## GAME-DAY STORYLINES

- The University of Texas women's basketball team continues a five-game homestand when it plays host to UT Rio Grande Valley on Thursday. Tip-off in the Frank Erwin Center is set for 7 p.m. CT and the game will be televised nationally by Longhorn Network.
- **The Series:** Texas and UT Rio Grande Valley (previously UT Pan American) meet for the seventh time in the history of the two programs. The Longhorns lead the all-time series 6-0. The two teams last met on November 26, 2014, a 72-45 Texas win in the Erwin Center.
- **Lang Heating Up:** After a slow start to her senior season, center Kelsey Lang has performed strong in her last four games. In her last three games combined, Lang is averaging a team-leading 12.8 points per game with a squad-best 8.3 rebounds per game. She has also blocked 15 shots during that span. In comparison, in her first three games this season, Lang averaged 4.7 points per game and 5.0 rebounds per game with two blocks.
- **Records Watch:** Junior guard Brooke McCarty has 119 career three-pointers and needs four more three-pointers to surpass Alisha Sare (122) for ninth place all-time in school history. Senior center Kelsey Lang has 128 career blocks and needs two more blocked shots to surpass Tracy Cook (129) for eighth-place on UT's all-time career blocked shots chart.
- **Board Play:** Texas has won the rebounding battle in each of its seven games so far this season. The Longhorns hold a +11.7 margin on the boards this year. Texas ranks 16th in the nation in rebound margin.
- **No. 17 Texas 72, Tennessee 67:** Five Texas players scored in double figures as the No. 17/17 Longhorns held off Tennessee, 72-67, at the Frank Erwin Center. Junior Brooke McCarty and freshman Jada Underwood each scored a team-high 13 points.
- **Up Next:** Texas has a quick turnaround before meeting UTSA on Saturday. Tip-off in the Frank Erwin Center is set for 5 p.m. CT and the game will be televised by Longhorn Network.

Sophomore center Kelsey Lang is beginning to flourish in a bigger role with Texas Women's Basketball. Lang scored a career-best 20 points to help No. 6/9 Texas beat Texas-Pan American, 72-45, on Wednesday night at the Erwin Center.

Lang shot 10-of-13 from the field, renewing her previous career-high scoring mark set less than a week ago, with 14 points as the Longhorns upset No. 6/1 Stanford on Nov. 20.

Last season, Lang averaged 5.4 points in 14 minutes per game. Lang is now averaging a team-best 14.5 points in 31 minutes.

Brady Sanders and Tasia Foman scored 10 points apiece for Texas. Another guard, Brianna Taylor, led the Longhorns in rebounds with a career-best 11 in 11 minutes.

Shwante' Goff led UTPA with 15 points.

### INJURY REPORT

- Junior forward **Audrey-Ann Caron-Goudreau** suffered a left knee bone bruise in Texas' game against Tennessee on Dec. 11. She is day-to-day.
- Junior guard **Ariel Atkins** missed the Tennessee game after a concussion in the Dec. 4 game vs. UConn. She is questionable for Thursday's game and it will be a game-time decision.

### QUICK HITS

- Texas women's basketball is in the midst of its 43rd season of intercollegiate basketball.
- The Longhorns have won 12 conference regular season titles and 10 conference tournament titles.
- Texas is one of just eight programs in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to reach 1,000 all-time wins. The Longhorns achieved the milestone on January 27, 2016. Texas ranks sixth all-time in NCAA history with 1,015 all-time victories.
- The Longhorns consistently play a rigorous non-conference schedule. The Longhorns' schedule consists of six non-conference opponents that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 or further during the 2015-16 campaign.
- Texas head coach **Karen Aston** is eight wins away from 100 on the Forty Acres. She is 92-50 at UT.
- The Longhorns are seeking their 500th all-time win in the Frank Erwin Center this season. Texas has a 499-96 (.839) all-time record within the friendly confines of the Erwin Center, which opened during the 1977-78 season.
- Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Texas is 49-6 (.891) when playing in the Frank Erwin Center.
- Texas has won the rebound battle in each of its seven games so far this season and holds a rebound margin of +11.7. The Longhorns rank 16th nationally in rebound margin.
- Junior guard **Brooke McCarty** has 119 career three-pointers made, which ranks 10th all-time in UT school history. She needs four more three-pointers to surpass Alicia Sare (122) for ninth place all-time.
- McCarty ranks fifth in school history in three-point field goal percentage with a .390 clip (119-of-305). Current Texas assistant **Jamie Carey** holds the school record in three-point field goal percentage at .418. Just three players in UT history - Carey, Kat Nash and Vicki Hall - have shot better than .400 beyond the three-point arc for their careers.
- Senior center **Kelsey Lang** currently ranks ninth in UT school history with 128 career blocks. She needs two more blocks to surpass Tracy Cook (129) for eighth place in school history.

