SIGNIFICANT NUMBERS

91,568 — Attendance. Texas ranked 8th in the nation in home attendance in 2014.

93 — temperature at kickoff with partly cloudy skies. Slight winds out of the east at 3 mph.

106 — games since a freshman QB had thrown for **300+ yards** in a game. Jerrod Heard tallied 364 tonight on 20-of-31. Last time was **Colt McCoy** with 308 yards against Iowa in the Alamo Bowl.

10 — plays of 20+ yards. Texas had **passes** of 22, 45, 26, 54 and 43 yards along with a **run** of 34 yards in the first half. In the second half Texas tallied passing gains of 38 and 26 and rushes of 27 and 45 yards.

68 — games since a QB had thrown for 300 yards and rushed for 100. Heard tallied 364/163 on the night. The last QB to do so was Colt McCoy against Texas A&M on Nov. 26, 2009.

1998 — last time a Longhorn tallied 145 yards receiving.

27 — games since Texas accumulated **600+ yards** of total offense. Texas had 650 on the night (286 rush, 364 pass) to rank 10th in school history. The last time Texas had 600+ yards of total offense was against **New Mexico State** on Aug. 31, 2013 when the Longhorns had 715 yards to open the season and break the school record.

TEAM NOTES

- Texas Team Captains: **Shiro Davis**, **Daje Johnson**, **Alex De La Torre** and honorary team captain **Interim Athletic Director Mike Perrin**
- Series: Texas is now 5-1 against Cal. The Longhorns had won the previous five contests, including the 2011 Holiday Bowl in their last meeting with the Golden Bears.
- Texas nearly overcame a 21-point deficit in the fourth quarter, scoring 20 unanswered points after Cal scored 21 points in the third quarter to cap off 31 unanswered points of its own.
- Texas tallied **650 yards** of total offense (286 rushing, 364 passing) to rank **8th in school history**.

OFFENSE

Jerrod Heard, QB

- Freshman Jerrod Heard posted the first 300-yard game of his career throwing for 364 on 20-of-31. He also ran for 163 yards on 24 carries to lead the team in both categories. His **527 yards of total offense** breaks the previous **school record of 506 by Vince Young** set against Oklahoma State in 2005.
- Heard's **364 yards** passing ties for **10th in school history**. David Ash also threw for 364 against Iowa State in 2012.
- The last time a QB threw for 300 yards and rushed for 100 was **Colt McCoy** against Texas A&M on **Nov. 26, 2009** when he threw for 304 yards and ran for 175.
- Heard's **163 yards** rushing marks the first time a freshman QB has rushed for 100 yards since **Vince Young** tallied 163 yards against Nebraska on Nov. 1, 2003 on 14 carries.
- The last time a **freshman QB** threw for 300 yards was Colt McCoy in the 2006 Alamo Bowl against Iowa.

Daje Johnson, WR

- Posted a **career-high** 145 receiving yards on 5 catches. His previous career-high was 85 yards at Kansas State in 2012 on five receptions. He had 99 yards on just two catches in the first quarter in today's contest.
- Johnson's **145 yards** marks the first 100-yd receiving game by a Longhorn since John Harris against Oklahoma State last season, a span of 5 games.
- His 145 yards receiving were the most since **Wane McGarity** also had 145 against **Rice in 1998**.

Johnathan Gray, RB

- Recorded a career-high 71 yards receiving. His previous high was 41 at Texas Tech in 2012.
- Gray also added 46 yards rushing and 2 TD's.

DEFENSE

- The fumble by Cal's Khalfani Muhammad in the 1st quarter was forced by **S Kevin Vaccaro** and recovered **CB Antwuan Davis**. It was the first forced fumble and fumble recovery, respectively of their careers. **DE Shiro Davis** also forced the first fumble of his career in the first half. Texas scored 10 points off those turnovers.

Kevin Vaccaro, DB

- Registered a career-high **9 tackles**, 7 solo, and forced a fumble. His previous high was 3 tackles against Notre Dame this year. He also tied for the team-lead in tackles tonight.

Malik Jefferson, LB

- Registered a team-high 9 tackles on the night.
