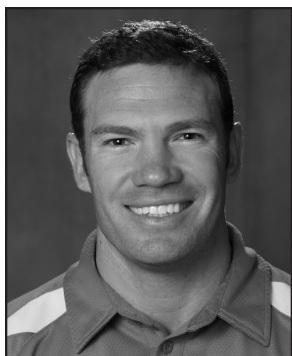

A four-year running back who played in 44 games with 25 starts ... started the last 17 games of his career ... ended his career No. 9 on the Texas all-time rushing yards list (2,678) ... had 11 career 100-yard rushing games which ranks tied for seventh in school history at the end of his career ... had 24 career rushing touchdowns which was only three from the UT all-time top 10 ... a two-time All-Big 12 selection by the coaches (second team in both 2013 & '14) ... member of the preseason watch lists for the 2014 Maxwell Award and Doak Walker Award ... a 2014 Academic All-Big 12 choice ... played in the 2015 East-West Shrine Game ... attended the 2015 NFL Combine ... a 2014 preseason first-team All-Big 12 selection by the league media, Athlon, Lindy's, Sporting News USA Today and Phil Steele ... a 2013 All-Big 12 selection (coaches) ... selected to the 2012 Maxwell Award watch list ... named 2011 second-team Freshman All-America by Yahoo! Sports ... named the 2011 Big 12 Newcomer of the Year (AP, Houston Chronicle, San Antonio Express-News, Fort Worth Star-Telegram) and the Big 12 Offensive Newcomer of the Year (Kansas City Star) ... one of 13 Texas freshmen to rush for over 500 yards in a season ... ranks seventh on the single season rushing yards (742) list for freshmen and tied for ninth for rushing touchdowns (5) ... his three 100-yard rushing games in 2011 are the third-most by a Longhorn freshman ... was on the College Football Performance Awards National Freshman Performer of the Year watch list ... prep All-American who played in the U.S. Army All-American Bowl ... an ESPN top 150 national prospect ... ranked as the seventh-best prospect in his class by ESPN ... named to the Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll each of the last two semesters.

### SENIOR (2014)

Started all 13 games at running back ... a second-team All-Big 12 selection by the league's coaches ... second-team Academic All-Big 12 ... led the team with 708 rushing yards and second with six rushing touchdowns ... had three games with two TDs (North Texas, Iowa State, Texas Tech) ... moved from 17th to ninth on the school's career rushing yards list during the season ... rushed for 65 yards on 13 carries with two TDs against North Texas ... ran for 33 yards on 14 carries against BYU ... rushed for 69 yards and caught two passes for 8 yards against UCLA ... served as a game captain for the UCLA game ... had 12 carries for 29 yards and two catches for 5 yards against Kansas ... rushed for 55 yards on 12 carries against Baylor ... rushed for 78 yards on 19 carries against Oklahoma ... carried the ball 14 times for 72 yards and two TDs against Iowa State ... had six carries for 21 yards against Kansas State ... had season highs in carries (22) and rushing yards (116) against Texas Tech ... also had two rushing TDs vs. the Red Raiders ... earned the team's offensive player of the game ... rushed for 90 yards on 20 carries against West Virginia ... carried the ball 15 times for 31 yards and had one reception for 11 yards against Oklahoma State ... ran 10 times for 29 yards and had season highs in catches (4) and receiving yards (33) vs. TCU ... rushed seven times for 25 yards vs. Arkansas in the Texas Bowl.

### JUNIOR (2013)

Played in all 13 games at running back with four starts (Oklahoma State, Texas Tech, Baylor and Oregon) ... first on the team in rushing yards (904) and all-purpose yards (1,099) ... second in all-purpose yards per game (84.5) ... a second team All-Big 12 choice (coaches) ... earned the team's D. Harold Byrd Tenacity Award for Offense ... a member of Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll ... his rushing total was the highest by a Longhorn since Jamaal Charles posted 1,619 in 2007 ... had five 100-yard rushing games, becoming the 11th player in Texas history to post five or more 100-yard