## NOTES FROM OUR LAST GAME

- No. 17/17 Texas defeated Tennessee 72-67 on Sunday in the Frank Erwin Center.
- The Longhorns have now won the last three meetings between the two teams.
- The win was Texas' 499th all-time in the Frank Erwin Center, which opened during the 1977-78 season. The Longhorns are 499-96 (.839) all-time within the Erwin Center.
- Texas used the starting lineup of Audrey-Ann Caron-Goudreau, Kelsey Lang, Brooke McCarty, Alecia Sutton and Brianna Taylor for the first time this season and improves to 1-0 with the current starting five.
- The Longhorns out-rebounded the Lady Vols 40-32 and have now won the rebound battle in each of their seven games this season.
- Texas shot a season-best 76.5 percent (13-of-17) from the free-throw line.
- Five Longhorns scored in double figures in Sunday's game, marking the third time this season that five or more Texas players have scored in double figures.
- Freshman guard Alecia Sutton earned her first career start on Sunday.
- Junior guard Ariel Atkins sat out Sunday's game after suffering a concussion in the team's Dec. 4 game at UConn.
- Senior center Kelsey Lang played a career-high 40 minutes and tied her career high with six blocks. She scored 12 points and added eight rebounds.
- Lang increased her career blocks total to 128, which ranks ninth all-time in UT school history. She needs two more to surpass Tracy Cook (129) for eighth-place on the school's all-time top-10 career list.
- Junior guard Brooke McCarty tallied 13 points, dished out four assists, and knocked down a pair of three-pointers. McCarty now has 119 career three-pointers and needs four more to surpass Alisha Sare (122) for ninth-place all time in program history.
- Freshman guard/forward Jada Underwood scored a career-high 13 points and brought down four rebounds.
- Senior guard Brianna Taylor came up with a game-high three steals.

## BOARD PROWESS

- Texas has experienced great success on the rebounding front during the 2016-17 season. The Longhorns are out-rebounding their opponents by a +11.7 margin, which ranks 16th nationally.
- The Longhorns have won the battle of the boards in each of the seven games they have played this season. Last season, Texas either held or tied for the edge in the rebounding battle in 30 of 36 games last season.
- Three Texas players are averaging four or more rebounds per game, led by senior center Kelsey Lang's team-high 6.9 boards per game.

## MCCARTY STARTS STRONG

- Junior point guard **Brooke McCarty** is off to a strong start, averaging 14.3 points per game, shooting 46.3 percent from the field and knocking down 15 three-pointers. She has dished out a team-high 25 assists.
- McCarty is a Preseason All-Big 12 First-Team selection and is on the Preseason Watch List for the Nancy Lieberman Award. Last season, she was a first-team All-Big 12 selection.
- McCarty is in her first season as the team's starting point guard, though she started the past two seasons at the shooting guard spot.
- McCarty has scored in double figures in six of her team's seven games this season.

## KAREN ASTON MILESTONES

- Texas head coach **Karen Aston** is entering her fifth season at the helm of the Longhorns program. During that time, she has taken Texas back to among the nation's elite programs.
- Aston needs seven more victories to reach her 200th career win. She currently has 193 career wins, which also includes head coaching stops at Charlotte and North Texas.
- Aston is 92-50 (.648) in four years at Texas. She needs eight more wins to achieve her 100th win as the head coach of the Longhorns.
- With 11 more victories, Aston would become the second-winningest coach all-time at Texas. Jody Conratt won 783 games from 1976-2007.

## MCCARTY ON WATCH LIST FOR LIEBERMAN AWARD FOR NATION'S BEST POINT GUARD

- Texas junior **Brooke McCarty** is one of 20 point guards nationally who was named to the preseason watch list for the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Award.
- Now in its 17th year, the Nancy Lieberman Award recognizes the top point guard in NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit floor leadership, play-making and ball-handling skills. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame is the host of the Nancy Lieberman Award.
- McCarty was a first-team All-Big 12 selection as a sophomore in 2015-16 and also was named to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team. She led her team in scoring with 11.8 points per game, knocked down a squad-best 67 three-pointers and was second on the team in assists with 89.

