WEATHER: Day opened with temperature 79 degrees; wind out of the south at 15-23 MPH and humidity of 62%. Light rain fell during most of the long jump, all of the shot put and a few minutes of the high jump. The 100 meter heats were all wind-aided by winds of 12 to 15 MPH. All timing: hand timing.

NOTES: Coffman took the lead on the 100 meters with a new PR and Texas Relays and Memorial Stadium decathlon 100 meters record of 10.3. Wise set the same records with a long jump of 24-4¼. Coffman broke the same records with a PR shot put of 52-4, and ran a 48.7 400 meters to set new Texas Relays and Memorial Stadium record of 4226 points for the first day. The high jump took one hour and fifty-five minutes. The day started at 1:00 pm and finished at 6:10 for five hours and ten minutes. Wise and Swanger attempted a new double record of 2.08 meters (6-9 7/8) in the high jump. Coffman needed to run a 50.4 400 meters to break the first day points record.

Wise took the lead after the vault and held it through the javelin. Alexander needed to beat Wise by at least 4.5 seconds in the 1500 to win the meet. Swanger is an 18 year old freshman in his second full decathlon.

"I got to Austin on a late flight last night because I had an exam yesterday afternoon. I guess I got to the motel after midnight. Then I couldn't get to ~~sleep~~ sleep. I rolled around in bed until after two am. Then I had to wake up at 7 am. So I was pretty lucky to win today. This is the first meet I've had since the NCAA Indoor (4 weeks) so my form is not right. I'm inconsistent."

William Snoddy, Oklahoma soph who led off OU's winning sprint medley; he ran a 9.87 100 at Dallas last weekend but pulled slightly:

"My leg felt fine, it didn't hurt. I was out there for just onething -- to get them a lead. We were here to win."

Randy Wilson, OU senior who anchored sprint medley win 3:17.62 and ran 1:48.1; OU swept the Texas-Kansas-Drake sprint medley in 1977:

"I first wanted to pass Ongwae on the backstretch, but he sped up and wouldn't let me past. So I decided to wait until the final straight. I felt fine ."

Randy Wilson-"The N.M runner wanted the lead and took it. That's alright. It makes it easier for me. I felt good all the way. Our goal this year? A triple crown sweep.

Mike Carter, Thomas Jefferson H.S. (winner in H.S. shot put) "Three weeks ago in warmups, I threw it 74 feet, so I felt like today I could throw it well." Carter threw it 71-1½. Third best throw ever by a high school youngster.

Jim McGoldrick, winner of the open discus throw with a toss of 210-10. "Very Satisfied with my throw. The best I've thrown so far is 202. I'm really pleased... it's just a great place to throw. I'd like to think I'm on my way to Moscow. Today is a good indication I can throw really well."

Frank Estes, Abilene Christian (winner of the pole vault at 17-0 -- "I'm very satisfied. The last five times I've been down here, I haven't cleared the opening height. This year I came down with that in mind and I won it. Today I felt good. The wind was the best I've ever seen in the east end. I also used a smaller pole today which made a difference. (Estes is a recent transfer from the University of Texas to A.C.)

Louise Ritter, TWU (winner of women's high jump at 6-0)--"It went real well today. I've been out for three weeks with an ankle injury. Obviously, we still need improvement on them. My switch to Brooks was a tight one." Leslie Kerr - "Brooks ran up on me and our exchange was pretty sorry. But Dickey and I had a pretty good pass." Curtis Dickey - "I was in third or fourth place when I received the baton but our handoff gave me a good running start."

Members of Arkansas" winning 4-mile relay team -- Steve Baker - "Our time was a little slow but with the wind it was about the best we could hope for. Mark Anderson - "We knew Arizona was the team we had to stay with so that's what we tried to do." Anchor Mike Clark - "I've been around 4 minutes for a couple of weeks, but that was my best time ever on an open race or in a relay. My strategy, as always, was try to stay close to the front and go all out to the last 660. I try to hold on because that's all I could do. The rest of the team did a great job. We have ~~to~~ two good freshmen and I wish I was one too so that I could go with them for the next two years."

John Kerbiro, Abilene Christian -- (winner of the 3,000 meter steeplechase) The wind was too much to run the kind of time I wanted to which would have been around 8:29."

Rickey Davenport, Southern Univ. (winner of the 110-meter HH) -- "Man, I was tight at the beginning and I tried to loosen up at the beginning of the race. I knew it was going to be tight because we had all ran about the same times yesterday. Everybody was so bunched up and hitting hurdles that a couple of them bit the dust. For sure, this is my biggest mile victory, because I haven't run that many of them. However, I'd have to admit the mile has made me stronger. My best race? 800 meters.
