Texas Track & Field will host its final home meet of the outdoor season this weekend when the Longhorns welcome teams from across the state and nation to Mike A. Myers Stadium for the Texas Invitational on Friday and Saturday.

Action is set to begin at 10 a.m. each day with Day 1 featuring a number of field events early on and a series of distance events to close the evening. Saturday will see another elite pole vault competition that will feature world indoor record holder Renaud Lavillenie of France and three other world-class vaulters from France. Team USA Olympian Logan Cunningham will be in that field as a total of four Olympians take the runway in the men's pole vault Saturday afternoon. The women's pole vault on Saturday is expected to feature world indoor record holder Jenn Suhr as Myers Stadium again brings top talent to Austin to jump.

The Longhorns will see strong competition in a number of the field events with Kansas State, Michigan and Princeton having athletes that rank among the NCAA leaders set to compete in the throwing events. The distance events welcome some of the national leaders from Michigan and Princeton as well as the hosting Longhorns. In the sprints it will be Texas taking on the likes of conference rivals Baylor along with Houston runners among the top in the NCAA so far in 2018.

Admission to the meet is free both days as fans are encouraged to take in the track meet as part of a full schedule of events on campus this weekend with Texas Softball and both Texas Men's Tennis and Texas Women's Tennis home for competition.

Fans unable to attend can follow the action from the Texas Invitational online with live results provided by Karma Rush. - Texas Track & Field is again among the top programs in the NCAA this season with the women ranked No. 8 in the latest USTFCCA Rankings heading into this week's action. The men's squad comes in at No. 22 this week.

## EVENTS TO WATCH

### TEXAS INVITATIONAL

#### • MEN'S POLE VAULT

Myers Stadium is among the best places in America to pole vault and its reputation has some of the world's best here this weekend to jump. Olympic gold medalist and world indoor record holder **Renaud Lavillenie** headlines a field loaded with post-collegiate athletes and world class talent as 4 Olympians take the runway on Saturday.

#### • WOMEN'S 400M HURDLES

A trio of runners set to battle for the Big 12 title will face each other this weekend with junior **Mariam Abdul-Rashid** and senior **Ariel Jones** taking on Kansas State's Ranae McKenzie. Abdul-Rashid currently ranks No. 6 in the NCAA this season with her time of 57.40 seconds. McKenzie is 8th and Jones is 12th. Jones is seeking to become the first woman to win 4 Big 12 titles in this event.

#### • WOMEN'S 100M HURDLES

Texas has one of the deepest groups of hurdlers in the nation. All-Americans **Rushelle Burton**, **Pedrya Seymour** and **Ariel Jones** joined by junior **Mariam Abdul-Rashid** give Texas a major scoring threat at Big 12's. Burton leads the NCAA this season with a time of 12.64 seconds to win the Texas Relays. All 4 of these Longhorns rank in the Top 48 in the NCAA this year.

#### • WOMEN'S HAMMER THROW

Sophomore **Elena Bruckner** broke senior **Lauryn Caldwell**'s school record in this event at Texas Relays as the pair look to have a friendly battle all season. Kansas State brings 2 throwers ranked in the Top 12 in the NCAA this year and Houston adds another at No. 16 to make this a strong field.

#### • MEN'S 200M

Freshman **Micaiah Harris** will see some of the top runners in the country when he gets in the blocks for this event. Half of Houston's NCAA champion 4x100m relay team is in the race and K-State's Terrell Smith gives the 200m a trio of All-Americans running along with 3 more post-collegiate athletes in the field.

• Bruckner broke the school record in the hammer throw on her first attempt with a mark of 56.21m (184-5). That mark surpassed teammate Lauryn Caldwell's mark of 55.42m.

• After her 3 attempts in Flight 1, Bruckner ran across campus to take a test in her Psychology of Advertising class while still wearing her uniform. She then hustled back to the track in time to take her final 2 throws in the finals.

