MONSTER SHOTS

Since the opening of UFCU Disch-Falk Field in 1975, only 42 players (for a total of 53 times) have cleared the “Monster” in straightaway centerfield, 400 feet from home plate. For the first 45 seasons at UFCU Disch-Falk Field, the wall sat 20-feet high and had to be cleared for a home run. Prior to the start of the 2021 season, the “monster” was raised to 28-feet and now a ball hit off the wall is ruled a homer. The last time it was accomplished by a Longhorn player was April 9, 2023 (Garret Guillemette vs. Kansas State). Below is a list of those who have hit the ball out of the deepest part of UFCU Disch-Falk Field.
