QUICK HITS

- · Texas has won eight of its last nine games, including a series victory at Texas Tech last weekend.
- ·Texas ranks fifth in the first official version of the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) released by the NCAA on Tuesday. The Longhorns have a 7-2 record against teams in the RPI top 30, including 5-1 in road and neutral games. Against the RPI top 50, Texas is 13-5 including 7-3 in road/neutral contests.
- ·The Longhorns led the Big 12 in hitting last week with a .338 average. Freshman Tres Barrera, who was 8-of-19 (.421) with seven RBI in four games, was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week.
- ·The Texas pitching staff leads the Big 12 and is tied for fourth nationally with a 1.98 ERA. That's a full run better than TCU, which is second in the league at 2.98. As a staff, Texas is holding opponents to a .218 batting average, also best in the league.
- · Texas has allowed just 76 runs (2.5 runs/game) this year. That's the lowest number of runs allowed through 30 games in head coach Augie Garrido's 18-year tenure at Texas (see more, page 2).
- ·The Longhorns rank second in the league and ninth nationally in fielding percentage (.981). At home, Texas has a .990 fielding percentage, having committed just seven errors in 18 games. Texas leads the Big 12 and is tied for 11th nationally in double plays (31).
- · Over the last nine games, Texas is averaging 6.55 runs per game and hitting .330 as a team with a .442 slugging percentage and .429 on-base percentage. The Horns have recorded double-digit hits in eight of those nine games. The Longhorns are 9-0 when scoring six or more runs this year.
- \cdot Barrera (18-40 .472), Zane Gurwitz (13-34, .382), Ben Johnson (14-37, .378), Brooks Marlow (13-36, .361), Mark Payton (12-34, .353) and C.J Hinojosa (11-34, .324) have been the offensive leaders over the last nine games.
- · Since March 11, Barrera is 24-of-54 (.444) at the plate, including five doubles, a triple and a home run. He has raised his batting average 169 points (128 to 297) in that span.
- · Texas is ranked in the top 15 by all five major polls, including 8th by Baseball America and 9th by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

QUICK HITS CONTINUED...

- \cdot Mark Payton leads the Big 12 in on-base percentage (.511) and triples (5), ranks second in batting average (.396) and third in walks (25). Payton has reached base safely in 69 consecutive games dating back to last season, which is the longest streak nationally and the second longest in Big 12 history (93 Nick Martini, K-State, 2009-11).
- \cdot Head coach Augie Garrido surpassed Gordon Gillespie for the most wins (1,894) by any college baseball coach at any level with the 5-1 win over Texas State on March 25. He now has 1,897.
- · Texas' 44 hits vs. Texas Tech last weekend are the most in a three-game series since March 16-18, 2012, when the Longhorns had 45 at Oklahoma.
- \cdot The Longhorns are 12-1 when scoring in the first inning this season. The lone loss came on March 29 at Texas Tech. Texas has scored in the first inning in six of the last seven games.
- \cdot The Longhorns are tied with TCU for a Big 12 best five shutouts. That also ranks t-9th nationally.
- Texas is No. 2 in the country in Iterative Strength Rating, according to college baseball site BoydsWorld.com (see more page 3). The Longhorns have played the ninth most difficult schedule.
- \cdot The Texas bullpen had a streak of 30 consecutive scoreless innings snapped when it surrendered five runs in the ninth inning against Kansas on March 16. On the year, the bullpen has a 1.95 ERA, while the starters have a 2.00 ERA.
- · Texas is 23-3 when scoring two runs or more.
- · Texas has stolen 27 bases on 34 attempts this season, with Collin Shaw (7-10), Ben Johnson (6-6) and Mark Payton (5-6) leading the way. The Longhorns have been excellent against the run, with opponents stealing just 12 bases on 18 attempts. That's the second lowest number in the Big 12, with West Virginia ranking first (10-16).
- ·Texas leads the Big 12 and ranks second nationally with 46 sacrifice bunts.
- ·Three pitchers with a combined 40 starts from last year return in 2014: Dillon Peters (14), Parker French (13) and Nathan Thornhill (13). The Longhorns return seven total pitchers from the 2013 staff which ranked seventh nationally in ERA (2.61).
- •The 2013 UT recruiting class was ranked second nationally by *Baseball America*. Five players ranked in the *Baseball America* 500: right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi (No. 162), third baseman Andy McGuire (No. 198), catcher Tres Barrera (No. 200), infielder Bret Boswell (No. 221) and right-handed pitcher Blake Goins (No. 256). The class is comprised of 12 freshmen and one junior-college transfer in Schiraldi.
- · Five of the 13 incoming players were selected in the 2013 MLB Draft but chose to report to campus rather than sign professional contracts. Goins was selected in the 12th round, left-handed pitcher Josh Sawyer was taken in the 32nd round, Schiraldi and infielder/right-handed pitcher Kacy Clemens were picked in the 35th round, and McGuire was taken in the 36th round.
- \cdot Seniors Mark Payton (OF) and Nathan Thornhill (RHP) return to The Forty Acres after being selected in the MLB draft in the 16th and 24th rounds, respectively.
- · Payton led the 2013 squad in nearly every hitting category including: batting average (.393), hits (70), doubles (11), triples (8), RBIs (29), total bases (97), slugging percentage (.545), walks (28), on-base percentage (.483), and sac bunts (7).
- ·Twenty-two players were named to the Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll in the fall 2013 semester for earning a 3.0 grade-point-average or higher. Of Texas' incoming class of 13 student-athletes, 10 made the honor roll.