• She finished the meet in 7th place and later tweeted that she made a 96 on her test.

### Lloyd Shatters Steeplechase Record

• Junior **Meghan Lloyd** shattered her own school record in the 3000m steeplechase to open her 2018 outdoor season. She shaved more than 7 seconds off her time to finish 2nd at the Texas Relays, clocking in at 10:13.35.

• Lloyd's time ranks her No. 2 in the Big 12 Conference this year and 13 in the NCAA.

• She held the lead for much of the race but was unable to hold off Clemson's Logan Morris to finish runner-up a second straight year at Texas Relays.

• Lloyd was not alone for Texas in registering solid marks in the steeplechase. Sophomore **Abby Guidry** made her career debut in the steeplechase and came in 3rd place with a time of 10:35.34. That time ranks her 3rd in school history and 5th in the Big 12 this season.

• Redshirt freshman **Skyler Bollinger** also clocked in with a Texas top 10 time at 10:56.05. She finished 7th, which also is her rank in school history. Bollinger has previous steeplechase experience having ran and won a 2000m steeplechase last year unattached at the Longhorn Invitational.

### Rice Wins Opener

• Redshirt sophomore **John Rice** dominated the field in his season opener to win the steeplechase at the Texas Relays. His time of 8:46.52 bested the competition by nearly 10 full seconds and cut 11 seconds off his previous personal best time.

• He currently sits at No. 8 in the NCAA this season and leads the Big 12 Conference. His time ranks him as the No. 9 Longhorn in school history.

### DMR Pulls Away in Dramatic Win

• The men's distance medley relay team of **Sam Worley**, **Andrew Price**, **Logan Emery** and **Alex Rogers** put together an impressive victory at the Texas Relays with a time of 9:43.99.

• The Longhorns led throughout much of the race before Rogers let the anchor leg from Texas A&M take the lead. Then with 300m to go, Rogers kicked it in gear, leaving the Aggies behind at the finish line.

• It marked the first time since 2013 the Longhorns won the DMR at their biggest home meet of the year.

### Piperi Claims Victory in Outdoor Debut

• Fresh off a 7th place finish at the NCAA Indoor Championships, freshman **Tripp Piperi** grabbed his first win of the outdoor season in the shot put at the Texas Relays.

- Piperi never trailed in the competition and eventually won by more than a foot with his toss of 19.60m (64-3.75).
- His throw ranks him 8th in school history and currently stands at No. 8 in the NCAA this season.

### Burton Rolls to NCAA Lead

- Sophomore hurdler **Rushelle Burton** showed she is ready for outdoor season with a blazing fast time of 12.64 seconds to win the 100m hurdles at the Texas Relays.
- After clocking 13.14 in the prelims, Burton took charge and rolled her way to victory in the final in a wind-aided time that leads the NCAA and is currently No. 2 in the world this year.
- Burton led a group of Longhorns in the final with senior Pedrya Seymour finishing 3rd, junior Mariam Abdul-Rashid finished 6th and senior Ariel Jones was 9th.
- The group of hurdlers represents a big scoring opportunity for Texas at the Big 12 Conference Championship later this year.

### Senior Javelin Throwers Continue to Thrive

- Seniors **Haley Crouser** and **Fabian Dohmann** are among the national leaders this year in the javelin as the pair has opened the 2018 outdoor season with a trio of impressive performances.
- Crouser has won both of her meets this year with big throws and dominated the field winning by more than 12 feet in her opener at the UTSA Invitational. Her throw of 53.94m (176-11) marked her best throw of her collegiate career and moves her closer to the school record of 182-6.
- The throw for Crouser bested her own meet record set last year when she threw the javelin 51.41m. It also is nearly three feet farther than her throw that earned her eighth place at the NCAA Championships last year.

