NOTES AT A GLANCE

- **TEXAS-WVU SERIES:** WVU leads the all-time series with Texas, 4-2. The Longhorns split the last year's regular season series with the Mountaineers before losing in the semifinals of the Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship. In the first-ever meeting between Texas and West Virginia, WVU defeated UT in the first round of the NCAA Championship, 68-55, on March 17, 2012 in Norfolk, Va.
- **DAVENPORT ON A HOT STREAK:** In the last two games, junior guard Empress Davenport is averaging 13.0 points, up from her career average of 7.6 points. The three-year starter has made two last-second shots to help keep the Longhorns unbeaten -- a basket to force overtime at Stanford and the game-winning layup against Texas A&M.
- **ENEMKPALI LEADING BIG 12:** Senior forward Nneka Enemkpali leads the Big 12 in rebounding (10.3 ppg) and ranks sixth in scoring (13.4 ppg). The national player of the year candidate is moving up the career statistic lists at Texas, ranking 13th in career rebounds (847) and 35th in career points (1,067). Enemkpali is on pace to become the fifth Longhorn with 1,000 rebounds and 1,000 points.
- **DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE:** Enemkpali enters Wednesday with six consecutive double-doubles. During the six-game streak, she is averaging 15.5 points and 13.0 rebounds. Enemkpali has 28 career double-doubles, including seven this season.
- **SANDERS ASSISTING:** Junior guard Brady Sanders leads the Longhorns in assists (3.2 apg) and ranks third in the Big 12 in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.7).
- **HOME COURT ADVANTAGE:** Texas is 23-2 at the Frank Erwin Center since last season, including a 9-0 mark at home this season. The Longhorns have a +26.8 scoring margin through nine home games this season.
- **POINTS IN THE PAINT:** Texas is out-scoring its opponents in the paint by an average of 40-to-19. 54.1 percent of UT's offensive production comes in the paint (484 paint points / 894 total points).
- **DEFENSE WINS:** Texas has made its way to a 12-0 record with the 13th-ranked scoring defense in the country. The Longhorns are holding opponents to 52.9 points per game. Texas has held six opponents to under 50 points, including two under 40 points.

**LAST TIME OUT: at #3/3 TEXAS 60, Kansas 46**

• Texas earned its 12th consecutive win after defeating Kansas, 60-46, in the Big 12 Conference opener on Saturday, Jan. 3.

• **SERIES:** Texas improves its lead in the all-time series with Kansas, 18-10, including an 9-4 mark in Austin and a 4-1 mark under Head Coach Karen Aston. The Longhorns have won the last four meetings with the Jayhawks.

• **BIG 12 OPENERS:** The Longhorns improve to 9-10 in Big 12 Conference openers. Saturday's win marked UT's first Big 12-opening win in 10 years. The last time Texas won its conference opener was a 66-51 victory against Kansas on Jan. 5, 2005 in Austin.

• **STARTERS:** For the fifth time this season, Celina Rodrigo, Empress Davenport, Brady Sanders, Nneka Enemkpali, and Kelsey Lang started for the Longhorns. Texas is 5-0 with this starting five.

• **NNEKA ENEMKPALI** earned her sixth consecutive double-double on Saturday, registering 12 points and 14 rebounds in 30 minutes of action. It ties her own program record for most consecutive double-doubles. Enemkpali -- who leads the Big 12 in rebounding (10.3 rpg) -- now has 28 career double-doubles, including seven this season.

• **EMPRESS DAVENPORT** registered her fifth double-figure scoring effort of the season with 13 points on 6-of-14 shooting.

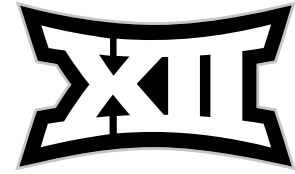

UNDEFEATED

- The 2014-15 Longhorns are the third team in program history to begin the season with a perfect 12-0 record, marking UT's best start since the 1985-86 season (34-0).
- Through Jan. 5, Texas is one of four teams in NCAA Division I with an undefeated record (343 total teams) -- South Carolina, Mississippi State and Princeton.
- **Since 1990, only two Texas teams have maintained winning streaks longer than 12 games -- 2002-03 and 2014-15.** Karen Aston is associated with both teams as an associate head coach in 2002-03 and a head coach in 2014-15.
- UT has posted overall winning streaks of 12 games or better 14 times in program history.