DOUBLE PLAY DUO - Texas leads the Big 12 and is tied for 11th nationally with 31 double plays. Second baseman Brooks Marlow and shortstop C.J Hinojosa have played a large part, with Marlow involved in 24 of the double plays and Hinojosa 21. The pair was also effective last season, when Hinojosa helped turn 31 and Marlow 23. First baseman Kacy Clemens, meanwhile, has been in on 25 of the double plays this season and is fielding at a .983 clip.

SERIES HISTORY - Texas leads the all-time series with Baylor, 234-105-4, including 113-39-1 at home. Baylor, however, has won five of the last six games including a sweep last season in Waco. The Bears took the last series in Austin in 2012, winning

two of three. Texas' last series victory was in 2011 when the teams split two games in Waco and the Longhorns won one in Austin.

QUALITY STARTS - Texas starting pitchers have allowed just 38 earned runs in 171.0 innings this season (2.00 ERA). Combined, they have a 15-5 record and opponents are hitting just .220.

YOUTH MOVEMENT - Freshmen have been relied upon heavily in the starting lineup this season, with first-year players accounting for 85 of 270 starts (31.5%). Texas is one of 13 teams nationally with four or more freshman position players that have started at least half of their team's games (Kacy Clemens - 27, Tres Barrera - 26, Zane Gurwitz - 22, Andy McGuire - 20). Of those 13 teams, Texas has the highest winning percentage (.767) and is the only team ranked in the top 25 of all five major polls.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS - Since 2009, Texas is 136-47 in non-conference play, a .743 winning percentage. The Longhorns were 20-6 against non-conference foes last year and are 20-4 this season.

WEEKLY HONORS - Three Longhorns have earned Big 12 weekly honors this season.

• Mark Payton was named Player of the Week on Feb. 17 after going 9-for-17 (.529) in a four-game series at Cal. The senior had a double, triple and home run on the weekend to go along with four RBI and three runs. Payton went 4-for-5 with runners on base.

- Dillon Peters was named Pitcher of the Week on March 3. Peters pitched eight shutout innings against then No. 12/15 Rice on Feb. 28, leading Texas to a 2-0 victory. The junior struck out six, allowed just four hits and didn't issue a walk.
- Tres Barrera was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week on March 31. The freshman went 8-for19 (.421) with a .737 slugging percentage on the week with three doubles, seven RBI and his first career home run.

TOUGH SCHEDULE - Texas has faced the 7th most difficult schedule in the nation according to BoydsWorld.com, and ranks second in their Iterative Strength Rating (through 4/1). The Longhorns have played a series against Texas Tech, which is 18th, Stanford, which is 32nd, and Kansas which is 39th, along with an individual game against Houston (#3) and two games against Rice (#12).

STARTING HOT - The Texas pitching staff has had a hot start to the 2014 season. Through the season's first 30 games the Longhorns have a 1.98 team ERA, having surrendered just 59 earned runs in 268 innings of work. That is the best start by a Texas pitching staff in at least five years. It is also Texas' best record in the first 30 games since also starting 23-7 in 2011.

GOING EXTRAS - Texas is 2-0 in extra inning games this year (2-1 win over UTPA in 11 innings on Feb. 25 and a 5-2 win over Texas Tech in 12 innings on March 31). The Longhorns were 1-2 in extras in 2013.

CURTISS COMES BACK - Redshirt sophomore John Curtiss made his return to the mound for Texas on Feb. 25 vs. UTPA, starting and logging two innings with two strikeouts. Curtiss, whose last appearance prior to that was on May 24, 2012 in the Big 12 Tournament, made his come-back from Tommy John and thoracic outlet syndrome surgeries. So far this season, Curtiss has logged 15 2/3 innings, allowing two earned runs (1.15 ERA) while striking out 12. He's taken over the closer role and has four saves in five opportunities.

