While the majority of the Texas Track and Field team rests in preparation for next week's Big 12 Championships, the Longhorns are sending a men's distance medley relay team to the Alex Wilson Invitational hosted by Notre Dame this weekend.

The Alex Wilson Invitational has become a meet known for producing a number of qualifying times for the NCAA Championships in the distance events. The DMR is expected to be the highlight of the meet as half the 2014 men's DMR teams at the NCAA meet qualified at this meet.

In 2013, all 12 DMR squads at the NCAA Championships ran their qualifying times at the Alex Wilson Invitational.

Texas will send the group of Brady Turnbull, Chris Irvin, Robert Uhr and Craig Lutz to the meet to see if the Longhorns can run fast enough to rank among the top 12 in the NCAA and reach the national championship meet.

Fans can watch the action live on FloTrack.org with a subscription to the site's FloCast services. Live results will be provided at deltatiming.com and updates will be available on Twitter by following the handles @UTexasTrack and @NDXCTF.

Texas currently ranks No. 16 in the NCAA this season and the top 12 relay teams advance to the NCAA Championships.

TEXAS TRACK & FIELD NOTEBOOK Longhorns Move into Top Five

- This week the men's and women's teams both moved into the Top Five of the USTFCCCA Rankings
- The rankings this week only take marks into account from the current season, except for the combined events (pentathlon/heptathlon)
- The Longhorn men moved up from No. 9 to No. 5 while the women climbed two spots to No. 4.
- Texas is among four schools that have their men and women ranked in the Top Five.
- The Big 12 Conference is well represented in the Top 25 with seven men's teams and four women's teams ranked this week. Three of the women's teams are No. 9 or better and all four are in the Top 15. Oklahoma State (9) joins Texas in the men's Top 10.

Women's 4x400 Leaves Competition Behind

- In a heat loaded with the No. 2, 3, 4 and 5 times in the NCAA, the Texas Longhorns women's 4x400 meter relay left Clemson, Arkansas and Florida behind to win at the Tyson Invitational.
- The team of Morolake Akinosun, Ashley Spencer, Courtney Okolo and Kendall Baisden combined to run 3:29.36 for the No. 1 time in the nation this year.
- It is the No. 1 time by nearly three seconds and ranks No. 10 in NCAA history.

Fares & Phynn Leap into Contention

- Long jumper Basil Fares posted a new personal best mark to win the Tyson Invitational.
- His jump of 7.79 meters (25-6.75) leads the Big 12 and moved him into the top 10 in the nation this year.
- Triple jumper Nick Phynn won the Tyson Invitational with a PR of 15.89 meters (52-1.75).
- Phynn posted personal bests on each of his first three jumps.
- Phynn leads the Big 12 Conference and ranks 12th in the NCAA this season.

Longhorns Surprise Field in Men's 4x400

- The men's 4x400 meter relay team of Byron Robinson, Zack Bilderback, Senoj-Jay Givans and Chris Irvin wowed the crowd at the Tyson Invitational with a dominating win in their heat.
- The time of 3:06.76 was just .11 of the school record and is now the No. 1 time in the Big 12 this year and is No. 7 in the NCAA.

Raines Moves Up in 5000m

- Sandie Raines ran No. 2 time in school history at the Husky Classic. Her time of 15:50.49 is second in UT history and less than half a second from breaking the record in the 5000m.
- Raines finished third against an NCAA Championship caliber field as well and now ranks eighth in the nation this season.

Crouser No. 1 in World

- NCAA champion Ryan Crouser entered the UW Invitational ranked No. 2 in the NCAA this season, he left No. 1 in the world. He posted a world-leading mark of 20.95 meters (68-9.00).
- Crouser was named Big 12 Conference Athlete of the Week for his performance at UW.
- He won the invitational shot put competition at the Tyson Invitational with the top six throwers in the NCAA in the field with a mark of 20.66 meters (67-9.50).

400m Depth

- The women's team boasts three returning first team All-Americans in the 400m
- Courtney Okolo is No. 1 in the world currently with her time of 51.35 seconds at the New Mexico Collegiate Classic.
- Okolo was recognized as Big 12 Co-Athlete of the Week for her win at UNM.
- Kendall Baisden is No. 2, clocking in at 51.81 seconds to win at the Rod McCravy Memorial.
- Ashley Spencer ran her first 400m race of the season to finish sixth at Tyson Invitational.
- Spencer's time of 52.46 seconds ranks 10th in the NCAA this season.
- Spencer and Okolo represent the last three NCAA outdoor titles in the 400m.

The Bowerman Award is given to the most outstanding male and female collegiate student-athlete in track & field annually by The United States Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association.

Past winners from the previous four years since its inception have won two Olympic Medals, two IAAF World Championships and six World Championship medals.

The award is named after Bill Bowerman, former legendary coach of the Oregon Ducks and co-founder of NIKE, who make significant contributions to the sport of track & field.



Cross Country Makes the Grade
