dangerous in the first five innings, outscoring opponents 279-86, including a 71-23 edge in the first. Texas owned a 27-2 record (.931 winning percentage) when scoring in the opening frame of contests last season. So far in 2014, UT has outscored its opponents, 231-129, through the first 38 games.

EXCELLING IN CLOSE GAMES ...

A year ago, Texas went 9-2 in one-run games, good for an .818 winning percentage. In the last 12 years, the Longhorns are 132-65 in such contests (.670 winning percentage), including an 1-9 mark so far in 2014.

HITS = WINS ...

When Texas held the edge in the hits column, it was nearly unbeatable a year ago. The Longhorns went 48-3 (.941 winning percentage) when outhitting opponents in 2013. So far this season, UT has out-hit 32 of its first 39 opponents and owns a 22-10 record when it does just that.

The trend has held over the last 12 years. Since 2002, UT is 467-47 (.909 winning percentage) when outhitting its foes and is 151-17 (.898 winning percentage) in the last four seasons.

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE ...

A year ago, the Longhorns went 29-3 (.906 winning percentage) at Red & Charline McCombs Field. In the last six years, UT has been nearly as impressive, posting a 138-33 home mark (.807 winning percentage). Texas is 13-7 on its home field this season.

A LOT COMING BACK ...

Despite the graduation of the powerful senior class from a year ago, UT enters the season returning six of its 10 positional starters and two of the team's four pitchers. A closer look at the percentage of offensive production Texas returns to this year's team:

... AND THE TEXAS FAITHFUL

Part of the Austin success is due to crowd support, as Texas has stood in the top 15 nationally in total home attendance every year since 1998. The average home attendance has also ranked in the top 20 in the country each season since the opening of McCombs Field, in 1998. AN NCAA TOURNAMENT REGULAR ...

UT has made a Big 12 third-best 14 appearances in the NCAA Tournament, trailing only Oklahoma's 20 and Oklahoma State's 18 trips. However, both programs began NCAA competition in the early 1980s while the Longhorns' initial year of NCAA competition was in 1997...The Longhorns have advanced to NCAA Regional play the last nine years.

A NEARLY PERMANENT PLACE IN THE POLLS ...

Texas has finished the season ranked in the National Fastpitch Coaches Association Top 25 poll 11 times in program history (highest finish: No. 3 in 2013) and has appeared in the poll during the season in 17 of its 18 years as a varsity program.

RECORDS ...

In 2013, Taylor Thom set or tied the program single-year records for runs batted in (66), doubles (16) and total bases (132). This season, she moved into first place in school history in RBIs with 156. Brejae Washington is the all-time leader in UT Softball history with 124 stolen bases, 19 triples and 30 sacrifice hits. In 2013 she tied the UT season record with her seven triples.

TYING NCAA RECORDS ...

Last season, Taylor Thom became the fourth player in NCAA history to hit two grand slams in a game when she tallied one in the first and third innings at Houston on Feb. 16. She set the Texas single-game record with eight runs batted in during the contest ... A week later, Thom matched another NCAA record with three doubles in a contest against Utah State on Feb. 23 ... During the season, Thom hit four grand slams, tying her for the third most in a year by an NCAA Division I player. She became just the fifth Division I player to hit four or more slams in a year.

SALUTE TO 2013

The Longhorns finished No. 3 in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball final polls with a record of 51-10, marking the second-most wins in school history. Only the 2006 team had more wins in a season with 55 ... The program made its fifth trip to the Women's College World Series and eventually reached its third trip to the WCWS Semifinals.

UT stole a school record 126 bases, hit .322 as a team and held opponents to a .173 average ... The Horns scored 356 runs, the second most in team history. Only the 2012 team, with 372 runs scored, has scored more in a season ... Three players earned NFCA All-America Honors: Blaire Luna (First Team), Taylor Hoagland (First Team), Taylor Thom (Third Team) ... A program record six players earned NFCA All-Central Region honors: Kim Bruins, Taylor Hoagland, Blaire Luna and Taylor Thom made the first team and Mandy Ogle and Brejae Washington made the second team ... Six players also earned All-Big 12 Honors: Taylor Hoagland, Blaire Luna, Taylor Thom and Brejae Washington made the first team. Kim Bruins and Torie Schmidt made the second team.

THE HILL EFFECT ...