## HOLMES PRESEASON NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR BY COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS

- Texas freshman **Joyner Holmes** has been named the 2016-17 Preseason National Freshman of the Year by College Sports Madness.
- Holmes was the nation's No. 1 recruit in the class of 2016, according to the Blue Star Report and the No. 2 prospect in the espnW Hoop Gurlz Top 100. She was a 2016 McDonald's All-American and was named co-Most Valuable Player of the prestigious Jordan Brand Classic this past spring.
- Holmes averaged an impressive 24.8 points per game, 8.1 rebounds per game, 2.4 assists per game, 2.6 steals per game and 0.8 blocks per game as a high school senior in 2015-16. She charted 13 double-doubles in 35 games last year.

## SUTTON BACK FROM ACL INJURY

- Freshman point guard **Alecia Sutton** was cleared for return to play on Thursday, October 13 following recovery from a left ACL tear during her senior season at Parkway North High School in St. Louis.
- Sutton, a 2016 McDonald's All-American, sustained her injury on December 27, 2015 when her high school team was competing in the 40th Visitation Christmas Tournament and underwent surgery on February 12, 2016. She missed the entire second half of her senior season of high school basketball. At the time of her injury, Sutton was averaging 14.3 points per game for Parkway North.
- Sutton was the No. 6 prospect, according to the espnW Hoop Gurlz Top 100, and the No. 2 point guard in the class of 2016. She was named a 2016 Naismith Second-Team All-American and a McDonald's All-American.

## CAREY RETURNS TO FORTY ACRES

- **Jamie Carey**, a standout basketball player for the University of Texas from 2002-05, rejoined the Longhorns as an assistant coach this past April, replacing Travis Mays, who accepted the head coaching position at SMU.
- Carey was a member of UT's 2003 NCAA Final Four team and also played four years in the WNBA. She has top-caliber experience at every level, including four years at USA Basketball as the assistant women's national team director. She returned to her alma mater after spending the past two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Colorado.
- Carey's responsibilities at Texas include instructing players at the guard position, coordinating the team's offensive schemes and recruiting.

## TEXAS PICKED SECOND IN BIG 12

- Texas was predicted to finish second in the Big 12 Conference this season, according to a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- Baylor received nine of 10 first-place votes and was selected as the league's preseason favorite. Texas garnered the conference's other first-place vote.

Boothe, the nation's No. 3 overall recruit and the No. 1 prospect at the forward position, is a 6-foot-3 recruit out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Fla. Boothe is an Ocala, Fla., native who was named to USA Today's Preseason All-America Team.

Boothe is a versatile left-handed player who can excel at any of the five positions on the floor. Blue Star Report rated her as the No. 2 player in the class of 2017.

Last season as a junior at IMG Academy, Boothe was named a Naismith Trophy Third-Team All-American. She averaged 22.7 points per game, 8.5 rebounds per game and 1.6 steals per game. In a game against Fort Myers High School last year, Boothe scored 41 points and brought down 20 rebounds. She was named a USA Today All-USA Third Team selection and was named to the USA Today All-Florida First Team.

Boothe was a member of the gold medal-winning USA U18 team at the FIBA Americas Championship this past summer. In the championship game, Boothe set a Team USA tournament record for free-throw percentage, shooting 9-for-9 from the charity stripe.

Boothe played the first two seasons of her high school career at Potter's House Christian in Jacksonville, Fla. As a freshman, she averaged 19.1 points per game, 10.6 rebounds per game and 2.2 blocks per game, helping her team to a 32-6 overall record. As a sophomore, she posted averages of 20.7 points per game, 13.8 rebounds per game and 2.7 blocks per game, directing her team to a 38-5 record and the National Association of Christian Athletes national championship. In 2014-15, she was named a MaxPreps Fourth-Team All-American.

Patterson, the nation's No. 1 point guard prospect, is a 5-foot-5 recruit out of North Shore High School in Houston. She was named to USA Today's Preseason All-America Team.

Patterson enters her senior season at North Shore with more than 2,200 points in her prep career and has helped lead her team to a 96-12 (.889) record over the past three seasons. She is known for her floor leadership skills, her athleticism and her threat as a scorer.

