NOTABLES

- **SUCCESS AGAINST TECH UNDER BARNES:** Texas is 31-4 against the Red Raiders during the Rick Barnes era. UT has won 12 of the last 13 and 18 of the last 20 meetings against Texas Tech. The Horns are a perfect 16-0 against Texas Tech in Austin during the Barnes era.
- **RIDLEY SEES DOUBLE:** Junior center **Cameron Ridley** recorded his second double-double in the last four games with his 15-point, 12-rebound effort in Wednesday's win against TCU. He set a season high in rebounds and tied his season high with four blocks in 28 minutes.
- **YANCY INCREASES HIS ROLE:** Sophomore guard **Kendal Yancy** has averaged 28.7 minutes per game over the last three contests. Yancy recorded 12 points (3-6 FG, 2-4 threes, 4-4 FT) and four rebounds in 22 minutes during Wednesday's victory against TCU.

TEXAS TECH SERIES INFO

- Saturday's contest marks the 135th meeting between Texas and Texas Tech.
- The Longhorns hold a 80-54 lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 48-28 Texas victory in Austin on Dec. 15, 1939.
- UT is 35-5 against the Red Raiders since the Big 12 began in 1996-97.
- Texas has won 12 of the last 13 and 18 of the last 20 games against Tech.
- **UT is a perfect 16-0 against the Red Raiders in Austin during the Barnes era.**
- Texas is 31-4 against Texas Tech during the Rick Barnes era.

BARNES RECORDS CAREER WIN NO. 600

- Texas coach **Rick Barnes** earned career victory No. 600 with Wednesday's 66-43 home win against TCU. He enters Saturday's contest with an overall career record of 600-308 (.661) in 28 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- **With Wednesday's victory, Barnes became just the 13th ACTIVE NCAA Division I men's basketball coach to reach the 600-win milestone** (joining: Mike Krzyzewski, Duke; Jim Boeheim, Syracuse; Bob Huggins, West Virginia; Roy Williams, North Carolina; Bo Ryan, Wisconsin; Rick Pitino, Louisville, Rick Byrd, Belmont; Jerry Slocum, Youngstown State; Cliff Ellis, Coastal Carolina; Larry Hunter, Western Carolina; John Beilein, Michigan; Stew Morrill, Utah State).

HORNS AT HOME

- UT is currently in its 38th season of play at the Frank Erwin Center.
- The Longhorns have registered an all-time record of 460-108 (.810) in the building.
- Since Rick Barnes arrived in Austin, UT has recorded a 235-36 (.867) mark at the Erwin Center, including a 109-27 (.801) record in Big 12 Conference home games.
- **Texas is 188-25 (.883) at the Erwin Center in the last 13 seasons (dating to the start of the 2002-03 season).**

LONE STAR STATE SUCCESS

- Since Rick Barnes arrived in Austin prior to the 1998-99 season, the Longhorns have emerged as the dominant college basketball program in the state of Texas.
- **The Horns have posted a 146-22 (.869) record against in-state foes during the Barnes era entering Saturday's game in Austin**, including marks of 29-9 against Baylor, 31-4 against Texas Tech, 23-7 against Texas A&M and 8-0 against TCU.

TCU POSTGAME NOTES

- The Longhorns have won 11 straight and 15 of the last 16 meetings against TCU.
- UT improved to 8-0 against TCU in the Rick Barnes era.
- Texas has won 13 straight home games against the Horned Frogs.
- The Horns limited TCU to 28.8% FG shooting (15-of-52), marking the sixth time this year UT has held its opponent below 30% FG shooting (6-0 record in those games).
- UT improved to 7-0 this season when shooting at least 50% from the field. Texas converted 19-of-37 (.514) field goals during the contest.
- **Javan Felix** reached double figures in scoring (game-high 16 points) for the 11th time this year and 40th time in his career (89 games). He tied his season high in three-pointers made (4-of-7).
- **Cameron Ridley** recorded his second double-double (15 points, 12 rebounds) of the year and 13th of his career (92 games). He reached double figures in scoring for the ninth time this year and 31st time in his career. Ridley reached double figures in rebounds for the third time this season and 19th time in his career. He set a season high in rebounds (two shy of career high) and tied his season highs in blocks (4) and free throws made (7-of-13).
- **Kendal Yancy** reached double figures in scoring (12 points) for the third time this year and sixth time in his career (58 games).