NON-CONFERENCE SUMMARY

- Texas finished one of its best non-conference schedules in program history with a 11-0 record, including three victories over top-10 opponents.
- It is the first time Texas has gone undefeated in non-conference play since the 1985-86 season.
- This season, the Longhorns have recorded three-year bests in scoring (75.8), scoring defense (53.5), shooting percentage (.459), assists (16.4), turnovers (15.2), rebounds allowed (31.5) and steals (8.9) during non-conference play.
- **Texas has won 58 consecutive games against unranked non-conference opponents at home.**
- Under Coach Aston, the Longhorns are 5-4 against top-25 non-conference opponents, including a 3-0 mark this season.

- McGee-Stafford, who missed the first eight games, registered four points and four rebounds in nine minutes in her season debut. She followed-up with two rebounds in six minutes against Texas A&M.
- The Los Angeles native was the 2013 Big 12 Freshman of the Year and earned All-Big 12 Second Team honors last season.

- It marked the first 20-point game from a Texas guard since Feb. 20, 2013 (Chassidy Fussell, 26 points vs. Kansas).
- McCarty made her first career start against Northwestern State (Dec. 14).
- McCarty accounts for 13 of UT's 34 total 3-point field goals made.
- McCarty, a 2014 McDonald's High School All-American, is averaging 6.1 points and 20.3 minutes this season.

ENEMKPALI, McGEE-STAFFORD LISTED ON NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LISTS

- Senior forward **Nneka Enemkpal** is listed on all three of the major national player of the year watch lists -- the WBCA's 'Wade Watch', Wooden Award Preseason Top 30, and the Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List.
- Junior center **Imani McGee-Stafford** is listed on Naismith Trophy Top 50 Watch List.
- **Wade Trophy**: regarded as "The Heisman of Women's Basketball." The Wade Trophy is presented annually to the WBCA NCAA Division I Player of the Year by SHAPE America - the Society of Health and Physical Educators and the WBCA. The 25-member list is made up of top NCAA Division I student-athletes who best embody the spirit of Lily Margaret Wade according to the following criteria: game and season statistics, leadership, character, effect on their team and overall playing ability.
- Created in 1976, the **John R. Wooden Award** is the most prestigious individual honor in men's and women's college basketball. It is bestowed upon the nation's best player at an institution of higher education who has proven to his or her university that he or she is making progress toward graduation and maintaining a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA. Previous winners include such notables as Larry Bird ('79), Michael Jordan ('84), Tim Duncan ('97), Candace Parker ('07 and '08), Kevin Durant ('09) and Maya Moore of Connecticut ('09 and '11).
- Named in honor of Dr. James Naismith, founder of the game of basketball, the **Naismith Trophy** is awarded annually to the women's and men's college basketball players of the year. In December of each year, the Atlanta Tipoff Club board of selectors, comprised of coaches, administrators and media from across the country, chooses the preseason top 50 "watch list". In February, the Naismith voting academy narrows the list to the top 30 based on athletic performance. In March, the voting academy selects the four finalists who will go to the final ballot. The winner is selected by a board of selectors vote in conjunction with fan voting. Fan voting accounts for 25 percent of the final vote.

LONGHORNS SNAP TOP-RANKED STANFORD'S HOME WINNING STREAK

- Texas defeated No. 6/1 Stanford 87-81 in overtime on Nov. 20 to snap Stanford's 28-game home winning streak at Maples Pavilion and a six-game winning streak in the series against Texas.
- Texas led for 36:33, while Stanford led for just 4:30. The game was tied for 3:48.
- The last time Texas defeated an AP Top-10 opponent was then-No. 4 Baylor, 58-55, on Feb. 1, 2009 in Waco.
- The last USA TODAY Coaches No. 1-ranked team Texas defeated was Tennessee, 74-59, on Nov. 25, 2004.
- Texas made its way to a six-point halftime lead (43-37) on 53.3 percent shooting (16-30 FG). The Longhorns committed just four first-half turnovers.
- Texas held Stanford to one field goal in overtime (1-7 FG), outscoring the Cardinal in the extra period, 12-6.
- Texas shot 48.5 percent from the floor (33-68 FG), while holding Stanford to 35.9 percent (23-64 FG).
- Four Longhorns reached double-figure points, including a team-high 18 points from senior forward Nneka Enemkpal.