- Crouser backed that up with a win at the Texas Relays and 51.29m (168-3). She took the win as the top collegiate in the field with the lone post-collegiate athlete not eligible for the victory.
- Dohmann took 2nd place at the Texas Relays with a throw of 74.13m (243-2). He fell to Utah State's Sindri Gudmundsson, who ranks No. 2 in the NCAA this year.
- Dohmann's throw at Texas Relays was just 5cm short of his mark from the UTSA Invitational earlier in the month that saw him set a new meet record of 74.18m. That distance currently ranks Dohmann No. 4 in the NCAA this season.

### Longhorns Morn Loss of Clyde Rabb Littlefield

- Texas Athletics mourns the loss of a Lifetime Longhorn who made a significant impact on not only the department, but also the entire University of Texas at Austin campus — Clyde Rabb Littlefield
- Clyde Rabb Littlefield passed away Wednesday, March 7, 2018.
- The son of legendary Longhorn track & field and football coach Clyde Littlefield, Clyde Rabb Littlefield remained heavily involved in the Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays his father started in 1925.

### Wasome Leaps to NCAA Crown

- Sophomore **O'Brien Wasome** made history for the Longhorns in the triple jump by winning the first men's NCAA Indoor title in the event at Texas. His jump of 16.82 meters (55-4.25) also broke the school record in the event.
- Wasome finished 3rd at NCAA Indoors last year as a freshman and he said that performance motivated him and gave him confidence that he could come back and win this year.
- He opened the meet with 3 big jumps and found himself in 2nd place behind the defending national champion through the first 3 jumps. After a foul in Round 4, Wasome lined up the best jump of his career on his 5th attempt. He measured at 16.82m to take the lead from Florida's KeAndre Bates by 6 inches, and that difference would hold through the final round of jumps.

### Zapalac Breaks School Record at NCAA Indoors

- Senior **Alan Zapalac** finally qualified for the NCAA Championships in his final year as a Longhorn and he did not take that opportunity for granted, finishing in 8th place and breaking the school record in the process.
- On the final throw of his career, Zapalac hurled the 35-pound weight 22.15 meters (72-8.00) to break the school record held by Canadian Olympian Dylan Armstrong.
- Zapalac's appearance was just the 2nd time in school history Texas had a representative in the men's weight throw. Armstrong finished 4th in 2001 when he set the school record at 22.12m.

### McCarter Finishes 5th at NCAAs

- Junior **Steffin McCarter** made it back-to-back years finishing on the podium at NCAA Indoors. He leapt a distance of 7.94 meters (26-0.75) on his 5th attempt to move up from 6th place into 4th. During the final round of jumps he was passed up by another competitor to finish in 5th place.
- An example of the depth and strength of the field this year is shown in the results. Last year, McCarter finished 3rd with a jump of 7.83m.

### Piperi Makes Podium as Freshman

- Freshman thrower Tripp Piperi earned his way onto the podium in the shot put at the NCAA Indoor Championships, joining an elite class of freshman to finish in the top 8.
- The Big 12 champion finished in 7th place in the shot put with his toss of 19.46m (63-10.25). In an event normally that does not see freshman make the podium, Piperi was part of a changing of the guard so to speak with 3 freshman finishing in the top 8 this year.

### **Women's 4x400m Takes for 8th at NCAAs**

- The Texas women's 4x400m relay was the last team to qualify for NCAA Indoor Championships and took advantage of the chance to compete at the national meet by moving up the ranks and finishing in 8th place.
- The team of Serenity Douglas, Zola Golden, Mariam Abdul-Rashid and Ariel Jones combined to run 3:33.06 to win their heat. That time would hold up through the other 3 heats to take 8th place.
- By making the podium and scoring for the Longhorns, Texas kept its streak of scoring at the NCAA Indoor Championships alive dating back to 1984.

