Texas Tech Red Raiders (7-5, 4-5 Big 12) _______**48 Texas Longhorns** (4-7, 3-5 Big 12) ______**45**

SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

94,299 — Attendance. Texas ranked 8th in the nation in home attendance in 2014.

75 — temperature at kickoff with light rain and drizzle, winds out of the SSE at 5 mph. Temps cooled to the low 70s late in the game.

403 — Texas total of team rushing yards. It marks the second time this season the Longhorns have rushed for 300+ yards and the third straight game with 275+.

10-3 — UT's record under Charlie Strong when the Longhorns score first. The only other games Texas has lost under Coach Strong after scoring first was at West Virginia two weeks ago, 38-20, and against Oklahoma last season, 31-26. Texas kicked a FG to go up 3-0 in that contest, and OU returned the ensuing kickoff 91 yards for a touchdown.

30.8% — Texas Tech's percentage on 3rd downs tonight. The Red Raiders entered the game No. 1 in the nation at 53.5% in 3rd Down Conversions. The Texas defense held Tech to 1-for-8 in the first half

Texas Tech elected to receive the opening kickoff. OFFENSE

Chris Warren III, RB

- Got the first start of his career in today's contest. He tallied **276 yards rushing** for the **most by a freshman** in program history. His 276 yards also rank **sixth all-time for Texas.**
- The previous record for rushing yards by a freshman was 213 by **Cedric Benson** on 28 attempts against Kansas in 2001.
- Warren broke a 91-yard touchdown run in the second quarter. It was his first career touchdown and ranks as the fourth-longest rush in program history and the **longest by a freshman**.

Tyrone Swoopes, QB

- Completed 9-of-18 passes for 52 yards.
- Ran for 98 yards and 2 TDs on 15 carries.
- Posted his 3rd game with multiple rushing TDs.
- Brings season total to 11 rushing TDs.

DEEENCE

Dylan Haines, S

Pulled in his fifth INT of the season on Texas Tech's first drive of the game. He returned it for 16 yards, bringing his career total
of INT return yards to 200. That ranks second in school history and is 61 yards behind the record held by Chris Carter.

Naashon Hughes, DE

- Led team with 10 tackles (7 solo) for his first 10+ tackle performance.
- Registered 1.5 sacks to lead the team.

John Bonney, CB

- Had 9 tackles (6 solo) and 1 TFL.
- Forced 1 of Texas Tech's 3 fumbles

Shiro Davis, D

• Forced his 2nd fumble of the season to lead the team in that category on the year.

Malik Jefferson, LB

• Forced 1st fumble of his career.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Daje Johnson, KR/PR

- Had 148 yards on 5 kickoff returns to bring his season total to 476 yards and his career total to 924 yards. He ranks 6th in a season and 7th for a career in Texas history.
- He averaged 29.6 yards on kickoff returns. His season average is now 22.7.