rushing games in a season... his team-best nine rushing touchdowns ranked tied for seventh in the Big 12 and all came in the last 10 games (eight in the last seven games) ... ranked seventh in the Big 12 in rushing (69.5 ypg) ... averaged 105.1 rushing yards over the last eight games (841 total yards) ... averaged 11.5 yards per reception on the season ... had six touches for 112 all-purpose yards against New Mexico State, including a career-long touchdown reception of 74 yards, which is the third-longest by a running back in UT history ... posted a career-high 109 receiving yards, becoming the fourth RB in UT history to have 100-plus in a game ... posted 15 yards on three carries and 15 receiving yards on two receptions vs. BYU ... registered 40 yards on nine carries, including a touchdown, and 7 yards on one reception against Kansas State ... had five touches for 20 all-purpose yards (8rush/12rec) vs. Iowa State ... rushed for 120 yards on 23 carries against Oklahoma ... earned one of the team's offensive player of the game awards ... it marked his sixth 100-yard rushing game and first time he and Johnathan Gray (123) had more than 100 yards in the same game (31st time in school history two players rushed for more than 100 yards) ... registered 17 carries for 51 yards with two rushing touchdowns against TCU ... recorded 20 rushes for 119 yards and a career-high four rushing TDs vs. Kansas ... became the 10th player in school history to post four or more rushing TDs in one game ... named honorable mention running back of the week by CFPA and shared the team's offensive player of the week award with Jaxon Shipley for his performance vs. the Jayhawks ... matched a career high with 28 carries for 89 yards with one touchdown against West Virginia ... also had two receptions for 10 yards vs. the Mountaineers ... had his first start of the season at tailback against Oklahoma State ... registered 25 carries for 73 yards, including one touchdown, and two receptions for 16 yards vs. the Cowboys ... posted 27 rushes for 128 yards against Texas Tech ... it marked the third time (32nd in school history) he and Joe Bergeron (102) both rushed for more than 100 yards in the same game ... shared the team's offensive player of the game award with Bergeron ... recorded 25 carries for 131 yards and four receptions for 19 yards, including one touchdown, vs. Baylor ... rushing total was second highest of his career ... had a career-high 150 all-purpose yards in the game ... posted 26 carries for 130 yards in the Alamo Bowl against Oregon ... rushing total was the third highest of his career ... had a career-long 40-yard run in the game.

### SOPHOMORE (2012)

Played in eight games at running back with one start ... missed five contests due to injury ... averaged 40.5 rushing yards per game (third on the team) ... second on the team with four rushing touchdowns ... member of the Maxwell Award watch list ... tabbed preseason first-team All-Big 12 by Athlon, Lindy's and Phil Steele magazines ... rushed for 105 yards on 15 carries vs. Wyoming ... had a season long 31-yard run in the game ... it marked the second time he and Joe Bergeron (110) both rushed for more than 100 yards in the same game ... had just two carries vs. New Mexico despite being on the field for 22 offensive snaps ... rushed for 128 yards on 21 carries, including two touchdowns, against Ole Miss ... had a season-high 143 all-purpose yards in the game ... made his first start of the season vs. Oklahoma State ... had just 7 yards on three carries before leaving with an ankle injury ... missed the West Virginia, Oklahoma, Baylor, Kansas and Texas Tech games with the same injury ... posted 10 carries for 31 yards and one reception for 2 yards in his return against Iowa State ... had seven carries for 40 yards and two touchdowns (one rushing, one receiving) against Kansas State ... posted a career-high six receptions and 43 receiving yards against the Wildcats.

### FRESHMAN (2011)

Started in seven games and played in 10 contests ... named second-team Freshman All-America by Yahoo! Sports ... named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Year (AP, Houston Chronicle, San Antonio Express-News, Fort Worth Star-Telegram) and the Big 12 Offensive Newcomer of the Year (Kansas City Star) ... ranked second among true freshmen in the NCAA and was eighth overall in the Big 12 with 74.2 rushing yards per game ... led the team in rushing with 742 yards and five touchdowns on 172 carries ... he was the first true freshman to lead Texas in rushing since Cedric Benson in 2001 ... his 742 yards rank seventh most on the Texas freshmen rushing list while his five touchdowns are tied for ninth ... he caught three passes for 17 yards on the year ... rushed for at least 100 yards in three games to rank tied for third among all-time Texas freshmen ... helped the Texas offense rank 21st in the nation in rushing offense (202.6 ypg) and average 392.5 yards in total offense ... team's leading rusher in eight of the 13 games ... four rushes of 20 or more yards ... rushed for a career-high 135 yards and two touchdowns on 19 carries against Oklahoma State ... his touchdowns against the Cowboys came on runs of 15 and 24 yards as he received CFPA honorable mention Running Back of the Week and the team Offensive Player

of the Week honors ... tallied 119 yards and two touchdowns on 28 attempts against Kansas ... joined Joe Bergeron to become the first Texas freshmen duo to each rush for over 100 yards in the same game ... notched his first career 100-yard rushing performance in his first collegiate start at UCLA, finishing with 110 yards and one touchdown on 16 attempts ... his first rushing touchdown came on a 16-yard run ... made his college debut against Rice with 86 yards on 16 carries ... followed with 14 attempts for 68 yards against BYU ... tallied 63 yards on 15 rushes at Iowa State in his first Big 12 game ... recorded 54 rushing yards on 17 carries against Oklahoma while also catching a 19-yard pass ... returned to the lineup against Kansas State and had 11 carries for 33 yards after missing the Texas Tech and Missouri games with a foot injury ... carried the ball 13 times for 35 yards in the Holiday Bowl against California.