A CONSISTENT DANCER

Texas has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 15 of Rick Barnes' first 16 seasons. UT has made a total of 31 all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (35-34 record). **The Horns have earned a bid to the NCAA tourney 23 times in the last 26 years.**

AN "ELITE" PROGRAM

Texas has reached the NCAA Elite Eight twice in the last nine years and three times in the last 12 seasons. During the Barnes era, the Horns have made trips to the regional final in 2003 (beat Michigan State to advance to the Final Four), 2006 (lost to LSU in overtime) and 2008 (lost to Memphis). **UT has advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight a total of seven times in program history** (1939, 1943, 1947, 1990, 2003, 2006 and 2008).

IN "SWEET" COMPANY

Texas has advanced to at least the NCAA Sweet 16 a total of five times in the last 13 years. The Longhorns have advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 a total of 13 times in program history (1939, 1943, 1947, 1960, 1963, 1972, 1990, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008).

DEFENSE WINS

Solid defense has been a trademark of the Texas program under Rick Barnes. Since Barnes arrived in Austin, the Horns have held 279 of their 572 opponents to under 40% FG shooting. **Texas sports a 251-28 (.900) mark in the Barnes era when accomplishing the feat** (14-2 mark in 2014-15).

- UT has held its first 24 opponents to an average of 59.4 ppg on a combined 36.1% FG shooting (492-of-1364), including a 33.1% mark from three-point range (141-of-426). **Texas ranks FOURTH nationally in FG percentage defense (.361) through games of Feb. 11.**
- The Horns have held 16 of their first 24 opponents to under 40% FG shooting.
- UT has held six of their first 24 opponents to under 30% FG shooting (6-0 record in those games).
- Texas held No. 16/15 West Virginia (Jan. 17) to 50 points on 24.1% FG shooting (13-of-54). **This marked a UT record for lowest FG percentage allowed (24.1) in a Big 12 Conference regular-season contest** (previous: 25.0 at Baylor [13-of-52] on Feb. 19, 2000). The 13 field goals allowed by UT also tied a school record for fewest FG allowed in a Big 12 game.
- UT limited No. 24/22 Connecticut (Nov. 30) to 54 points on 30.4% FG shooting (17-of-56), including a 3-of-16 (.188) mark from three-point range.
- Texas limited Cal (Nov. 21) to 55 points on 31.3% FG shooting (20-of-64).
- UT held No. nr/25 Iowa (Nov. 20) to 57 points on 29.6% FG shooting (16-of-54), including a 4-of-14 (.286) mark from three-point range.

IMPROVED 'D' RECENTLY

Texas has been a much-improved defensive team in its last two victories against Kansas State (Feb. 7) and TCU (Feb. 11).

- **In those two games, the Longhorns have held their opponents to an average of 50.0 points per game on a combined 30.3% FG shooting (30-of-99).**
- UT limited TCU (Feb. 11) to 43 points on 28.8% FG shooting (15-of-52).
- Texas held K-State (Feb. 7) to 31.9% FG shooting (15-of-47), including a 24.0% mark (6-of-25) in the first half.

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Texas sports a +10.2 rebound margin (41.1-30.9) through its first 24 games this year and has outrebounded its opponent in 19 of its first 24 contests (UConn, Oklahoma, Kansas and Baylor have been the only four teams to win the rebound battle against UT; Texas was even at Oklahoma State). **The rebound margin (+10.2) ranks SECOND nationally through games of Feb. 11.**
- UT has posted double-digit rebound advantages in 14 of its first 24 games this season.
- The Horns posted a +27 rebound advantage (55-28) against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- Texas recorded a +24 rebound margin (45-21) against Texas State (Dec. 13).
- The Horns registered a +11 rebound margin (42-31) at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5). The Wildcats entered the game with a +14.6 rebound margin.
- Texas posted a +27 (52-25) rebound margin against UT Arlington (Dec. 2).

BLOCK PARTY

The Horns set a single-season team record with 206 blocks in 2013-14 (previous mark: 203 in 1997-98).