Assistant coach **Corrie Hill** joined the Texas staff in 2006 and has been the team's primary offensive coach since. During her tenure, UT has rewritten the offensive record books, posting five of the program's top six batting averages, hit totals, run totals and runs batted in while owning all of the top five home run marks.

1,000TH GAME

Texas Softball played its 1,000th game in program history and under head coach Connie Clark on Feb. 14, 2014 against No. 7/9 Kentucky at McCombs Field. The Horns fell 6-4 in the contest, which capped UT's record at 700-297-3 through its first 1,000 games. Texas played its first varsity softball game on Feb. 8, 1997 at St. Edwards, where it won, 8-2.

BRIGHT LIGHTS ...

Texas Softball will have 31 of its 54 games nationally televised this season. All 27 home games at Red & Charline McCombs Field will be broadcasted by Longhorn Network. UT will also get national exposure by FOX Sports Southwest when it plays at Baylor (March 22 and May 6) and then at Oklahoma by ESPN2 and FOX Sports Regional on April 17 and April 19, respectively.

FOUR PLAYERS INKED TO 2014 RECRUITING CLASS...

During the national signing period, four players committed to join the Longhorns' softball program in 2014. Shortstop/outfielder **Alyssa Angel** (La Grange, Texas/La Grange), right-handed pitcher/first base **Kristen Clark** (Richmond, Texas/Foster), catcher/outfielder **Randel Leahy** (Norco, Calif./Santiago) and right-handed pitcher **Erica Wright** (Huntington, Texas/Huntington) will begin playing for The University of Texas in the spring of 2015.

**BEHIND THE SCENES WITH THE HORNS**

- Sophomore **Stephanie Ceo** also has a sister playing collegiate softball as Courtney is a senior on Oregon's squad. Courtney was a National Fastpitch Coaches Association First Team All-Region selection last year.
- Senior **Mandy Ogle's** older brother Brock was a 2010 graduate from The University of Texas. Ogle's other brother, Tyler, is a catcher for the Albuquerque Isotopes, AAA affiliate for the Los Angeles Dodgers' organization, and was a three-year starter for the Oklahoma program.
- Sophomore **Taylor King** is not only a member of the Longhorns' softball team, but is also an active member of The University of Texas Army ROTC program. UT's ROTC began in September of 1947. Army ROTC graduates are commissioned as U.S. Army Second Lieutenants and receive specialized training in one of 17 different Army branches.
- **King**, an applied movement science major, says of the opportunity to be involved in both, "I look at it as planning for the future. It has probably been one of the hardest things I have done. I am constantly going from one place to another. It's difficult, but it helps me with my time management. It's a blessing in disguise."
- Sophomores **Holly Kern** and **Rachel Scott** were high school teammates at Plano East. Prior to making their Longhorn debuts, the pair had played at Red & Charline McCombs Field as high school seniors and freshmen as part of the University Interscholastic League 5A state tournament semifinals.
- Sophomore **Erin Shireman**, a graduate of Lutheran South Academy, was the 2011 Texas Association of Private and Parochial Schools 4A state champion in the pole vault with a mark of 11-6. Shireman also played her first season of softball with the Lady Pioneers that spring, the school's first time fielding a varsity team.
- Senior **Brejae Washington** was also a high school track standout, earning Cajon's most valuable runner honor three times (2007-09). Washington led her squad to the San Andreas Championship in 2010 and broke the league's 30-year-old long jump record with her 18-4 mark.
- Sophomore **Lindsey Stephens** became the first Hampshire-Fannett High School softball player to sign a Division I scholarship when she inked her National Letter of Intent with Texas in November, 2011. Stephens was a 3A Texas Girls Coaches Association All-State team selection as a junior and senior.
- Junior **Marlee Gabaldon** graduated from Permian High School in Odessa, Texas, home of the famed *Friday Night Lights* book, movie and television series.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE...

- Texas will square off against eight squads that ended the 2013 season ranked or receiving votes in the USA Today/National Fastpitch Coaches Association final poll and four that finished in the top 15. The Longhorns will also have rematches against three of the teams (Arizona State, Michigan and Oklahoma) they faced during last year's Women's College World Series run.
- UT is slated to play at least 36 of their 54 regular-season games versus teams that finished 2013 with a winning record.
- The Longhorns will face 13 opponents in the regular season who are ranked or receiving votes in the 2014 preseason NFCA Top 25.

