SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

92,529 — Attendance. Texas ranked 8th in the nation in home attendance in 2014.

63 — temperature at kickoff with cloudy skies and 76% humidity. Light winds out of the north at 10-15 mph. Temperatures dropped to high-50's in the second half.

10-1 — UT's record under Charlie Strong when they score first.

8 — plays of 20+ yards for the Longhorns today. Texas averaged 8.5 yards gained per play.

76.5 — average length of two touchdown receptions by freshman **WR John Burt** this season.

5.75 — **sacks averaged** by Longhorns over last four games.

33 — games since Texas scored **50+ points**. The Longhorns had 56 points against New Mexico to open the 2013 season.

48 — games since Texas completed a pass of 80+ yards. Jerrod Heard threw an 84-yard TD strike to John Burt on UT's first play from scrimmage. The last 80+ pass came on Dec. 3, 2011 at Baylor from Case McCoy to Marquis Goodwin.

591 — games since Texas had a rush of 90+ yards. D'Onta Foreman had a 93-yard touchdown run tonight. The last time was the school-record 96-yard rush by Chris Gilbert against TCU on Nov. 18, 1967.

POSTGAME NOTES

TEAM NOTES

- Texas Team Captains: **Taylor Doyle, Nick Rose and Marcus Hutchins**. UT Chancellor Bill McRaven (retired Navy four-star admiral) and Associate Vice Chancellor Tony Cucolo (retired Army major general) served as honorary captains, along with four World War II veterans, at the coin toss. Kansas won the toss and elected to receive.
- Series: Texas is now **13-2 against Kansas** all-time and has never lost at home to the Jayhawks.
- The Longhorns had **6 sacks** for the third time in the last four games.
- Texas had **598 yards** of total offense tonight with 299 both passing and rushing.

OFFENSE

Tyrone Swoopes, QB

- Came off the bench to spell Jerrod Heard again at times in the "18 Wheeler" package and **gained 59 yards on four carries with four touchdowns**. His season total on rushing touchdowns is now up to nine.
- Today marked Swoopes' second game this season with multiple rushing touchdowns.
- The last time a Texas player had four rushing touchdowns was Nov. 2, 2013, against Kansas by **Malcolm Brown**.
- Swoopes also threw a 40-yard TD to Armanti Foreman and picked up a fumble and carried it 10 yards for a score.
- Completed 6-of-7 passes for 98 yards and one touchdown.

Jerrod Heard, QB

- Connected with freshman WR John Burt for an **84-yard touchdown** on UT's first offensive play from scrimmage. It is the second-longest pass in school history by a freshman and third-longest reception by a freshman in UT history.
- Completed 13-of-23 passes for 201 yards and one touchdown.

John Burt, WR

- Caught an **84-yard touchdown** on UT's first offensive play. It is third-longest reception by a freshman in UT history.
- It was Burt's second touchdown of the season. His other score was a 69-yard strike against Rice.
- Tallied first **100-yard game** of his career with four receptions for 113 yards.

D'Onta Foreman, RB

- Posted a **93-yard touchdown run**. The third-longest rush in school history. He also has the 12th-longest rush in school history.
- Tallied **157 yards on 12 carries**. His third 100-yard game of the season.

DEFENSE

Dylan Haines, SS

- Pulled in his fourth interception of the season and returned it 36 yards to the KU 4-yard line in the first quarter. Haines now ranks fourth in school history with 184 return yards on interceptions.
- It was his eighth career interception.

DeShon Elliott, S

- Pulled in two interceptions, the first of his career. The last time a player had two INTs in a game was last season at Kansas by **Duke Thomas**.

Duke Thomas

- With his two picks today, he is tied for fifth in school history for interceptions in a season by a freshman.
