GAME-DAY STORYLINES

- The University of Texas women's basketball team will play its second game in less than 48 hours on Saturday when it plays host to UTSA. Tip-off in the Frank Erwin Center is slated for 5 p.m. CT and the game will be televised nationally by Longhorn Network.
- **The Series:** Texas and UTSA meet for the seventh time in the history of the two programs. The Longhorns lead the all-time series 6-0. Texas and UTSA have met in each of the last three years. Last season, the Longhorns defeated the Roadrunners 90-53 in Austin.
- **Longhorns Earn Win No. 500 In Erwin Center:** Texas' 85-61 win against UTRGV on Thursday night marked the program's 500th all-time win in the Frank Erwin Center. The Longhorns hold a 500-96 (.839) record at home since the Erwin Center opened during the 1977-78 campaign. Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Texas is 50-6 (.893) when playing in the Frank Erwin Center.
- **Records Watch:** Junior guard Brooke McCarty has 121 career three-pointers and needs two more three-pointers to surpass Alisha Sare (122) for ninth place all-time in school history. Senior center Kelsey Lang has 129 career blocks and needs one more blocked shot to surpass Tracy Cook (129) for eighth-place on UT's all-time career blocked shots chart.
- **Board Play:** Texas has won the rebounding battle in each of its eight games so far this season. The Longhorns hold a +12.1 margin on the boards this year. Texas ranks 15th in the nation in rebound margin.
- **No. 17 Texas 85, UTRGV 61:** Freshman Joyner Holmes and senior Kelsey Lang both registered double-doubles as No. 16/17 Texas Women's Basketball defeated UT Rio Grande Valley inside the Frank Erwin Center on Thursday night, 85-61.
- **Up Next:** In its final game before the holiday break, Texas plays host to New Orleans on Tuesday at 7 p.m. CT. The game will be televised nationally by Longhorn Network.

No. 12/11 Texas Women's Basketball opened the 2015-2016 season with a 90-53 victory over the UTSA Roadrunners inside the Frank Erwin Center.

Sophomore Brooke McCarty led all scorers with a career-high 22 points, including a 4-for-6 effort from downtown. Senior Imani Boyette recorded her 28th career double-double for the night with 11 points and 10 rebounds, splitting it evenly between offensive and defensive boards. A total of six Longhorns (McCarty, Boyette, Empress Davenport, Celina Rodrigo, Lashann Higgs, and Kelsey Lang) scored in double digits for the Longhorns.

Texas shot 39.2 percent (29-of-74) from the floor and held UTSA to 27.4 percent (17-of-62) shooting. Texas also added nine three-pointers, tying their 2014-2015 season-high against Iowa State on January 10. The Longhorns outrebounded the Roadrunners in the contest, 57-35.

INJURY REPORT

- Junior forward **Audrey-Ann Caron-Goudreau** suffered a left knee bone bruise in Texas' game against Tennessee on Dec. 11. She is day-to-day.
- Junior guard **Ariel Atkins** has missed the last two games due to a concussion suffered Dec. 4 vs. UConn. She is expected to play on Saturday vs. UTSA.

