TEAM NOTES

- Texas Team Captains: Marcus Johnson, Marcus Hutchins, Peter Jinkens. Former Texas long snapper Nate Boyer tossed the coin today. Oklahoma State won the toss and deferred to the second half. Texas elected to receive the opening kickoff.
- Series: Texas is now 24-6 against Oklahoma State. The road team has now won seven consecutive years in the series.
- Tyrone Swoopes' 7-yard TD run capped off a 97-yard scoring drive for the Longhorns. The last time Texas had a longer touchdown drive was Sept. 3, 2011, against Rice when the Horns drove 99 yards on eight plays.
- Texas scored two non-offensive touchdowns for the second time this season: 34-yd fumble return by Rassan Ridgeway and 41-yd interception recturn by Holton Hill. The last time Texas scored two defensive touchdowns was Oct. 31, 2009 at Oklahoma State.

OFFENSE

Jerrod Heard, QB

- Tallied 119 yards passing on 9-of-17 throwing and 48 yards rushing.
- Heard's **167 yards** of total offense give him 907 yards through his first three career starts. More than any of the previous six starting QB's for Texas, dating back to Vince Young in 2003.

Tyrone Swoopes, QB

• Came off the bench to spell Jerrod Heard periodically. He had three carries for 35 yards, including a 7-yd TD in the second quarter to give Texas its first lead of the game.

Caleb Bluiett, TE

· Career-long 29-yard reception in third quarter

Marcus Johnson, WR

• Recorded his first reception of the year with a 47-yard grab in the first quarter. It was the second-longest play of his career. His longest was a 65-yard TD catch against TCU his sophomore year.

DEFENSI

Hassan Ridgeway, DT

• Picked up his first career fumble recovery in the second quarter. He returned it 33 yards for a touchdown.

Holton Hill, DI

• Returned interception 41 yards for his first career touchdown.

Peter Jinkens, LB

· Led the team with nine tackles, five of them solo stops and two for loss.
