## SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

**88,283** — Attendance (tickets distributed). Texas ranked 8th in the nation in home attendance in 2014.

**67** — temperature at kickoff with steady rain. Winds out of the northeast at 19 mph.

**9-1** — UT's record under Charlie Strong when scoring first.

**46.7%** — 3rd Down conversion rate for Texas today. The Longhorns were averaging 35.2% on 3rd downs this season.

**9** — games since Texas recovered an on-side kick. Kevin Vaccaro grabbed the pooch kick off one bounce following Tyrone Swoopes' second touchdown of the game during the second quarter today. Last time, was Nov. 8, 2014 against West Virginia.

**35** — **penalty yards** for Texas today. The Longhorns' season-low was 40 yards.

**1** — **sack allowed**. Fewest allowed by the Longhorns this season.

**0** — **plays of 20+ yards for K-State**. Texas did not allow the Wildcats to gain yard in chunks. K-State averaged 3.97 yards per play in today's contest.

## POSTGAME NOTES

### TEAM NOTES

- Texas Team Captains: **Peter Jinkens, Taylor Doyle and Sedrick Flowers**. Texas won the toss and deferred to the second half. K-State chose to receive the opening kick. Legendary Texas coach Darrell K Royal's wife Edith participated in the coin toss today for her 90th birthday.
- A moment of silence was observed before today's game in memory of Texas mascot **BEVO XIV** who passed away last week after a battle with Bovine Leukemia Virus.
- Series: Texas is now 7-9 against K-State all-time. Texas has won two of the last three meetings.
- The Longhorns had **five sacks** today, one shy of their season-best two weeks ago against Oklahoma.
- Those five sacks were tallied by a total of six players as the Longhorns brought the attack from multiple positions.
- Texas held K-State to 28.6% on **third downs** (4-of-14). Opponents were averaging 48.9% entering today's game.

### OFFENSE

#### Johnathan Gray, RB

- Posted a season-high **103 yards** on the ground on 18 carries.
- It marked his sixth 100-yard game in his career. His career-best is 141 yards against K-State in 2013.
- 103 yards brings career total to 2,497 yards and moves him into 13th in Texas Longhorns history. He needs 168 yards to surpass Hodges Mitchell for 10th on the list.

#### Tyrone Swoopes, QB

- Came off the bench to spell Jerrod Heard again at times in the "18 Wheeler" package and **scored three rushing touchdowns**.
- He represented **all 52 yards** on UT's game-clinching driving in the fourth quarter on three rushes, capped off by a 10-yard score.
- Second player this season to score three TD's in a game for Texas, joining Jerrod Heard.

#### Daje Johnson, WR

- Had six receptions on the day, one shy of his career best against Kansas and West Virginia in 2013.

### DEFENSE

#### Dylan Haines, S

- Intercepted his third pass of the season at midfield late in the fourth quarter to halt a comeback by K-State.
- Now has seven interceptions for his career.

#### Duke Thomas, CB

- Led team with eight tackles (six solo), one shy of his career-high against UCLA last season.

#### Derrick Roberson, DE

- Forced a fumble late in the fourth quarter for the first of his career. The fumble was recovered by K-State.