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY - Senior center fielder Mark Payton is back for his senior season after starting 167 games in his first three years at UT. Payton led the Big 12 and ranked 12th nationally with a .393 batting average last year, the highest mark by a Longhorn since Dustin Majewski hit .401 in 2002. He's one of just two Longhorns to hit .390 or better in a season in the last 25 years (also Majewski). Payton became the first Longhorn to win the Big 12 batting title since Seth Johnston in 2005 (.378).

- Payton has been a model of consistency for UT, having reached base in 127 of 132 games over the last two-plus years (30-30 in 2014, 47-50 in 2013, 50-52 in 2012). Dating back to last year, he is on a 69-game streak of having reached base safely which leads the nation. Last year he led the team with 20 multiple hit games and has achieved that feat in 13 of 30 games this year.
- \bullet On the season, Payton is batting .396 (42-106) and has a 1.068 OPS (.557 slugging + .511 on-base).
- Payton is now alone in second in school and Big 12 history with 19 career triples. He needs just one more to match Bill Bates' (1983-85) school record and Jeff Liese (2000-03) of Nebraska's Big 12 record.

PAYTON NAMED SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATE - Mark Payton was named one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award on March 19. The award is presented annually to a NCAA Division I senior who has notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Payton's Senior CLASS bio can be viewed here: http://www.seniorclassaward.com/athletes/mark_payton/. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2014 College World Series® in June.

TWO-OUT PRODUCTION - Payton has been at the top of his game when coming to bat with two outs. The senior is 12-for-30 on the season and has started several key two-out rallies: his two-out single in the fifth inning of game three at Cal led to a two-run inning in a game that UT won 6-2; his two-out single in the fifth inning against TAMU-CC on 2/18 led to a five-run inning; against Stanford on 2/21, he had a two-run triple with two outs that started a five-run inning; on 2/22 vs. Stanford, with the game tied 2-2 in the seventh inning, Payton worked an eight-pitch at bat and hit a run-scoring single to give Texas the lead; on 3/8 vs. Hawai'i, down 2-0 in the fifth he hit a two-run triple to tie the game. The Longhorns went on to win, 3-2; on 3/16 against Kansas he hit an RBI double to tie the game at one apiece.

- C.J Hinojosa (15-for-40), Collin Shaw (10-for-26), Zane Gurwitz (7-for-23), Ben Johnson (9-for-32), Brooks Marlow (12-for-42) and Madison Carter (3-for-5) have also provided key two-out hits.
- Of Texas' 138 runs this season, 69 have come with two outs.

WALKING OFF - Senior Jacob Felts has provided the last two walk-off hits for Texas. His single to center in the 11th inning vs. UTPA on Feb. 25 scored Alex Silver to give Texas a 2-1 win. Prior to that, Texas' last win on a walk-off hit was March 16, 2013, on a double by Felts vs. Texas Tech. Felts also had a game-winning hit vs. Hawai'i on March 7, breaking a 2-2 tie with a run-scoring single in the eighth inning.

and 46th overall with a career record of 1,897-878-9. He is assisted by Skip Johnson (eighth season at Texas), Tommy Nicholson (fourth season at Texas) and Ryan Russ (third season at Texas). Johnson has led UT to top-10 national finishes in ERA in five of his seven seasons on the Forty Acres. Nicholson, a volunteer assistant in 2009 and 2010, returned to the staff as an assistant coach prior to last season. He coaches the infielders and hitters and helped the Longhorns lead the Big 12 in fielding percentage last season. Russ, in his third season as volunteer assistant, coaches the outfielders and helps coach the hitters.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS - The Texas baseball team has a long history of academic success.

- Since 2006, over 30 Texas Baseball student-athletes have returned to campus to earn their degrees.
- The program has posted a perfect score of 1,000 Academic Progress Rate (APR) from 2007-11 and has received APR Public Recognition Awards four times for having multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent in their sport (2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11, 2011-12).
- The team earned the College World Series Award for the team with the highest GPA in 2009 and 2011.
- The team has had six consecutive semesters of a GPA of 3.0 or better and currently holds a 3.2 GPA. Over 70% of students on the team holds a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better


HONORING JAMES STREET - Texas will honor the late James Street, who passed away in September of 2013, throughout the season by wearing a "JS" decal on their hats and helmets. A two-sport star, Street helped lead UT to three consecutive College World Series appearances and posted a career record of 29-8. Street ranks sixth in UT history with 21 complete games and ninth with a career 1.86 ERA and 302 strikeouts. He threw a perfect game in 1970 (vs. Texas Tech) and a no-hitter in 1969 (vs. SMU). Street was a two-time second-team All-America selection and a three-time All-SWC choice. On the football field, Street was a perfect 20-0 as a starting quarterback from 1968-69 and helped lead UT to the 1969 National Championship. The Longhorns posted a perfect 11-0 record (7-0 in the Southwest Conference) and capped off their second national title with a 21-17 victory against No. 9 Notre Dame in the 1970 Cotton Bowl. Street earned consensus All-SWC honors that season.