- **UT has averaged 7.6 blocks per contest in its first 24 games this year (183 total blocks). Texas ranks FIRST nationally in blocks per game (thru games of Feb. 11).**
- The Horns have reached double figures in blocked shots a total of four times in their first 24 games.
- Texas tied a school record for most blocks in a Big 12 game with 12 at Oklahoma State (Jan. 10).
- UT set a single-game record for most blocked shots in a half (10) during the first half against Lipscomb (Dec. 16). The Horns recorded 11 blocked shots for the game.
- Texas tied a single-game school record with 13 blocks in the win against UT Arlington (Dec. 2). The Horns also blocked 13 shots vs. UTSA on Dec. 29, 2004 and vs. Cal on Nov. 15, 2000.

HOLMES LEADS BY CONSISTENT EXAMPLE

The lone scholarship senior on this year's roster, forward **Jonathan Holmes** is in his fourth year as a starter in the frontcourt. In his career, Holmes has reached double figures in scoring 55 times and in rebounds 14 times and has nine career double-doubles.

- **He leads the team in rebounding (6.4 rpg) and ranks second in scoring (11.5 ppg)** in 26.4 minutes per game while hitting 30-of-84 (.357) from three-point range and 62-of-78 (.795) free throws.
- Holmes suffered a concussion midway through the second half of the home game against Oklahoma State (Feb. 4). He has missed the last two contests (at Kansas State on Feb. 7 and vs. TCU on Feb. 11).
- He registered 17 points, 10 boards (six offensive) and two blocks in 32 minutes at No. 15/16 Iowa State (Jan. 26).
- Holmes recorded 16 points (career-high 11-of-12 FT) and 11 rebounds (five offensive) in 31 minutes against No. 16/15 West Virginia (Jan. 17).
- He recorded 12 points and 10 rebounds (eight offensive) in 29 minutes against Rice (Dec. 29).
- Holmes tied his career high in rebounds (16) against UT Arlington (Dec. 2). Nine of his 16 boards came on the offensive glass.

HOLMES JOINS 1,000-POINT CLUB

With his layup at the 19:52 mark of the second half at Texas Tech (Jan. 3), **Jonathan Holmes became the 34th player in UT history to join the 1,000-point club.** He enters Saturday's contest with 1,090 points in 117 career games (99 starts).

LAST-SECOND HEROICS FOR HOLMES ... AGAIN

Jonathan Holmes connected on the game-winning three-pointer from the left corner with 2.2 seconds left during the win at No. 24/22 Connecticut (Nov. 30). **This marked Holmes' second collegiate game-winning shot, either at the buzzer or within the final three seconds of regulation.** Last year (Jan. 21, 2014), he converted a three-pointer from the right corner as time expired to lift Texas to a 67-64 home win against No. 22 Kansas State. In addition, Holmes also hit a game-tying three-pointer with three seconds left in regulation to force overtime in a home contest against West Virginia (Jan. 9, 2013) during his sophomore campaign.

HOLMES SHINES IN THE BIG APPLE

Jonathan Holmes claimed 2K Classic Tournament MVP honors, averaging 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game while hitting 13-of-23 (.565) field goals, including 4-of-8 threes, and 10-of-13 (.769) free throws during the two contests at Madison Square Garden.

- Holmes also earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week (Nov. 24) accolades for his performance in New York City.
- He had a team-high 19 points (7-of-12 FG, 3-of-5 threes) and five boards in 31 minutes against No. nr/25 Iowa (Nov. 20). Holmes scored 17 of his 19 points in the second half (6-of-8 FG, 3-of-4 threes in final 20 minutes).
- Holmes tallied a game-high 21 points (6-of-11 FG, 8-of-10 FT), 13 rebounds and two blocks in 32 minutes against Cal (Nov. 21) in the title game.

TAYLOR RETURNS TO FORM

Sophomore point guard **Isaiah Taylor** started the first 38 games of his career prior to suffering a left wrist injury against Iowa (Nov. 20). He missed 10 games (UT went 8-2 without Taylor) before returning to action in the Big 12 opener at Texas Tech (Jan. 3). Taylor has played in 49 career games (all starts) and has reached double figures in scoring 37 times, including seven 20-point performances.