RECENT SUCCESS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

Since the beginning of the Longhorns' varsity program, in 1997, Texas has played 354 games against teams ranked in the *USA Today*/NFCA Top 25 poll. In those contests, UT is 176-179-1, including a 39-28 mark since the current seniors arrived on campus for the 2011 season. A year ago, the Longhorns posted a 12-6 record versus ranked foes, the program's most wins versus top-25 opponents since claiming 19 in 2006. The 2013 regular season schedule provided the opportunity to face multiple top-25 clubs, as 13 teams that participated in NCAA Regionals the previous spring were on the regular-season slate. Below is a closer look at UT's last 30 contests against Top 25 teams. Texas is 4-6 against nationally ranked opponents in 2014.

CONNIE CLARK

Cal State Fullerton ('87) | 19th season



Few coaches can boast of successful 18-year spans in their careers, and even fewer can claim such a run at the beginning of their head coaching days. Since starting The University of Texas' softball program in 1996, head coach Connie Clark has built one of the most successful programs in college softball.

In 17 varsity seasons, Clark has given Texas Softball its reputation for having the best players, facilities, traditions and coaches. When people talk about Texas Softball, they talk about only one thing: success.

Since its ascension to varsity status in 1997, Texas has emerged as one of the most dominant softball programs in the nation under the direction of Clark. In 17 seasons at the helm of the varsity program, Clark -- the 1987 Broderick National Softball Player of the Year as a collegian -- has led UT to five Women's College World Series appearances (1998, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2013), 14 NCAA Tournament appearances (1998-2000, 2002-03, 2005-13), four Big 12 Conference Championship tournament titles (1999, 2002, 2003, 2005) and four Big 12 regular-season titles (2002, 2003, 2006, 2010). In fact, Texas' appearance in the 1998 WCWS -- in just its second varsity season -- still ranks as the quickest arrival at the NCAA Division I softball "Elite Eight" tournament in the history of the sport.

Texas is at the forefront of the national and international softball scene. Clark has produced one national player of the year (three times), 25 All-America selections, six Academic All-Americans and countless All-Big 12 honorees.

The Longhorns can also claim two Olympic gold medalists (pitchers Cat Osterman and Christa Williams), and a total of nine national and junior national team members, with three members of the 2013 Texas squad (Taylor Hoagland, Taylor Thom and Erin Shireman) being part of that group.

Clark's peers have taken notice of her work in Austin, voting her the Big 12 Coach of the Year in 2002, 2006 and 2010. Clark and her assistants' efforts in developing the Texas program were noted when they were honored as the 2006 National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Midwest Region coaching Staff of the Year after being named the 2003 Speedline/NFCA Division I Coaching Staff of the Year.

In 2003, her Longhorns became the first-ever team to win both back-to-back Big 12 regular-season titles and back-to-back Big 12 Championship tournament titles.

Clark spent the 1996 season developing the Longhorns' program at the club level before guiding UT softball to intercollegiate Division I status in 1997. Texas commenced its status as a varsity program with a bang, collecting a winning record (30-24/.556) in its first official season.

Clark has not only created a national power, but has also molded many of the nation's top collegiate talents. Many UT players under Clark's eye have achieved national honors.

In her tenure, Texas players have earned three USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Awards (Osterman in 2003, 2005 and 2006) and two Honda Awards for national player of the year (Osterman in 2005 and 2006). Clark had at least one student-athlete earn NFCA All-America honors in each of the 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2006, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 seasons, including Osterman, who is the program's only four-time All-American.

In 1999, Williams earned second-team All-America accolades in her second season at Texas, while infielder Nikki Cockrell and outfielder Autumn Eastes represented UT on the third team. Williams and Cockrell were NFCA first-team members in 1998, and shortstop Jodi Reeves earned second-team recognition that year. Second baseman Lindsay Gardner earned second-team honors as a freshman in 2000.

Additionally, Clark's players have distinguished themselves at the regional and conference levels. Thirty of Clark's players have earned a total of 56 All-Region honors, including a program-high-tying six in 2013 with Kim Bruins, Hoagland, Blaire Luna, Mandy Ogle, Thom and Brejae Washington. Clark has recruited six Big 12 Freshmen of the Year (shortstop Thom in 2011, pitcher Luna in 2010, second baseman Chez Sievers in 2003, Osterman in 2002, Gardner in 2000 and second baseman Reeves in 1997).