As a junior in 2015-16, Patterson averaged 24.5 points per game, 5.4 steals per game and 4.8 assists per game. She was a Texas Association of Basketball Coaches All-State selection and was the District 21-6A Most Valuable Player. Named to the All-Tournament Team of the state tournament, Patterson led her team to the state semifinals with a 36-2 overall record. She was named to the All-Greater Houston first team. In a game against West Brook on Jan. 26, 2016, Patterson impressively recorded a triple-double with 24 points, 12 assists and 11 steals.

As a sophomore, Patterson averaged 21.5 points per game, 4.1 steals per game and 3.9 assists per game. She was a District 21-6A first-team selection and led her team to the regional tournament. In her freshman season of 2013-14, she was named the District 21-6A Newcomer of the Year and a TABC All-State selection. Patterson averaged 15.7 points per game, 3.2 steals per game and 3.1 assists per game. Her squad tallied a 28-7 record and advanced to the regional quarterfinals.

**PALO ALTO, Calif.** -- Stanford junior guard Brittany McPhee posted a career-high 28 points to lead all-scorsers en route to No. 11/10 Stanford's win over No. 8/6 Texas inside Maples Pavilion on Monday night, 71-59.

Tonight marked Texas head coach Karen Aston's 300th career game as a head coach. Aston holds an all-time record of 190-110 (.635) in her 10th season at the helm of a collegiate program.

The Cardinal leads the all-times series over the Longhorns, 7-4, and picks up its first against Texas since the 2013-2014 season.

"They were the better team. We haven't executed things in practice the way we need to," said Aston. "We went through a stretch where we fouled too much, and we went through a stretch where we weren't helping each other defensively. We will get home and get to work because that's all we can do."

Junior guard Brooke McCarty led the Horns across the board, registering a team-high 20 points and five rebounds on the night. Junior guard Ariel Atkins joined her in the double-figures with 14 points, including a 3-of-6 effort from downtown, and a game-high four steals.

As a team, Texas shot 35.3 percent (24-of-68) from the field to Stanford's 54.9 shooting percentage (28-of-51). The Horns outrebounded the Cardinal, 38-32, and registered nine steals in the contest.

Stanford's McPhee capped off her record night with seven rebounds and two assists.

Texas held the early 9-8 edge headed into the first media timeout, but Stanford answered with a 9-4 rally to lead by four (17-13) with 48 seconds remaining in the quarter. The Horns wasted no time on offense with a quick three-pointer from sophomore guard Higgs, and a buzzer-beating tip-in from Atkins closed the first in favor of Texas, 18-17.

The Longhorns held onto their lead until the 5:23 mark of the game when a Cardinal tie tied the match at 24. Stanford gained momentum behind an 11-3 run to lead at the half, 35-29.

Atkins and McCarty found the sweet spot behind the arc to open the second half, cutting the margin to five (40-35 Stanford) at 8:20 mark of the third. The Cardinal extended their lead to double-digits (52-42), but another trey from McCarty and a layup from freshman guard/forward Joyner Holmes got the Horns within five once again. Stanford continued to find its strength in the paint and held the lead heading into the final stretch, 58-50.

An 8-0 Cardinal run was cut short by a three-point play from McCarty, but Stanford continued to convert in the paint. The Cardinal would outscore the Longhorns, 13-9, in the fourth to close the game with the 71-59 win.

Texas will host its first regular season game against the Houston Baptist Huskies inside the Erwin Center on Wednesday, Nov. 16. Tip is slated for 11 a.m. and the game will be carried live on Longhorn Network.

**AUSTIN, Texas** -- Freshman Joyner Holmes was one rebound shy of her first career double-double and led all scorers with 22 points and nine rebounds as the No. 8/10 Texas Women's Basketball toppled Houston Baptist, 98-46, in front of 6,378 fans inside the Frank Erwin Center on Wednesday.

With the win, the Longhorns move to 39-4 (.907) all-time in home openers and hold an unblemished 5-0 record under Texas head coach Karen Aston.

This was the first meeting between Texas and Houston Baptist in program history. The Horns lead the all-time series over Southland Conference foes, 36-9.

"I thought our team came out with a lot of energy," said Aston. "It was a difficult game for us to play this morning, honestly, because of the road trip and how late we got back. I was anxious to see how we would bounce back from a loss. I was pleased with the fact that we were focused and ready to play today."

Holmes's 22-point game came behind an 8-of-17 shooting effort (.471) from the floor. She also added three blocks and one assist. Junior Brooke McCarty followed suit with 16 points, including a 4-of-5 effort from downtown, and four assists.