- **He leads the team in scoring (14.0 ppg) while adding 4.2 apg and 3.7 rpg in a team-best 31.6 mpg.** He has converted 54-of-66 (.818) free throws.
- **Despite missing 10 games, Taylor LEADS the team in steals (12) and ranks second in total assists (59) on the year.**
- He registered a game-high 23 points (6-of-10 FG, 11-of-15 FT) and four assists in 39 minutes in the win at Kansas State (Feb. 7). He set a career high in FT made.
- Taylor tallied a game-high 18 points (6-of-7 FT) while playing in a career-best 43 minutes against Oklahoma State (Feb. 4).
- Taylor registered his first career double-double with 16 points and 10 assists against just one turnover and grabbed six

rebounds while tying his career high in minutes (38) at No. 20/19 Baylor (Jan. 26).

- He posted 17 points and eight assists without a turnover in 33 minutes at No. 15/16 Iowa State (Jan. 26).
- Taylor recorded a season-high 23 points (7-of-8 FT) and five rebounds in 35 minutes against No. 11/14 Kansas (Jan. 24).
- He had 13 points (6-of-12 FG), seven boards and six assists at TCU (Jan. 19).
- Taylor posted a game-high 18 points (6-of-11 FG, 2-of-3 threes) and seven rebounds in 28 minutes against North Dakota State (Nov. 14).
- He appeared on a regional cover of *Sports Illustrated* in early November. Texas was one of five schools selected for a regional cover in the magazine's annual College Basketball Preview issue, joining Arizona, Duke, Kentucky and Wisconsin.
- Taylor was one of 36 players named to the preseason watch list of candidates for the 2015 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball.

HOLLAND IS THE GLUE

Junior **Demarcus Holland** has played in all 93 career games (71 starts) in his first three seasons. **Holland has started the last 59 games.** He earned the team's Most Outstanding Defensive Player award in each of his first two seasons. In his career, Holland has reached double figures in scoring 18 times and in rebounds three times.

- **He leads the team in assists (65) and ranks second in minutes (29.9 mpg) and sixth in scoring (7.0 ppg) while hitting 59-of-122 (.484) field goals, including 15-of-34 (.441) from three-point range, and 34-of-48 (.708) free throws.**
- Holland tallied a season-high 14 points (5-of-6 FG, 4-of-4 threes) and five rebounds in a career-high 42 minutes during the home overtime loss to Oklahoma State (Feb. 4). His four 3-pointers made also were a career high.
- He set a career high with eight assists against just two turnovers while adding nine points in 28 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- Holland registered 10 points (5-of-5 FT), four rebounds (three offensive), five assists against one turnover and two steals in 38 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- He had 11 points (7-of-7 FT) and five rebounds in 35 minutes during the 2K Classic title game against Cal (Nov. 21).

TURNER OFF TO SOLID START

Freshman forward Myles Turner leads the team in blocks (65, 2.71 bpg) and ranks second on the team in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and third in scoring (10.8 ppg) through the first 24 contests. He has converted 76-of-91 (.835) free throws while averaging 22.0 minutes per game. Turner has reached double figures in scoring 10 times this year.

- Turner has recorded at least five blocked shots in six of his first 24 contests and at least three blocks in 11 of the first 24 games.
- Earlier in the year (Dec. 2-29), he converted 22 consecutive free throws. The streak was snapped in his final attempt against Rice (Dec. 29) and dated back to the UTA game on Dec. 2 (span of seven contests).
- Turner registered 16 points (7-of-12 FG), six boards and three blocks in 24 minutes at No. 15/16 Iowa State (Jan. 26).
- He posted 16 points (9-of-9 FT) and seven rebounds in 24 minutes against No. 16/15 West Virginia (Jan. 17).
- Turner tallied a team-high 18 points (4-of-4 threes), six boards and five blocks in 26 minutes at Oklahoma State (Jan. 10).
- He started and had a season-high 11 rebounds and two blocks in 31 minutes at Texas Tech (Jan. 3).
- Turner made his first collegiate start against Rice (Dec. 29) and posted a team-high 16 points (6-of-7 FG) in 22 minutes.
- He tallied a season-high 26 points (9-of-15 FG, 7-of-7 FT), nine boards and six blocks in 23 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- Turner posted 18 points (14-of-17 FT), 10 rebounds (six offensive) and five blocks in 22 minutes against UT Arlington (Dec. 2).
- He had 10 points (4-of-7 FG), seven boards and six blocks in 20 minutes against Alcorn State (Nov. 16). His six blocks were one shy of the UT freshman mark (shared by Chris Mihm and Tristan Thompson).
- Turner tallied 15 points (6-of-8 FG, 3-of-4 FT), six rebounds and two blocks in 20 minutes against North Dakota State (Nov. 14). The 15 points were just five shy of the UT record for most in a collegiate debut (20 by Kevin Durant in 2006-07).
- He was one of 14 players named to the 2015 Integris Wayman Tisdale Award Midseason Watch List (Jan. 23). The award is presented to the national freshman of the year by the USBWA.