Clark has also guided three pitchers to six other major conference awards as

Luna claimed conference pitcher of the year honors in 2010 and Osterman was the back-to-back conference pitcher of the year in 2002 and 2003 and again in 2005 and 2006. Clark coached Williams to Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors in 1998. Clark has coached players to a total of 84 all-conference accolades.

International recognition also has come to Clark's pupils. The 2006 edition of the Longhorns' was the most internationally decorated unit at the Forty Acres since Clark started the program. The squad included a 2004 Olympic gold medalist and a 2003 Pan Am Games gold medalist (Osterman) and three players who represented the U.S. at the World Junior Championships (Boutelle in 2002, Denny and Desiree Williams in 2003).

Christa Williams' accolades continued in September of 1999, when she was named to the 2000 USA Olympic Softball team, the first of Clark's players to be tabbed an Olympian. Williams went on to win a gold medal at the Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia, in addition to her gold medal from the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta. Williams also represented the United States at the 1999 Canada Cup, earning the Lori Sippel Award for the tournament's most outstanding pitcher.

Gardner competed with the 2001 USA Softball Team and 2002 USA Elite Team as well as being a member of the 2002 USA Softball National Training Team. Osterman was Gardner's teammate on the Elite Team, as well as the training team.

For Clark's Longhorns, the team's success always carries over into the classroom as numerous players have received national and conference honors for their academic success. In all, Clark's athletes have earned six Academic All-America honors, including Osterman's third-team recognition in 2003, the same year she earned her first USA Softball National Player of the Year honor.

Longhorns have garnered CoSIDA Academic All-District honors 21 times, most recently as senior infielder Lexy Bennett represented Texas on the 2012 team. Clark has also coached 94 Academic All-Big 12 Team selections at Texas.

Clark, a standout athlete in her playing days, has been associated with national-caliber softball programs everywhere she has been. As an assistant coach at Florida State (1990-95), Clark helped build the Seminoles into a

national softball power and helped lead FSU to four appearances in the NCAA Women's College World Series and to five NCAA Regional trips.

Under Clark's direction, nearly every Florida State pitching record was broken during those five seasons. In 1994, one of Clark's protégés at FSU, Rebecca Aase, set the then-NCAA record for consecutive victories with 50, while the FSU pitching staff established a then-NCAA mark for most consecutive scoreless innings with 124.2.

History has proved that Clark has mastered the art of teaching. She helped coach six of her Florida State players to All-America honors, 23 to all-region honors and six to Academic All-America accolades. During that time, Clark also was busy completing her education, earning a master's degree in athletic administration from FSU in April of 1995.

Prior to coaching at Florida State, Clark was an outstanding pitcher in her own right, leading softball powerhouse Cal State Fullerton to the NCAA Women's College World Series title as a junior in 1986.

A three-time All-America pitcher, Clark posted a 20-2 record with 197 strikeouts in 155.1 innings while leading the nation with a 0.18 earned run average in 1986. The following year, Clark posted a 33-5 record with 32 complete games, 19 shutouts and 261 strikeouts in 283 innings, earning the Broderick Award as National Softball Player of the Year. Clark's career ERA of 0.37 as a Titan places her in the top 10 for career ERA in Division I softball.

In 1987, Clark earned a bachelor's degree in physical education from CSF, then worked as a private instructor at the Rod Carew Baseball School in California and conducted private clinics in Tokyo, Japan; Auckland, New Zealand; Shanghai, China; and Italy.

Prior to her two-year stint with Cal State Fullerton, Clark pitched for Central Arizona Junior College under the direction of Mike Candrea, who is now the head softball coach for the eight-time NCAA Champion Arizona Wildcats and the gold-medal winning 2004 Olympic team. Under Candrea's guidance, Clark led her team to back-to-back NJCAA championship crowns in 1984 and 1985.

For all of her success, Clark was inducted into the Arizona Softball Foundation Hall of Fame (2005), NJCAA Hall of Fame (2006), Cal State Fullerton Athletics Hall of Fame (2009) and Central Arizona Junior College Hall of Fame (2010).

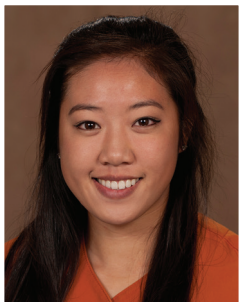