QUICK HITS

- Texas women's basketball is in the midst of its 43rd season of intercollegiate basketball.
- The Longhorns have won 12 conference regular season titles and 10 conference tournament titles.
- Texas is one of just eight programs in NCAA Division I women's basketball history to reach 1,000 all-time wins. The Longhorns achieved the milestone on January 27, 2016. Texas ranks sixth all-time in NCAA history with 1,016 all-time victories.
- The Longhorns consistently play a rigorous non-conference schedule. The Longhorns' schedule consists of six non-conference opponents that advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 or further during the 2015-16 campaign.
- Texas head coach **Karen Aston** is seven wins away from 100 on the Forty Acres. She is 93-50 (.650) at UT.
- The Longhorns on Thursday earned their 500th all-time win in the Frank Erwin Center. Texas has a 500-96 (.839) all-time record within the friendly confines of the Erwin Center, which opened during the 1977-78 season.
- Since the start of the 2013-14 season, Texas is 50-6 (.893) when playing in the Frank Erwin Center.
- Texas has won the rebound battle in each of its eight games so far this season and holds a rebound margin of +12.1. The Longhorns rank 15th nationally in rebound margin.
- Junior guard **Brooke McCarty** has 121 career three-pointers made, which ranks 10th all-time in UT school history. She needs two more three-pointers to surpass Alicia Sare (122) for ninth place all-time.
- McCarty ranks fifth in school history in three-point field goal percentage with a .390 clip (121-of-310). Current Texas assistant **Jamie Carey** holds the school record in three-point field goal percentage at .418. Just three players in UT history - Carey, Kat Nash and Vicki Hall - have shot better than .400 beyond the three-point arc for their careers.
- Senior center **Kelsey Lang** currently ranks tied for eighth in UT school history with 129 career blocks. She needs one more blocks to surpass Tracy Cook (129) for sole possession eighth place in school history.

- Texas used the starting lineup of Lashann Higgs, Joyner Holmes, Kelsey Lang, Brooke McCarty and Brianna Taylor for the first time this season and improves to 1-0 with the current starting five.
- The Longhorns out-rebounded the Vaqueros 50-35 and have now won the rebound battle in each of their eight games so far this season.
- Two Texas players (Joyner Holmes and Kelsey Lang) had double-doubles in the same game for the first time since January 26, 2013 vs. Kansas State (Imani Boyette and Nneka Enemkpali).
- Texas shot 53.2 percent (33-of-62) from the field, marking the second time this season that the Longhorns have shot 50 percent or better from the floor.
- Freshman guard/forward Joyner Holmes recorded her first career double-double with a game-high 16 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. She also tied her career high with three blocked shots and dished out a career-high four assists.
- Junior guard Brooke McCarty scored 14 points, marking her seventh time in eight games this season to score in double figures. She also dished out a season-high six assists.
- McCarty connected on a pair of three-pointers in the game to increase her career three-pointers made tally to 121. She needs two more three-pointers to surpass Alisha Sare (122) for ninth place on the school's all-time career three-pointers made list.
- Senior center Kelsey Lang charted her fourth career double-double and her third this season with 10 points and 10 rebounds.
- Lang blocked one shot in the game and increased her career blocks total to 129. That ties her with Tracy Cook for eighth place all-time on UT's career blocked shots chart.
- Freshman guard/forward Jada Underwood scored in double figures for the fourth time this season with 12 points. She has tallied double-figure scoring in each of her last three games. Underwood was a perfect 4-for-4 from the floor and 4-for-4 from the free-throw line.
- Freshman guard Alecia Sutton scored a career-high nine points.
- Junior guard Ariel Atkins sat out her second consecutive game after suffering a concussion in the team's Dec. 4 game vs. UConn. Junior Audrey-Ann Caron-Goudreau sat out the game after suffering a left-knee bone bruise in the team's Dec. 11 game vs. Tennessee.

BOARD PROWESS

- Texas has experienced great success on the rebounding front during the 2016-17 season. The Longhorns are out-rebounding their opponents by a +12.1 margin, which ranks 15th nationally.
- The Longhorns have won the battle of the boards in each of the eight games they have played this season.

- Last season, Texas either held or tied for the edge in the rebounding battle in 30 of 36 games last season.
- Three Texas players are averaging four or more rebounds per game, led by senior center Kelsey Lang's team-high 6.4 boards per game.

MCCARTY STARTS STRONG

- Junior point guard **Brooke McCarty** is off to a strong start, averaging 14.3 points per game, shooting 46.6 percent from the field and knocking down 17 three-pointers. She has dished out a team-high 31 assists.
- McCarty is a Preseason All-Big 12 First-Team selection and is on the Preseason Watch List for the Nancy Lieberman Award. Last season, she was a first-team All-Big 12 selection.
- McCarty is in her first season as the team's starting point guard, though she started the past two seasons at the shooting guard spot.
- McCarty has scored in double figures in seven of her team's eight games this season.