- Turner tied the UT single-game record for highest FG percentage (min. 10 attempts). He converted 11-of-12 (.917) field goal attempts. That tied the mark set by Butch Skeete at SMU on Feb. 6, 1962 (11-of-12 FG).

RIDLEY'S RESUME

Junior center **Cameron Ridley** has played in 92 career games (75 starts). He hit the game-winning putback against Arizona State

at the buzzer in the NCAA Second Round last year. In his career, Ridley has reached double figures in scoring 31 times and in rebounds 19 times and has 13 career double-doubles.

- Ridley ranks second on the team in blocks (43, 1.79 bpg), fourth in rebounding (5.2 rpg) and fifth in scoring (8.9 ppg).
- He registered 15 points (4-of-7 FG, 7-of-13 FT), 12 rebounds and four blocks in 28 minutes against TCU (Feb. 11).
- Ridley tallied 12 points (6-of-8 FT), five boards and three blocks in 34 minutes against Oklahoma State (Feb. 4).
- He posted 12 points (6-of-12 FG) and 11 rebounds (seven offensive) in 29 minutes at No. 20/19 Baylor.
- Ridley recorded a game and season-high 19 points (8-of-10 FG), six boards, four blocks and two steals in 26 minutes against No. 16/15 West Virginia (Jan. 17). He tied his career high in field goals made.
- He registered 11 boards (five offensive) and two blocks in 28 minutes at Oklahoma State (Jan. 10).

THE FELIX FILE

Junior **Javan Felix** has played in 89 career games (48 starts). In his career, Felix has reached double figures in scoring 40 times, including seven 20-point performances.

- He ranks third on the team in assists (46) and fourth in scoring (10.5 ppg) in 26.1 minutes per game.
- After missing two games (Oklahoma State on Feb. 4 and at K-State on Feb. 7) with a concussion, Felix tallied a game-high 16 points (5-of-8 FG, 4-of-7 threes), three boards and four assists without a turnover in 26 minutes against TCU (Feb. 11).
- He recorded a season-high 20 points (7-of-8 FG, 4-of-4 threes, 2-of-2 FT) and a season-high eight assists against just one turnover in 29 minutes at No. 15/16 Iowa State (Jan. 26).
- Felix posted a game-high 15 points (6-of-11 FG) in 23 minutes at TCU (Jan. 19).
- He recorded a season-high 19 points (7-of-16 FG, 3-of-4 FT) and two assists without a turnover in 31 minutes against Stanford (Dec. 23).
- Felix tallied a team-high 17 points (6-of-9 FG, 3-of-5 threes), four rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 20).

LAMMERT PLAYING A LARGER ROLE

Junior **Connor Lammert** has played in all 93 career games (32 starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring 11 times and in rebounds five times and has two double-doubles.

- **He ranks third on the team in rebounding (5.8 rpg) and fifth in assists (32) through the first 24 games.**
- Lammert posted a season-high 12 points (4-of-7 FG, 3-of-6 threes) and a game-high nine rebounds in 28 minutes off the bench at Kansas State (Feb. 7). He tied his career high in three-

pointers made.

- He recorded his second career double-double with 10 points and 12 rebounds (one shy of his career high) in 27 minutes against Long Beach State (Dec. 20).
- Lammert posted 10 rebounds to go along with seven points and two assists in 29 minutes against Texas State (Dec. 13).
- He registered nine rebounds (four offensive) in 34 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- Lammert tallied 11 points (3-of-4 FG, 4-of-4 FT) and six boards in 24 minutes against Saint Francis (Nov. 25).
- He set a career high with seven assists without a turnover to go along with eight points in 17 minutes against Alcorn State (Nov. 16). Six of his seven assists came in the first half.

YANCY STEPPING UP

Sophomore guard **Kendal Yancy** has played in 58 career games (18 starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring six times.