### **Texas Women Win Big 12 Championship**

- The Texas women claimed their 4th Big 12 indoor title in 5 years amassing 117 points and holding off then-ranked No. 13 Kansas by just 5 points.
- The win was a total team effort with the Longhorns scoring points in all but 3 of the 19 events.
- Texas used its depth in the hurdles, mid-distance and pentathlon to grab big points in those areas. The Longhorns had 4 runners make the final in the 60m hurdles to combine for 27 points with **Pedrya Seymour, Rushelle Burton** and **Ariel Jones** finishing 1-2-3. **Megan Rourke** and **Sydne Fowler** finished 2-3 in the 600yds to score 14 point. And the group of **Ashtin Zamzow, Georgia Wahl** and **Virginia Preiss** earned 17 points in the pentathlon. Zamzow became the first Longhorn to win the event.
- The mid-distance and distance runners combined to score 34 of the team's points and play a big role in the win.
- The sprints/hurdles group tallied 46 points on the women's side and the throwers and pole vaulters contributed 34 points to the victory. The jumps group added 3 points.
- Texas has now won 9 women's Big 12 Indoor Championships, 3 more than the next school.

### **Longhorns Sweep Multi-Events**

- **Ashtin Zamzow** made history for the Longhorns becoming the first woman to win a Big 12 title in the pentathlon.
- Her score of 4,076 points also set a new school record for Texas.
- Zamzow was in a battle with Texas Tech's Kaylee Hinton throughout the competition and it came down to the narrowest of margins as she defeated Hinton by just 1 point.
- Going into the final event, Zamzow needed to make sure Hinton did not finish more than half a second ahead of her in the 800m. The both came to the line together with Hinton just edging Zamzow, but the Longhorn dove for the finish line and clocked 2:18.02 and was .44 behind Hinton's 2:17.58.
- It marked only the 2nd time in Big 12 history the pentathlon was decided by single digits.
- **George Patrick** dominated the field to win the heptathlon with a total of 5,552 points. He posted personal bests in all 4 events on Day 1 to take command and build a comfortable cushion.
- His win marked the 9th Big 12 title for the Texas men in the heptathlon, an event they have had more success in than any other team in the conference.
- With Zamzow and Patrick both winning their respective multi-event crowns, it marked just the 4th time a school has won both the pentathlon and heptathlon, joining Missouri 2003, Nebraska 2011 and Kansas State 2014.

### **Hurdlers Score Big at Big 12s**

- Texas showed off its depth in the 60m hurdles again to help the women's team win the Big 12 title as 4 Longhorns qualified for the final and combined to score 27 points.
- Senior **Pedrya Seymour** won with a time of 8.09 to grab her first conference title of her career, even dating back to her time at Illinois in the Big Ten. Sophomore **Rushelle Burton** was 2nd and senior Ariel Jones was 3rd. Junior Mariam Abdul-Rashid took sixth.
- Texas now has 8 Big 12 titles in the 60m hurdles to go along with the 2 titles in the 55m hurdles the conference ran in 1997 and 1998.

### **Men's Distance Crew Claims Big 12 Crowns**

- The Longhorns made a statement in the distance events at the Big 12 Indoor Championship, winning a pair of events and scoring big points across the board.
- Texas closed the first night of competition with a dominant win in the Distance Medley Relay. The team of **Alex Rogers, Terry Brown Jr., Logan Emery** and **Sam Worley** combined to run 9:40.11 after a strong opening leg from Rogers gave Texas a huge lead.
- The win marked the first for Texas since 2009 in the men's DMR.
- Texas earned another conference title in a distance event with Rogers running away from the field in the mile. He clocked 4:02.60 to win by more than 3 seconds and claim UT's first mile championship since 2008.
- The Longhorns added valuable points in the 800m with Worley finishing 3rd. Emery joined Rogers in the final of the mile and finished fifth to make it 14 points in that event. **Jake McConnell** took 6th in the 1000m. The pair of **John Rice** and **Charles Mills** combined for 7 points in the 5000m and Rice added 5 more points in the 3000m.