RECRUITING CLASS RANKED NO. 5

- UT's incoming 2015-16 class of newcomers is being heralded as a consensus top-10 class, including a No. 5 ranking by *ESPN.com*. On Nov. 12, the Longhorns signed four-star forward **Christina Aborowa** (Ondo, Nigeria), five-star guard **Lashann Higgs** (Round Rock, Texas), and five-star forward **Jordan Hosey** (Pearland, Texas) to National Letters of Intent.
- All three are top-100 recruits, including two consensus top-10 signees -- Higgs and Hosey.

HALL OF HONOR

- **Yulonda Wimbish-North** was inducted into the UT Women's Hall of Honor on Nov. 7. Wimbish-North was the 1988 Southwest Conference Player of the Year, a member of the 1986 national championship team, and totaled 1,486 career points as a Longhorn.

41ST SEASON OF WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- Texas Women's Basketball is in its 41st season of intercollegiate basketball.
- The Longhorns hold an all-time record of 960-356 (.729) in its previous 40 years of competition.
- UT has had just four head coaches over a 40-year span -- Rod Page (1974-76), Jody Conradt (1976-2007), Gail Goestenors (2007-12) and Karen Aston (2012-present).
- In the 32 years Women's Basketball has been an NCAA-sanctioned sport, Texas has made 27 NCAA tournament appearances, three Final Fours and won one NCAA title (1986).
- The Longhorns have won 12 conference regular season titles and 10 conference tournament titles.
- In the program's first game, Texas defeated Huston-Tillotson, 68-17, on Nov. 26, 1974.
- Entering the 2014-15 season, Texas is the seventh-winningest program in NCAA Women's Basketball history.

Aborowa is a 6-foot-4 forward ranked No. 77 overall and No. 14 at the forward position in the class of 2015 (*ESPN.com*). Aborowa was born in Nigeria and has played the last two years in Philadelphia, Pa., at Neumann-Goretti High School and for the Philadelphia Belles club team. Aborowa led Neumann-Goretti to a 29-1 record and the Philadelphia Catholic League title as a junior, with its only loss coming in the state title game.

Karen Aston: "Christina adds much-needed depth at the forward position as Nneka [Enemkpal] graduates this spring. Fans will be drawn to her because of her infectious smile. She has tremendous upside and brings athleticism and a motor. Great coaches, both in high school and on the storied Philly Belles program, have developed her well. I look forward to seeing her blossom as a person and player here on the Forty Acres."

Higgs is a 5-foot-9 floor general ranked No. 6 overall and No. 3 at the guard position in the class of 2015 (*ESPN.com*). The Round Rock, Texas native is a two-time All-State performer and daughter of Texas assistant coach George Washington. Higgs was named to the Texas Association of Basketball Coaches (TABC) Small Private School All-State team after averaging 19.6 points and 10.6 rebounds as a freshman at The Kinkaid School in Houston. WITH KAREN ASTON



Karen Aston returned to the institution where she originally carved her reputation as an energetic leader and relentless recruiter in 2012, becoming just the fourth Texas Women's Basketball head coach in program history.

Since arriving at The University of Texas, Aston has made steps to lay the foundation for the Longhorns' return to national prominence, which she experienced as an eight-year assistant to Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame coach Jody Conradt. Aston was instrumental in the Longhorns' trip to the 2003 NCAA Final Four and a pair of Sweet 16 appearances in 2002 and 2004.

Entering the 2014-15 season, Aston has five postseason appearances as a head coach, a 135-93 (.592) overall record through seven seasons, and a 34-30 (.531) record through two seasons as UT's leader.

Aston bolstered the Longhorns' roster of 10 returning letterwinners for the 2014-15 season with a recruiting class ranked No. 11 by ESPN.com. Included in Aston's marquee recruiting class are McDonald's All-Americans Ariel Atkins and Brooke McCarty, Colorado Gatorade Player of the Year Diani Akigbogun and all-state guard Tasia Foman.