LANG FINDING RHYTHM

- Senior center **Kelsey Lang** struggled in her first three games of the season before really finding her rhythm after the team's loss at Mississippi State on Nov. 20.
- In her last five games combined, Lang is averaging 12.2 points per game, 8.6 rebounds per game and 3.2 blocked shots per game. All of those averages lead the team during that stretch.

MCCARTY ON WATCH LIST FOR LIEBERMAN AWARD FOR NATION'S BEST POINT GUARD

- Texas junior **Brooke McCarty** is one of 20 point guards nationally who was named to the preseason watch list for the 2017 Nancy Lieberman Award.
- Now in its 17th year, the Nancy Lieberman Award recognizes the top point guard in NCAA Division I college basketball. Candidates exhibit floor leadership, play-making and ball-handling skills. The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame is the host of the Nancy Lieberman Award.
- McCarty was a first-team All-Big 12 selection as a sophomore in 2015-16 and also was named to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team. She led her team in

scoring with 11.8 points per game, knocked down a squad-best 67 three-pointers and was second on the team in assists with 89.

HOLMES PRESEASON NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR BY COLLEGE SPORTS MADNESS

- Texas freshman **Joyner Holmes** has been named the 2016-17 Preseason National Freshman of the Year by College Sports Madness.
- Holmes was the nation's No. 1 recruit in the class of 2016, according to the Blue Star Report and the No. 2 prospect in the espnW Hoop Gurlz Top 100. She was a 2016 McDonald's All-American and was named co-Most Valuable Player of the prestigious Jordan Brand Classic this past spring.
- Holmes averaged an impressive 24.8 points per game, 8.1 rebounds per game, 2.4 assists per game, 2.6 steals per game and 0.8 blocks per game as a high school senior in 2015-16. She charted 13 double-doubles in 35 games last year.

SUTTON BACK FROM ACL INJURY

- Freshman point guard **Alecia Sutton** was cleared for return to play on Thursday, October 13 following recovery from a left ACL tear during her senior season at Parkway North High School in St. Louis.
- Sutton, a 2016 McDonald's All-American, sustained her injury on December 27, 2015 when her high school team was competing in the 40th Visitation Christmas Tournament and underwent surgery on February 12, 2016. She missed the entire second half of her senior season of high school basketball. At the time of her injury, Sutton was averaging 14.3 points per game for Parkway North.
- Sutton was the No. 6 prospect, according to the espnW Hoop Gurlz Top 100, and the No. 2 point guard in the class of 2016. She was named a 2016 Naismith Second-Team All-American and a McDonald's All-American.

CAREY RETURNS TO FORTY ACRES

- **Jamie Carey**, a standout basketball player for the University of Texas from 2002-05, rejoined the Longhorns as an assistant coach this past April, replacing Travis Mays, who accepted the head coaching position at SMU.
- Carey was a member of UT's 2003 NCAA Final Four team and also played four years in the WNBA. She has top-caliber experience at every level, including four years at USA Basketball as the assistant women's national team director. She returned to her alma mater after spending the past two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Colorado.
- Carey's responsibilities at Texas include instructing players at the guard position, coordinating the team's offensive schemes and recruiting.

TEXAS PICKED SECOND IN BIG 12

- Texas was predicted to finish second in the Big 12 Conference this season, according to a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- Baylor received nine of 10 first-place votes and was selected as the league's preseason favorite. Texas garnered the conference's other first-place vote.

Boothe, the nation's No. 3 overall recruit and the No. 1 prospect at the forward position, is a 6-foot-3 recruit out of IMG Academy in Bradenton, Fla. Boothe is an Ocala, Fla., native who was named to USA Today's Preseason All-America Team.

Boothe is a versatile left-handed player who can excel at any of the five positions on the floor. Blue Star Report rated her as the No. 2 player in the class of 2017.