Coached by Mike Jinks at Steele High School ... prep All-American, two-time first-team all-state, three-time first-team all-district and three-year starter at running back ... earned first-team All-America honors from USA Today, CBS College Sports, RivalsHigh.com, ESPN RISE All-America and Parade Magazine ... a second-team MaxPreps U.S. Air Force All-American ... played in the 2011 U.S. Army All-American Bowl ... a member of ESPN's top 150 national prospects ... ranked as the second-best running back and seventh-best overall prospect by ESPN ... ranked as the eighth-best overall prospect by the Sporting News ... rated as the best running back by Dave Campbell's Texas Football ... a member of the Fort Worth Star-Telegram's Elite 11 and the Austin American-Statesman's Fab 55 (state's top prospects) ... four-year letterman who finished his career with 6,663 rushing yards (third-best in San Antonio history), 86 rushing TDs and 9.8 yards per carry ... helped Steele compile a 44-9 record in three years as a starter ... named first-team 5A all-state and 5A Offensive Player of the Year by the Texas Sports Writers Association as a senior ... a first-team All-Texas High School selection by Dave Campbell's Texas Football ... named Class 5A Offensive Player of the Year, while earning first-team All-State honors by the Associated Press ... helped lead Steele to a 14-2 record, a district championship and a state title ... tabbed the district 25-5A Offensive MVP ... rushed for 2,637 yards (ninth-best in San Antonio history and third-best in class 5A) and 33 TDs ... also returned a kickoff 102 yards for a TD ... named a Dave Campbell's Texas Football Player of the Week finalist after rushing for 353 yards and four TDs against Kerrville Tivy ... also named a finalist after rushing for 231 yards and three TDs on eight carries against Converse Wagner ... rushed for 242 yards and three TDs in a state quarterfinals win over MacArthur ... named the Offensive Player of the Game in the Class 5A Division II state championship in a win over Denton Guyer ... named the Sports Illustrated High School Player of the Week on Nov. 2 ... named to Tom Lemming's Junior All-American team ... tabbed first-team all-state by the Associated Press ... also earned first-team all-state honors from the TSWA ... tabbed the district 27-4A offensive MVP after recording 2,200 rushing yards and 33 TDs ... helped lead Steele to a 9-3 record and an appearance in the second round of the state playoffs ... rushed for 329 yards and four TDs in a win over Kerrville Tivy ... named to Class Acts by Dave Campbell's Texas Football ... selected to San Antonio Express-News' Sub-5A All-Area football first team as a sophomore ... tabbed first-team all-district 27-4A ... helped lead Steele to a 10-2 record, a co-district championship and an appearance in the second round of the state playoffs as a sophomore ... rushed for 1,352 yards and 17 TDs in seven games before a season-ending ankle injury ... named to Class Acts by Dave Campbell's Texas Football ... a four-year letterman in track and field and played basketball as a freshman ... state qualifier as a sophomore and regional qualifier as a junior in the 4x200-meter relay.

A three-year player who emerged as one of the best defensive players in the nation as a junior ... two-year starter who was named a 2014 finalist for both the Bronko Nagurski Trophy (top defensive player) and Outland Trophy (top interior lineman) ... earned 2014 All-America honors from Walter Camp, AP, FWAA, Sporting News, CBS Sports, USA Today and ESPN.com ... became the 47th Longhorn (eighth defensive tackle) to earn consensus first team All-America honors by appearing on the AP, Sporting News and FWAA squads ... he joined DTs Rodrique Wright (2005), Casey Hampton (2000), Tony Degrade (1984), Kenneth Sims (1980-81), Steve McMichael (1979), Brad Shearer (1977) and Scott Appleton (1963) on the consensus first team list ... a 2014 first-team All-Big 12 selection by The Associated Press, league coaches, ESPN.com and Austin American-Statesman ... played in all 39 games over his three seasons (26 starts) ... announced his intention to declare for the 2015 NFL Draft on Jan. 8 ... attended the 2015 NFL Combine ... ended his career having started 26 straight games which was second on the team behind Cedric Reed (32) ... in 2014 became the first defensive tackle to lead the team in tackles for loss and sacks since Tony Degrade in 1984 ... a member of the watch list for the 2014 Chuck Bednarik Award ... an All-American in high school ... rated as the second-best DT in the nation coming out of high school by ESPN.