Aston and the Longhorns began a steady incline during the 2013-14 season with five wins over ranked opponents, a third-place finish in the Big 12 standings, a 10-win improvement from the previous season, and winning a game in the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2008. UT's tie for third-place in the Big 12 was the highest league finish since 2005.

As with any Karen Aston-coached team, defense and rebounding were essential factors of success in 2013-14. Texas led the Big 12 in field goal percentage defense (.347) and rebounding margin (+11.1), while enjoying improved success long-range shooting. After finishing last in the league in 3-point field goal percentage in 2012-13 (.278), UT paced the Big 12 with a .365 mark in 2013-14.

Three Longhorns earned All-Big 12 honors in 2013-14, led by first team Nneka Enemkpali (First Team), Imani McGee-Stafford (Second Team) and Chassidy Fussell (Honorable Mention). Fussell finished her collegiate career ninth on UT's all-time scoring list with 1,717 points.

In addition to on-court success, Aston's team reached high academic marks with a 3.32 cumulative team GPA for the 2013-14 academic year, completing ten consecutive semesters with a GPA of 3.0 or better. Each of her student-athletes currently holds a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better, and six were named to the Big 12 All-Academic Team in 2014, leading the conference with five first-team nominees.

In Aston's debut as the Longhorns head coach on Nov. 9, 2012, she guided UT to a season-opening win over No. 14 St. John's, 70-60. Her first recruiting class at UT featured three starters and the 2013 Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Imani McGee-Stafford.

She returned to the Forty Acres in 2012 after five years of experience reviving the women's basketball programs at Charlotte and the University of North Texas.

Aston tripled the Mean Green's victory total in one season, as UNT went 15-16 during the 2011-12 season

under her direction after winning just five games the previous year. At Charlotte, Aston led the program to record-breaking heights, with 86 victories in four seasons, including a school-record 27 wins in 2010-11.

Aston led the 49ers to four-straight postseason appearances and the 2009 Atlantic 10 Tournament Championship en route to the school's second ever NCAA Tournament appearance. In her final season at Charlotte, Aston's squad advanced to the WNIT Final Four.

While on Conradt's Texas staff from 1998-2006, Aston saw the Longhorns post a 173-83 (.676) record during that span, with seven NCAA Tournament appearances, two trips to the "Sweet 16" and a march to the 2003 Final Four. The Longhorns also captured the 2003 Big 12 regular season and tournament titles, and UT shared the 2004 Big 12 regular season title. Aston was promoted from assistant coach to associate head coach in July of 2000 after serving as UT's assistant coach for two seasons.

Aston spearheaded UT's signing of 25 nationally-recognized recruits, including seven McDonald's High School All-Americans and seven WBCA/Nike All-Americans. Two of those high school All-Americans - Tiffany Jackson and Erika Arriaran - were named National High School Players of the Year. All eight of the recruiting classes Aston attracted were nationally ranked, including the No. 1 class in the nation in 2005-06.

Aston originally came to Austin from the University of North Texas, where she served as an assistant coach for two seasons (1996-98). Prior to joining the North Texas staff, Aston was an assistant coach at Baylor for two seasons (1994-96).

Following Aston's stint on the Forty Acres, she was named associate head coach at Baylor during the 2006-07 season. With Aston on board, the Lady Bears won 26 games and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Before entering the collegiate coaching ranks, Aston was recognized as one of the top high school women's coaches in the south. She coached five years at Vilonia High School (1988-93) in Vilonia, Ark., and one year at Fort Smith Northside (1993-94) in Fort Smith, Ark. She guided Fort Smith Northside to a 24-10 record and a fifth-place finish in Class 4A. For her efforts, she was named the Arkansas Northwest Region Coach of the Year.

While at Vilonia, Aston was not only the head basketball coach but also the head cross country and track coach. In 1992-93, she was named the Arkansas Basketball Coach of the Year after leading Vilonia to a 36-1 record and a Class 2A State Championship. Aston's cross country teams also claimed back-to-back state titles in 1991 and 1992.

A native of Benton, Ark., Aston was a two-time first-team all-state selection at Bryant High School. She capped her high school career by leading Bryant to the 1982 Arkansas Class 4A State Championship. Aston earned a Bachelors of Arts degree in physical education from Arkansas-Little Rock in 1987. She played two seasons of basketball at UALR after transferring from Ouachita Baptist.