- Yancy ranks in fourth on the team in assists (38) this season.
- **He has averaged 28.7 minutes per contest over the last three games.**
- Yancy started and posted 12 points (3-of-6 FG, 2-of-4 threes, 4-of-4 FT) and four boards in 22 minutes against TCU (Feb. 11).
- He started and tallied seven points, five rebounds and two assists in 27 minutes at Kansas State (Feb. 7).
- Yancy logged a career-high 37 minutes off the bench and added four points, three rebounds and two assists against Oklahoma State (Feb. 4).
- During the 10 contests that Isaiah Taylor was injured, Yancy averaged 7.2 ppg and 4.4 rpg in 27.2 minutes per game.
- He started and set career highs in scoring (14 points) and field goals made (6-of-10) and added five boards in 34 minutes against Stanford (Dec. 23).
- Yancy started and set a career high with seven assists against just one turnover in 20 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).
- He started and set a career high with eight rebounds and added three assists in 25 minutes against Texas State (Dec. 13).
- Yancy registered six rebounds (four offensive) in 17 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).
- He started and posted 12 points (5-of-10 FG) and six rebounds while tying his career high in minutes (34) against Saint Francis (Nov. 25).

PRINCE'S PRESENCE

Junior center **Prince Ibeh** has played in all 93 career games (six starts). In his career, he has reached double figures in scoring four times and in rebounding one time.

- **Ibeh ranks third on the team with 29 blocked shots this season.**
- He tied his season high with four blocked shots to go along with four points and four rebounds in 20 minutes off the bench at Kansas State (Feb. 7). Ibeh's solid defense on Thomas Gipson (0-7 FG) forced a Gipson miss in the final 10 seconds.

Ibeh then grabbed the defensive board (jump ball) to seal the victory.

- Ibeh recorded a season-high seven rebounds in 13 minutes at TCU (Jan. 19).
- He made his first start of the year (fifth of his career) at Texas Tech (Jan. 3). It marked his first start since Feb. 9, 2013 vs. Oklahoma State.
- Ibeh registered a season-high four blocks against Long Beach State (Dec. 20).
- He recorded six points (2-of-3 FG) and four rebounds in 17 minutes at No. 1/1 Kentucky (Dec. 5).

BARNETT MAKING STRIDES

Freshman forward **Jordan Barnett** has played in 20 of the first 24 contests and is averaging 2.0 points and 1.4 rebounds in 9.0 minutes per game.

- Barnett registered six points (2-of-2 threes) and two rebounds in 11 minutes against No. 16/18 Oklahoma (Jan. 5).
- He recorded a season-high three assists and tied his season highs in rebounds (four) and steals (two) while adding four points in 21 minutes against Rice (Dec. 29).
- Barnett had a season-high 11 points (4-of-5 FG, 3-of-3 threes), four rebounds, one assist and two steals in a season-high 24 minutes against Lipscomb (Dec. 16).

THREE-POINT STREAK

The last time Texas did not convert a three-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC-Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc on that day. **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 815 consecutive games.** In fact, UT has converted at least one three-pointer in 943 of 949 games since the trey was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season. The Horns have failed to attempt at least one three-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988; at TCU, 69-55 win).

NOTEWORTHY VICTORY AT UCONN

- UT's 55-54 win in Storrs (Nov. 30) snapped a 44-game win streak by the Huskies against non-conference opponents at Gampel Pavilion. The streak dated back to a UConn loss to Detroit-Mercy in the 2001 NIT (March 18, 2001).
- The last time UConn had lost a regular season non-conference game in Gampel to a ranked (AP) opponent came on Feb. 6, 1993 to No. 12 Florida State.
- Prior to the win by Texas, UConn had not lost an on-campus, non-conference game played in November/December since a 91-85 defeat to Holy Cross on Dec. 5, 1973.

2K CLASSIC CHAMPIONS

- Texas captured the 2K Classic benefitting Wounded Warrior Project championship with back-to-back wins against nr/#25 Iowa (71-57) and Cal (71-55) at Madison Square Garden.
- UT captured its first November neutral-site tournament title since the 2009 CBE Classic in Kansas City.

RECORD-SETTING DEFENSE

- Texas limited Texas State (Dec. 13) to 27 points on 21.6% FG shooting (11-of-51).
- **The 27 points marked the fewest points Texas has allowed since Dec. 6, 1946** (53-23 home win against Houston YMCA).