Junior Ariel Atkins posted 11 points with three steals, while rookies Jada Underwood and Alecia Sutton rounded out the double-digit scorers with 11 and 10 points, respectively.

Senior Kelsey Lang put up two points and two blocks for the game, moving her onto the Texas all-time top-10 list for career blocks with 112.

As a team, Texas shot 46.1 percent (35-of-76) from the floor while holding Houston Baptist to a 28.8 shooting percentage (15-of-52). The Horns dominated every category across the board, including double-figures in assists (18), blocks (10), and steals (11).

Houston Baptist was led by freshman Lauren Calver with 11 points.

Texas jumped out on a 19-3 run to open the game, but the Huskies found their strength from the three-point range, draining four treys in the first quarter, to try and chip away at the Longhorns lead. Early foul trouble proved problematic for HBU, and Texas went on to end the quarter, 28-17.

The Horns held HBU to only four points in the second stanza and used their quick hands to convert 11 points off turnovers. The 29-4 margin quickly widened the Texas lead heading into the locker rooms, 57-21.

The third quarter played to Texas's post advantage, and the Longhorns went on to claim 14 points inside the paint. Holmes put an exclamation point on the quarter with a buzzer-beating jumper to end the stanza, 81-31.

Texas took its largest lead of the night, a 56-point spread, after a three-pointer from Sutton with 6:55 remaining on the game clock. In the end, the Longhorns finished just two shy of the century mark with the 98-46 victory.

Up next on the slate, Texas will travel to Starkville, Miss. to take on No. 10/9 Mississippi State on Sunday, Nov. 20. Tip-off is set for 5 p.m. and the game will be carried on the SEC Network.

**AUSTIN, Texas** – Five Longhorns scored in the double-figures as No. 17/17 Texas Women's Basketball (3-4) held off Tennessee (4-4) inside the Erwin Center on Sunday afternoon, 72-67.

Although Tennessee has the 23-15 edge over Texas in series history, this is the third consecutive meeting the Longhorns have won over the Lady Vols. Texas possesses a 144-72 (.667) record all-time against members of the Southeastern Conference.

"I think that this win is, first of all, much needed for our team," said Texas head coach Karen Aston. "This was just a little bit of a preview of what our games might be like for a while, and that's not a bad thing. It was a good learning experience for our young players."

Junior Brooke McCarty posted 13 points, including two treys, along with four blocks and assists on the match. Freshman Jada Underwood joined her with 13 points of her own, good for her new career high.

Senior Kelsey Lang notched another impressive performance, just two shy of her third-straight double-double with 12 points and eight rebounds. Lang also tied her career-high with six blocks while adding two assists and one steal for the game in a career-high 40 minutes of play.

Freshman Joyner Holmes flirted with her first career double-double, registering 12 points and eight boards. Sophomore Lashann Higgs totaled 12 points, including a 5-of-10 effort from the field.

As a team, Texas shot 45.2 percent (28-of-62) from the floor while holding Tennessee to a 41.8 shooting percentage (28-of-67). Texas outrebounded the Lady Vols, 40-32, and has won the battle of the boards in all seven matches this season.

The Lady Vols were led by junior Jaime Nared with 22 points.

The Longhorns jumped out on an 11-2 run early in the game capped off by a tip-in from Holmes headed into the media timeout. Underwood knocked down the last four points for Texas to close the first stanza in the Horns' favor, 22-12.

Texas took its largest lead of the game at the 6:10 mark of the second quarter when a jumper from freshman Alecia Sutton put Texas on top by 15 (31-16). Tennessee slowly chipped into the Longhorn lead, converting three from downtown, to close the gap to five points headed into the locker rooms, 37-32 Texas.

The Lady Vols opened the second half on a 7-0 rally to take their first lead of the game (39-37) with 6:19 left in the third. From there, it remained a one-possession game, and a buzzer-beater from Higgs put Texas on top headed into the final stretch, 48-46.

After things evened at 52 with 7:36 remaining in the game, the Horns widened their edge to as many as eight (66-58) after a three-point play from Holmes. Tennessee continued to find its strength from behind the arc, knocking down three triples in just over a minute, to make it a 70-67 Texas with 7.3 seconds on the game clock. Underwood put things on ice with two from the charity stripe to end the game, 72-67 Longhorns.

Up next, Texas will continue its homestand against UT Rio Grande Valley on Thursday, Dec. 15. Tip-off inside the Erwin Center is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT, and the game will be televised nationally on Longhorn Network.