### JUNIOR (2014)

Started all 13 games at defensive tackle ... a consensus first team All-American ... named one of three finalists for the Outland Trophy (best interior lineman) on Nov. 25 ... named one of five finalists for the Bronko Nagurski Trophy (top defensive player) on Nov. 20 ... a first-team All-America choice by the AP, FWAA, Sporting News, USA Today, CBS Sports and ESPN.com, and second-team choice by Walter Camp ... a first team All-Big 12 selection by The Associated Press and Austin American-Statesman, the league's coaches and ESPN.com ... third Longhorn defensive tackle to claim first-team All-Big 12 honors from both the AP and coaches in the same season, joining Rodrique Wright (2005) and Casey Hampton (1999, 2000) ... earned semifinalist honors for the Outland Trophy on Nov. 20 ... a named to both the ESPN and SI.com Midseason All-America teams ... a preseason first-team All-Big 12 selection by Athlon and ESPN.com, and a second-team choice by Lindy's and Phil Steele ... led the team in sacks (6.5), tackles for loss (15) and forced fumbles (2), and tied for QB pressures (8) ... sixth on the team in tackles with a career-high 72 ... became the first defensive tackle to lead Texas in tackles for loss and sacks since Tony Degrade in 1984, the year he won the Lombardi Award ... ranked tied for ninth (first among DTs) in the Big 12 in sacks (0.50 per game) ... one of just four Longhorns to record at least 3.5 sacks in the first three games of a season since 2001 (4, Eddie Jones - 2010; 4, Brian Orakpo - 2008; 3.5, Maurice Gordon, 2001) ... recorded three tackles, including one for a loss, and one QB pressure against North Texas ... tied his career high with 10 tackles vs. BYU ... also had career bests in tackles for loss (4) and sacks (2.5), and a forced fumble vs. the Cougars ... became just the 10th Texas player (11 occurrences), and only second defensive tackle (3.0 by Cedric Woodard vs. Texas A&M, 1998), to have 2.5 or more sacks in a game since 1998 ... recorded seven tackles, including three for a loss and a sack, and one QB pressure against UCLA ... had six tackles, one for a loss, and a quarterback pressure against Kansas ... shared the team's defensive player of the game award with Jordan Hicks and Duke Thomas ... made seven tackles (five solo) against Baylor ... had four tackles and a pass breakup against Oklahoma ... had nine tackles, including one sack, against Iowa State ... also recovered a fumble to end the game ... made four stops against Kansas State ... had five tackles and a quarterback pressure in the Texas Tech game ... recorded seven tackles, including two for a loss, and two quarterback pressures against West Virginia ... recorded four stops, including two sacks, and forced a fumble against Oklahoma State ... was named the Big 12

Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against the Cowboys ... was named co-defensive player of the game (also Dylan Haines) by the coaching staff ... recorded four stops against TCU ... had eight tackles vs. Arkansas in the Texas Bowl.

### SOPHOMORE (2013)

Started all 13 games at defensive tackle ... finished the season ranked tied for third on the team in PBUs (5), third in tackles for loss (12) and third in QB pressures (6) ... seventh on the team in tackles (68) ... shared the team's Joseph W. 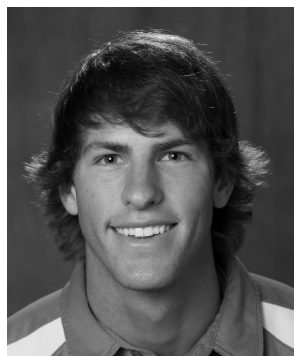

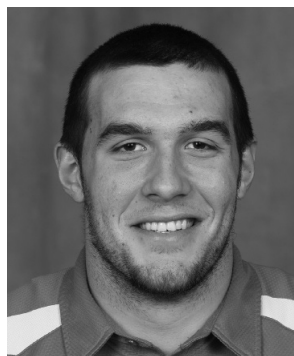

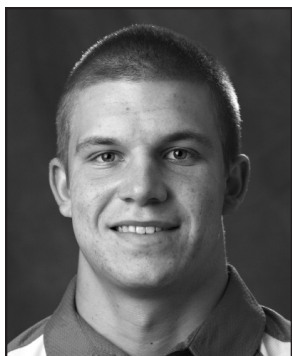