- It marked the first time UT had held an opponent below 30 points since Feb. 25, 1948 (32-29 home victory against Baylor).
- UT held the Bobcats to just nine points on 16.0% FG shooting (4-of-25) in the first half. **This marked the fewest points allowed in a half by the Longhorns since the start of the 1949-50 season** (as far back as the school has box scores and records in a half). The previous mark for fewest points allowed in a half was 10 (2nd half vs. Nicholls State on Dec. 13, 2011; 2nd half vs. Baylor on Jan. 21, 1984). The previous mark for fewest points allowed in a first half was 11 (vs. Arkansas-Monticello on Nov. 18, 2007).
- The 21.6% FG shooting marked the third-lowest FG percentage allowed by UT in a game since the start of the 1949-50 season.

SUCCESS IN THE CLASSROOM

- Texas Basketball has received public recognition awards for its multi-year NCAA Division I Academic Progress Rate (APR) in each of the last five years (2010-14). The awards are given to teams scoring in the Top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sport. **UT has earned a perfect 1,000 score in each of the last five multi-year APR reports.** In addition, Men's Basketball has posted perfect 1,000 APR single-year scores in EVERY season dating back to 2005-06 (eight consecutive years).
- The Men's Basketball team's semester GPA in Spring 2014 was a 3.33 (4.0 scale), the highest single-semester team GPA in program history.
- **The team's semester GPA in Fall 2014 was a 3.12. The team finished the Fall 2014 semester with a team cumulative GPA of 3.19.**
- Twelve of UT's 16-man roster were named to the Fall 2014 Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll (achieving a minimum 3.0 GPA for the semester).
- Twelve UT players hold a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better.
- Four UT players earned a spot on the 2014 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team. **Connor Lammert** was named to the First Team, while **Javan Felix**, **Demarcus Holland** and **Prince Ibeh** were each selected to the Second Team.

SUCCESS IN THE BIG 12 UNDER BARNES

Since head coach Rick Barnes took over the Longhorns in 1998-99, Texas is the second-winningest team in regular season Big 12 Conference games over the last 17 years with 183 wins.

CONSISTENT SUCCESS IN THE BIG 12

Texas has reached the 10-win mark in Big 12 Conference play a total of 11 times in the first 16 seasons under Rick Barnes (the first 13 years featured 16-game league schedules). The Horns have recorded at least nine league wins in all but one of Barnes' 16 seasons in Austin. UT has recorded at least 13 conference victories in six of Barnes' 16 seasons in Austin (13-3 in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11).

LOOKING TO REACH 20-WIN MARK ... AGAIN

With their 24-11 mark last year, **the Longhorns reached the 20-win mark for the 14th time in 16 seasons under coach Rick Barnes.** UT had a school-record streak of 13 consecutive 20-win seasons snapped in 2012-13. Prior to that streak, the previous school mark for most consecutive 20-win seasons was four (1988-89 to 1991-92). The Longhorns have reached the 20-win plateau of total of 29 times in their previous 108 seasons of basketball.

BEATING THE BEST

UT's win at No. 2 Kansas on Jan. 22, 2011 equaled the highest-ranked (AP) opponent the Longhorns have defeated in school history. Six of Texas' nine all-time wins against AP Top Three teams have come during the Rick Barnes era.

UT INKS GUARD DUO DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

Eric Davis (Saginaw, Mich.) and **Kerwin Roach** (Houston, Texas) signed a National Letter of Intent to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. The guard duo will join the Longhorns for the 2015-16 season.

- **Davis** (6-3, 172), a guard from Saginaw Arthur Hill High School who plays under coach Greg McMath, is ranked as the No. 41 overall prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 42 by 247Sports and No. 53 by Rivals.com. He averaged 27 points, five rebounds, four assists and three steals per game in his junior year while leading Arthur Hill to the Saginaw Valley League championship. Davis earned Michigan Class A Player of the Year honors as a junior.
- **Roach** (6-3, 160), a guard from Houston's North Shore High School who plays under coach David Green, is ranked as the No. 35 overall prospect in the nation by Rivals.com and No. 71 by 247Sports. He averaged a team-best 16.1 points per game as a junior while leading North Shore to a 33-3 record and the Class 5A state title. Roach also claimed the 5A state championship in the triple jump last May in Austin.