Last season as a junior at IMG Academy, Boothe was named a Naismith Trophy Third-Team All-American. She averaged 22.7 points per game, 8.5 rebounds per game and 1.6 steals per game. In a game against Fort Myers High School last year, Boothe scored 41 points and brought down 20 rebounds. She was named a USA Today All-USA Third Team selection and was named to the USA Today All-Florida First Team.

Boothe was a member of the gold medal-winning USA U18 team at the FIBA Americas Championship this past summer. In the championship game, Boothe set a Team USA tournament record for free-throw percentage, shooting 9-for-9 from the charity stripe.

Boothe played the first two seasons of her high school career at Potter's House Christian in Jacksonville, Fla. As a freshman, she averaged 19.1 points per game, 10.6 rebounds per game and 2.2 blocks per game, helping her team to a 32-6 overall record. As a sophomore, she posted averages of 20.7 points per game, 13.8 rebounds per game and 2.7 blocks per game, directing her team to a 38-5 record and the National Association of Christian Athletes national championship. In 2014-15, she was named a MaxPreps Fourth-Team All-American.

Patterson, the nation's No. 1 point guard prospect, is a 5-foot-5 recruit out of North Shore High School in Houston. She was named to USA Today's Preseason All-America Team.

Patterson enters her senior season at North Shore with more than 2,200 points in her prep career and has helped lead her team to a 96-12 (.889) record over the past three seasons. She is known for her floor leadership skills, her athleticism and her threat as a scorer.

As a junior in 2015-16, Patterson averaged 24.5 points per game, 5.4 steals per game and 4.8 assists per game. She was a Texas Association of Basketball Coaches All-State selection and was the District 21-6A Most Valuable Player. Named to the All-Tournament Team of the state tournament, Patterson led her team to the state semifinals with a 36-2 overall record. She was named to the All-Greater Houston first team. In a game against West Brook on Jan. 26, 2016, Patterson impressively recorded a triple-double with 24 points, 12 assists and 11 steals.

As a sophomore, Patterson averaged 21.5 points per game, 4.1 steals per game and 3.9 assists per game. She was a District 21-6A first-team selection and led her team to the regional tournament. In her freshman season of 2013-14, she was named the District 21-6A Newcomer of the Year and a TABC All-State selection. Patterson averaged 15.7 points per game, 3.2 steals per game and 3.1 assists per game. Her squad tallied a 28-7 record and advanced to the regional quarterfinals.

AUSTIN, Texas – Five Longhorns scored in the double-figures as No. 17/17 Texas Women's Basketball (3-4) held off Tennessee (4-4) inside the Erwin Center on Sunday afternoon, 72-67.

Although Tennessee has the 23-15 edge over Texas in series history, this is the third consecutive meeting the Longhorns have won over the Lady Vols. Texas possesses a 144-72 (.667) record all-time against members of the Southeastern Conference.

"I think that this win is, first of all, much needed for our team," said Texas head coach Karen Aston. "This was just a little bit of a preview of what our games might be like for a while, and that's not a bad thing. It was a good learning experience for our young players."

Junior Brooke McCarty posted 13 points, including two treys, along with four blocks and assists on the match. Freshman Jada Underwood joined her with 13 points of her own, good for her new career high.

Senior Kelsey Lang notched another impressive performance, just two shy of her third-straight double-double with 12 points and eight rebounds. Lang also tied her career-high with six blocks while adding two assists and one steal for the game in a career-high 40 minutes of play.

Freshman Joyner Holmes flirted with her first career double-double, registering 12 points and eight boards. Sophomore Lashann Higgs totaled 12 points, including a 5-of-10 effort from the field.

As a team, Texas shot 45.2 percent (28-of-62) from the floor while holding Tennessee to a 41.8 shooting percentage (28-of-67). Texas outrebounded the Lady Vols, 40-32, and has won the battle of the boards in all seven matches this season.

The Lady Vols were led by junior Jaime Nared with 22 points.

The Longhorns jumped out on an 11-2 run early in the game capped off by a tip-in from Holmes headed into the media timeout. Underwood knocked down the last four points for Texas to close the first stanza in the Horns' favor, 22-12.

