SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

48,694 — Attendance. Second-largest attendance in TCU history at Amon G. Carter Stadium.

68 — temperature at kickoff with partly cloudy skies. Slight winds out of the southeast at 6 mph.

7 — games since Texas had a 100-yd game from a running back. D'Onta Foreman had 112 yards on 18 carries today.

30 — points allowed by Texas in the first quarter. The last time Texas allowed 30+ points in a quarter was on Nov. 7, 1987, when Houston scored 31 points in the fourth quarter to defeat Texas, 60-40.

35 — games since Texas allowed two players with 100+ yards receiving. TCU's Josh Doctson had 7 catches for 129 yards and 2 TD's and KaVonte Turpin had 6 catches for 138 yards and 4 TD's. The last time that occurred was Nov. 3, 2012 against Texas Tech.

POSTGAME NOTES

TEAM NOTES

- Texas Team Captains: **Alex De La Torre, Taylor Doyle and Nick Rose**. Texas won the toss and deferred to the second half. TCU chose to receive the opening kickoff.
- Series: Texas is now 62-23-1 against TCU all-time. The series is 3-1 in favor of TCU since the Horned Frogs joined the Big 12 Conference in 2012.
- Texas allowed 604 yards on defense. TCU had 228 yards rushing and 376 passing yards. It marks the first time a team has had 600+ yards of offense against Texas since BYU had 679 on Sept. 7, 2013.

OFFENSE

D'Onta Foreman

- Tallied a career-high 112 yards rushing on 18 carries. His previous career-high was 47 yards on nine carries this season against Cal. Foreman added 19 yards receiving with three catches.
- Foreman broke those career-highs both in the first half. He had 15 carries for 93 yards in the first half.
- The last time a Texas RB ran for 100+ yards was last season against West Virginia when Johnathan Gray had 10 carries for 101 yards in a 33-16 victory.

Tyrone Swoopes, QB

- Came off the bench to spell Jerrod Heard and posted 74 yards passing on 5-of-8 with one touchdown to Lorenzo Joe. He had five carries for 25 yards.

Lorenzo Joe, WR

- Caught his first career touchdown in the fourth quarter of today's game.
- It was his first reception of the season and went for 21 yards.

Jerrod Heard, QB

- Was 8-of-20 passing for 48 yards and added 23 yards rushing on 12 carries.
- Now has 978 yards of total offense in his first four starts at QB.

DEFENSE

Peter Jinkens, LB

- Registered eight tackles, with six solo, to lead the team.
- Had one tackle for loss

Duke Thomas, DB

- Led team with two PBU's.

Holton Hill, DB

- Had career-high seven tackles, six of them solo stops.