OFF THE COURT WITH THE HORNS

- **Brandon Allums** served as a practice player for the Texas women's basketball team in 2012-13 (his freshman year).
- **Jordan Barnett's** father, Bob Bonner, played basketball at Midwestern State University (Wichita Falls, Texas) for four years. Jordan and his mom (Karen Barnett) lived in San Antonio, when Jordan was two-to-six years old.
- **Shaquille Cleare's** father, Brian, played basketball at the University of Science and Arts of Oklahoma (Chickasha, Okla.). He wears jersey No. 32 to honor his father, who also wore No. 32 during his collegiate playing days. Cleare was high school teammates with **Isaiah Taylor** at The Village School (Houston), when Cleare was a senior and Taylor was a junior.
- **Javan Felix** is oldest of four children (has three younger sisters). The Felix family was forced to relocate to Atlanta for four months while Javan was in sixth grade due to Hurricane Katrina (August 2005). The family was able to return to New Orleans in January 2006. Felix has interest in becoming an NBA General Manager following his playing career.
- **Demarcus Holland** moved to Dallas from Tyler when he was in the second grade. He has one older brother, Derrick, Jr., and three younger brothers, Craig, Desmond and Devon.
- **Jonathan Holmes'** father, Daryl, played football at the University of Nebraska (lettered in 1980 as a defensive end).
- **Prince Ibeh** was born in London and lived there for his first five years. He moved with his family to Amarillo, Texas at age five and lived there until he was 10 years old. The family then moved to Dallas when Prince was 10. His parents (Francis and Charity) lived in Mbaise, Nigeria before moving to London in 1987. Prince's middle name is Chinenye (pronounced KEN-yay). The name in Nigerian means "god's gift." Prince has three older brothers and one younger sister.
- **Connor Lammert** has an older brother, Clark, who is a senior on the basketball team at Texas Tech. His father, Dean Lammert, played basketball at Texas A&I University (now called Texas A&M University-Kingsville) from 1980-83. His mother, the former Christi Scherrey, played volleyball at Texas A&I University from 1979-82.
- **Tarale Murry** is the cousin of former UT basketball player Ivan Wagner and former UT football player Wane McGarity.
- **Isaiah Taylor's** uncle, Terrell Lowery, played basketball at Loyola Marymount (1989-92). As a sophomore on the 1990 LMU squad that advanced to the "Elite Eight" in the NCAA Tournament, Lowery also played professional baseball, including stints with the Chicago Cubs (1997-98), Tampa Bay Devil Rays (1999) and the San Francisco Giants (2000).
- **Myles Turner** wears jersey No. 52 to honor Habram (huh-BRAUM) Rosario, a close friend and middle school teammate who passed away from leukemia when Myles was in ninth grade (Rosario wore No. 52 on the middle school team).
- **Kendal Yancy's** brother, Terrel Harris, played basketball at Oklahoma State and went on to play professionally with the Miami Heat (2011-2013) and New Orleans Hornets.

The all-time winningest coach in UT history, Rick Barnes, is in his 17th season at Texas. He has compiled 600 wins in his 28 years as a head coach at George Mason, Providence, Clemson and Texas. With the home win against TCU (Feb. 11), Barnes earned his 600th career victory and became the 13th active Men's Basketball Division I coach to reach the 600-win milestone (counting victories only while at Division I schools). Barnes has guided his teams to a total of 21 NCAA and three NIT trips.

• UT has recorded at least 13 league victories in seven of Barnes' first 16 seasons in Austin (13-3 in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11). The Longhorns have reached the 10-win mark in Big 12 Conference play a total of 11 times in the 16 seasons under Barnes. Texas posted 9-7 conference marks in 2004-05, 2008-09 and 2009-10 and a 9-9 league record in 2011-12. The Horns have recorded at least nine league wins in 15 of Barnes' first 16 seasons in Austin.

• UT owns a 34-20 (.630) mark against AP Top 25 opponents at the Erwin Center under Barnes.

• Barnes had a personal streak of 17 consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances snapped during the 2012-13 season. Barnes reached the NCAA tourney in each of his last three years at Clemson (1996-98) and in each of his first 14 seasons at Texas (1999-2012).