Texas took its largest lead of the game at the 6:10 mark of the second quarter when a jumper from freshman Alecia Sutton put Texas on top by 15 (31-16). Tennessee slowly chipped into the Longhorn lead, converting three from downtown, to close the gap to five points headed into the locker rooms, 37-32 Texas.

The Lady Vols opened the second half on a 7-0 rally to take their first lead of the game (39-37) with 6:19 left in the third. From there, it remained a one-possession game, and a buzzer-beater from Higgs put Texas on top headed into the final stretch, 48-46.

After things evened at 52 with 7:36 remaining in the game, the Horns widened their edge to as many as eight (66-58) after a three-point play from Holmes. Tennessee continued to find its strength from behind the arc, knocking down three triples in just over a minute, to make it 70-67 Texas with 7.3 seconds on the game clock. Underwood put things on ice with two from the charity stripe to end the game, 72-67 Longhorns.

Up next, Texas will continue its homestand against UT Rio Grande Valley on Thursday, Dec. 15. Tip-off inside the Erwin Center is scheduled for 7 p.m. CT, and the game will be televised nationally on Longhorn Network.

AUSTIN, Texas – Freshman Joyner Holmes and Senior Kelsey Lang both registered double-doubles as No. 16/17 Texas Women's Basketball defeated UTRGV inside the Drum on Thursday night, 85-61.

The victory marks 500 all-time wins for Texas Women's Hoops inside the Erwin Center. The Longhorns hold a 500-96 (.839) record at home since the Erwin Center opened during the 1977-78 campaign.

This is the first time two Texas players have notched double-doubles in the same game since Imani Boyette and Nneka Enemikpali accomplished the feat against Kansas State on Jan. 26, 2013.

Texas holds a perfect 7-0 record over UTRGV in series history.

"It's always exciting to be part of a win that is historic," said Texas head coach Karen Aston. "I'm happy it was the 500th in the Erwin Center, and it just means a whole lot of special basketball has gone on here for a whole lot of years, and we're really proud to be a part of that."

Holmes led the way for Texas with a game-high 16 points and career-high 13 rebounds. The freshman also totaled a career-high four assists and three blocks.

Lang picked up her third double-double of the season with 10 points and rebounds, respectively. She also added one block for the night, moving her in a tie for 8th place all-time on the Texas blocked shots list with Tracy Cook (1998-02).

Junior Brooke McCarty posted 14 points along with five boards and a game-high six assists. Freshman Jada Underwood rounded out the Longhorns in the double figures with 12 points, including a perfect 4-4 effort from both the field and the charity stripe.

As a team, Texas shot 53.2 percent (33-62) from the field while holding UTRGV to a 29.2 shooting percentage (21-72). The Longhorns outrebounded the Vaqueros, 50-35, and have not lost a battle of the boards yet this season.

UTRGV was led by senior Shawnte' Goff and sophomore Bernesha Peters with 12 points each.

The Horns opened on a 9-2 push to start the game, and consecutive McCarty to Holmes lay-ups made it 15-10 Texas at a UTRGV timeout with 6:08 remaining in the first. Texas closed with a sophomore Jordan Hosey jumper and six lay-ups to end the first quarter, 29-17.

It was a 17-15 battle with Texas narrowly holding the edge as the Vaqueros found all their points from downtown with five triples in the second stanza. McCarty knocked down her first trey of the game at the 2:51 mark, and the Longhorns headed into the half with the 46-32 lead.

The Horns held UTRGV to only eight points in the third quarter and took their largest lead of the night, a 33-point spread, with just under a minute remaining. Lang knocked down two from the line to close the third, 71-40 Texas.

The Vaqueros held the edge in the closing quarter, 21-14, but it wasn't enough as Texas went on to win the game, 85-61.

Coming up, the Longhorns have a quick turnaround as they host UTSA inside the Drum on Saturday night. Tip is set for 5 p.m. CT, and the game will be broadcasted on Longhorn Network.