Seven Big 12 Conference Championships (2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2010, and 2011) and four league tournament crowns (2002, 2003, 2008 and 2009). These are the results and why head coach Augie Garrido was hired to guide the Texas baseball program in 1996.

During his first 17 years on the Forty Acres, Garrido became the all-time winningest coach in NCAA Division I baseball history by capturing his 1,428th career win on June 9, 2003, (a 6-5 Texas victory over then No. 1 Florida State during NCAA Super Regional action in Tallahassee,

Fla.). He brought Texas back to the CWS for the first time since 1993 during the 2000 campaign, and returned the Horns to the pinnacle of collegiate baseball in 2002 by leading UT to a 57-15 record that produced the school's first-ever Big 12 regular-season and tournament championships as well as its first national title since 1983. He duplicated the feat in 2005, guiding the Longhorns to their sixth National Championship - the second-most for one school in NCAA history. Texas' rise under Garrido has been the culmination of inking 16 straight top 15 recruiting classes and producing teams that have stood tall against perennial powers such as LSU, Miami (Fla.), Stanford and USC. Now, in his 18th year in Austin, Garrido, who was selected as both the 2002 and 2005 National Coach of the Year, looks to keep the program in contention for college baseball's ultimate prize each and every season.

Garrido is the second coach in Division I baseball history to tally 1,700 or more career victories. He is one of only two Division I coaches to ever win 500 or more games at two different schools and the only coach to ever win 600 or more games at two different schools.

He is also the first coach to lead teams from two different schools to national crowns (Cal State Fullerton & Texas), guide squads to National Championships in four different decades, and is one of only three coaches in history to win five or more NCAA titles (1979, 1984, 1995, 2002, 2005). Garrido has earned 14 trips to the CWS and 31 NCAA Regional Championship appearances, including 13 at Texas, while garnering National Coach of the Year honors six times (1975, 1979, 1984, 1995, 2002, 2005), regional coach of the year accolades on seven occasions (1975, 1979, 1984, 1995, 2002, 2004, 2005) and conference coach of the year distinctions eight times (1987, 1995, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2010, 2011) after leading his clubs to 25 league crowns.

The Vallejo, Calif., native is just the 13th coach in UT's 120-year baseball history, and, with the exception of the war years of 1943-45 when Blair Cherry was at the helm, is only the fourth Texas head coach since 1911.

As a result of his unique coaching style, Garrido has been ranked as one of the top three baseball teachers in the nation by Major League Baseball Directors of Player Development. To deserve that distinction, Garrido has coached three Golden Spikes Award winners, four National Players of the Year, six College World Series MVPs, 52 All-Americans, 14 All-League MVPs and 119 professional players over his career. He has also had 16 of his players selected in the first round of the Major League Baseball Draft, including Longhorns Beau Hale (No. 14) in 2000, Omar Quintanilla (No. 33) in 2003, both J.P. Howell (No. 31) and 2005 American League Rookie of the Year Huston Street (No. 40) in 2004, the duo of Drew Stubbs (No. 8) and Kyle McCulloch (No. 29) in 2006, Chance Ruffin (No. 48) in 2010, '10-'11 Big 12 Male Athlete of the Year Taylor Jungmann (No. 12) and Corey Knebel (No. 39) in 2013. In addition, during his 17 years at UT, Garrido has tutored the skills of 26 players who have earned All-America honors a total of 33 times, 23 Freshman All-Americans, including a school-record four in 2006, 149 All-Conference performers, 11 USA Baseball National Team members and 92 players who have gone on to play in professional baseball.

Garrido's name is also held in high regard when people speak of his accomplishments in the College World Series. He is currently tied for second with five National Championships (trailing only Rod Dedeaux's 10 at USC), ranks fourth and sixth, respectively, in victories (38) and winning percentage (.655; 38-20), as well as fifth in both series games (58) and appearances (14) among all-time coaches. He is also one of only eight men in history to coach two or more different teams in the CWS and is only the third Longhorns head coach (Bibb Falk & Cliff Gustafson) in the 120 years of Texas baseball to lead the Horns to Omaha. He was one of three coaches named to the College World Series Legends Team in 2010.






